(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a meditation chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a meditation chair according to the present design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the meditation chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the meditation chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the meditation chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the meditation chair shown in FIG. 1;

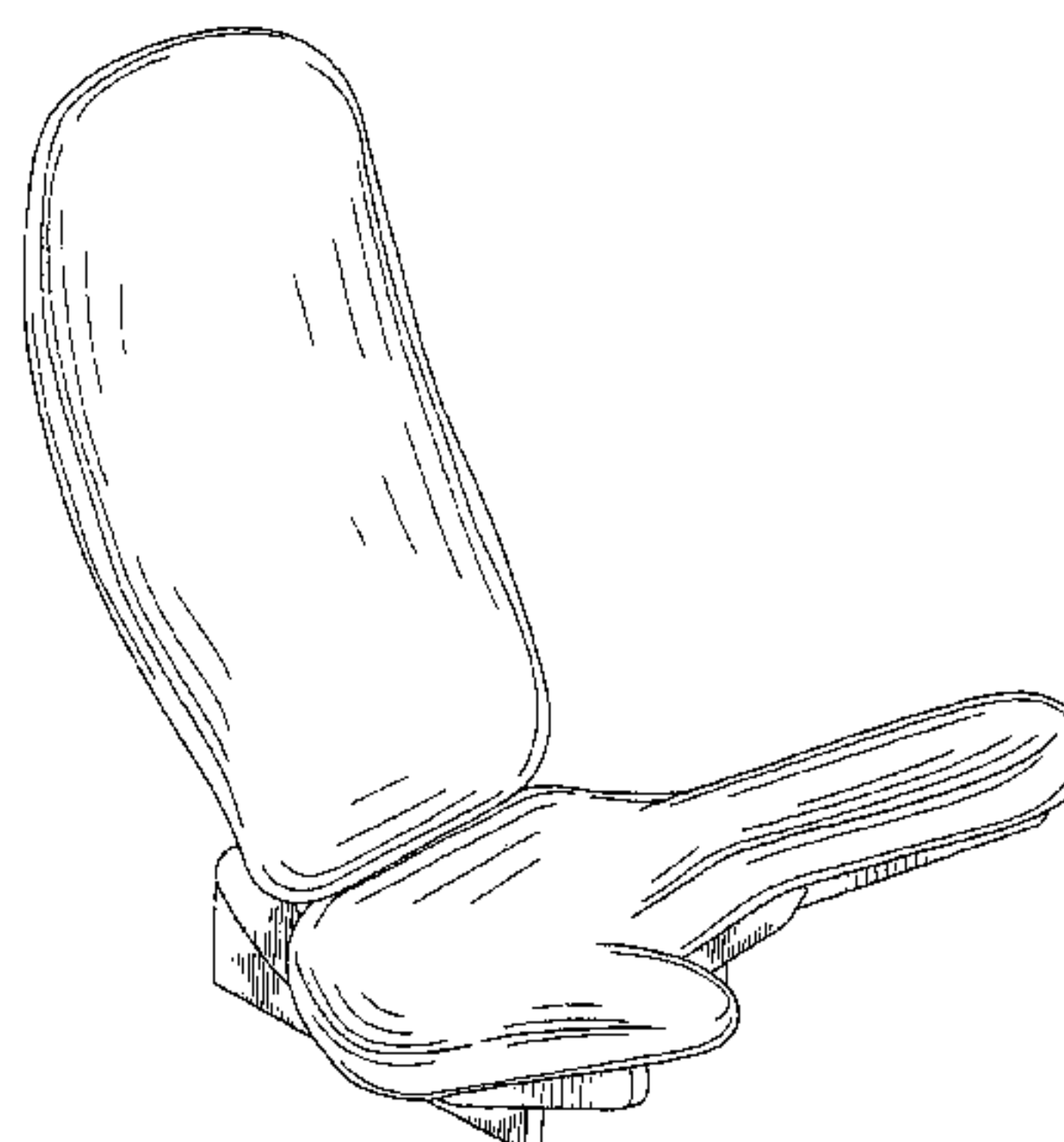
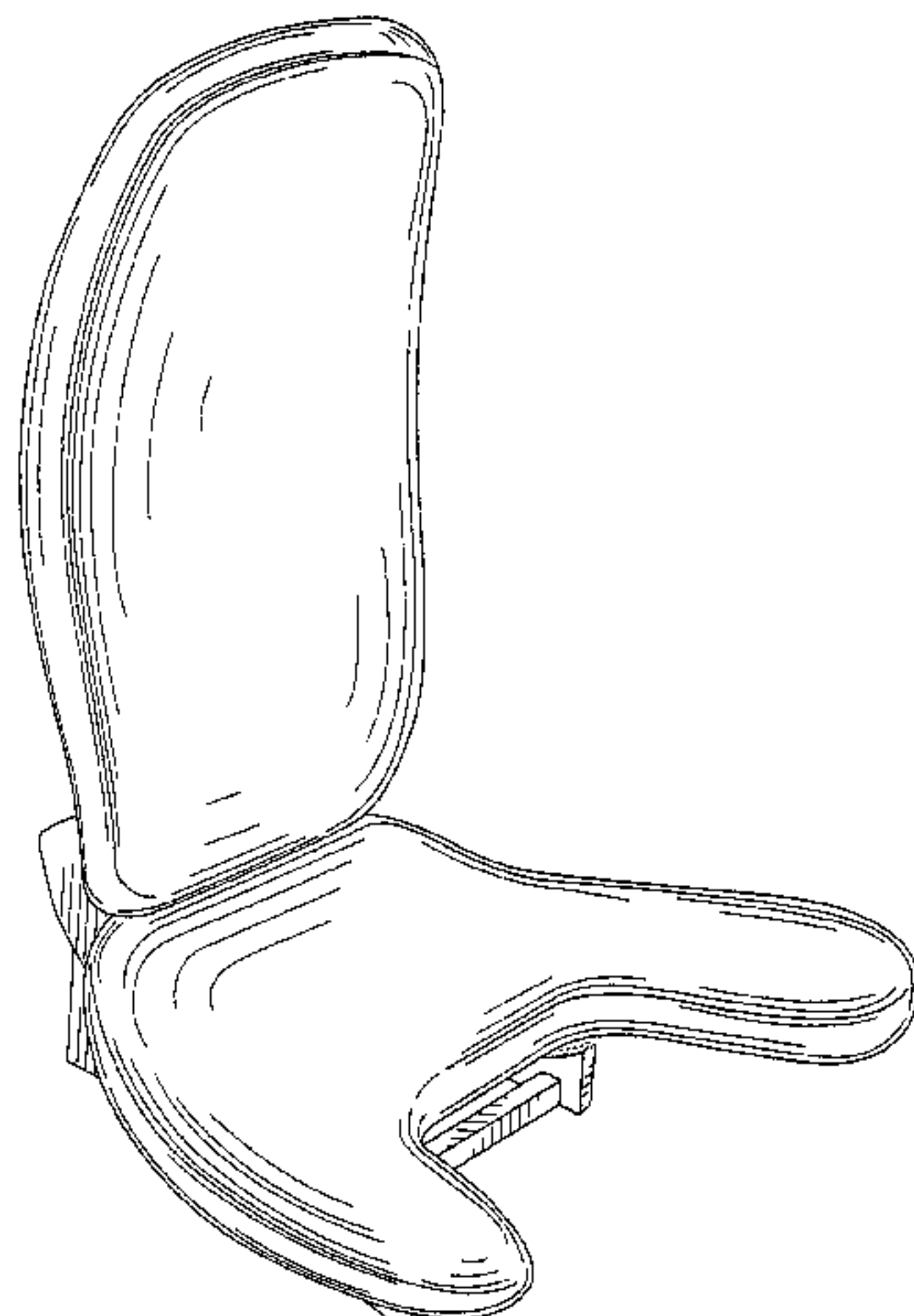
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the