FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment showing my new design;

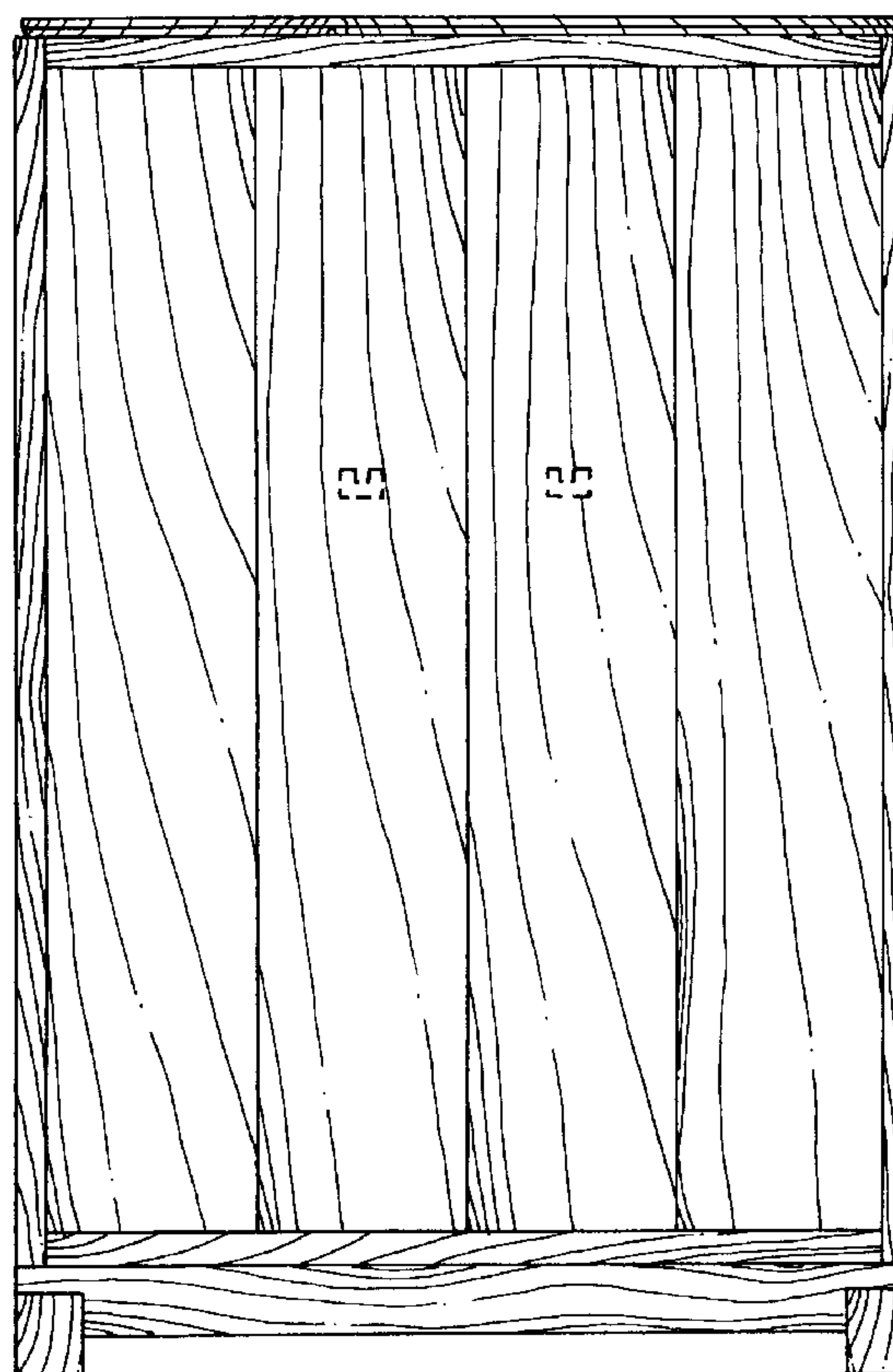
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image;

