DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a preferred embodiment of
the footwear outsole;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof.

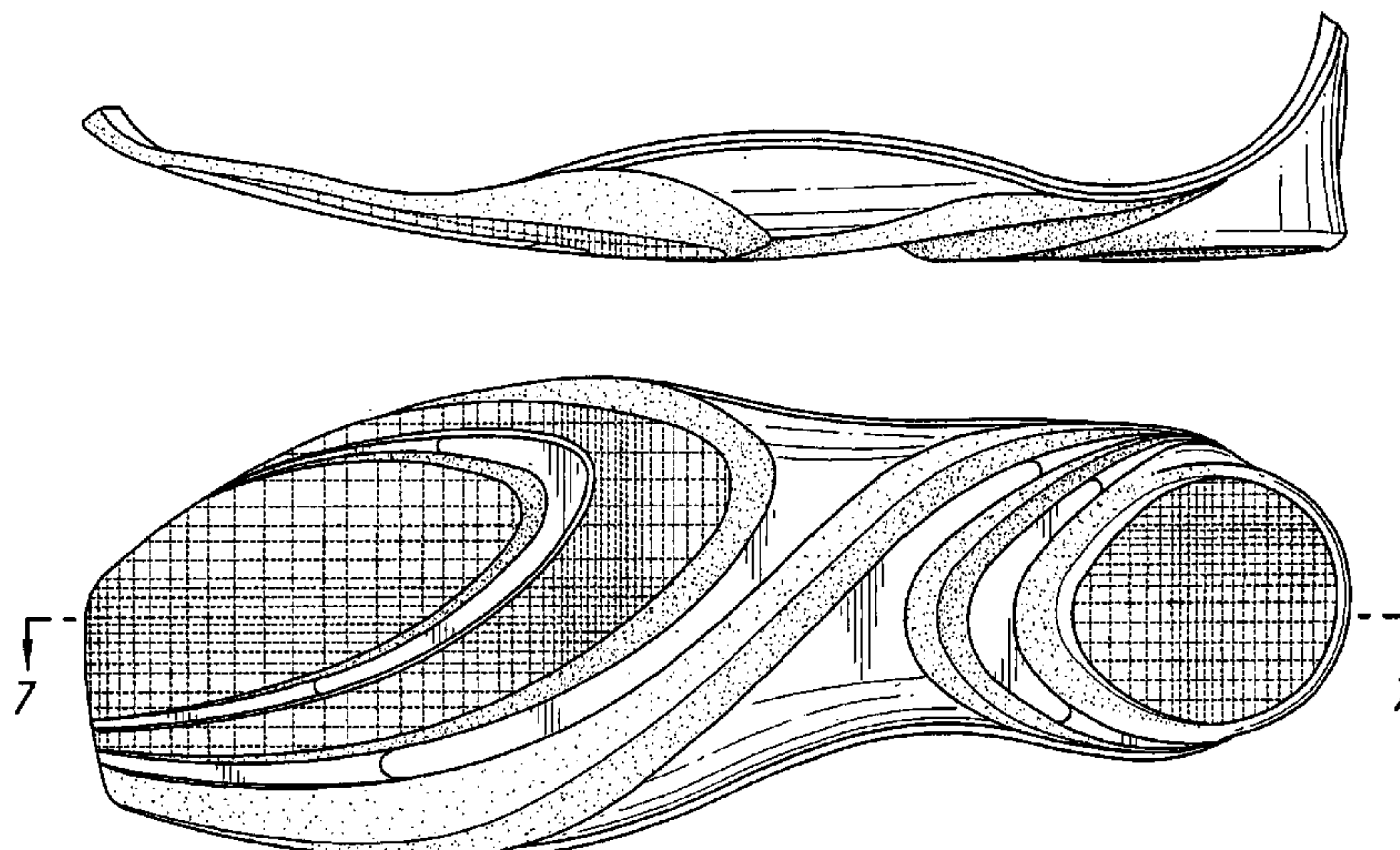
The broken lines