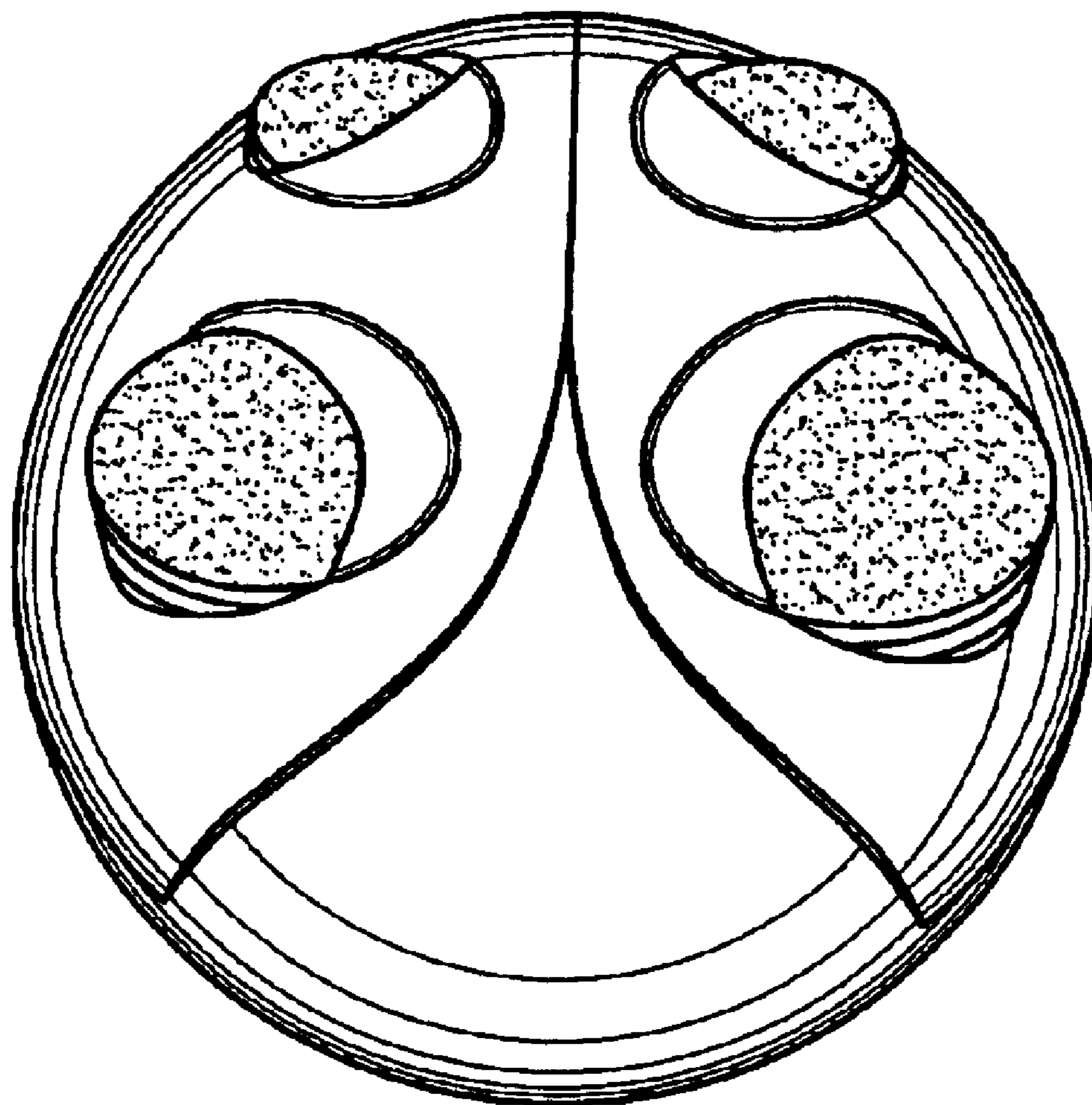

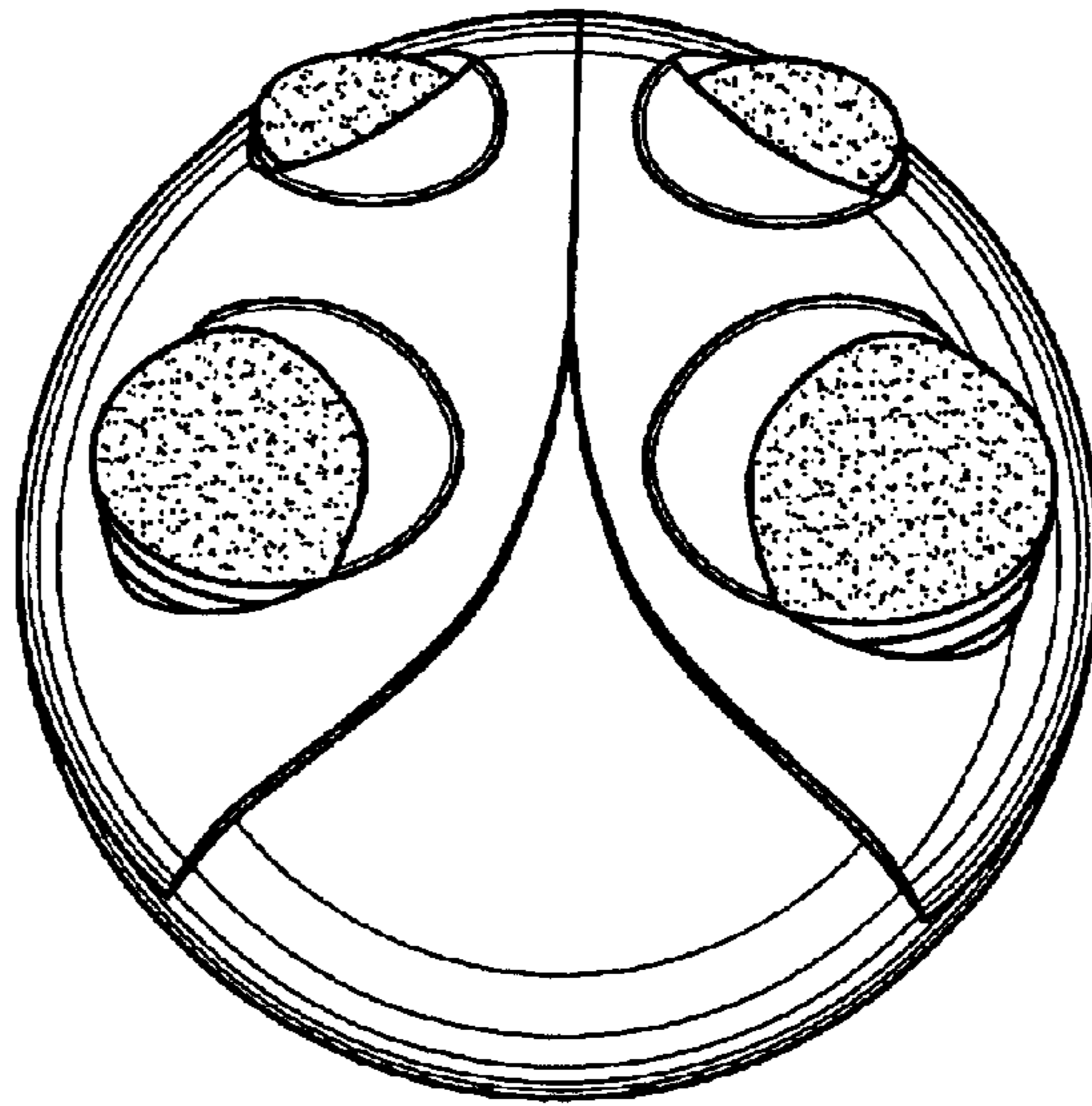
The ornamental design for a lady bug coin dispenser, as shown and described.

