DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sponge handle showing my invention;

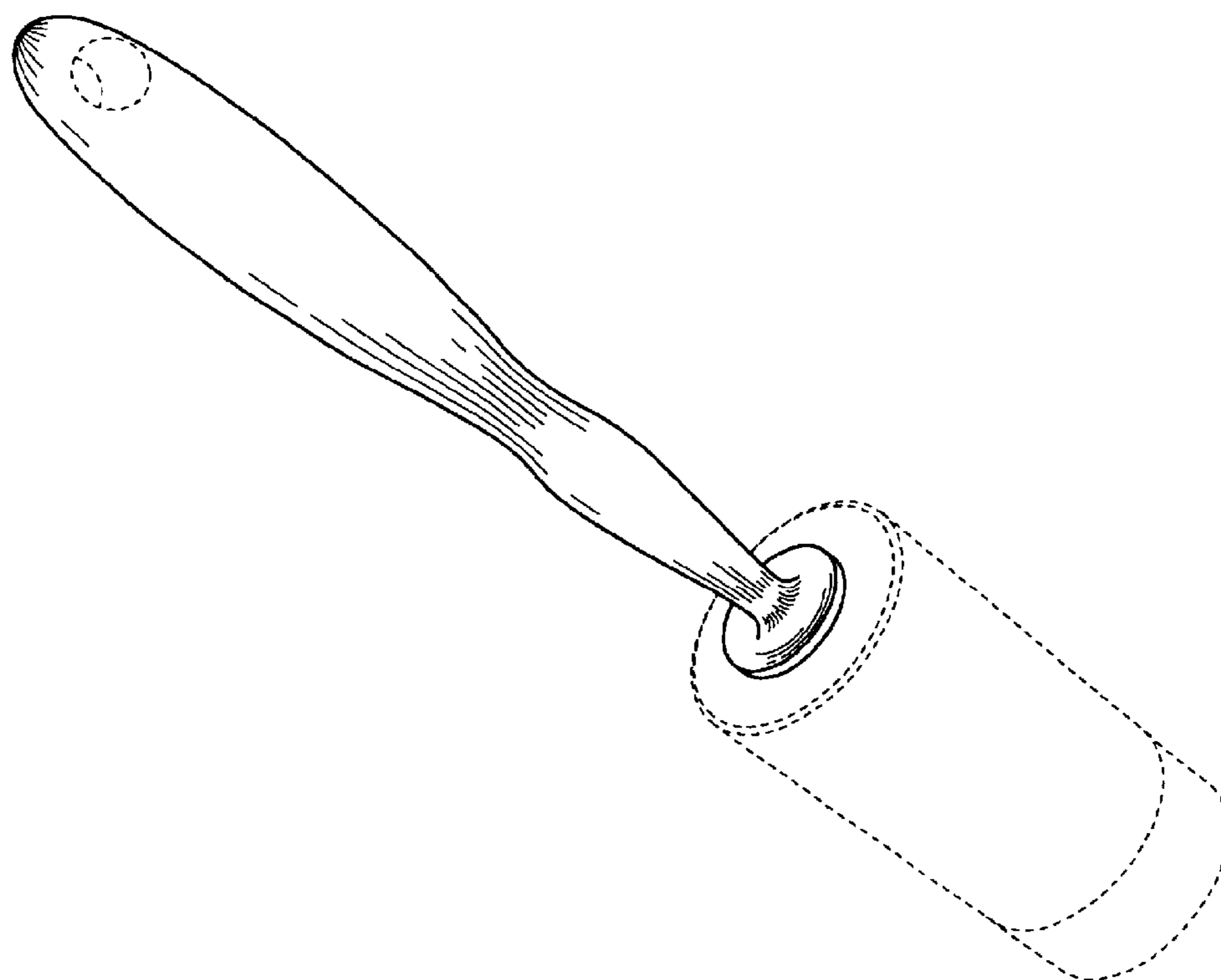
FIG. 2 is a back side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof.

