DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a corn holder showing an exemplary embodiment of our new design; FIG. 2 is another side perspective view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a left side view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a right side view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a back view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a front view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; and FIG. 7 is a top view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; and FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the corn holder of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 9 is a side perspective view thereof, with another corn holder interlocked and shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design.