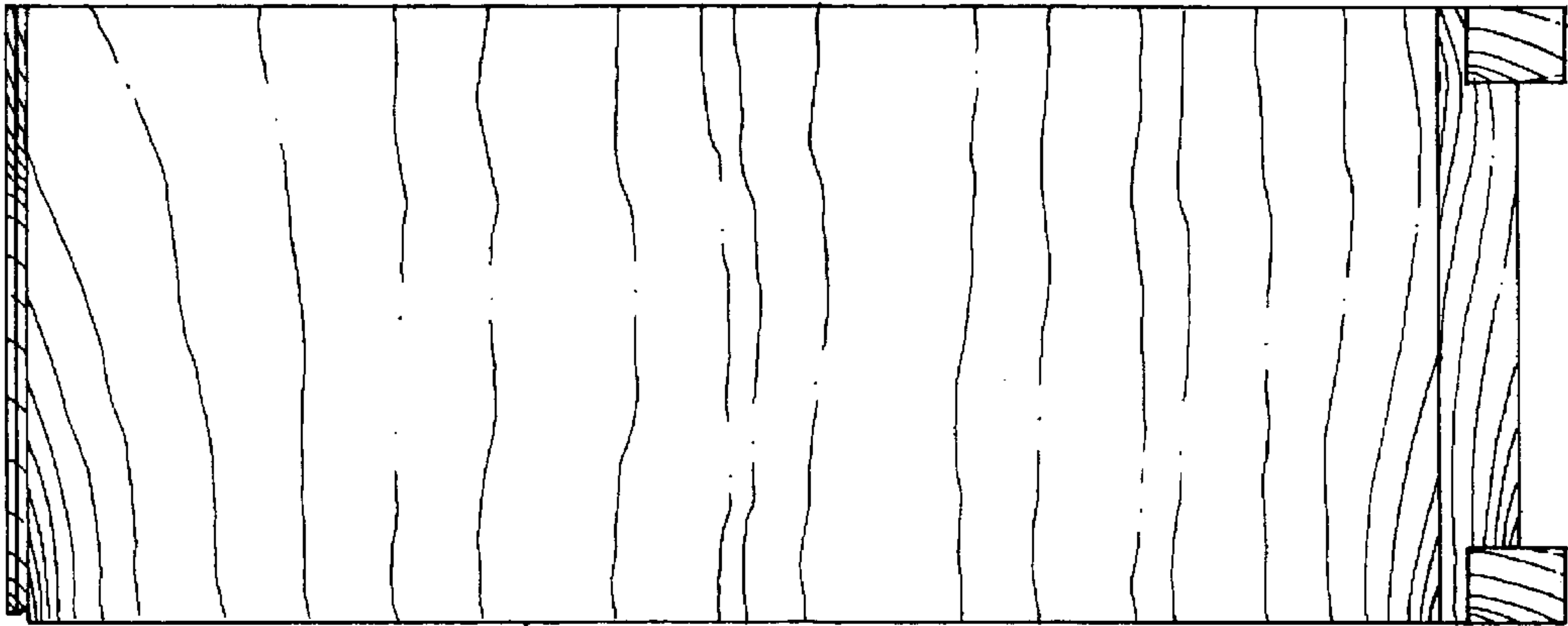

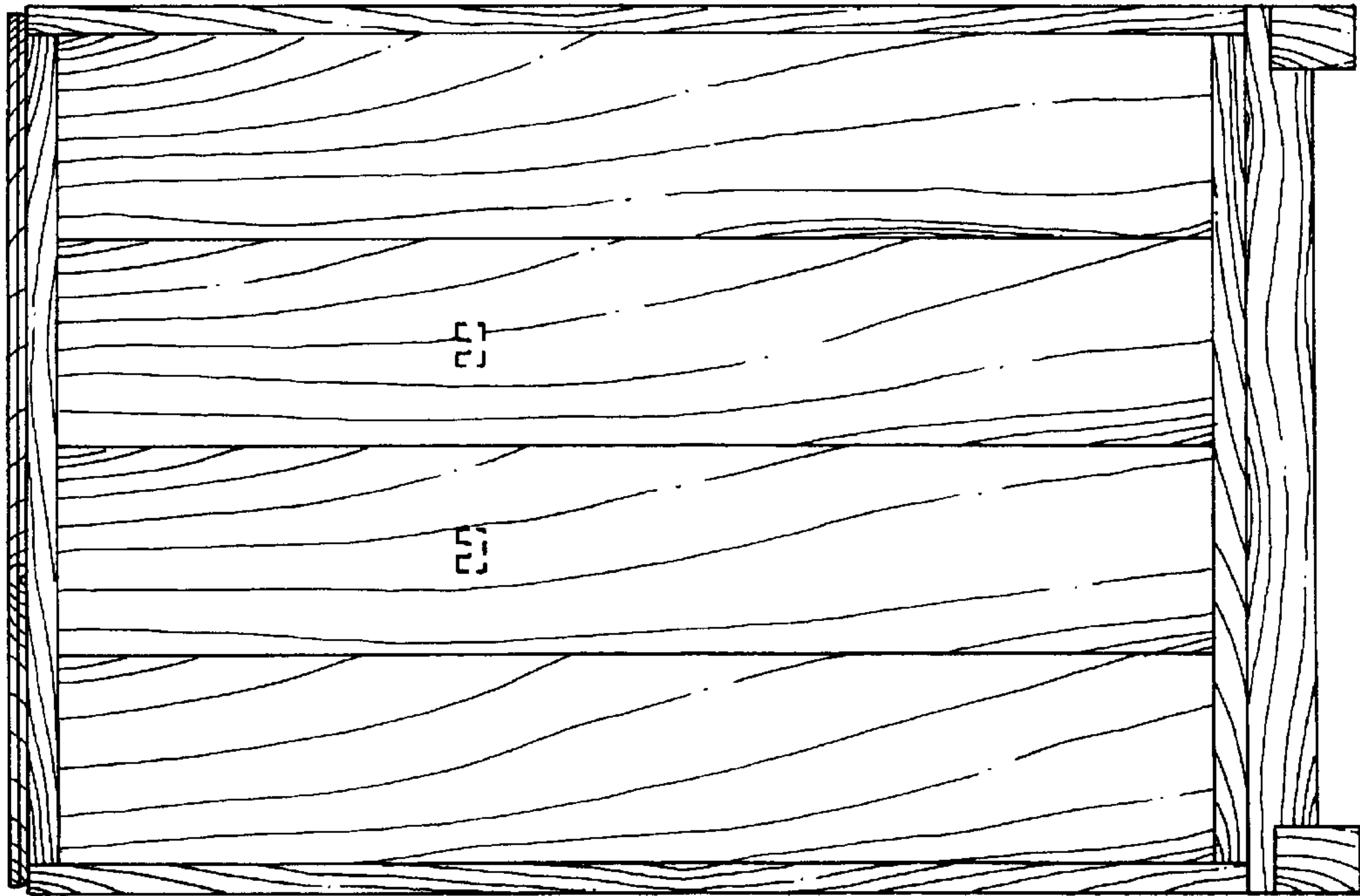

