(57) **CLAIM**

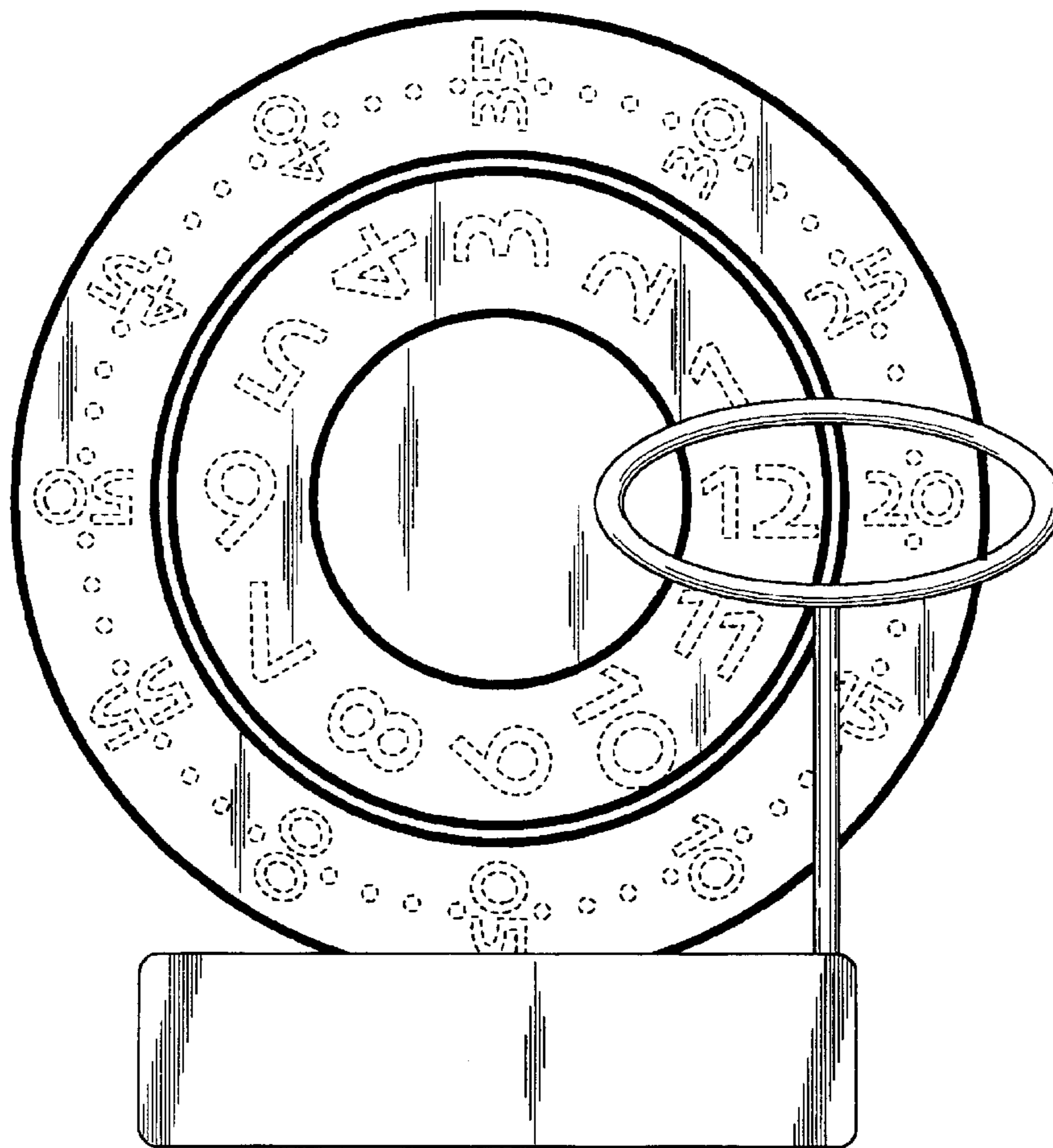
The ornamental design for a time piece, as shown and described.