creating a grid pattern on the surface of the

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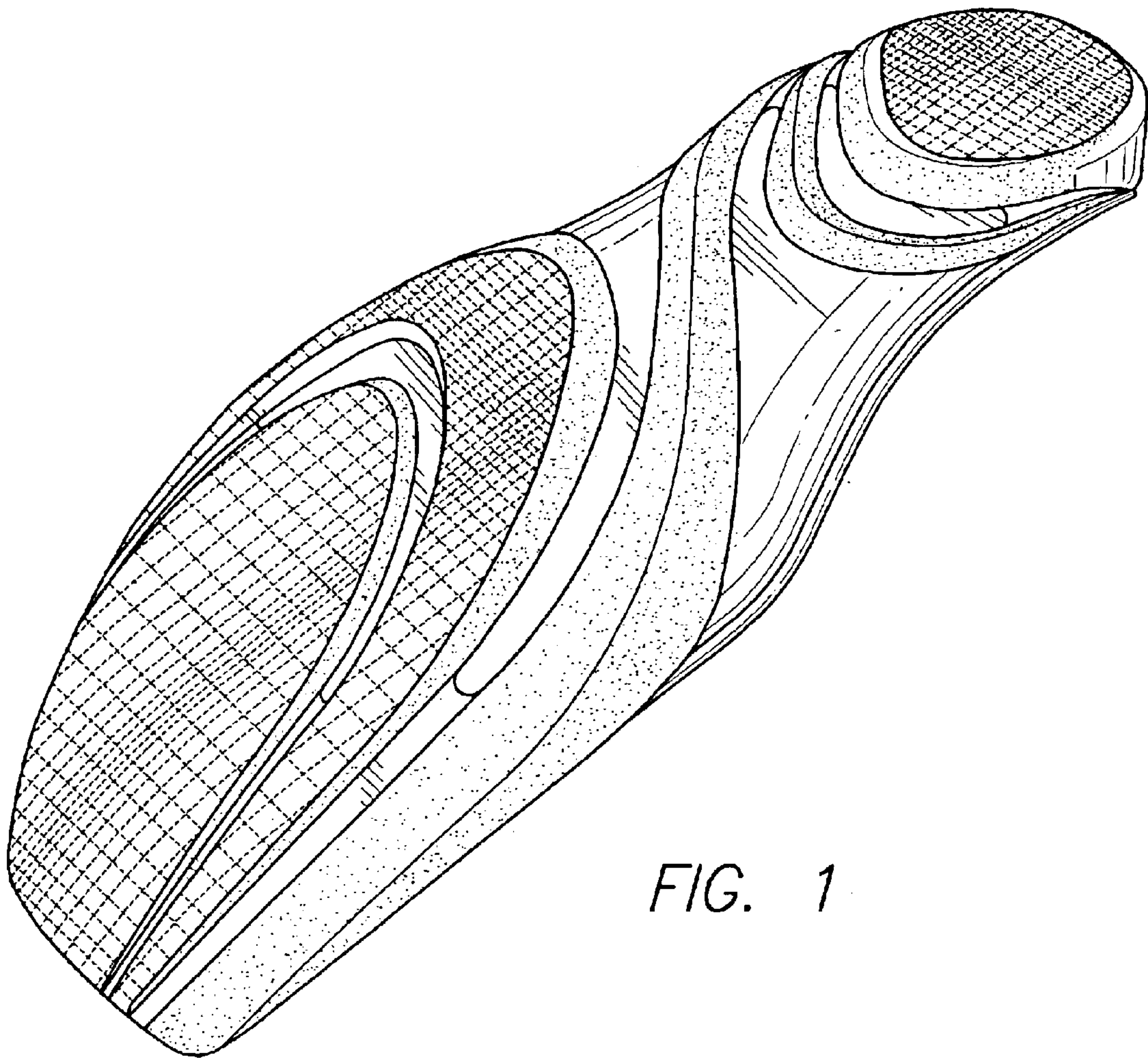

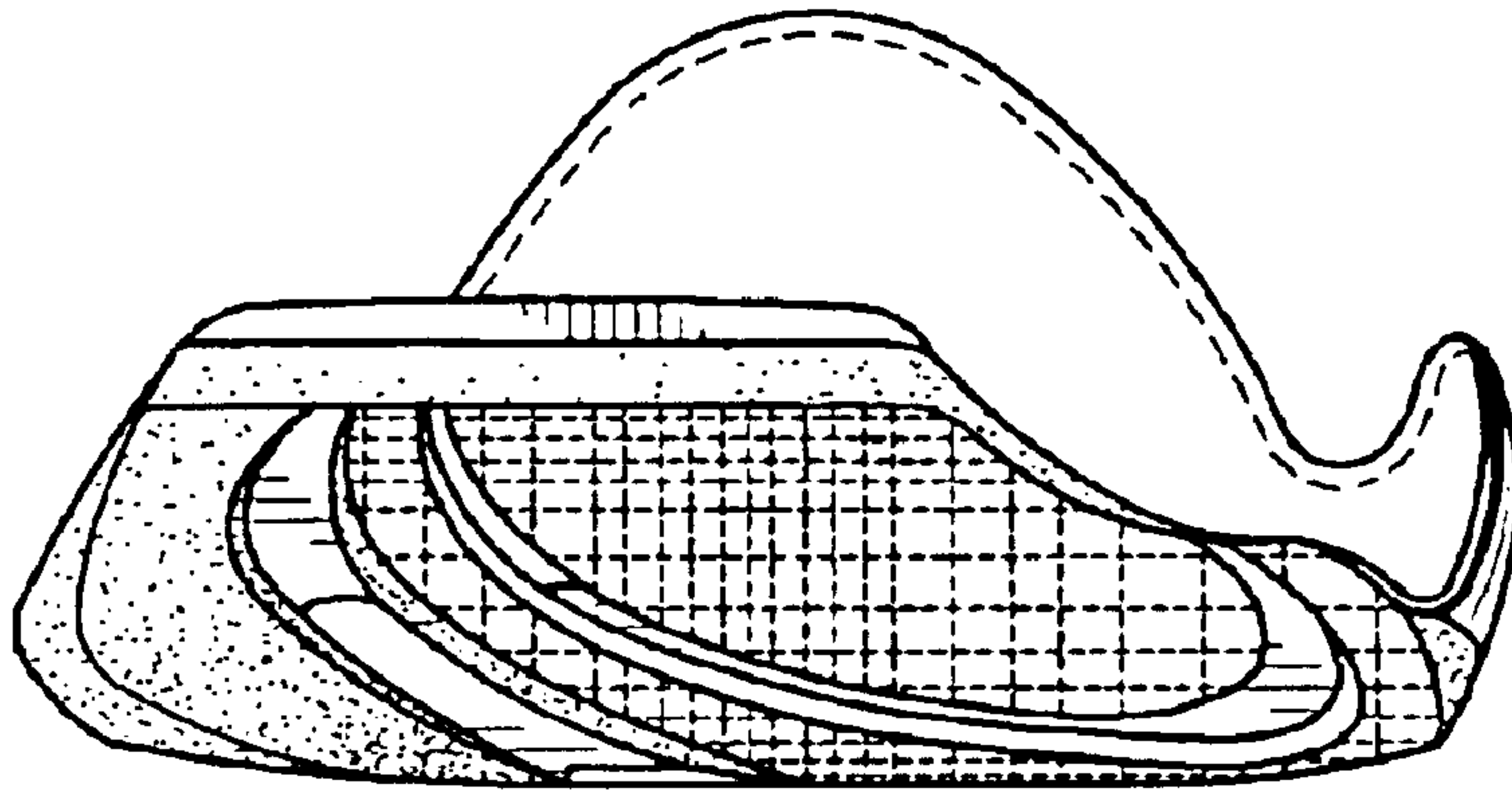

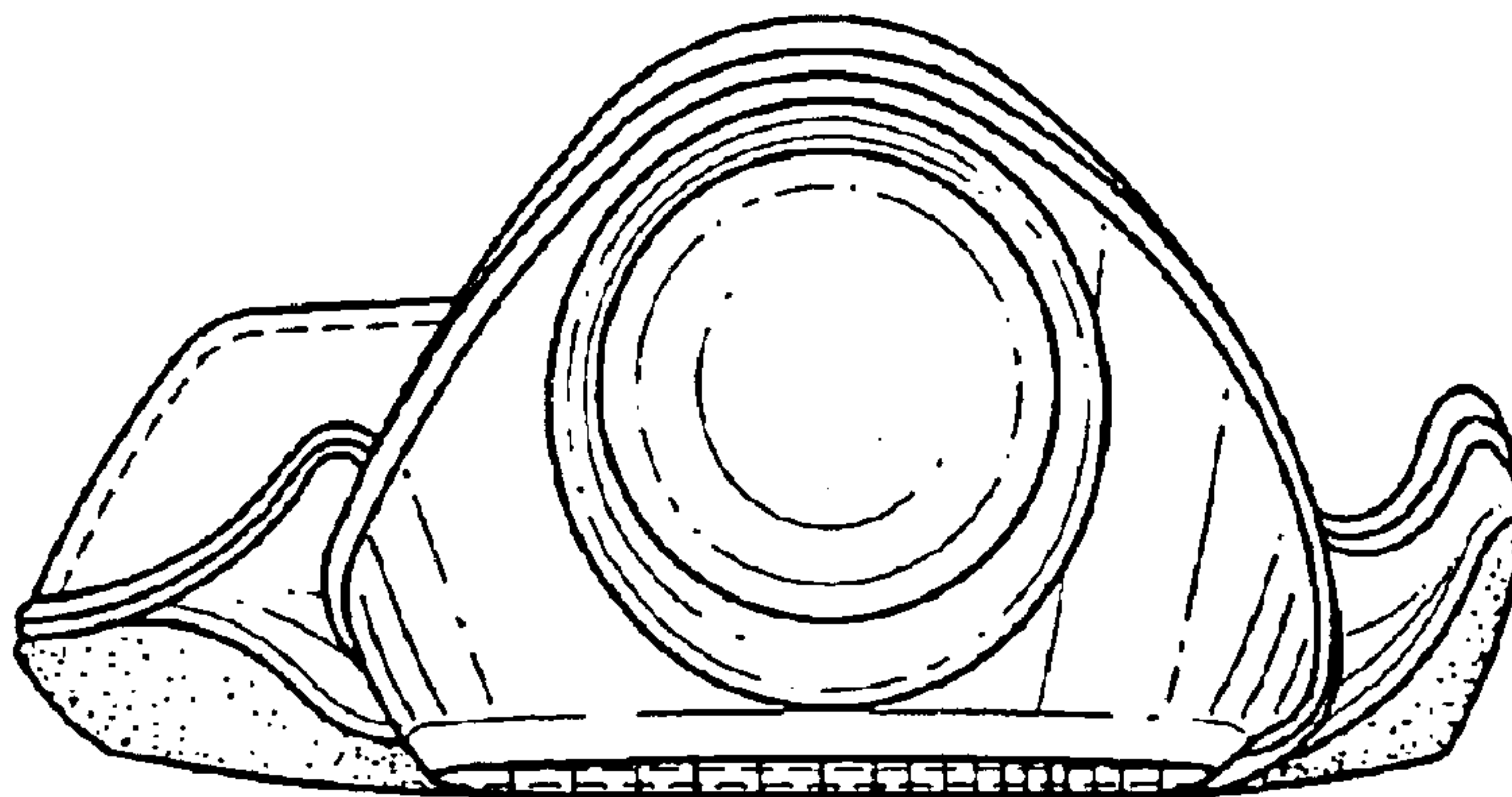