meditation chair shown in FIG. 1;

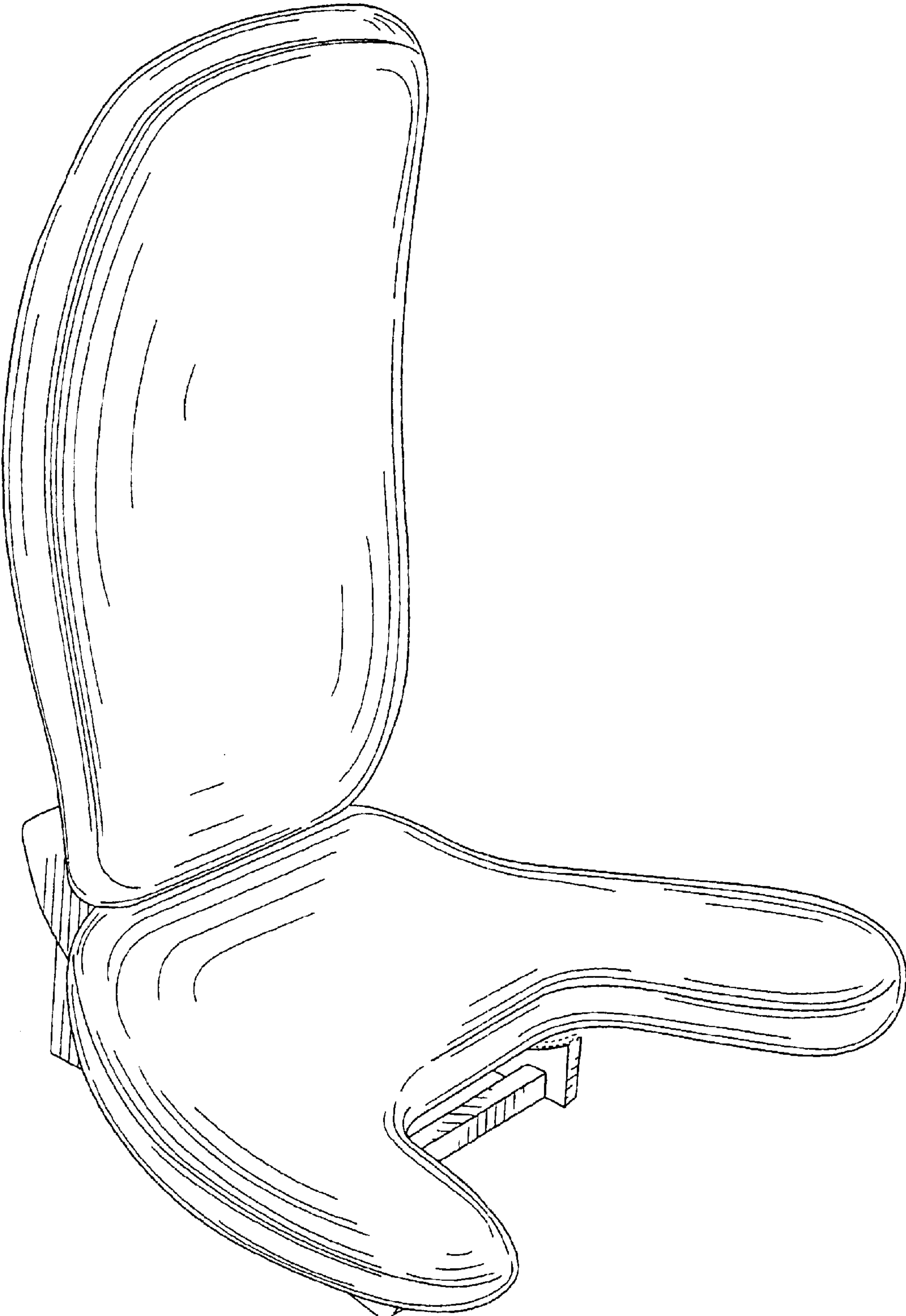

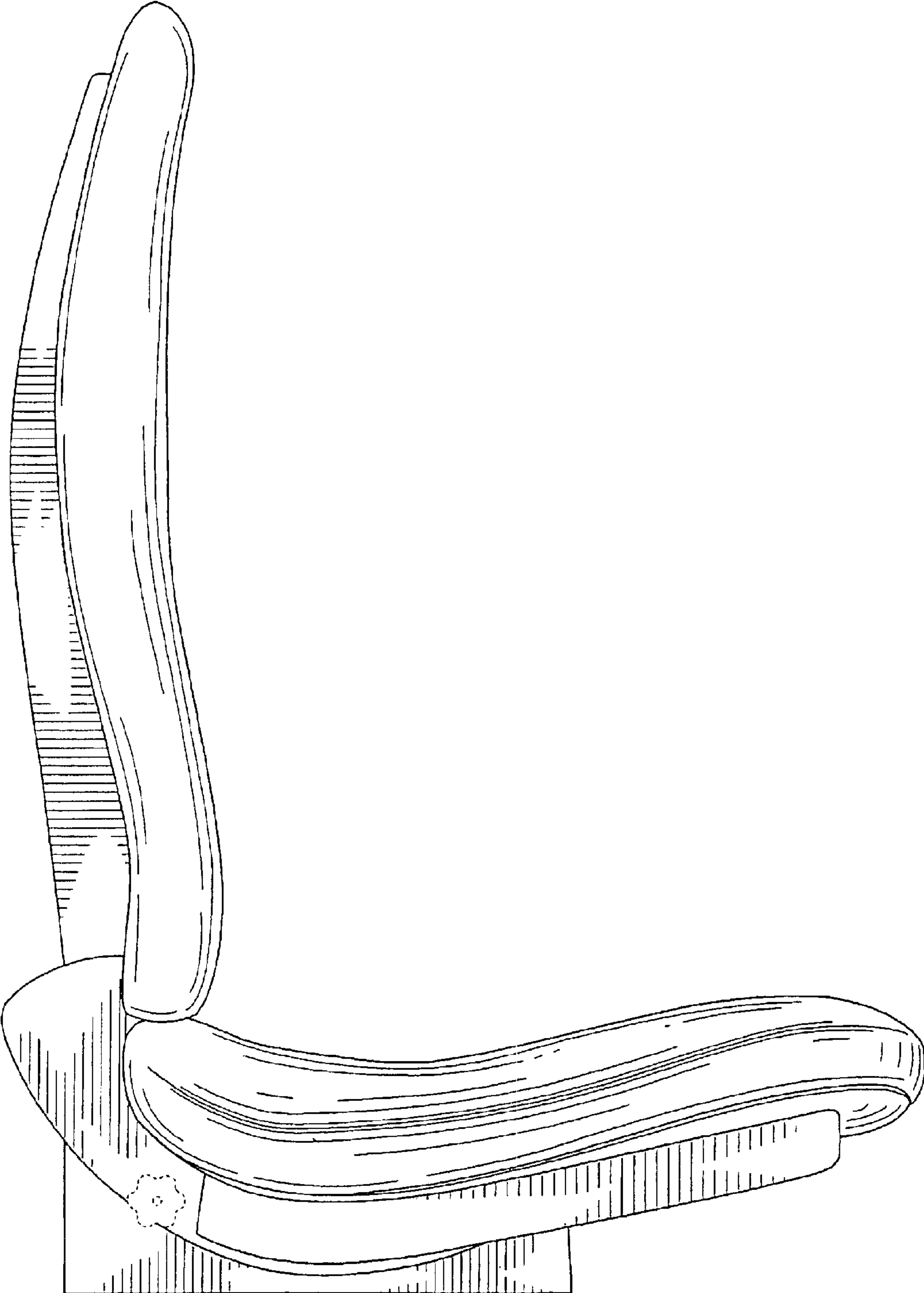

