FIG. 3 is a side view of the pendant of the present invention.

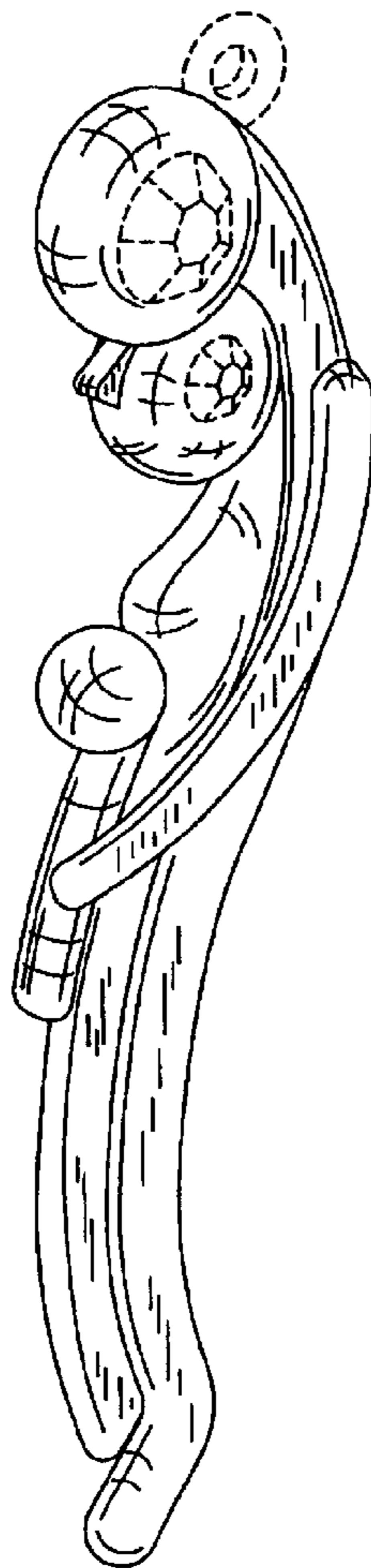
FIG. 4 is a back view of the pendant of the present invention.

