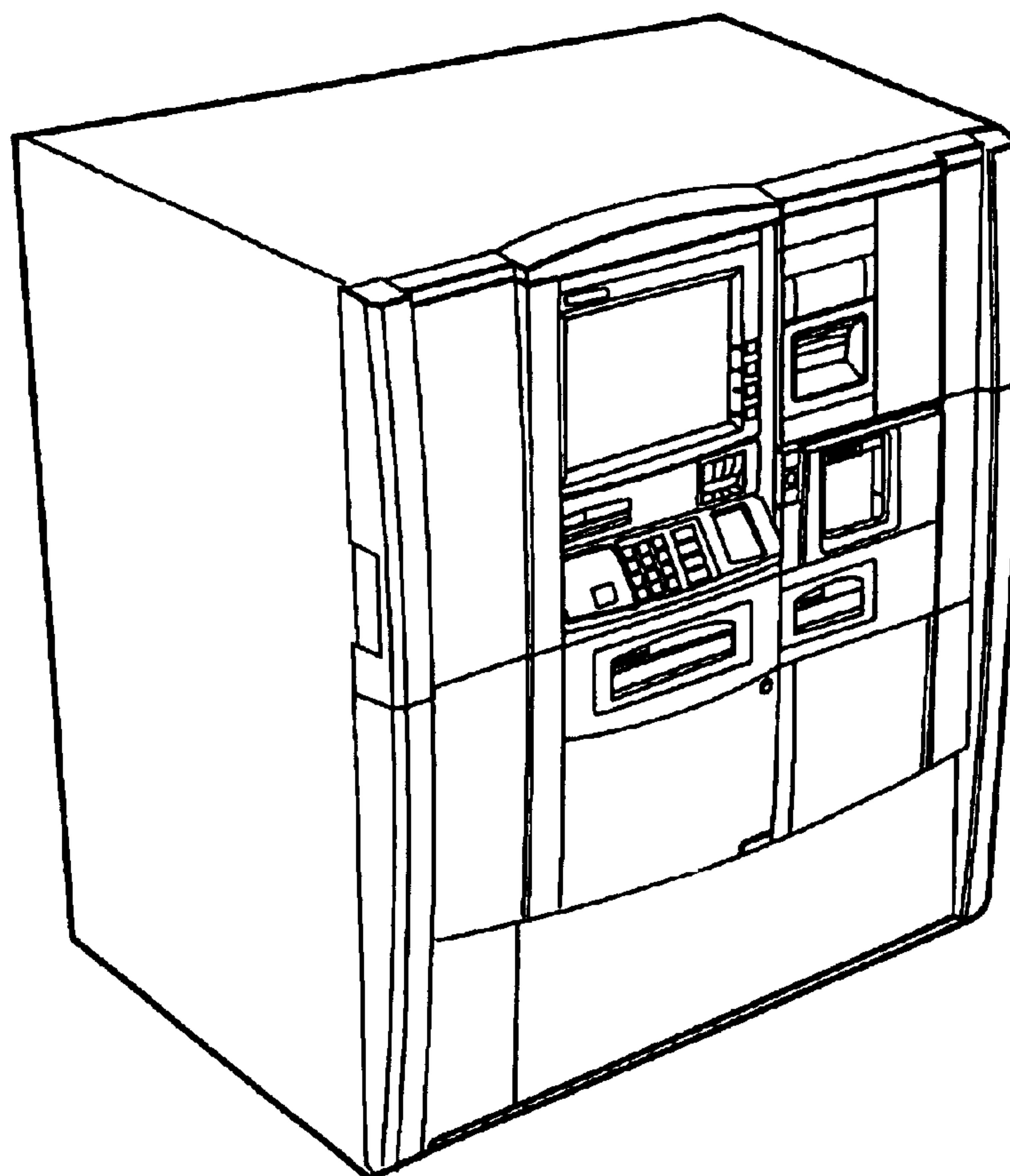