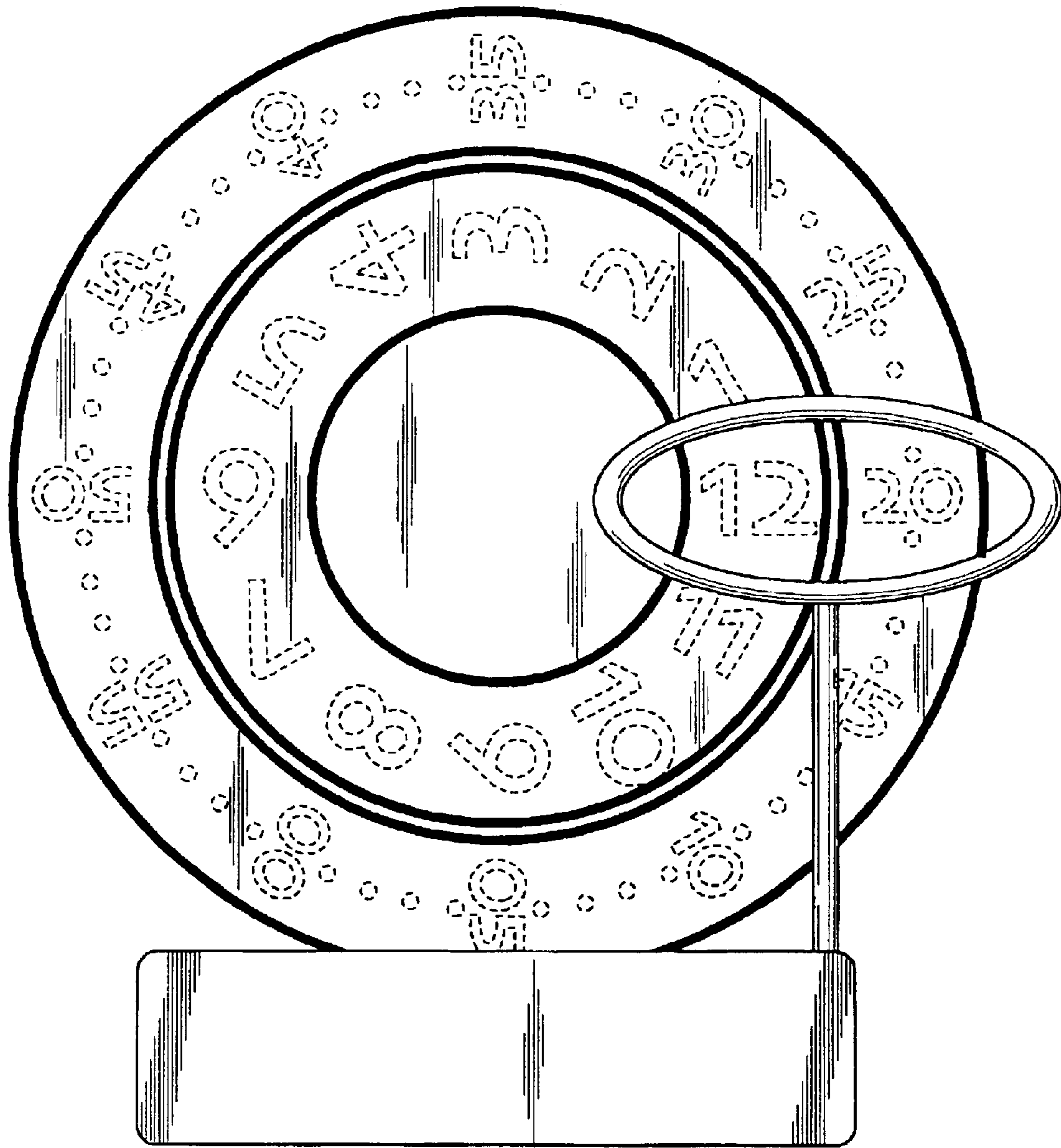

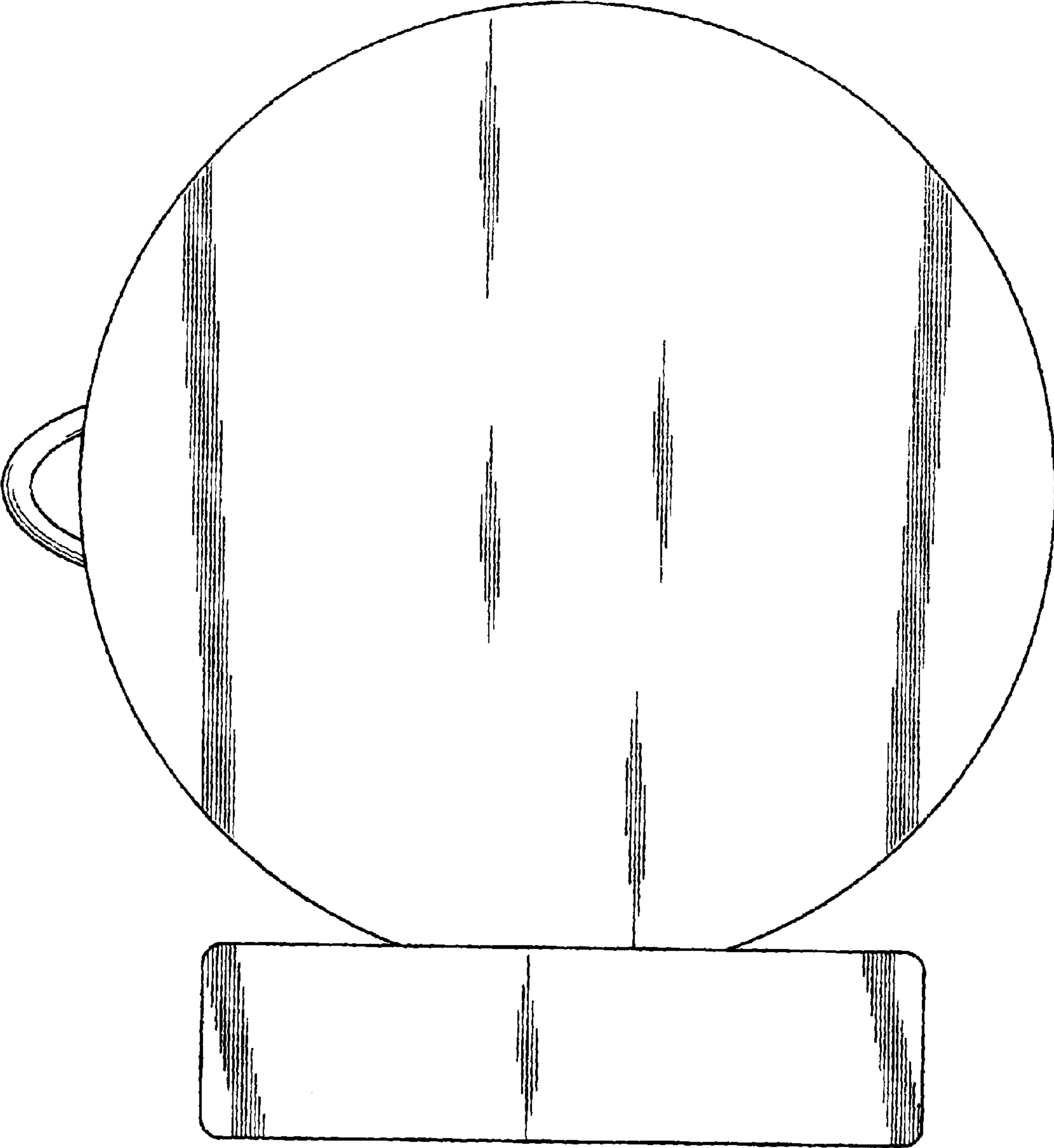

