The ornamental design for footwear upper, in any of the embodiments as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the footwear upper embodying the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof;

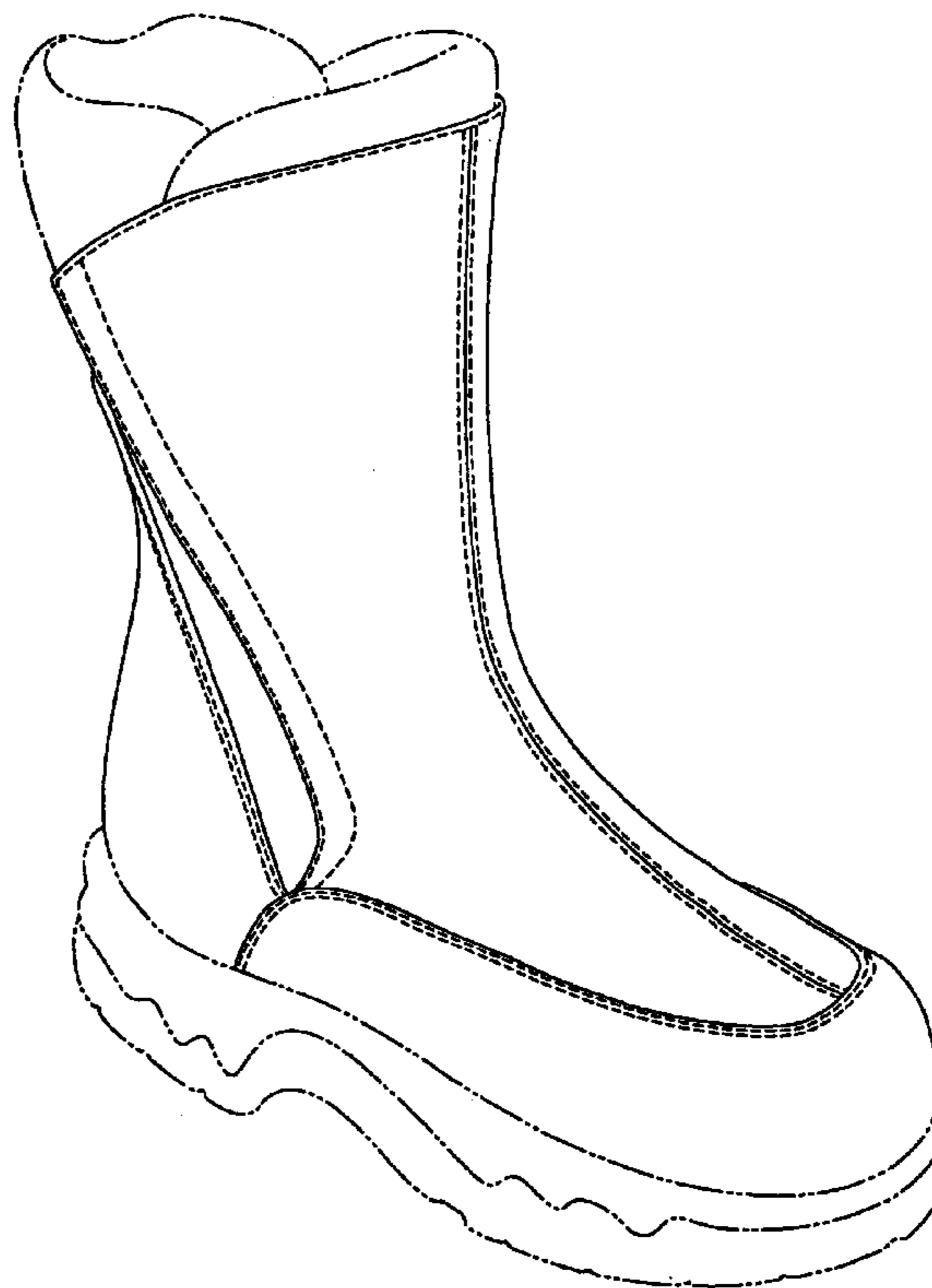
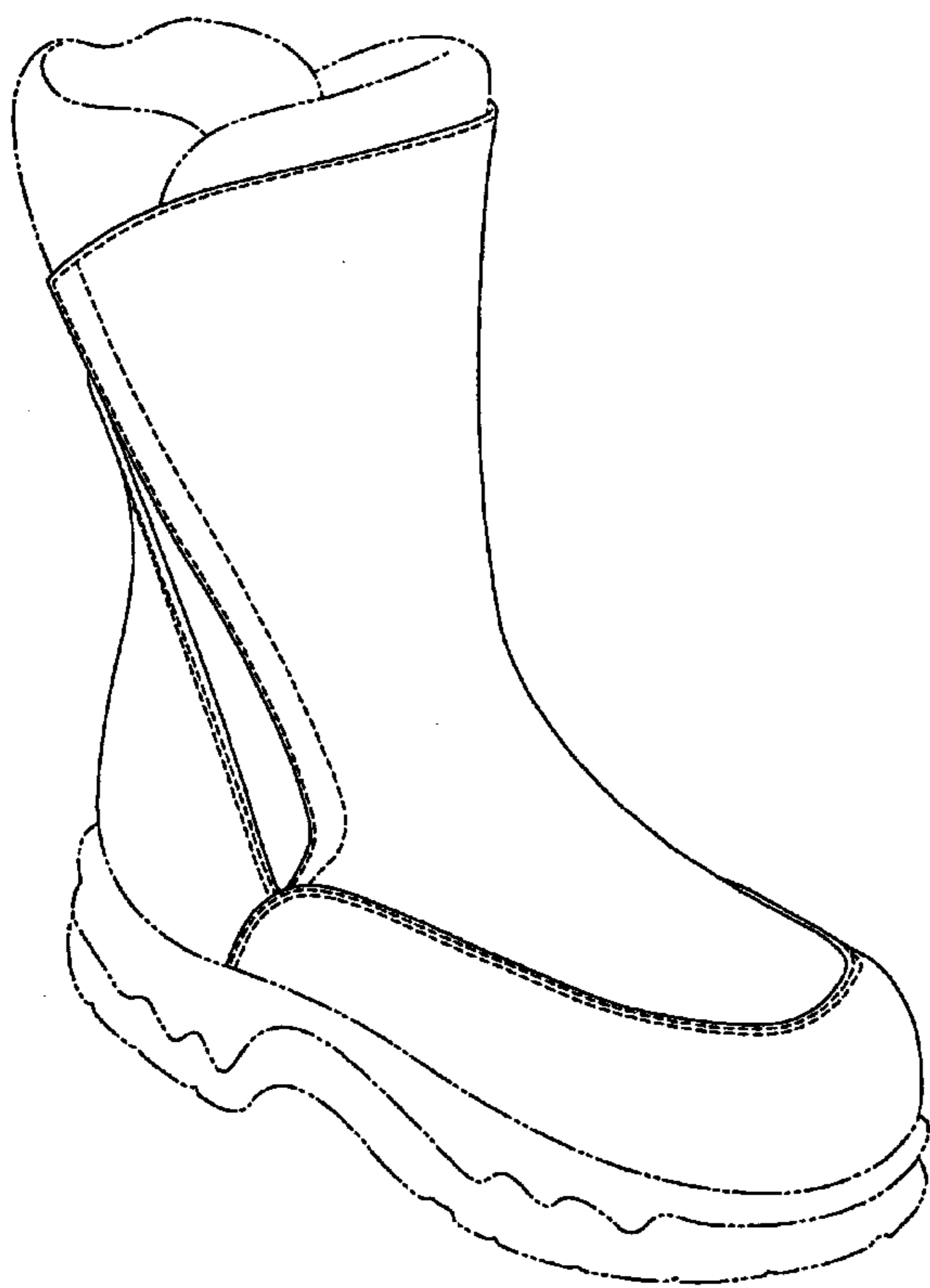
FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof;

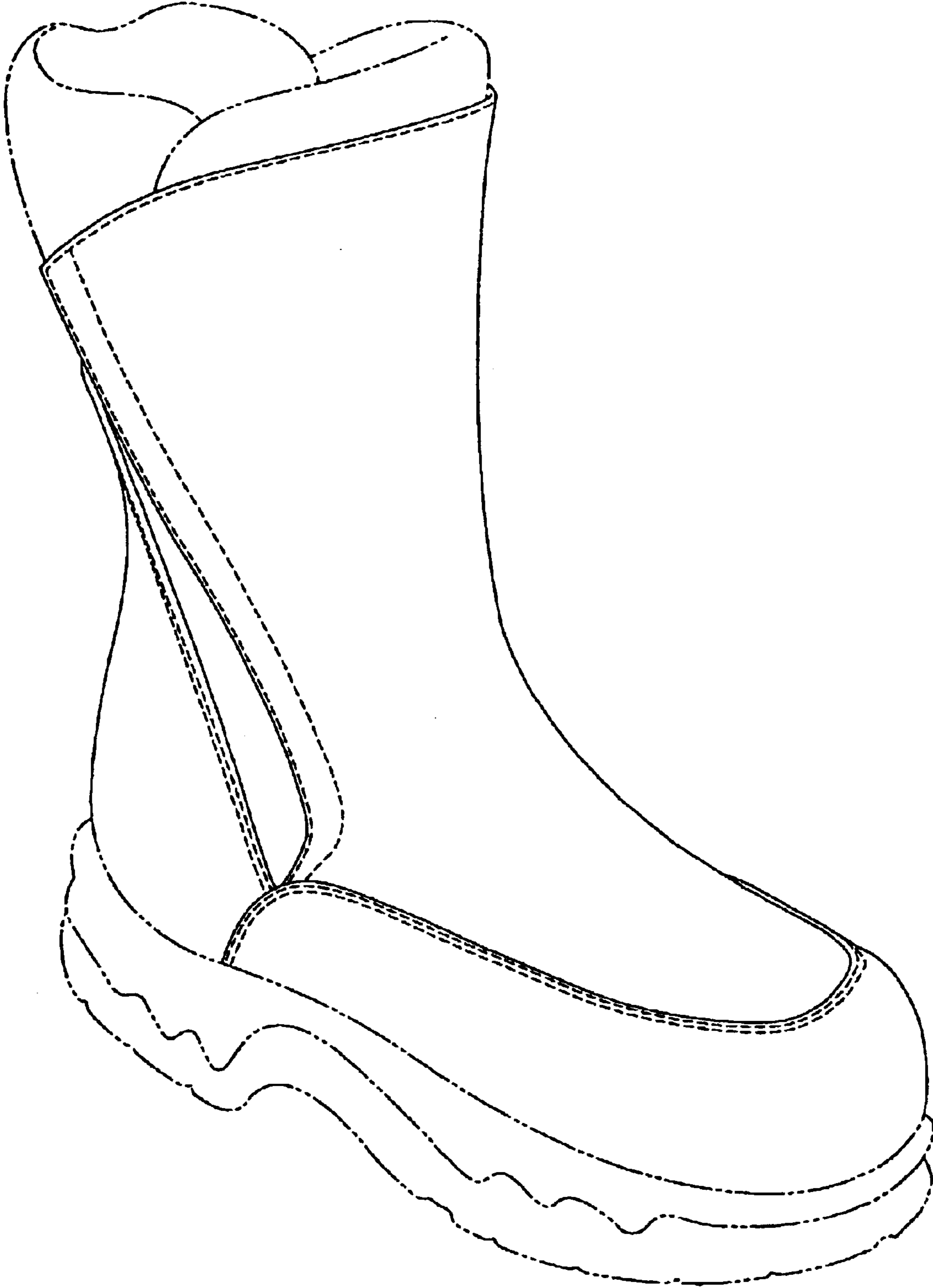