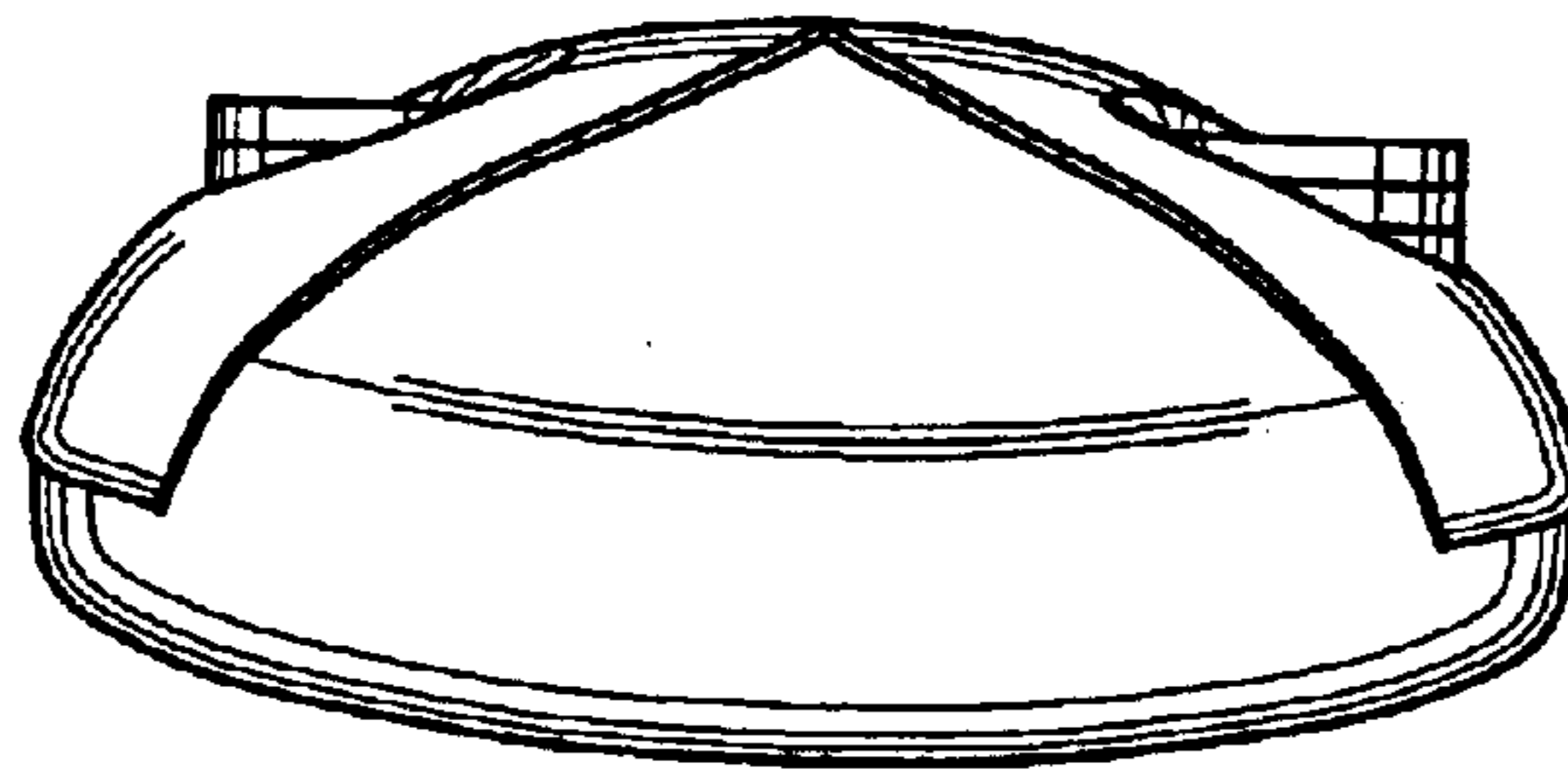
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the invention.