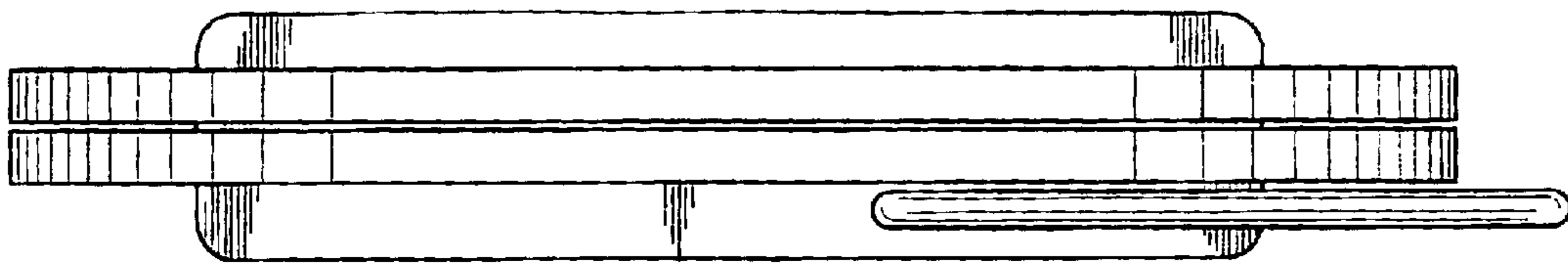

