(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for tree grate portion, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the tree grate portion embodying the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

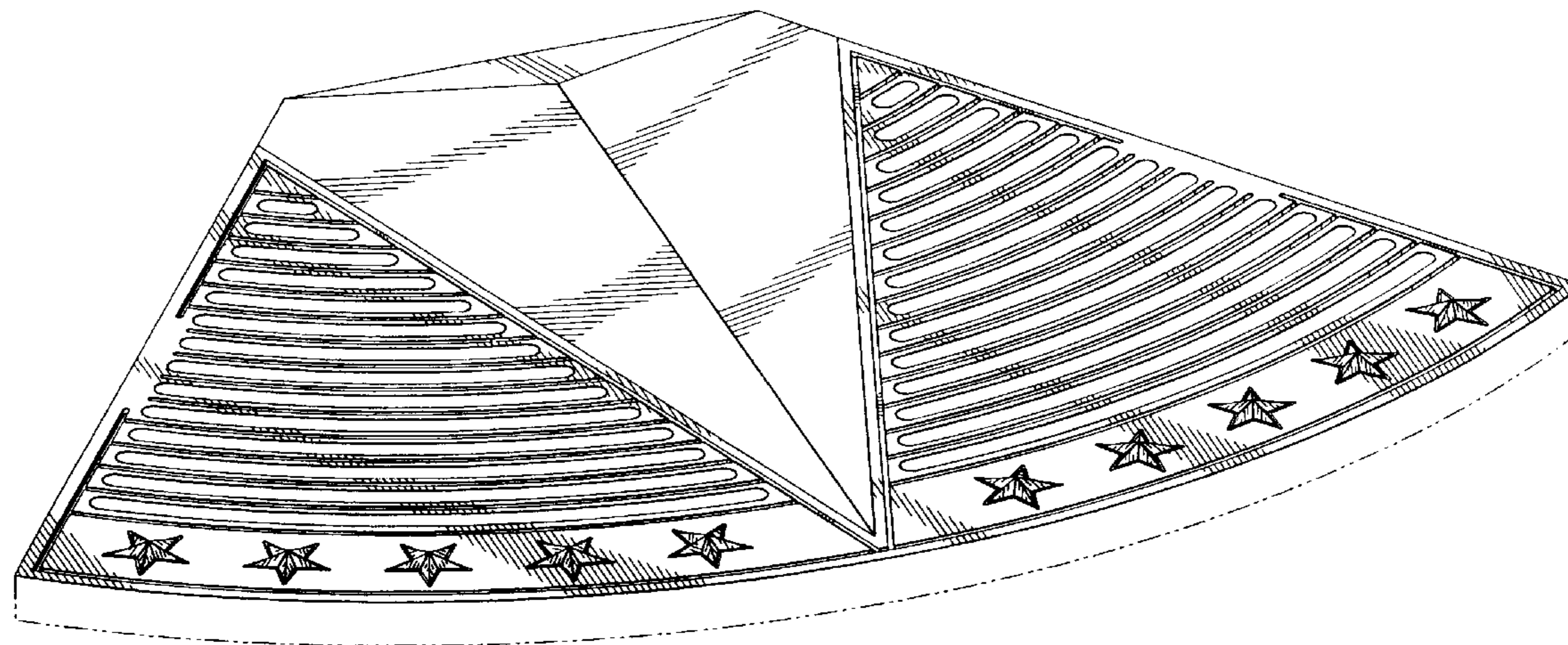
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective elevational view thereof showing the remaining segments of an assembled tree grate in broken lines; and,

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof showing the remaining segments of an assembled tree grate in broken lines.

FIGS. 1 and 3–7 show portions of a tree grate in broken lines, the broken lines are shown for environmental purposes and form no part of the claimed design.

