DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hand tool handle according to my new design, the broken lines of the hand tool handle are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the hand tool handle of FIG. 1, the broken lines of the hand tool handle are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design, the rear elevational view being an identical image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the hand tool handle of FIG. 1, the broken lines of the hand tool handle are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design, the opposite side elevational view being an identical image thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is another perspective view of the hand tool of FIG. 1, the broken lines of the hand tool handle are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.