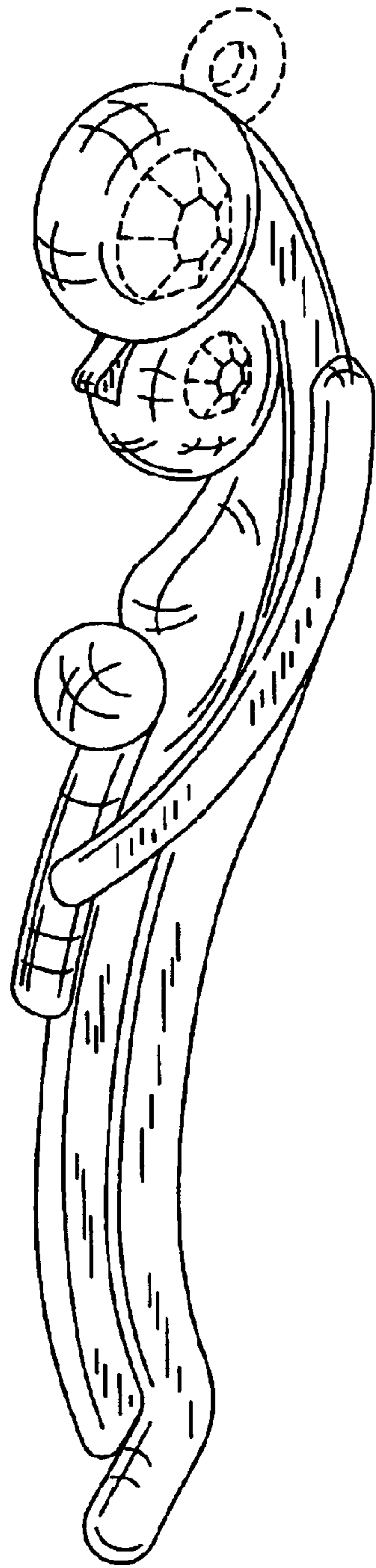

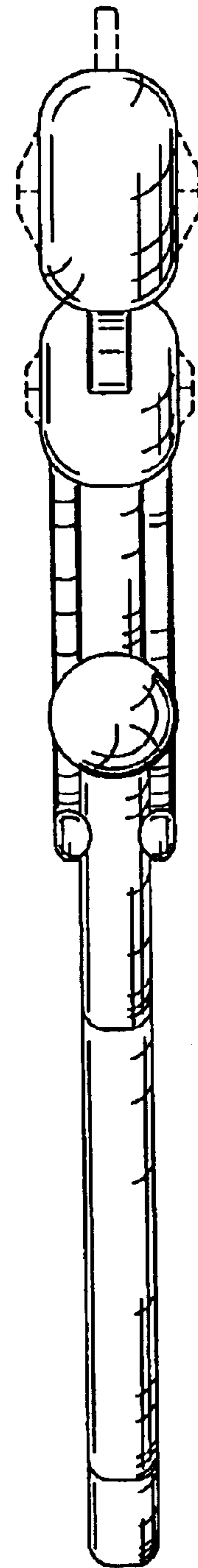

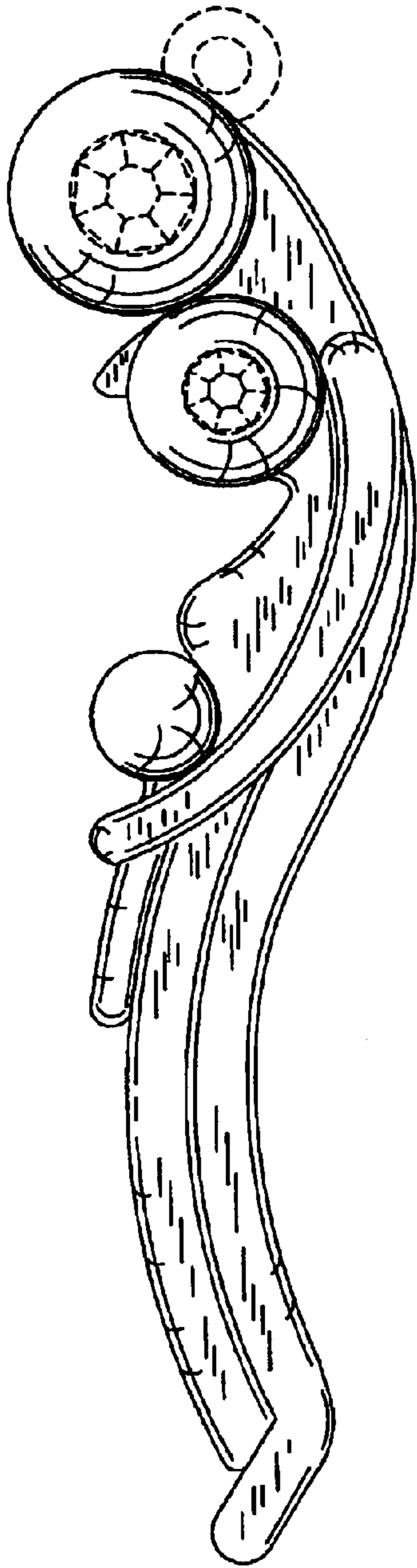