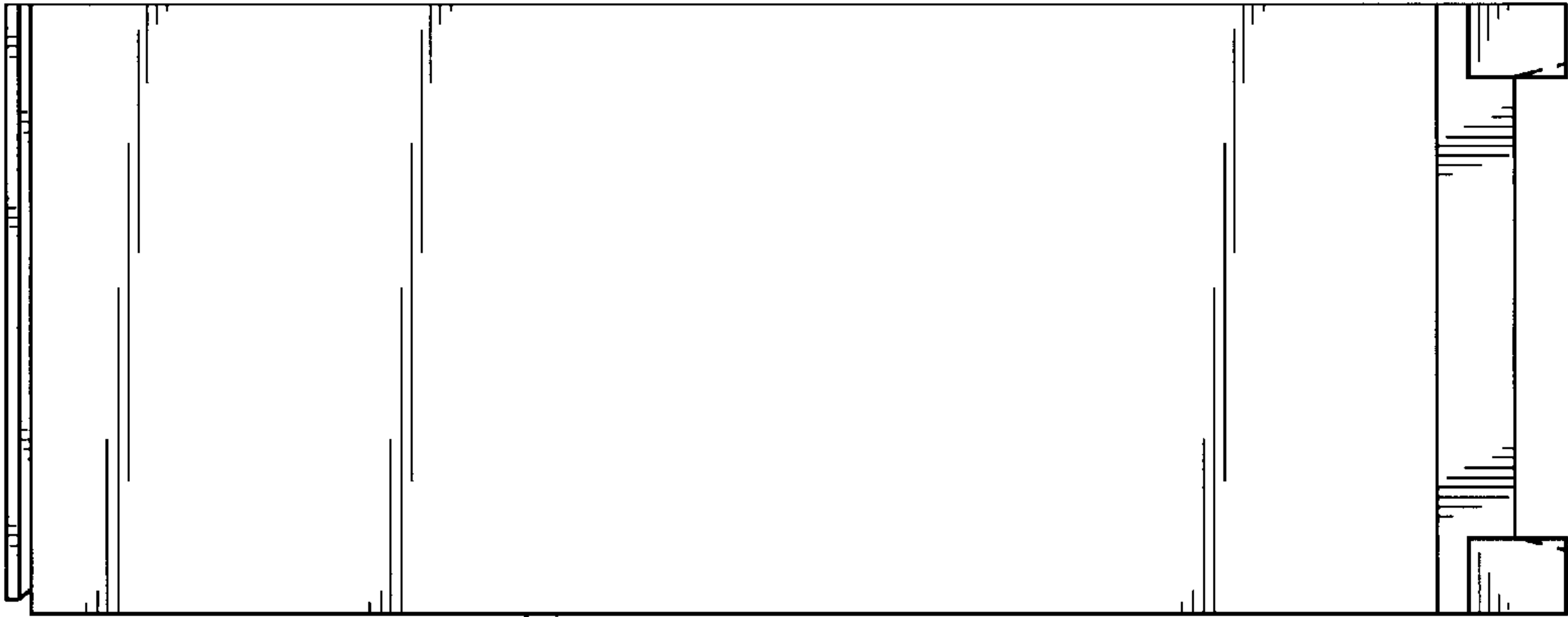

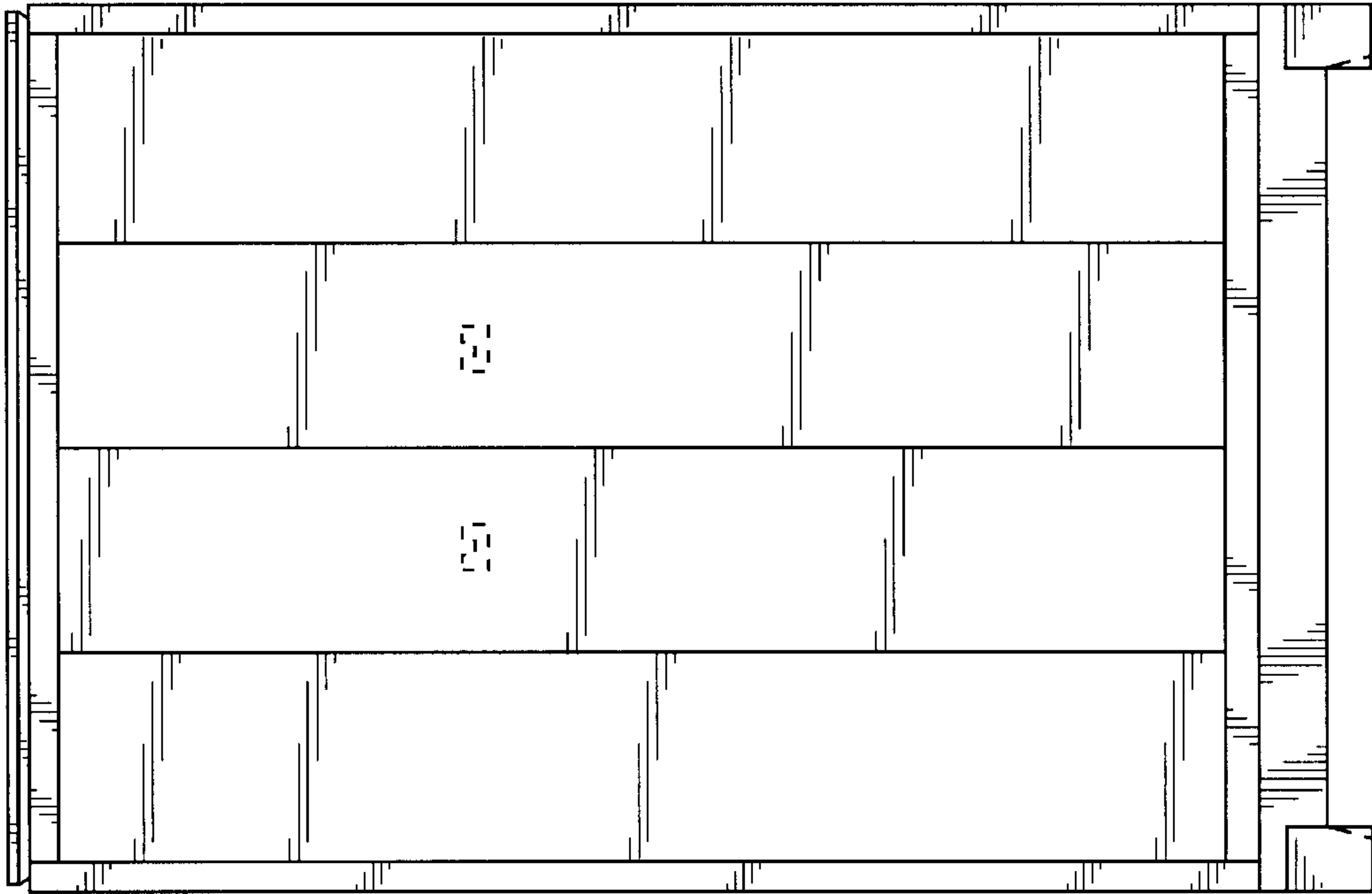
