DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the Bible marker

FIG. 19 is a front elevational view of a fifth Bible marking strip forming part of the Bible marker as shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 20 is a is a right side elevational view of the Bible marking strip as shown in FIG. 19;

FIG. 21 is a rear elevational view of a second embodiment of a holder for Bible marking strips forming part of the Bible marker shown in FIG. 1, the front elevational view is identical to FIG. 1;

FIG. 22 is a top plan view of the holder shown in FIG. 21, the bottom plan view is identical;

FIG. 23 is a left side view of the holder shown in FIG. 21, the right side view is identical to FIG. 6;

FIG. 24 is a rear elevational view of a third embodiment of a holder for Bible marking strips forming part of the Bible marker shown in FIG. 1, the front elevational view is identical to FIG. 1;

FIG. 25 is a top plan view of the holder shown in FIG. 24, the bottom plan view is identical;

FIG. 26 is a left side view of the holder shown in FIG. 24, the right side view is identical to FIG. 6;

FIG. 27 is a rear elevational view of a fourth embodiment of a holder for Bible marking strips forming part of the Bible marker shown in FIG. 1, the front elevational view is identical to FIG. 1; FIG. 28 is a right side view of the holder shown in FIG. 27, the left side view is identical, and the top plan view and bottom plan view are identical to FIG. 8; FIG. 29 is a rear elevational view of a fifth embodiment of a holder for Bible marking strips forming part of the Bible marker shown in FIG. 1, the front elevational view is identical to FIG. 1, and top plan view and the bottom plan view are the same as FIG. 22; FIG. **30** is a right side view of the holder shown in FIG. **29**, the left side view is identical, and the top plan view and bottom plan view are identical to FIG. **8**;

FIG. 31 is a rear elevational view of a sixth embodiment of a holder for Bible marking strips forming part of the Bible marker shown in FIG. 1, the front elevational view is identical to FIG. 1;

FIG. 32 is a right side view of the holder shown in FIG. 31, the left side view is identical; and,

FIG. 33 a is top plan view of the holder shown in FIG. 31, the bottom plan view is identical.

The various views of the holder portions in FIGS. 5 through 9 and 21 through 33, and the Bible marking strips in FIGS. 10 through 20, have been shown separately for ease of illustration.
