(57) **CLAIM**

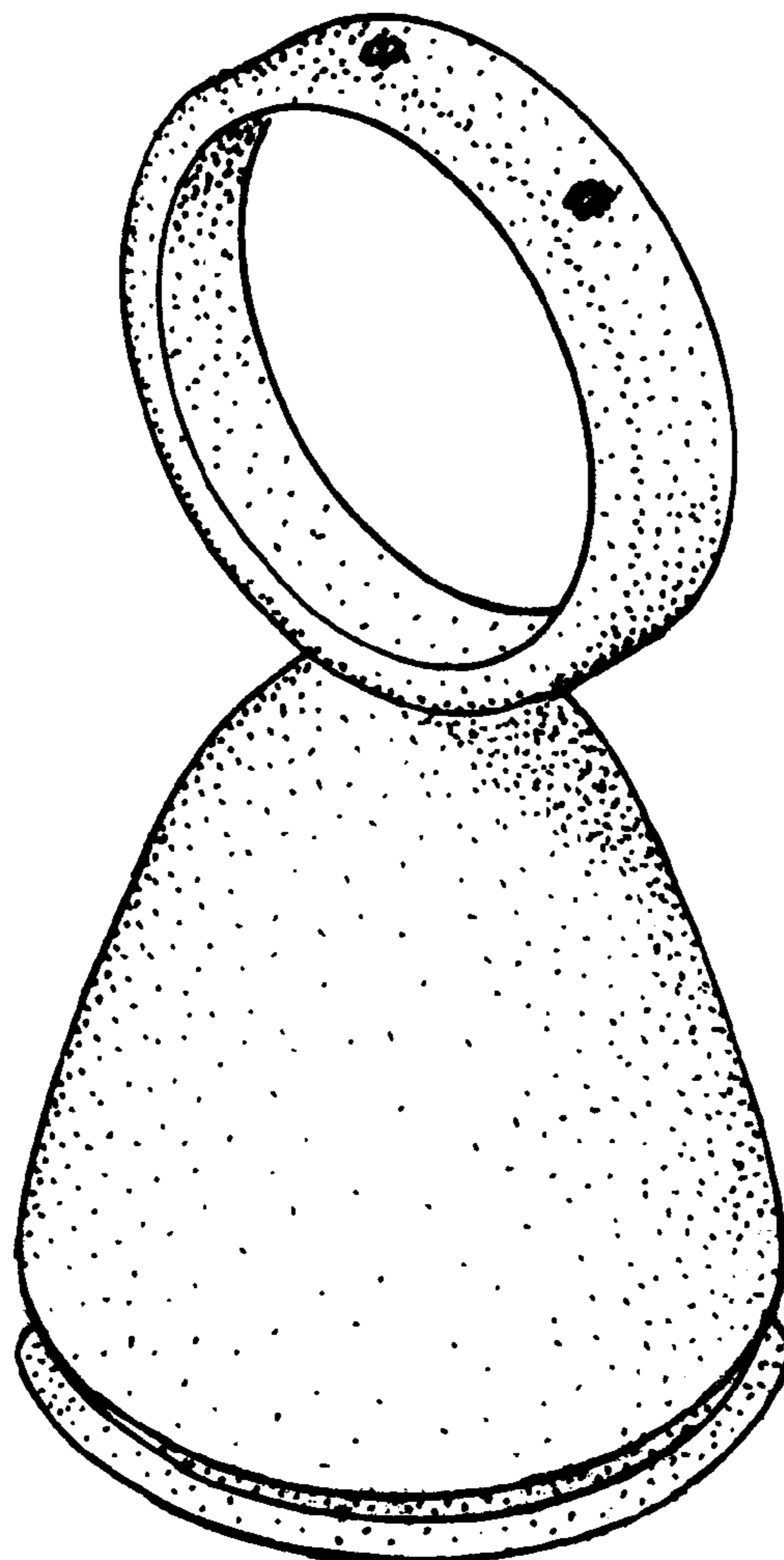
The ornamental design for a candle snuffer, as shown.