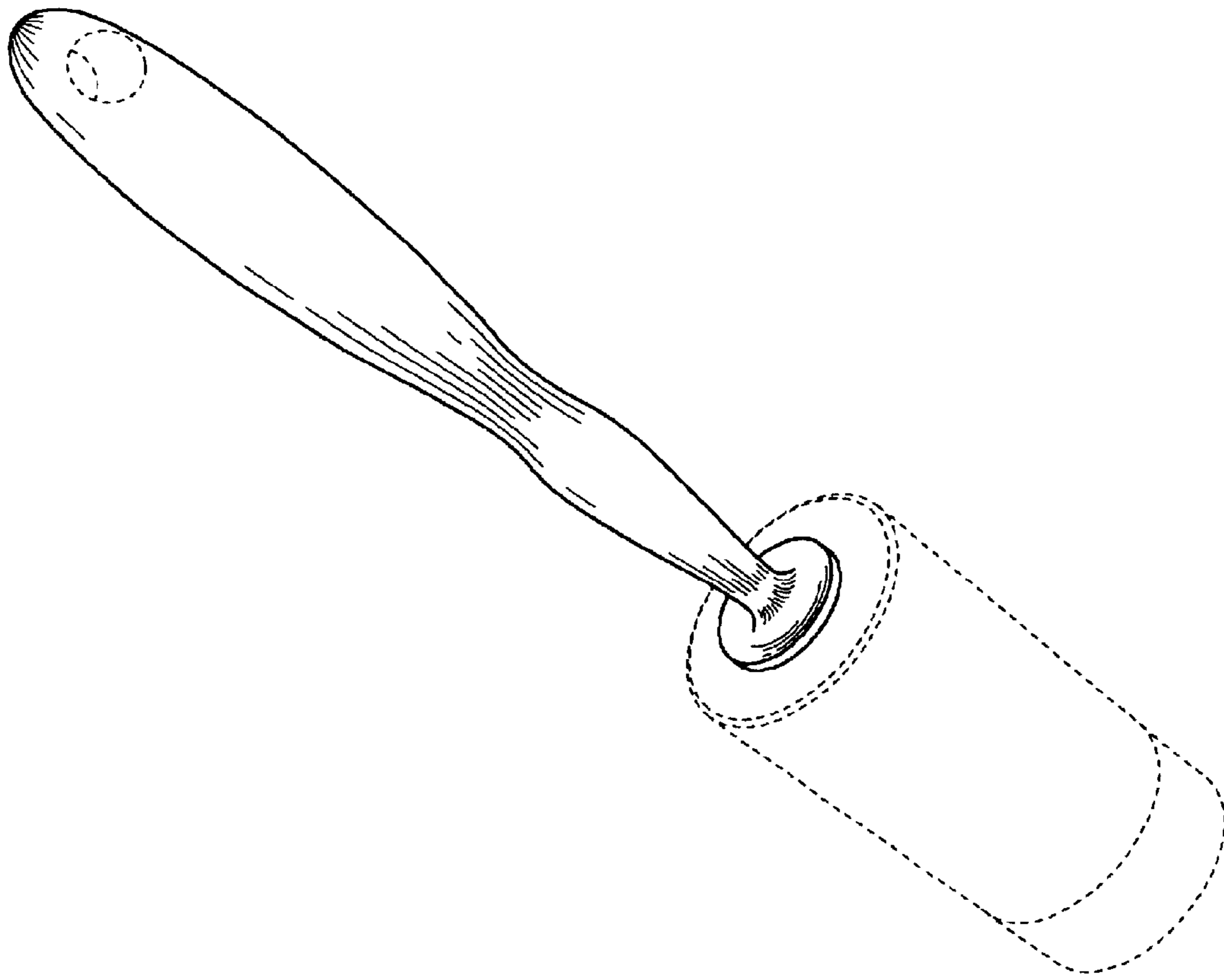

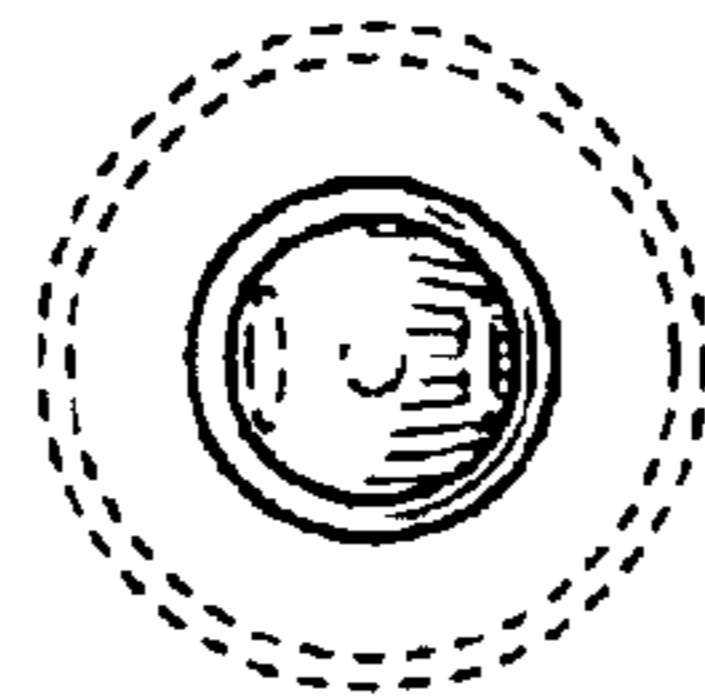