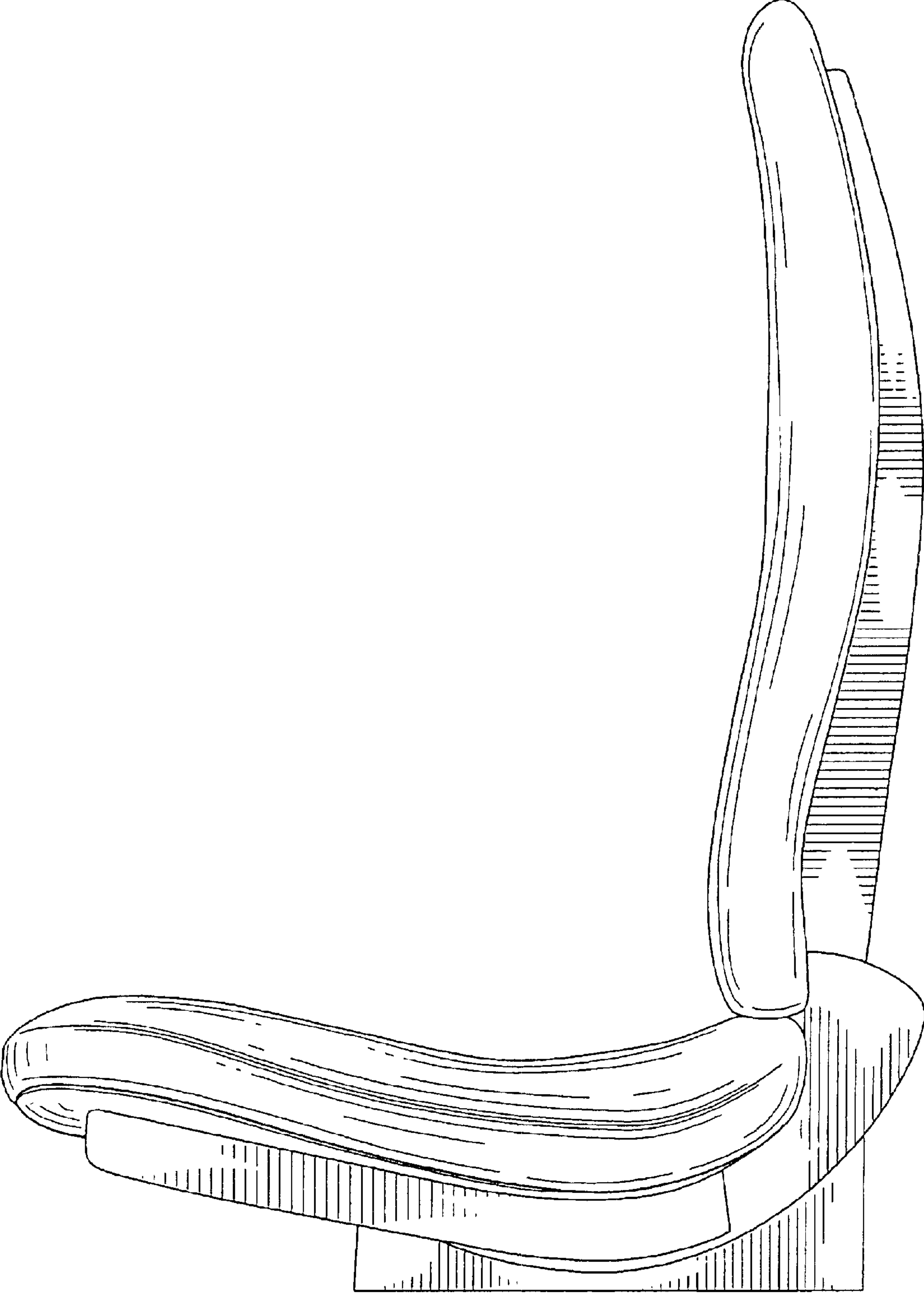

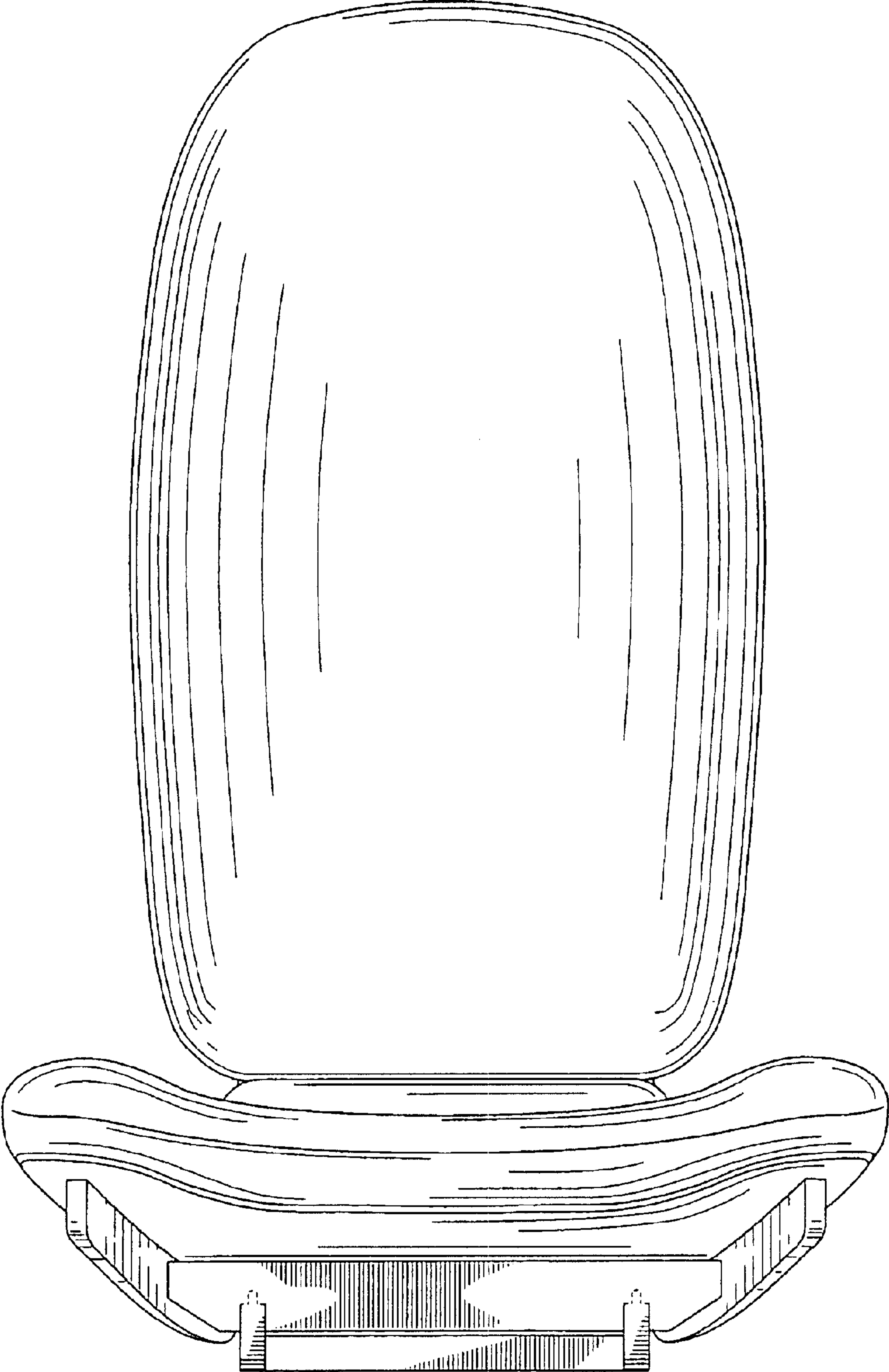

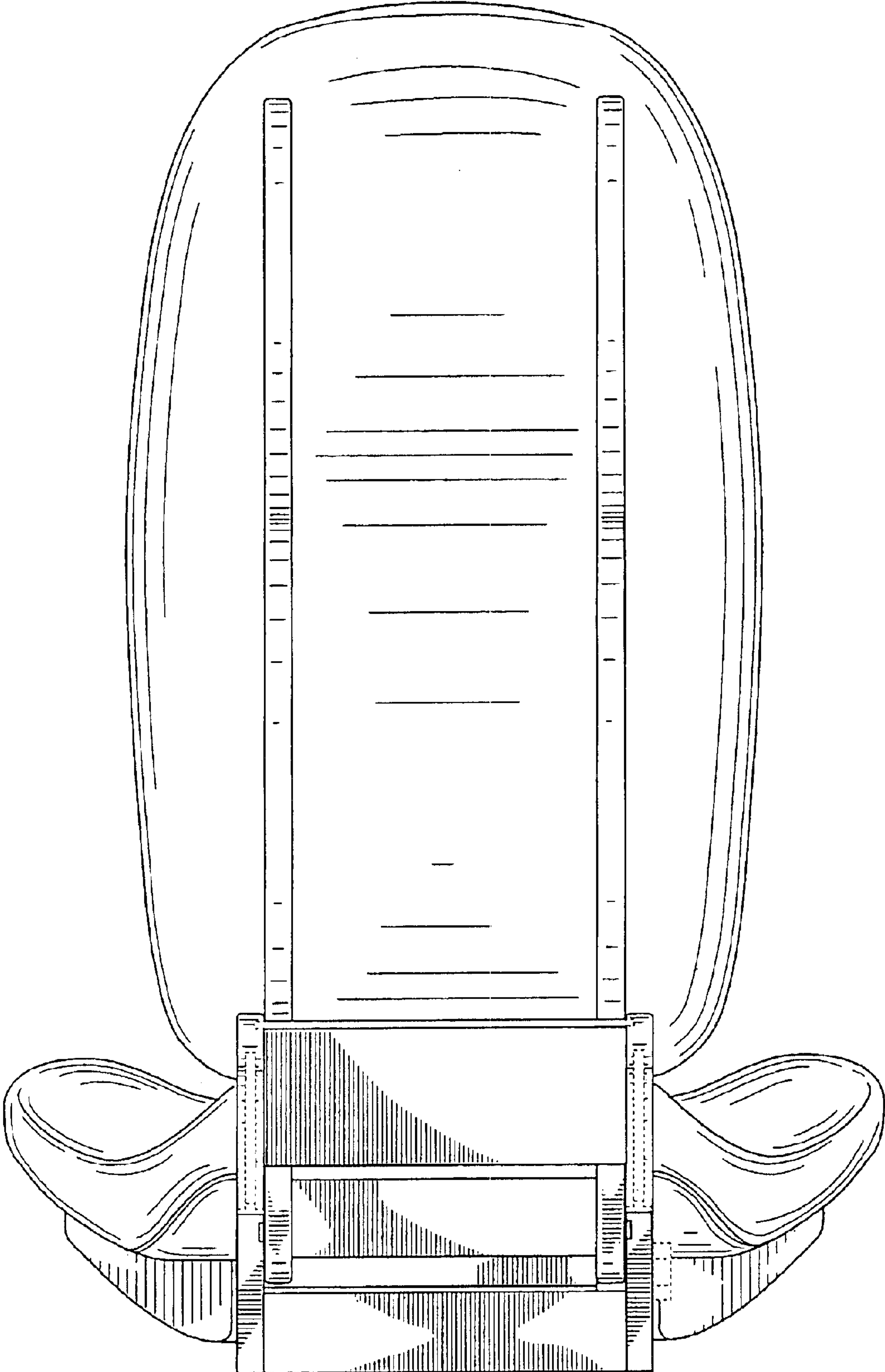

