The ornamental design for a mobile phone case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mobile phone case showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view showing a mobile phone case unbuttoned at one end of a suspended bond from a body thereof; and,

FIG. 9 is a reference view showing a mobile phone case in use.
