DESCRIPTION

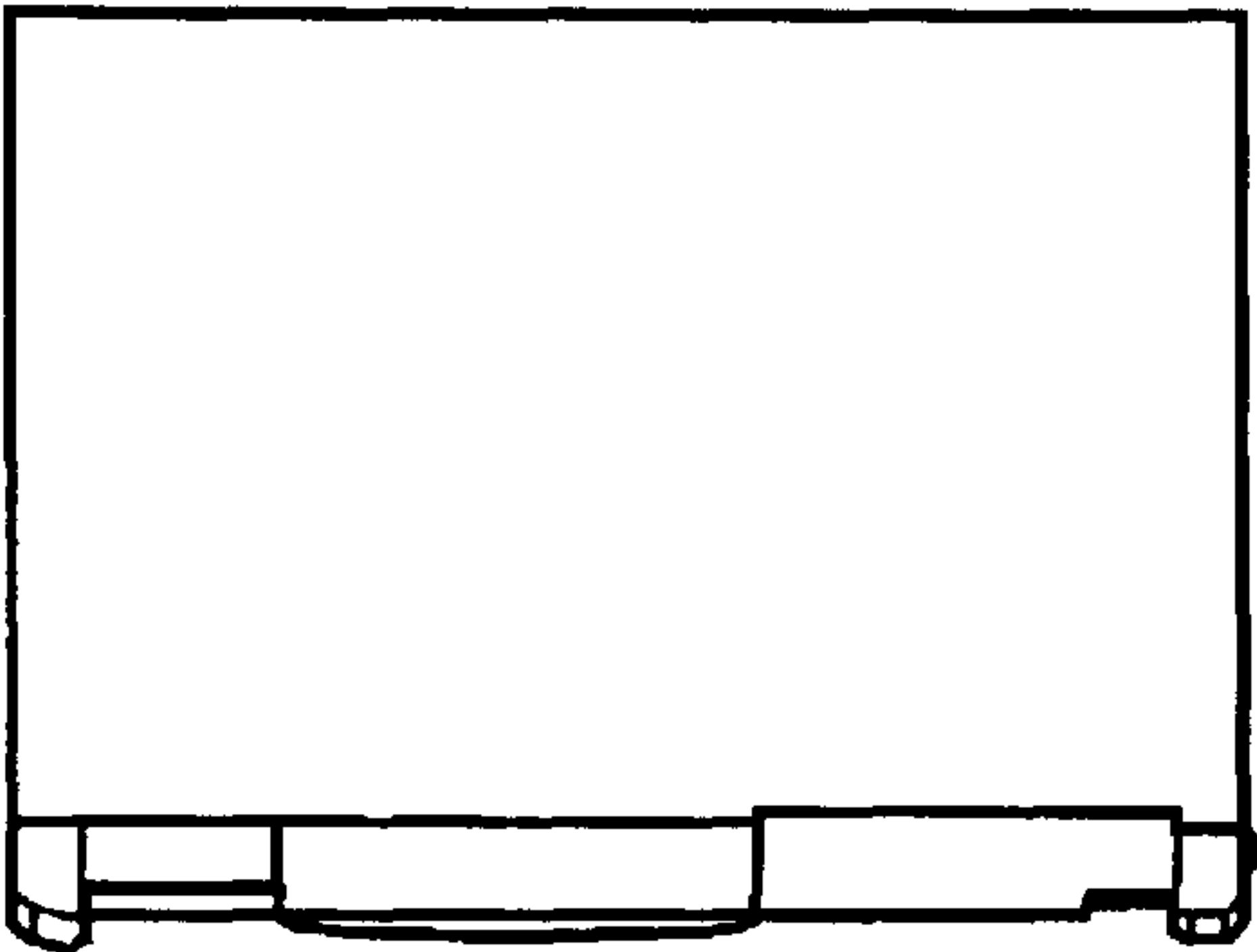