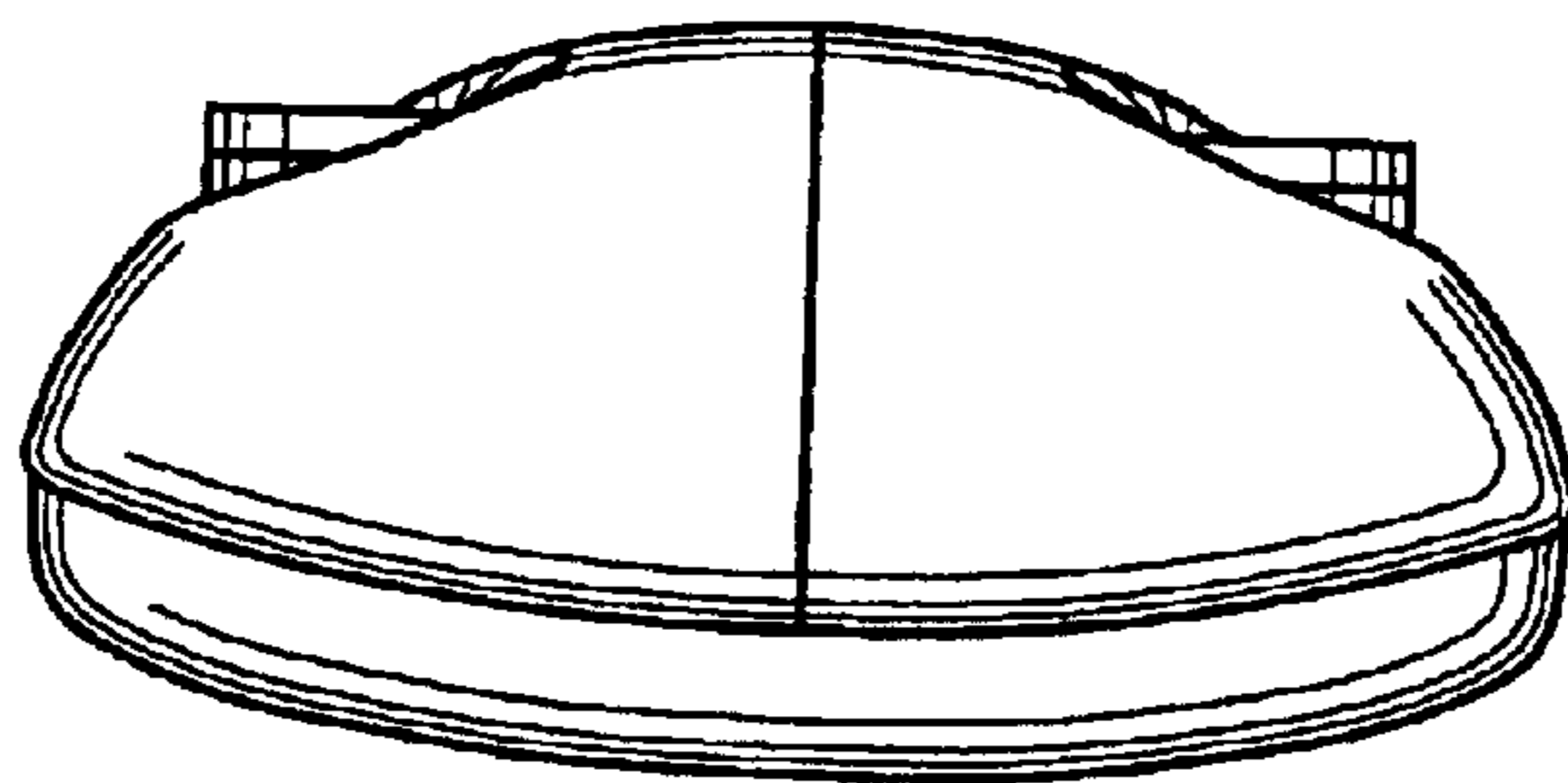