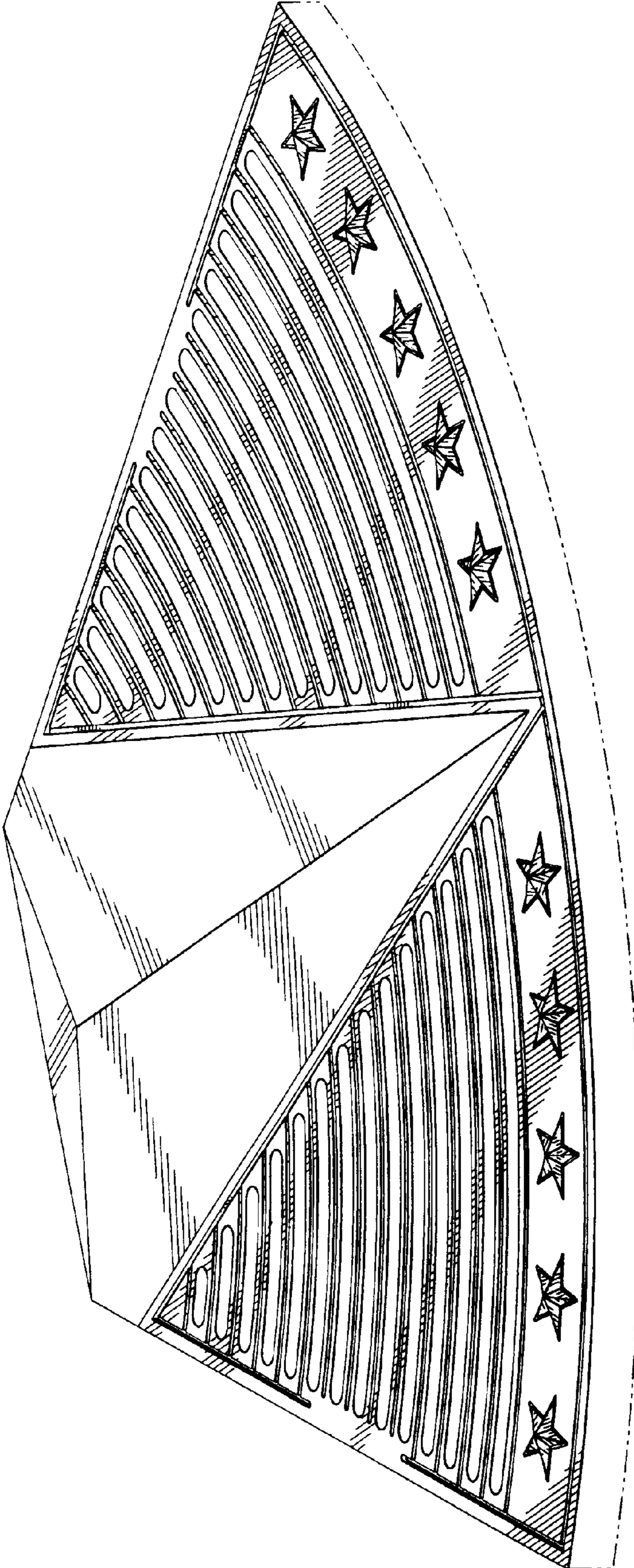

