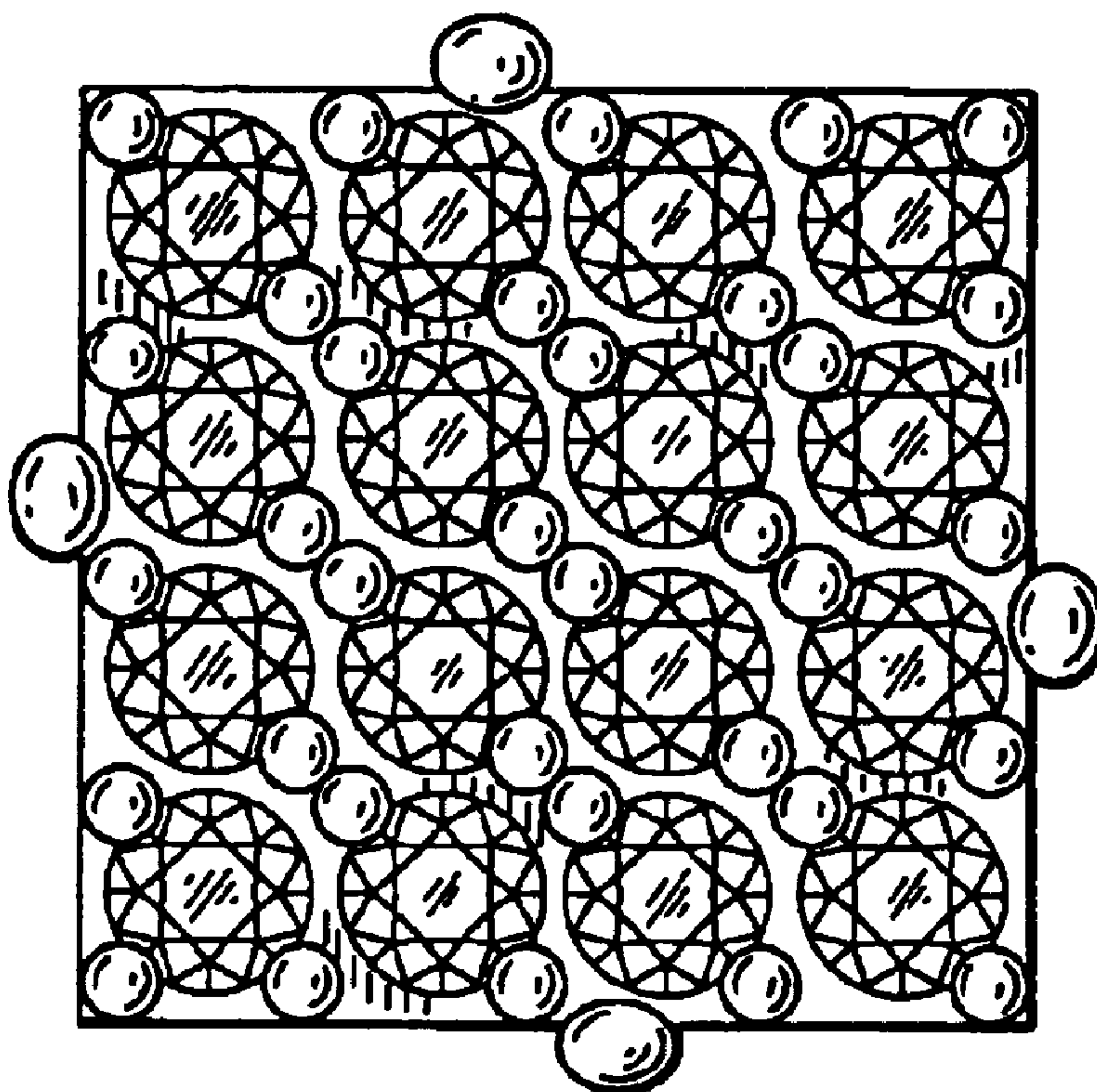
The ornamental jewelry cluster, as shown and described.