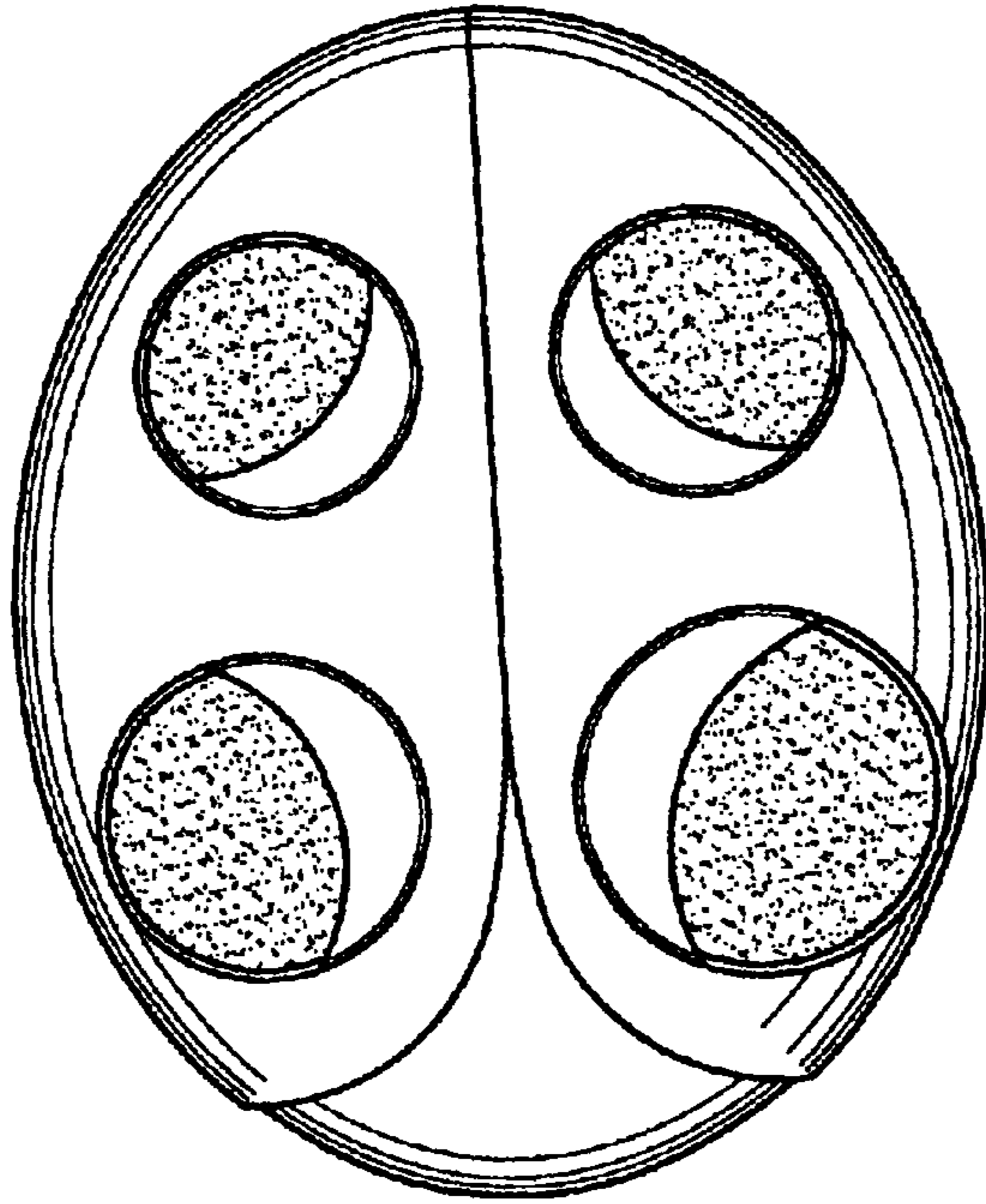