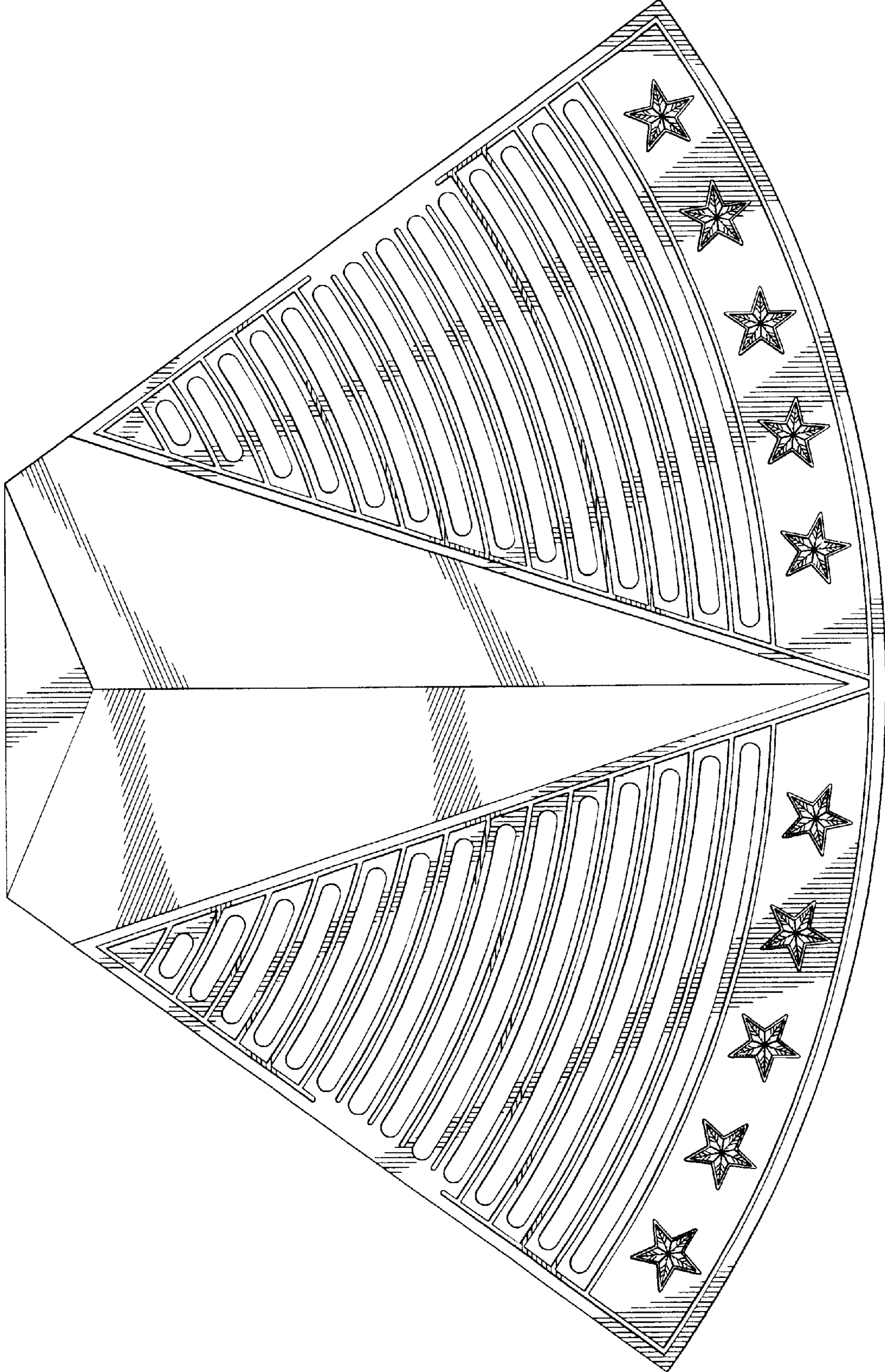

