CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for a military service headstone medallion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a military service headstone medallion showing my new design; and,

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof, the undisclosed rear is not part of the claimed design.