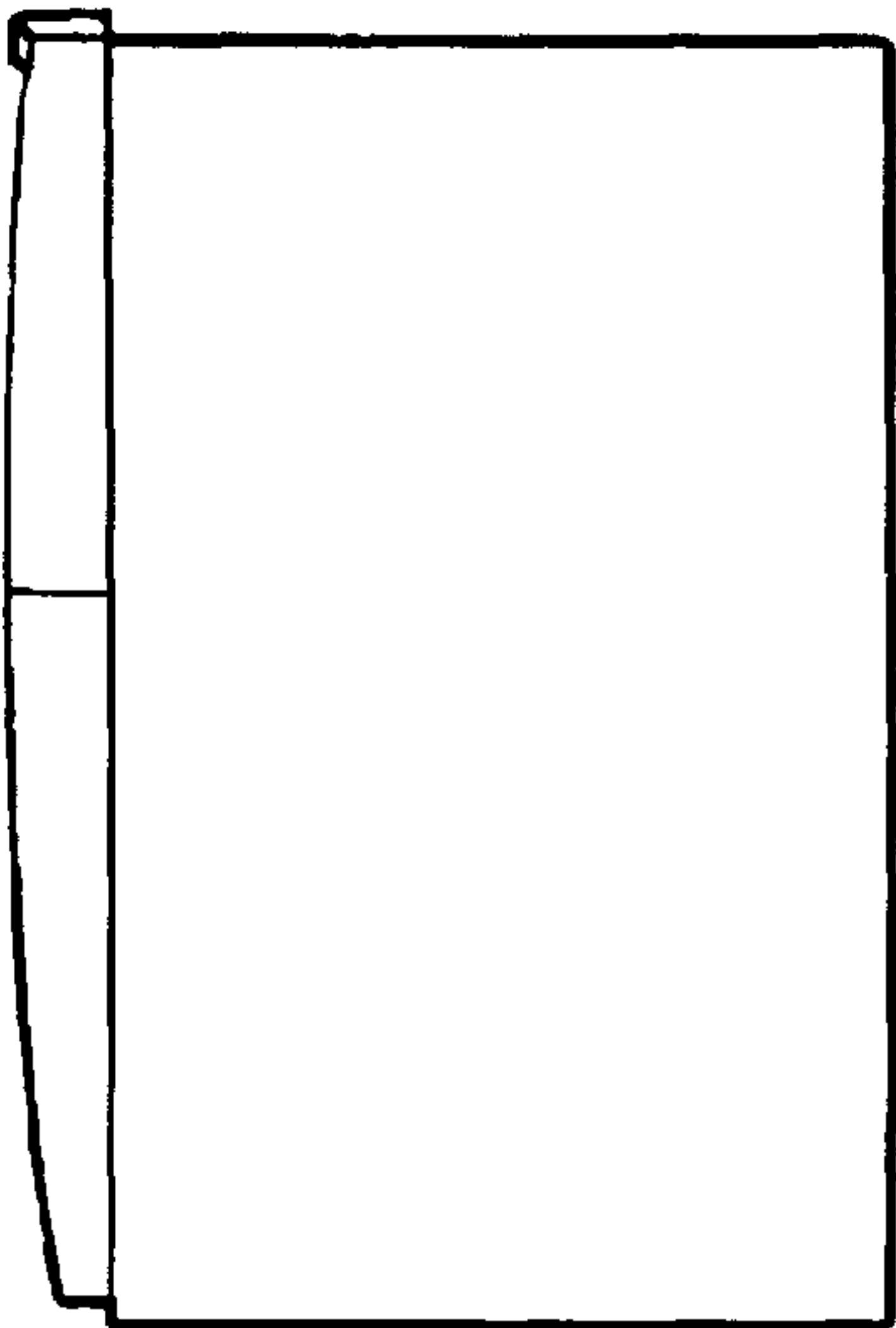