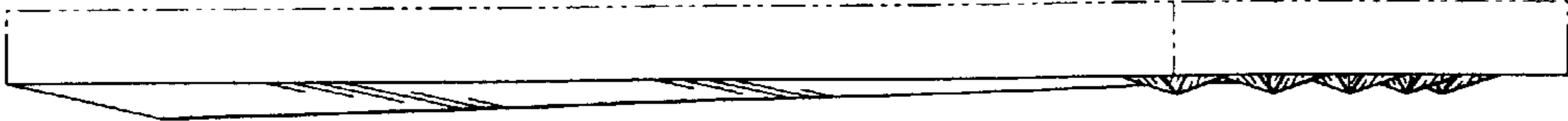

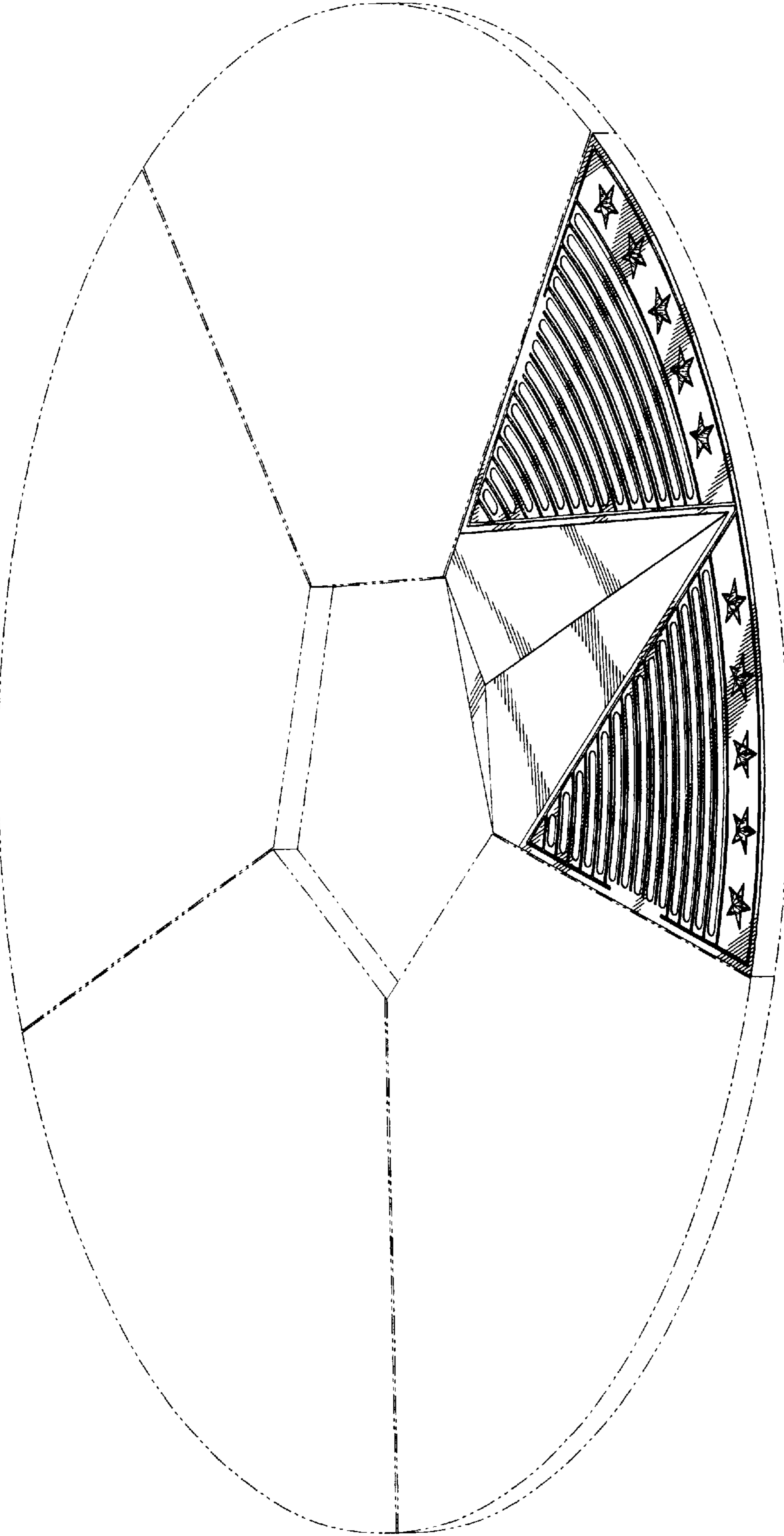