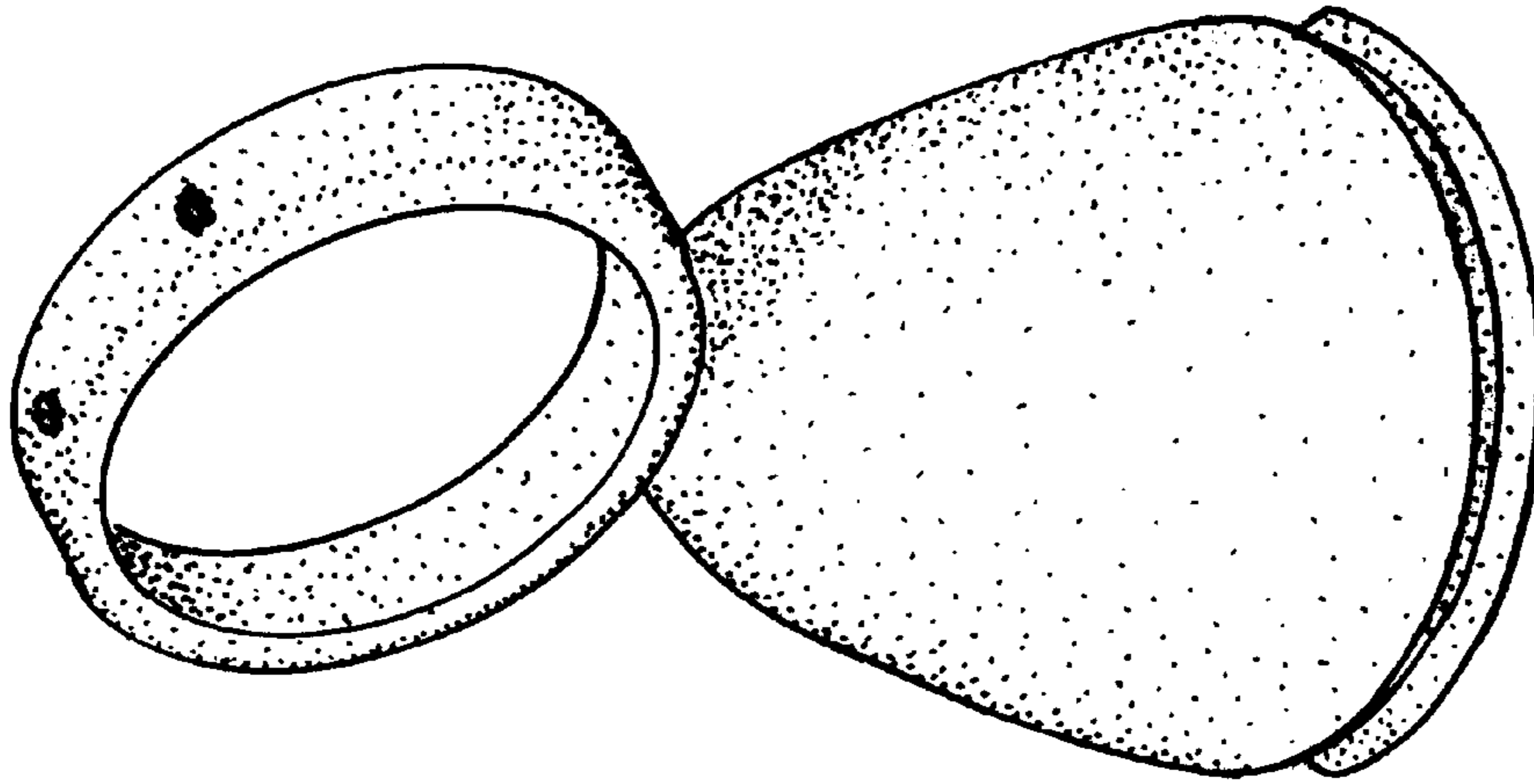