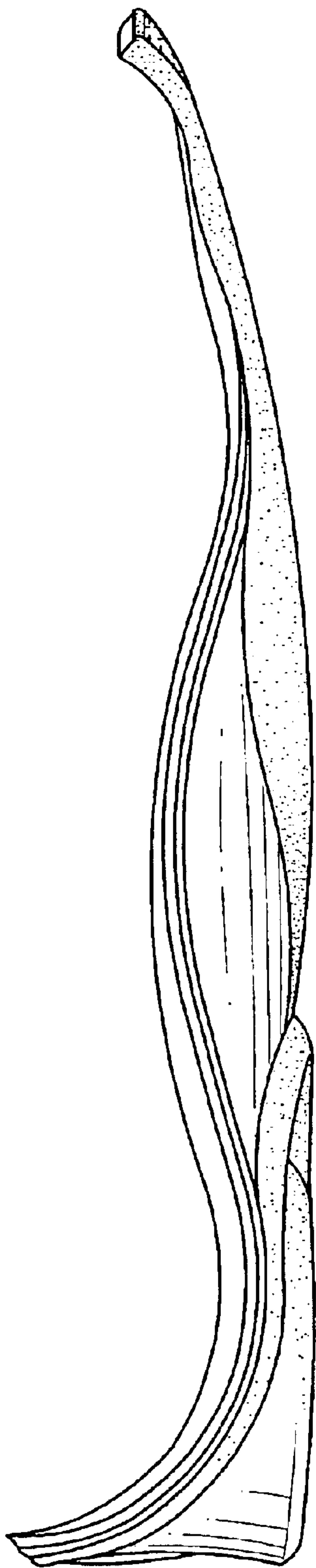

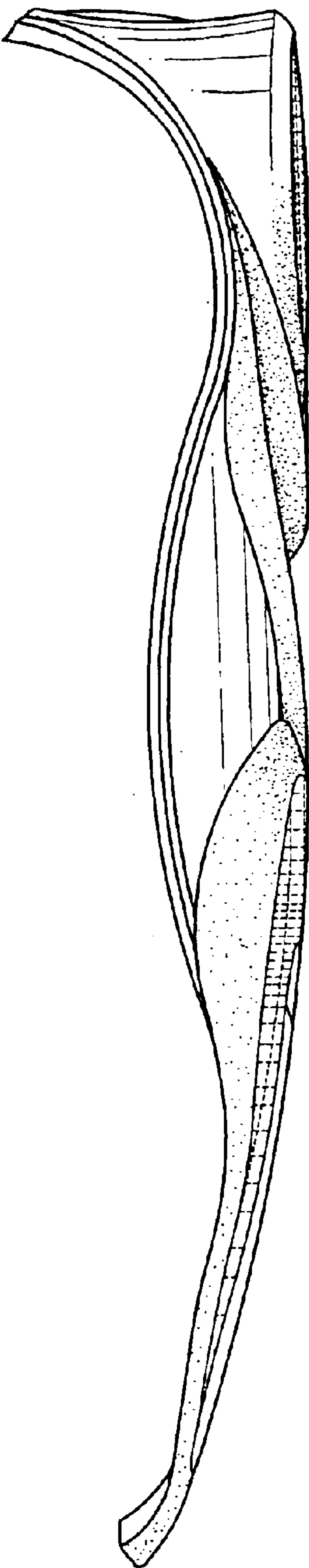