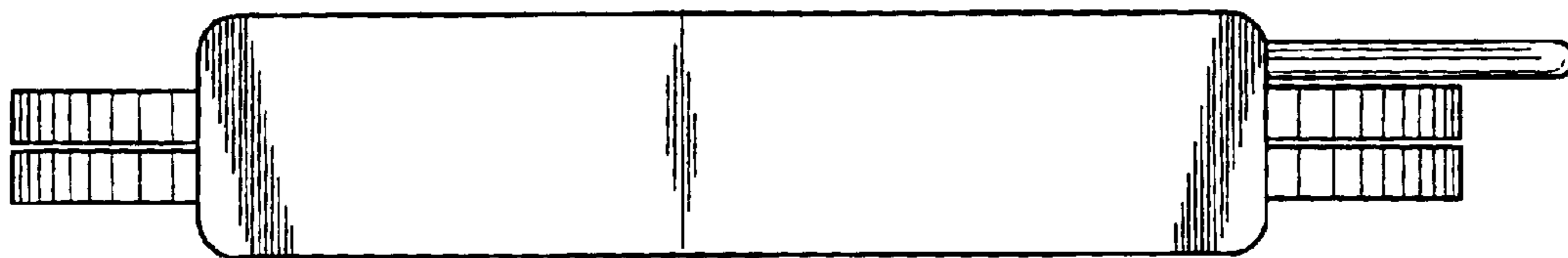

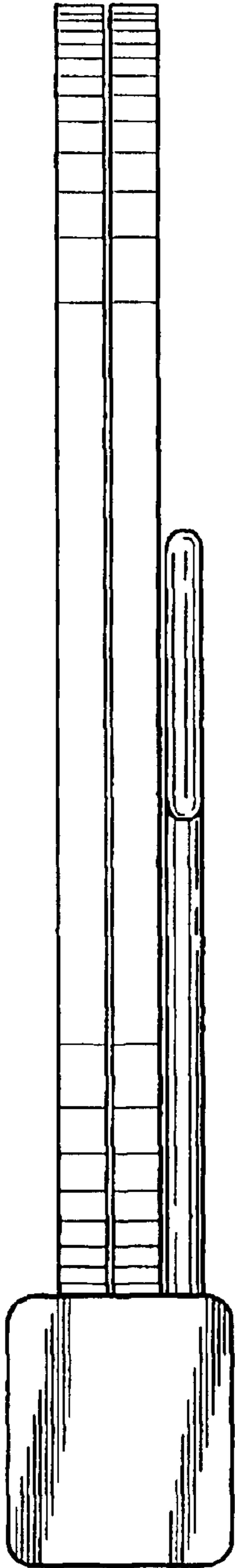

