DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a handle for a flashlight
showing my new design, with the opposite sides being a
mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof, of FIGS. 1, 3 and 4
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment
thereof, with the opposite sides being a mirror image
thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a third embodiment
thereof, with the opposite sides being a mirror image.

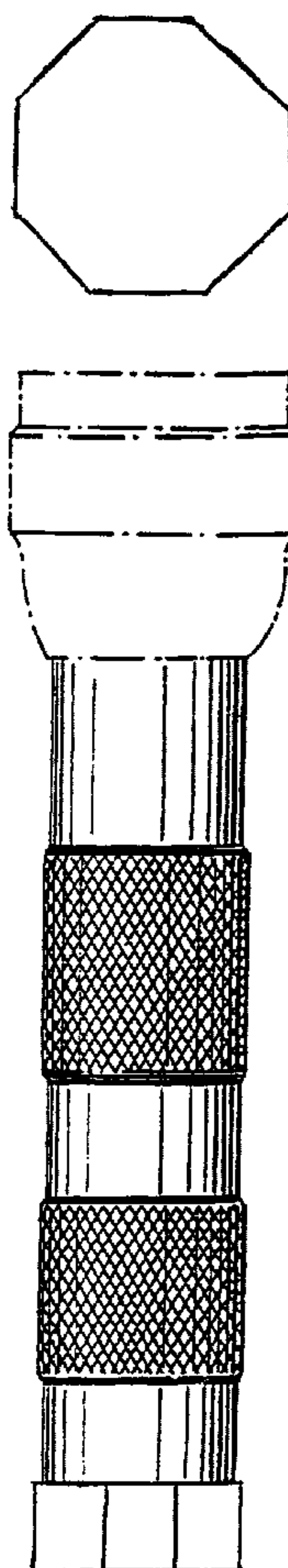

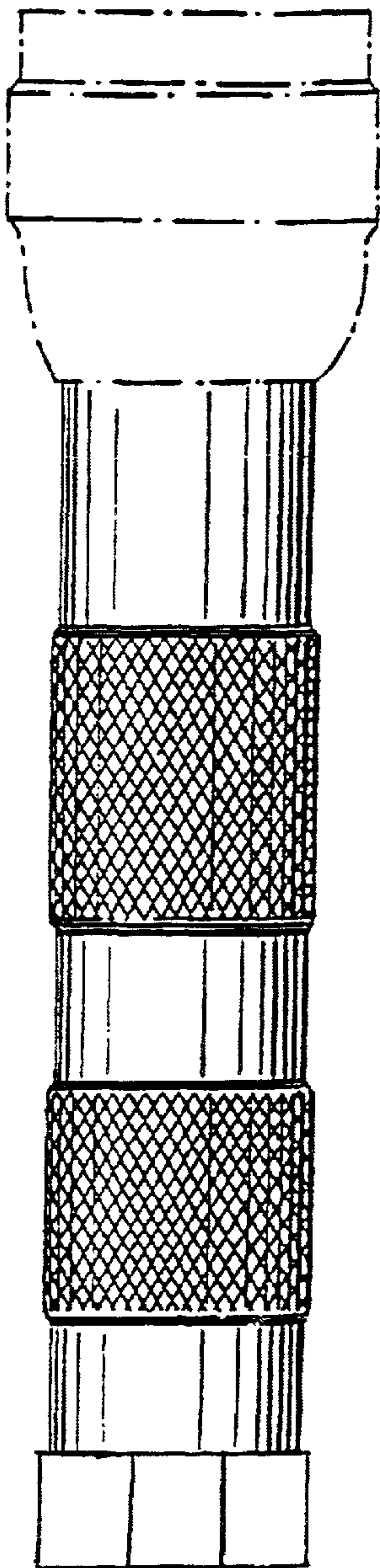

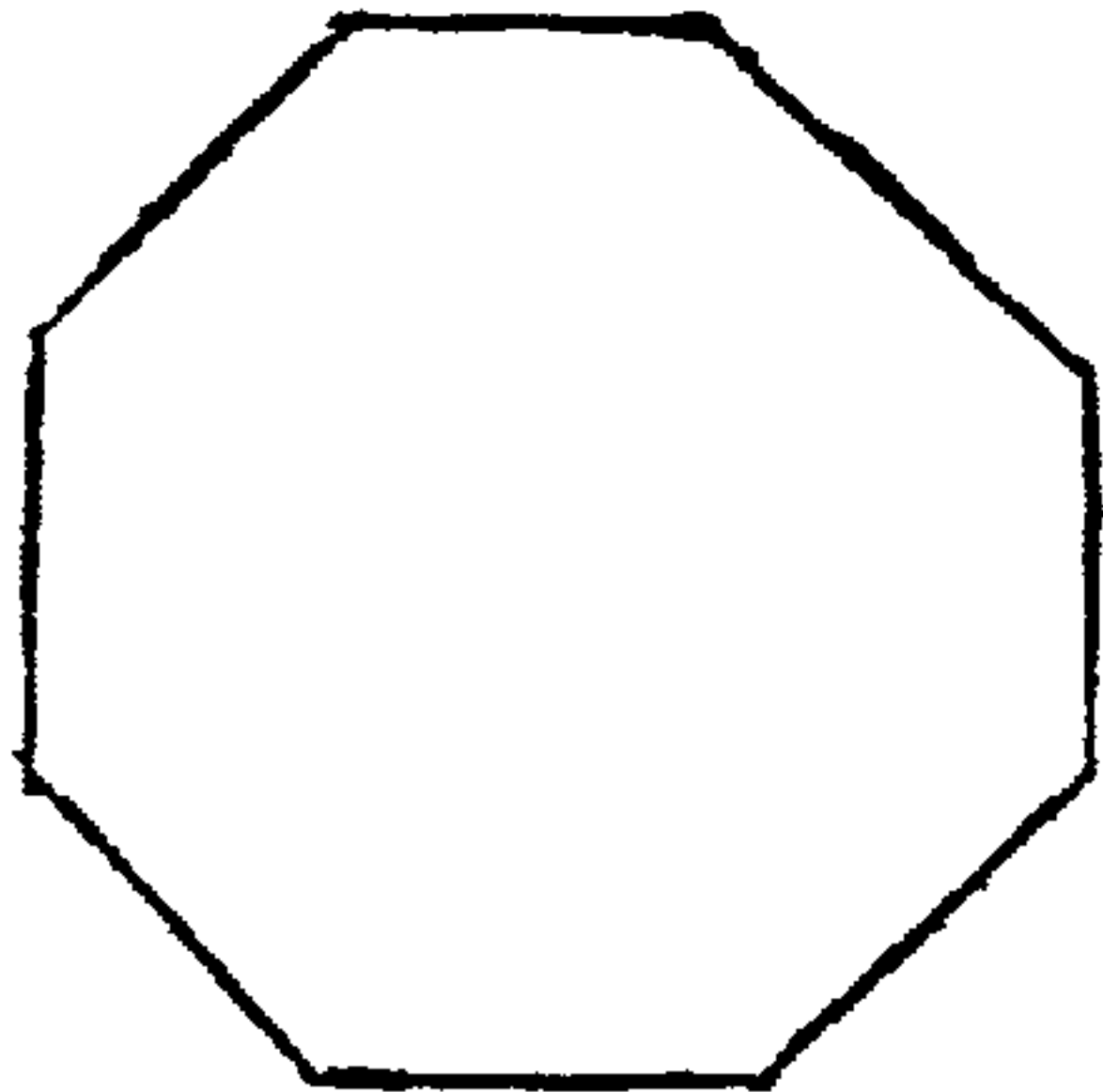

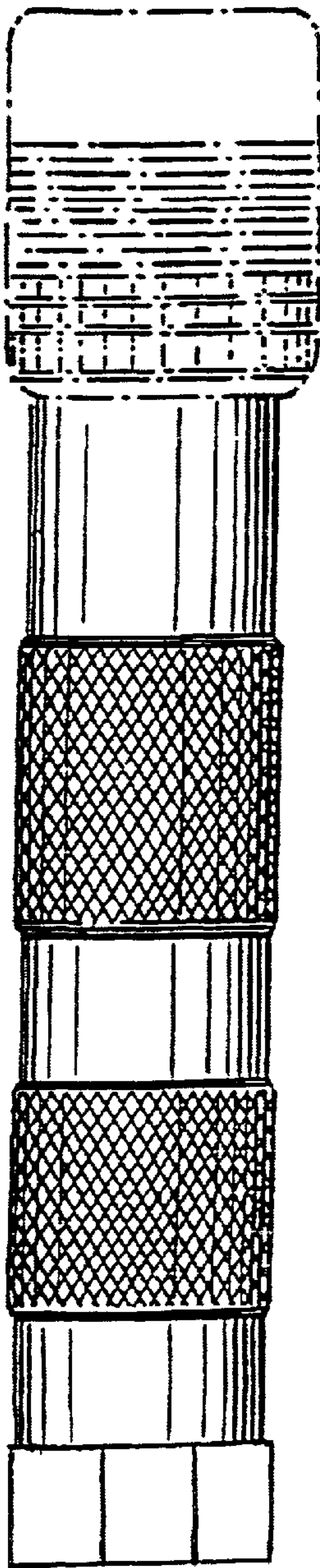