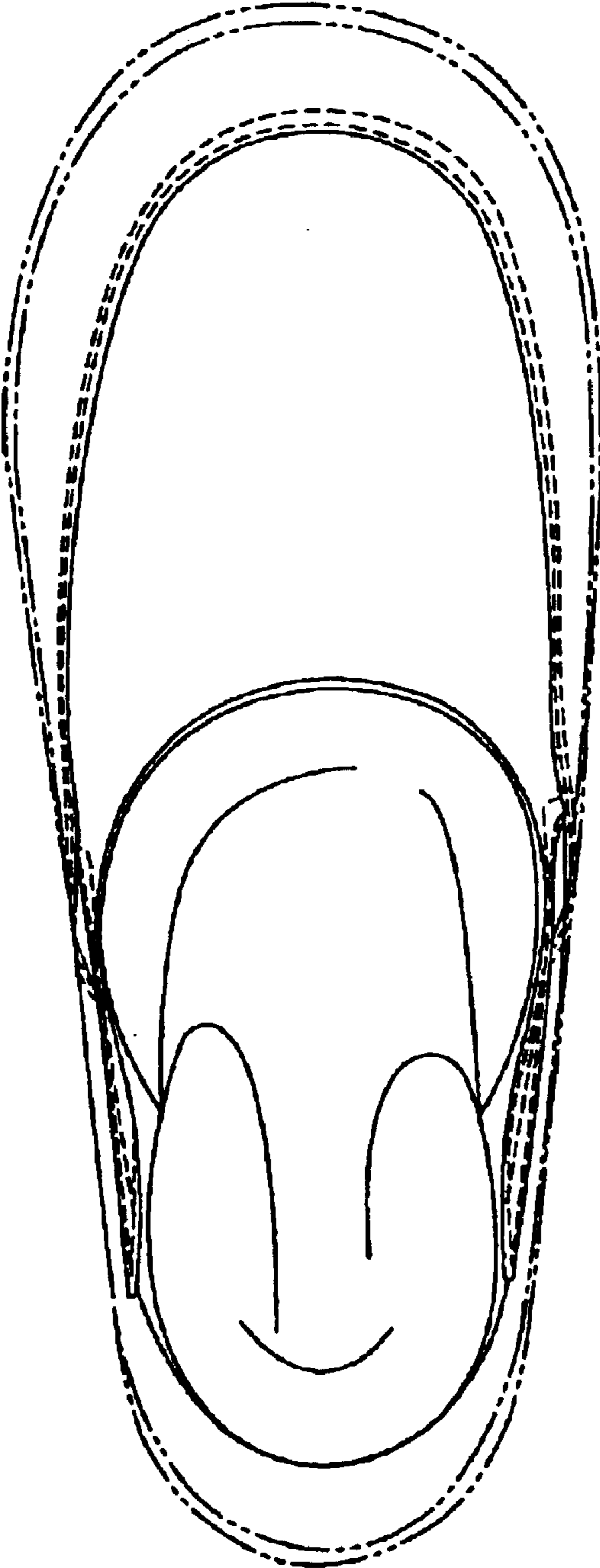

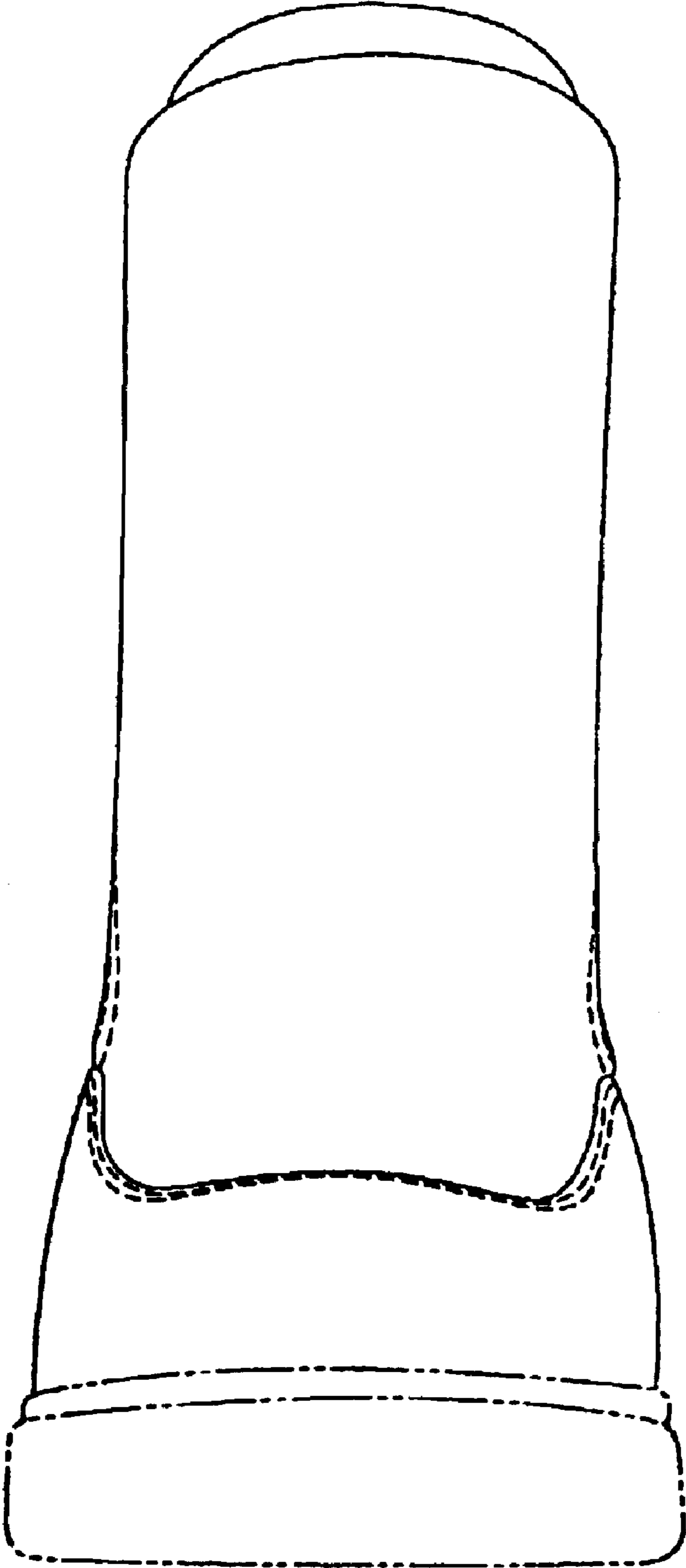

