(57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a knife block, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a knife block, showing our new design in an open position for use thereof;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view showing the knife block of FIG. 2 in a closed position for storage of the knives therein;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the closed position of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the pivotal knife holder in the knife block, which is shown separately for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the closed position of FIG. **3**;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of the closed position of FIG. **3**;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the closed position of FIG. 3; and,

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the closed position of FIG.

The broken line drawings of the knives and kitchen tools in FIGS. 1, 2, 3 and 5 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.