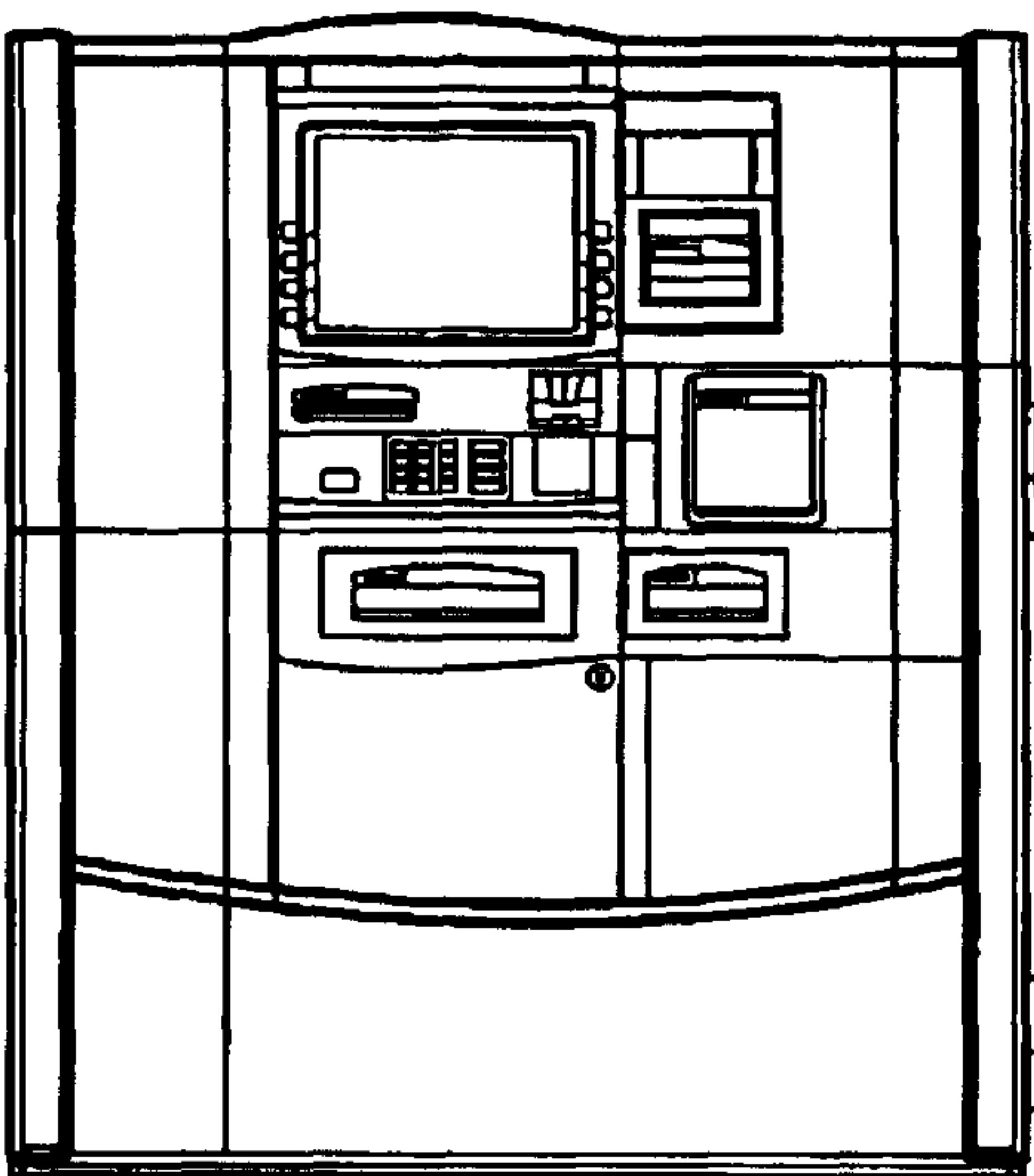