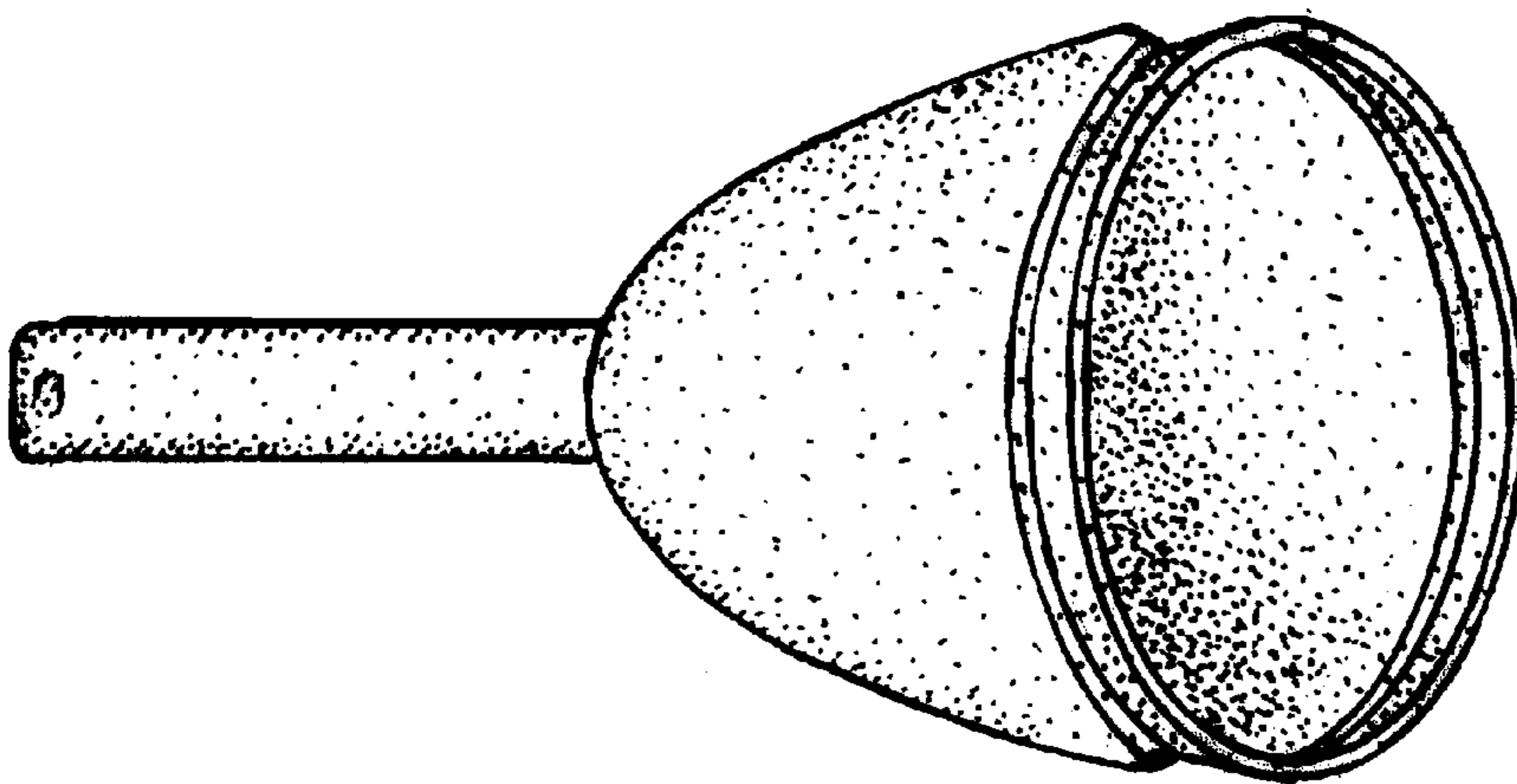