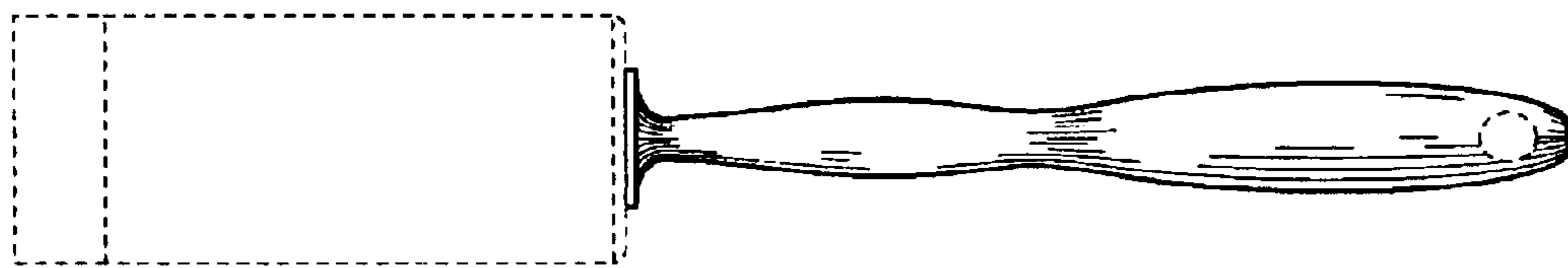

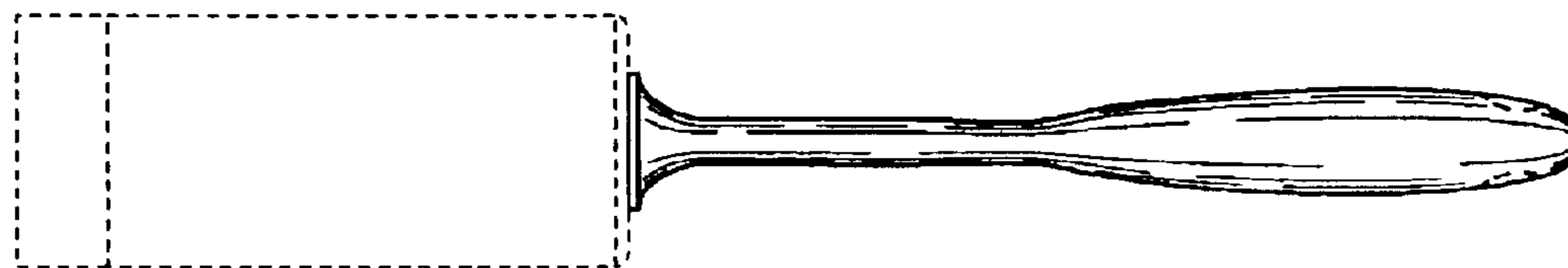