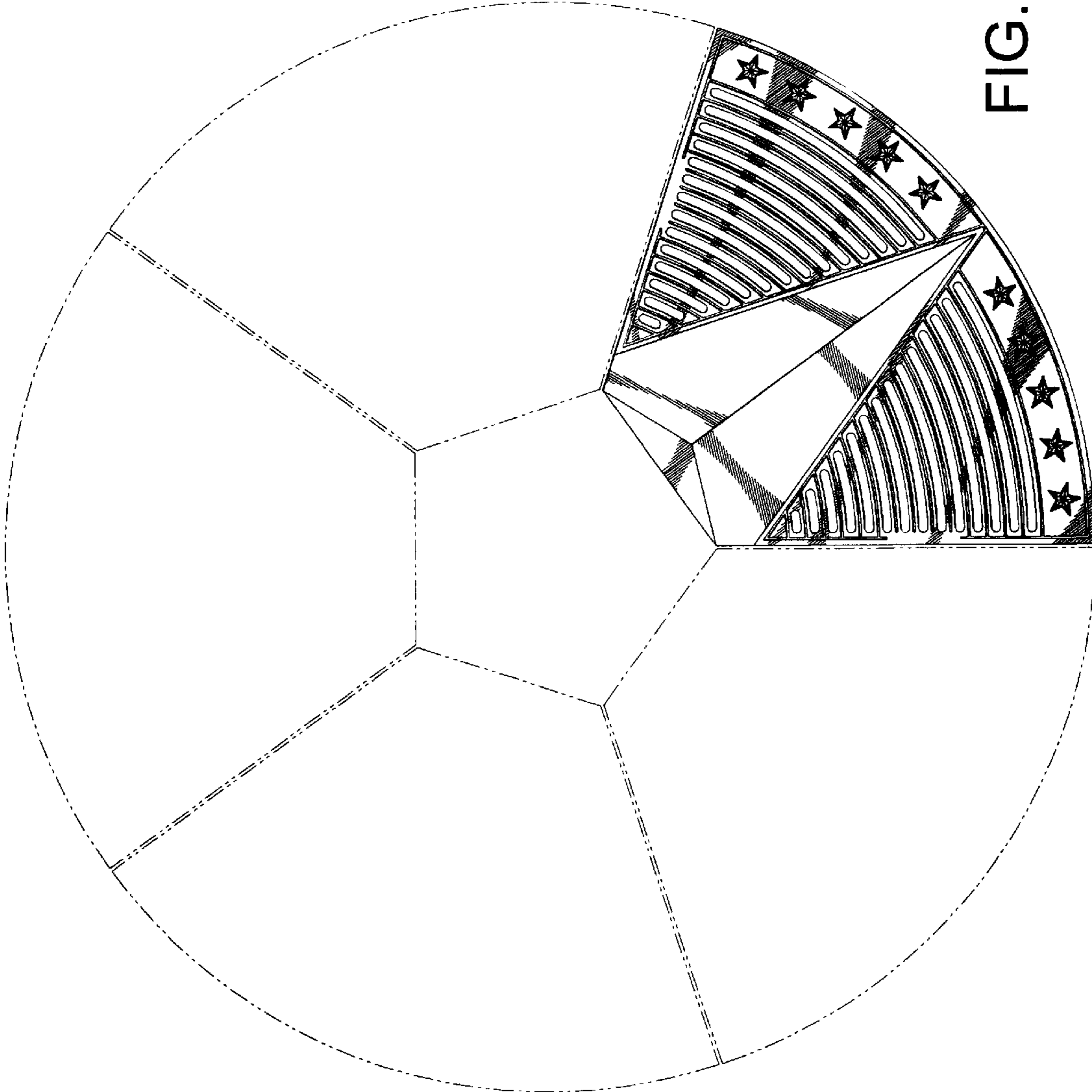