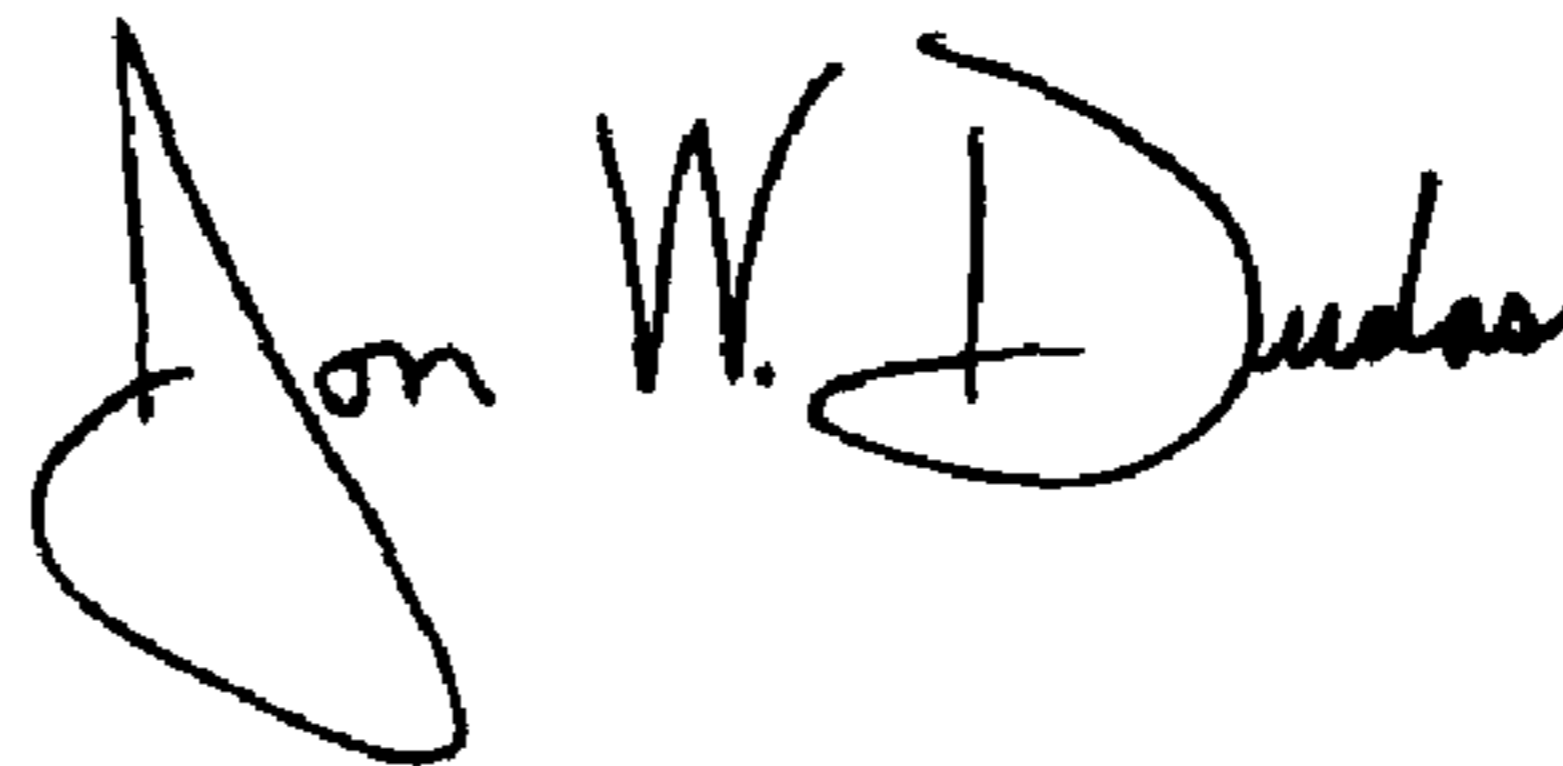