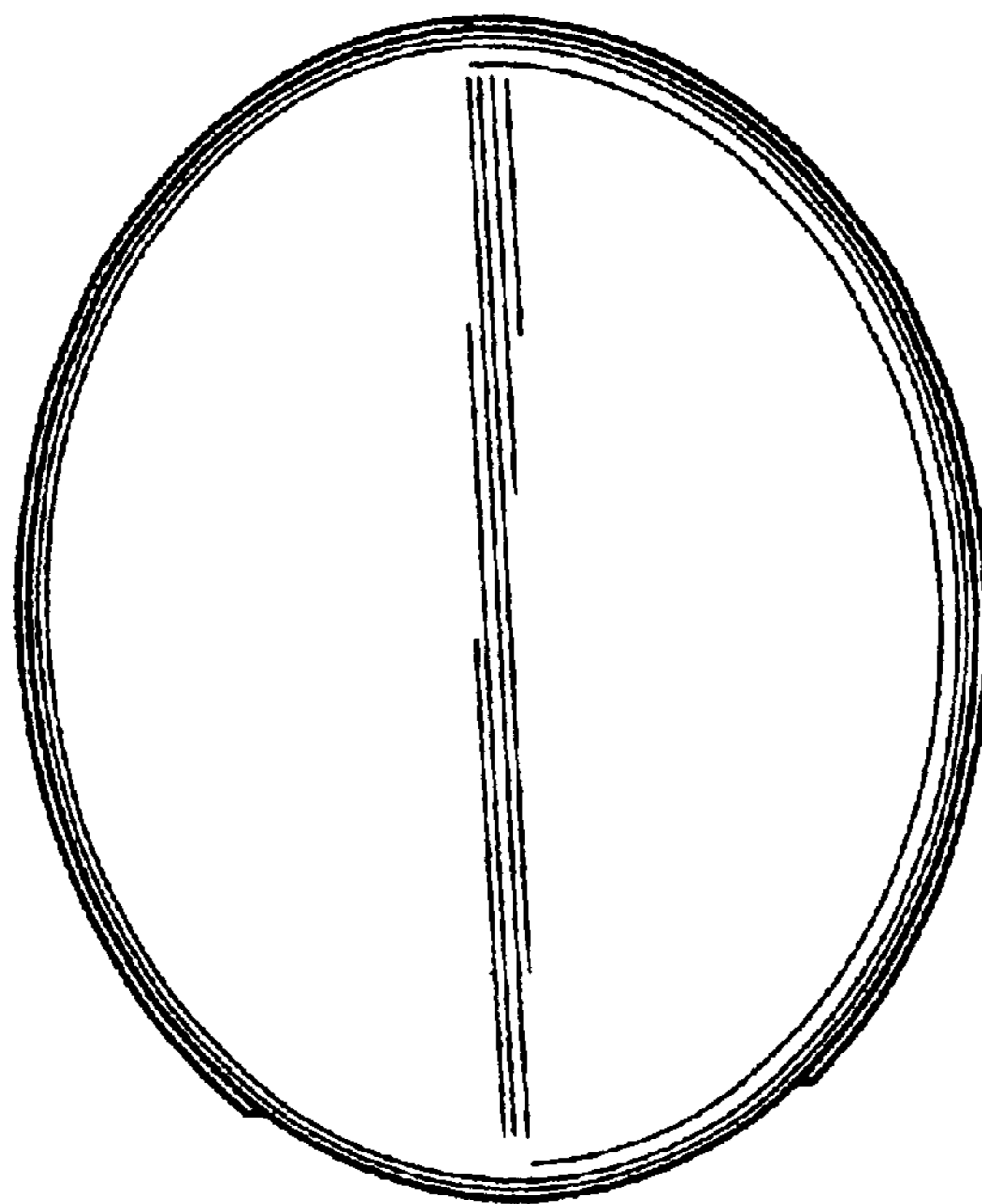