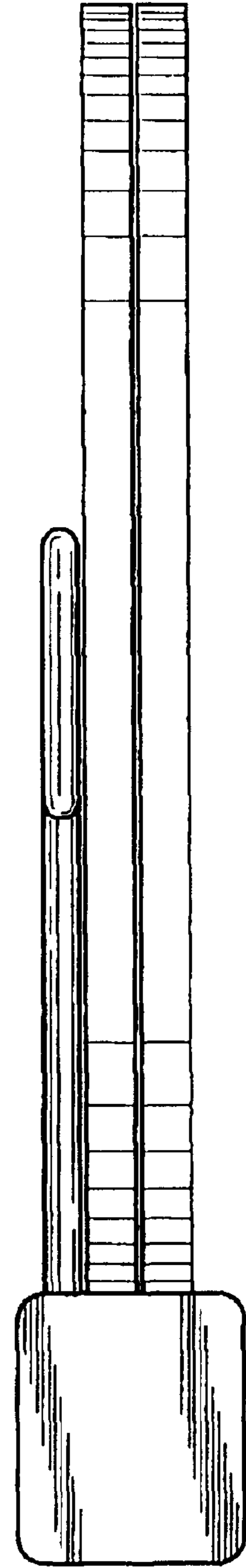

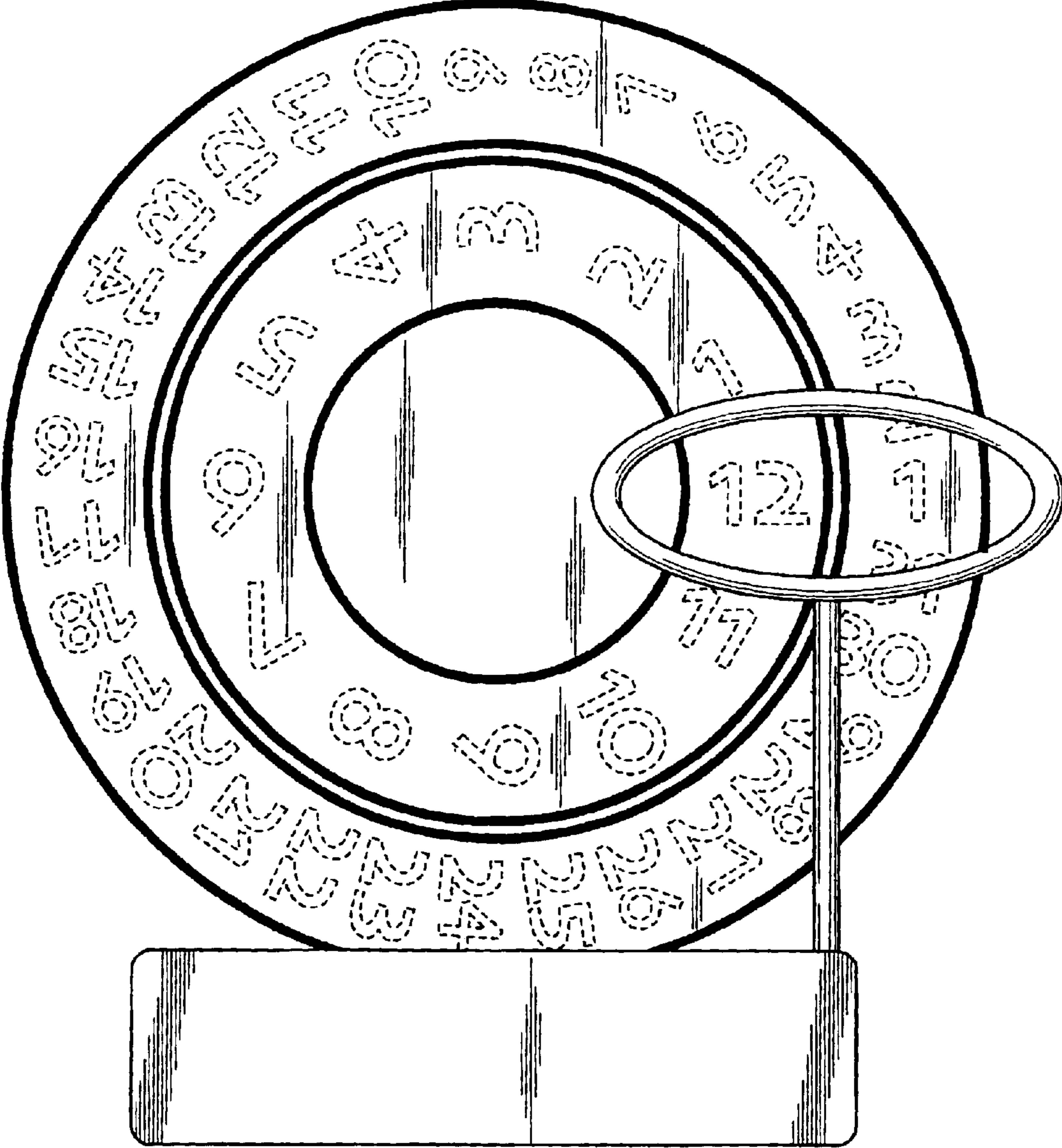
