(57)CLAIM


The ornamental design for a furniture leg, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a furniture leg showing my new design;
- FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,
- FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

The views of the furniture leg not shown form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines depicting a portion of a table represent environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design.