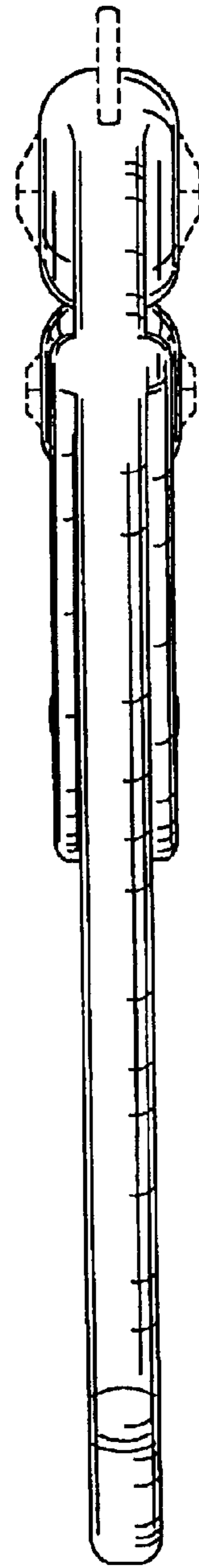

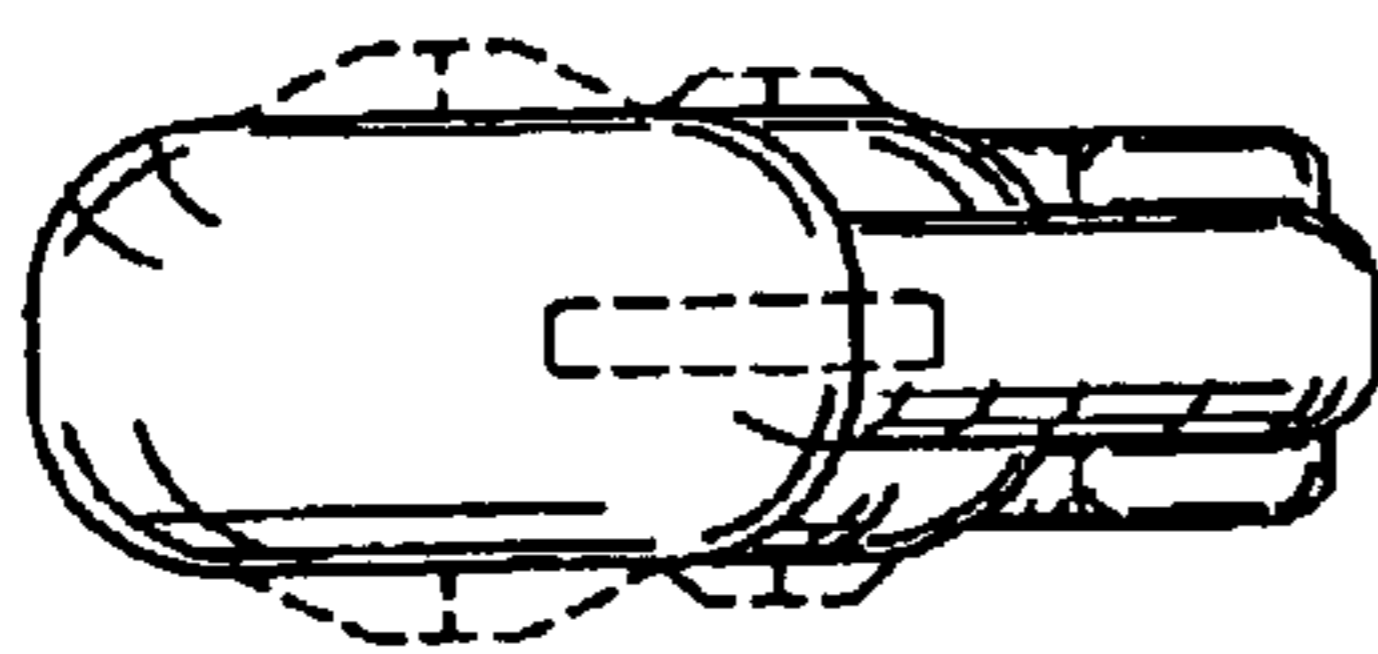

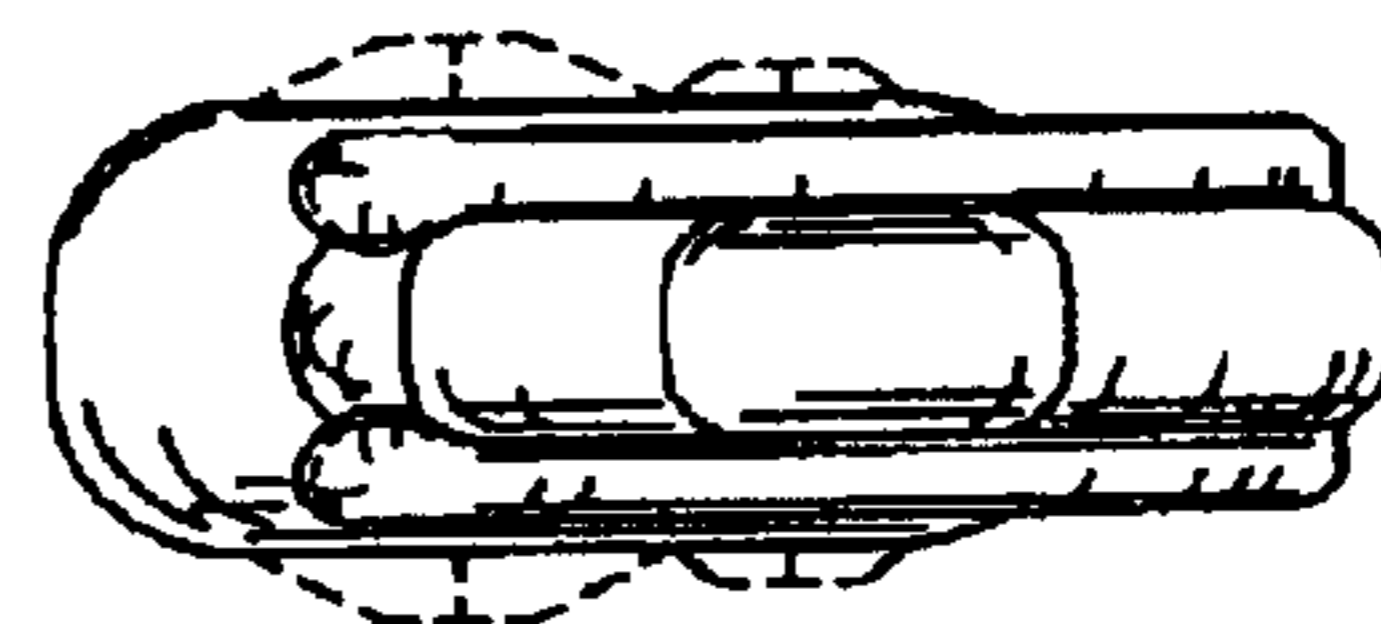