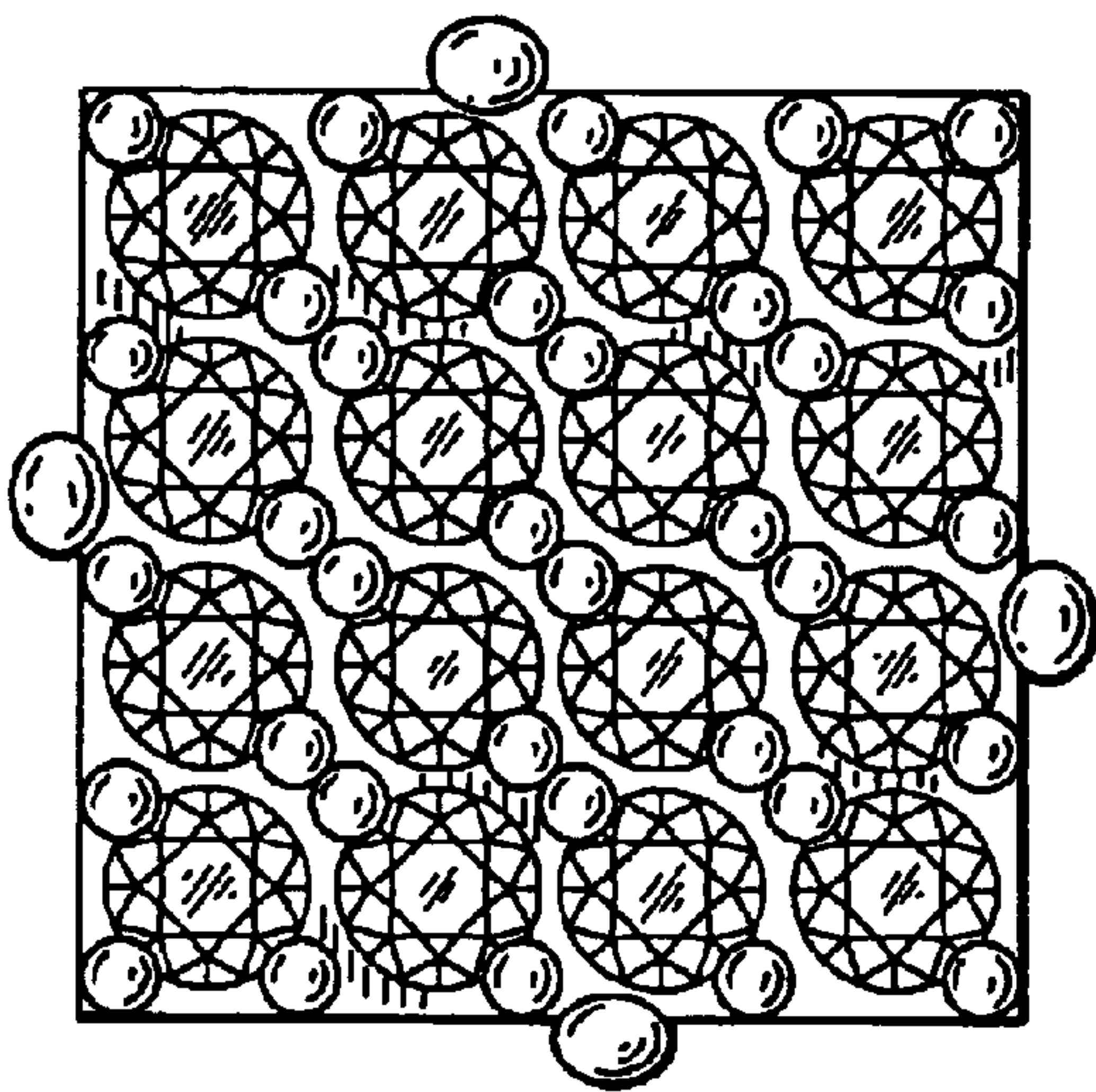