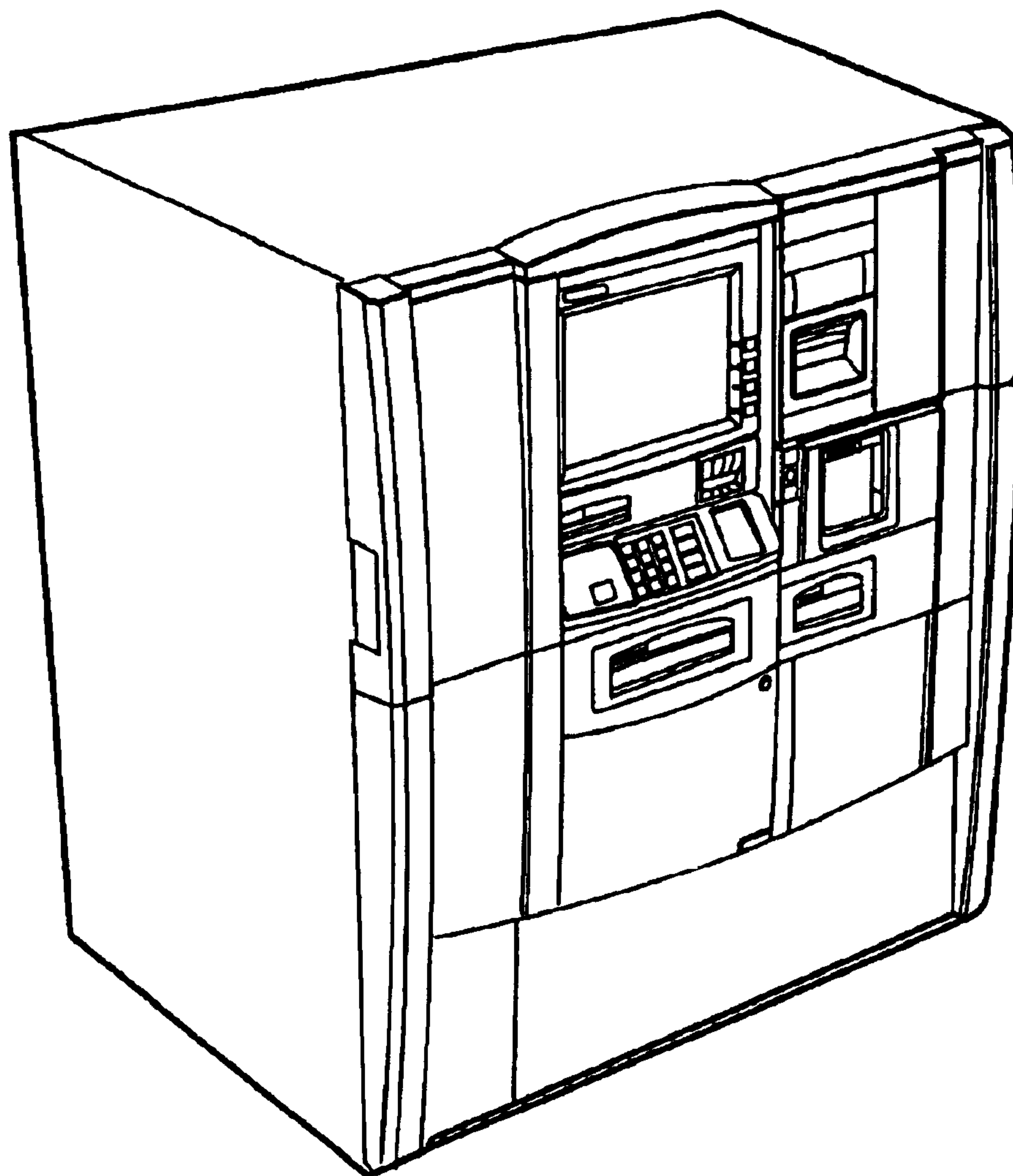