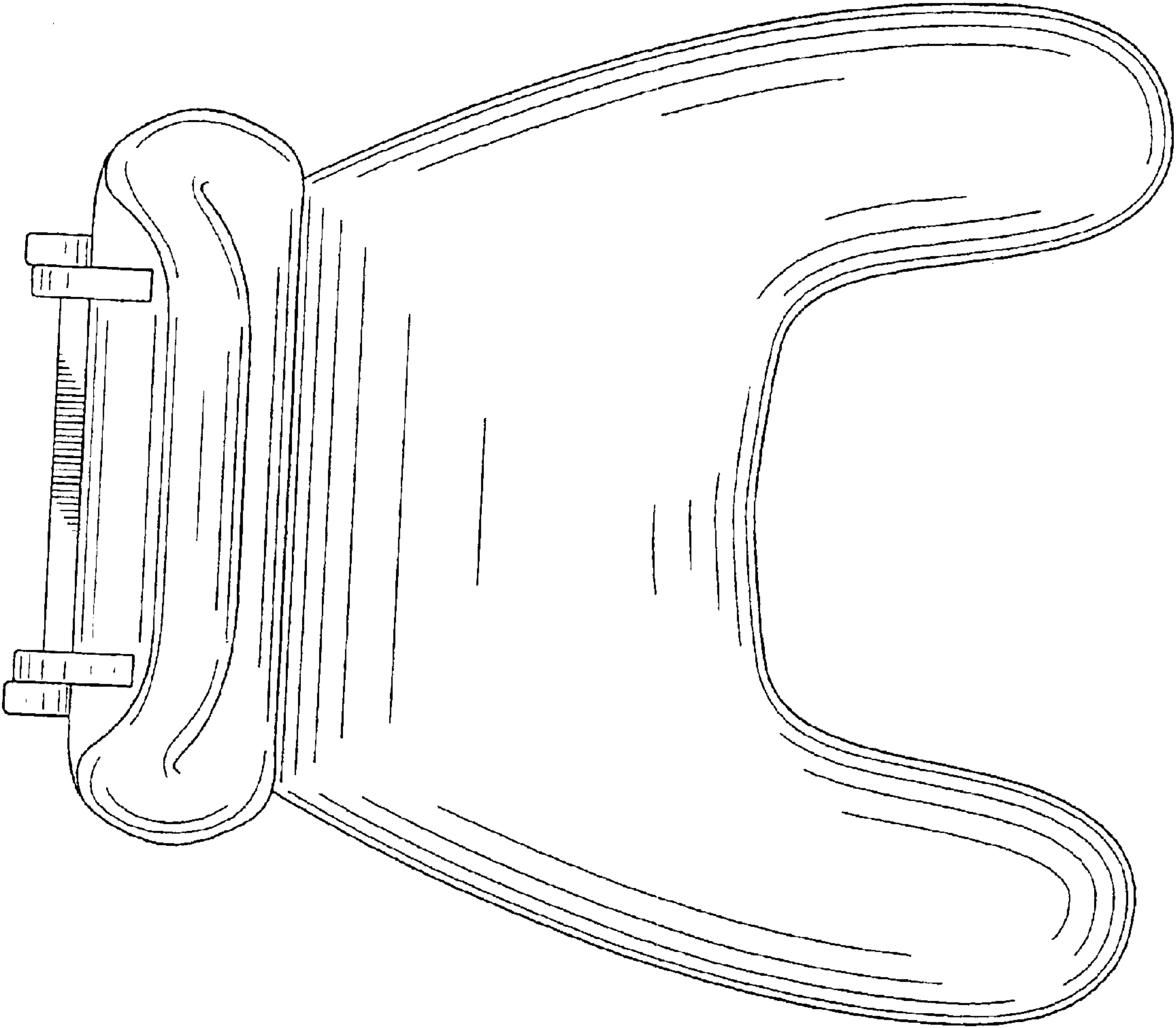

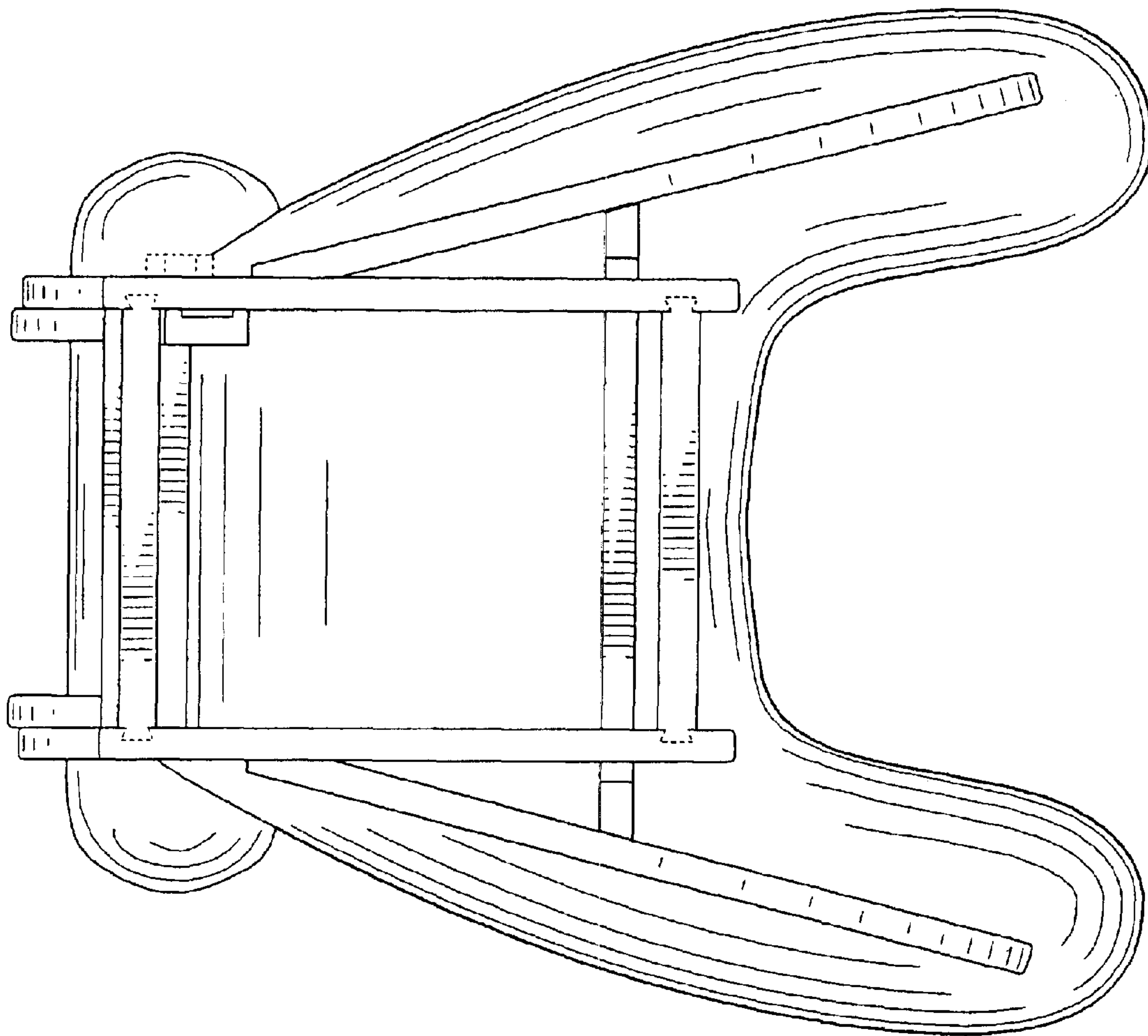

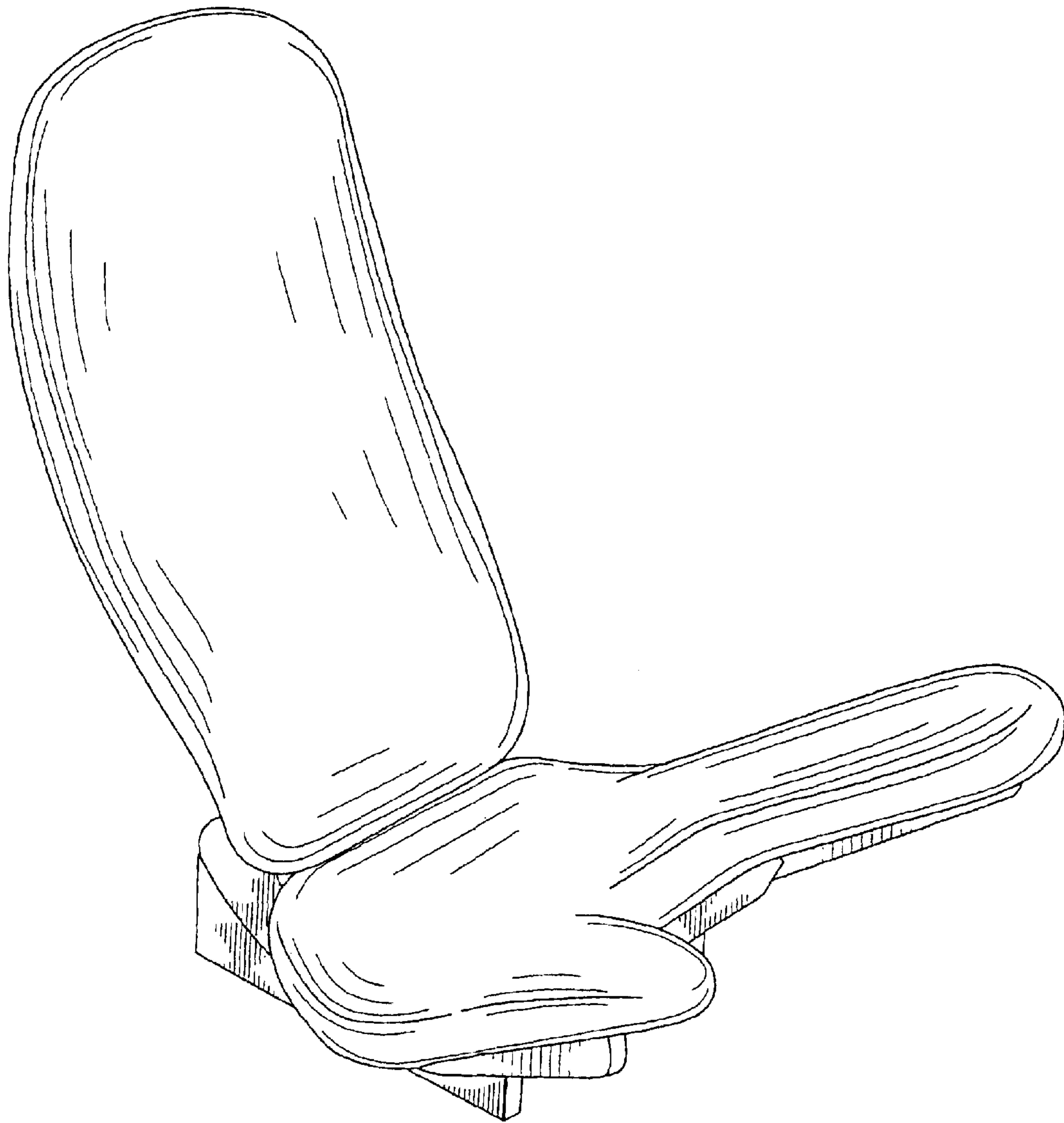