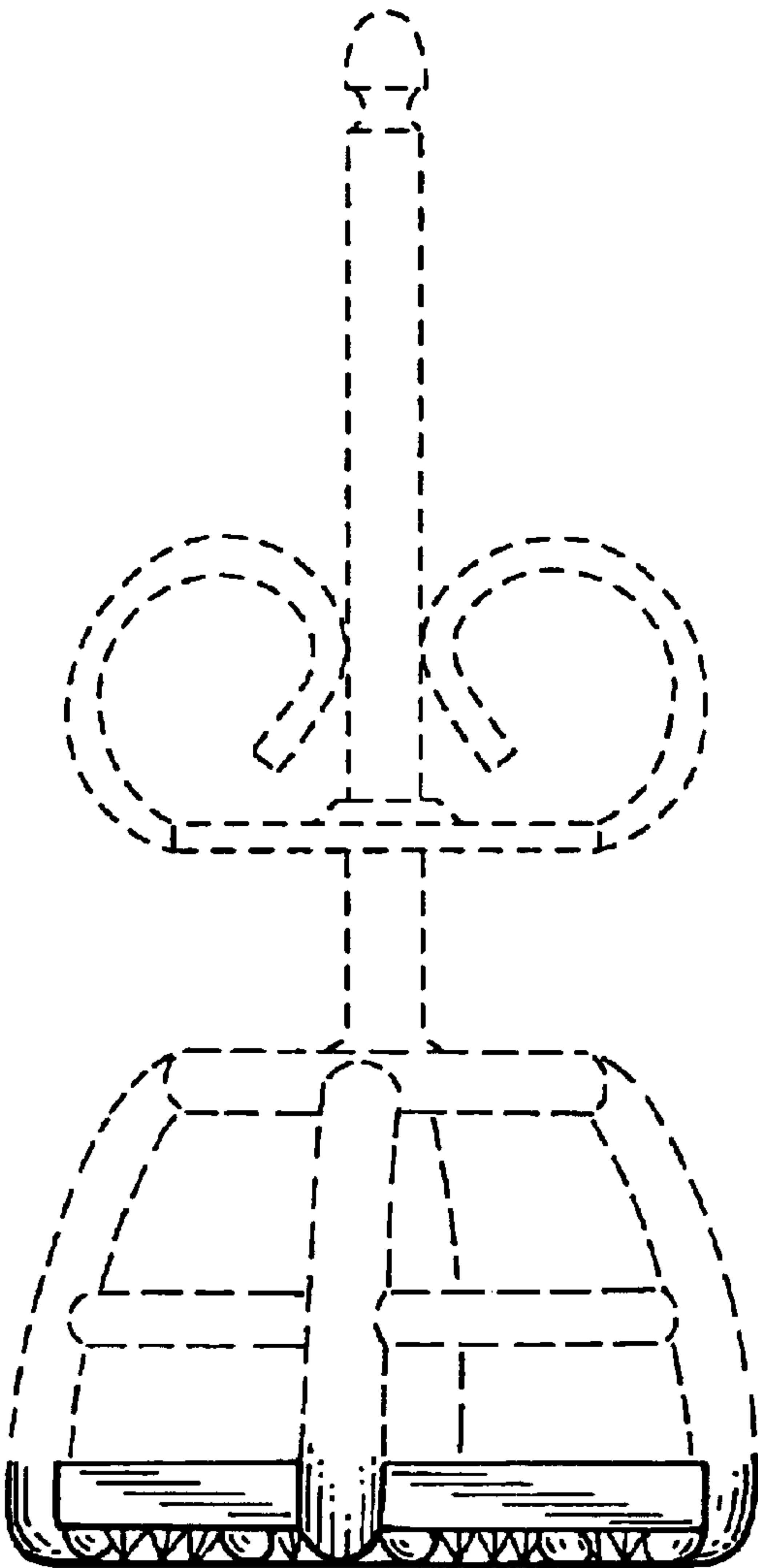