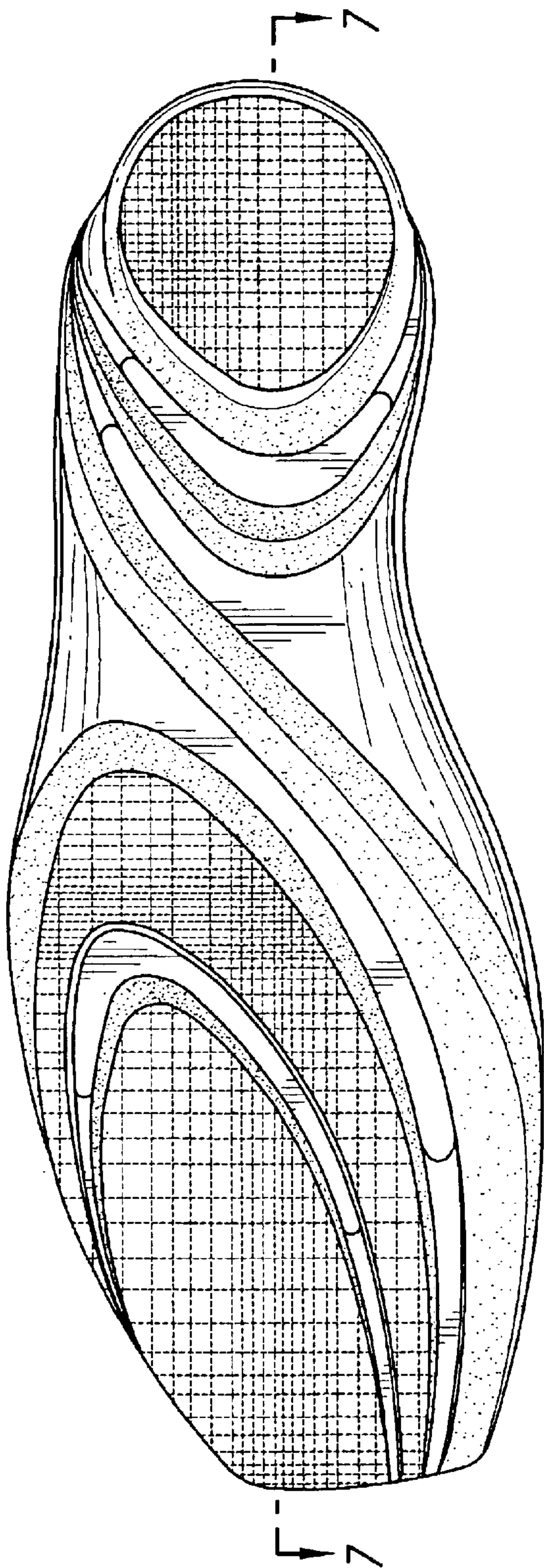

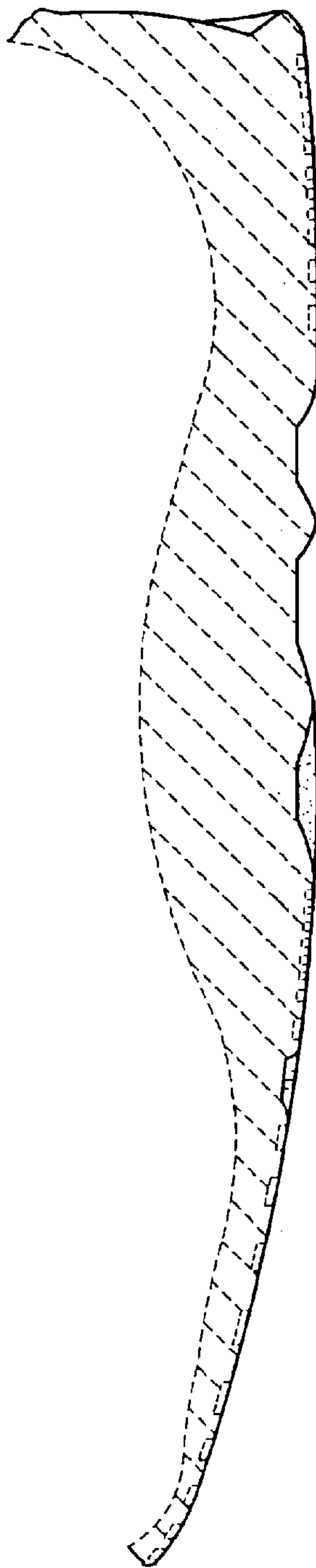

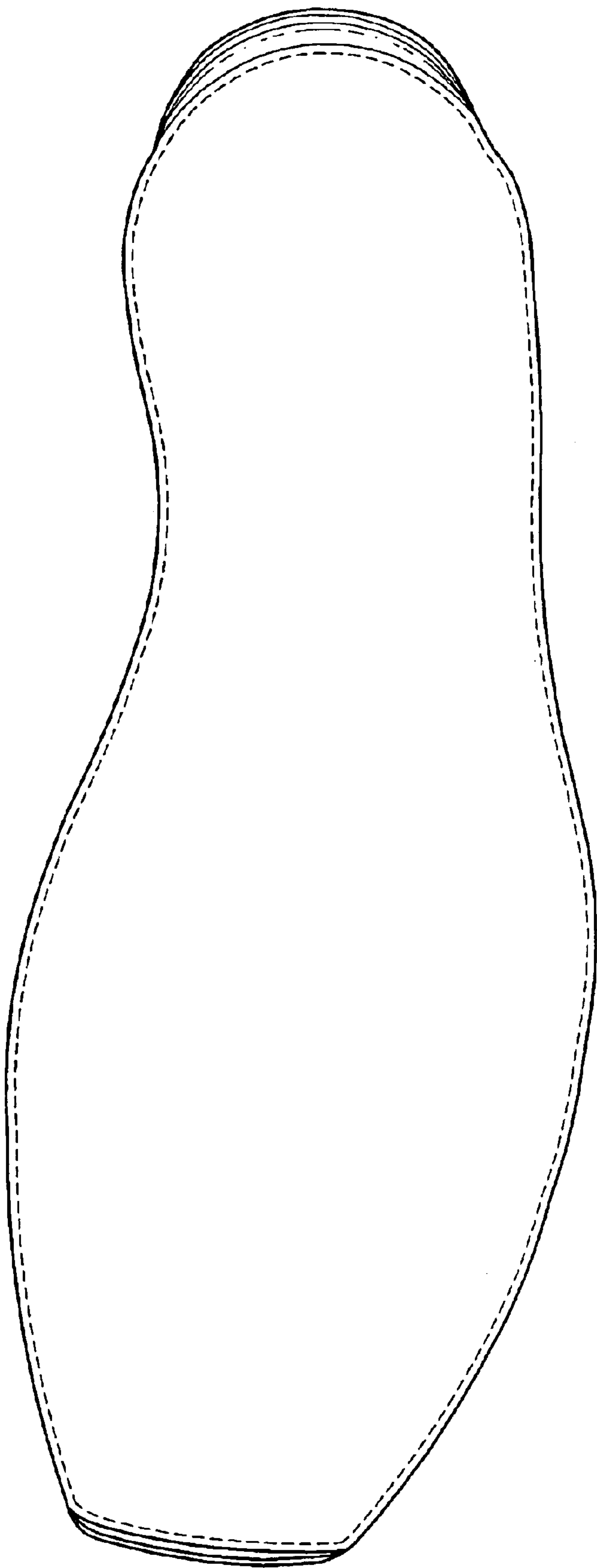