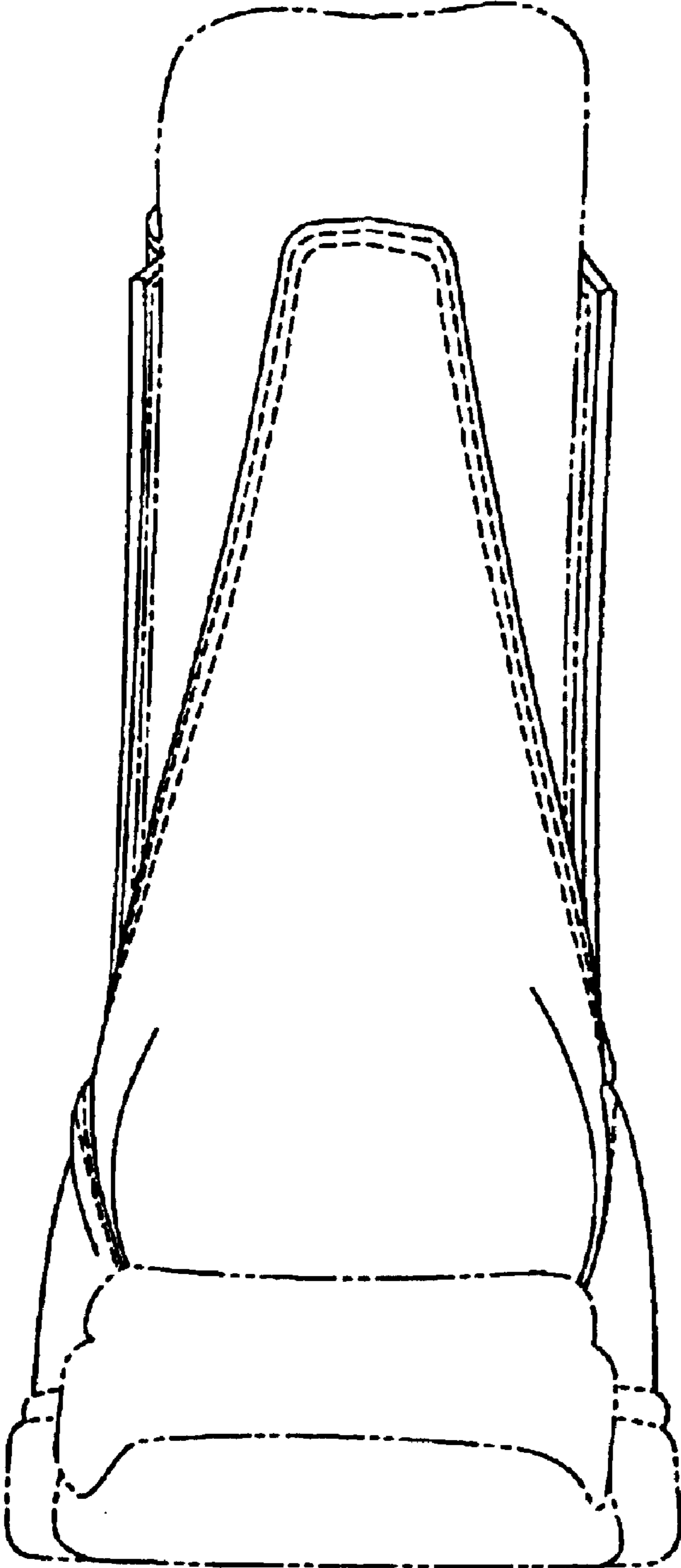

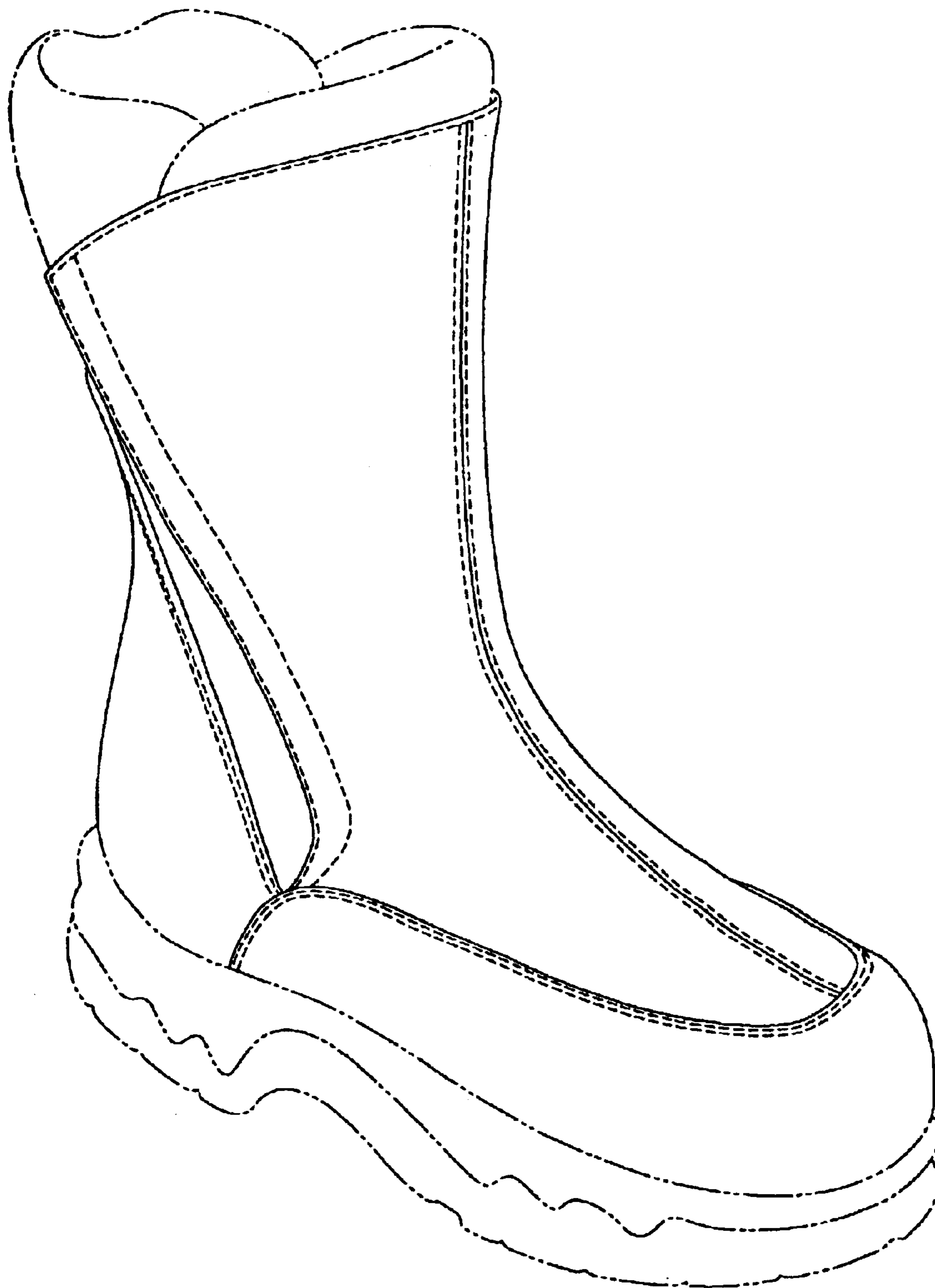

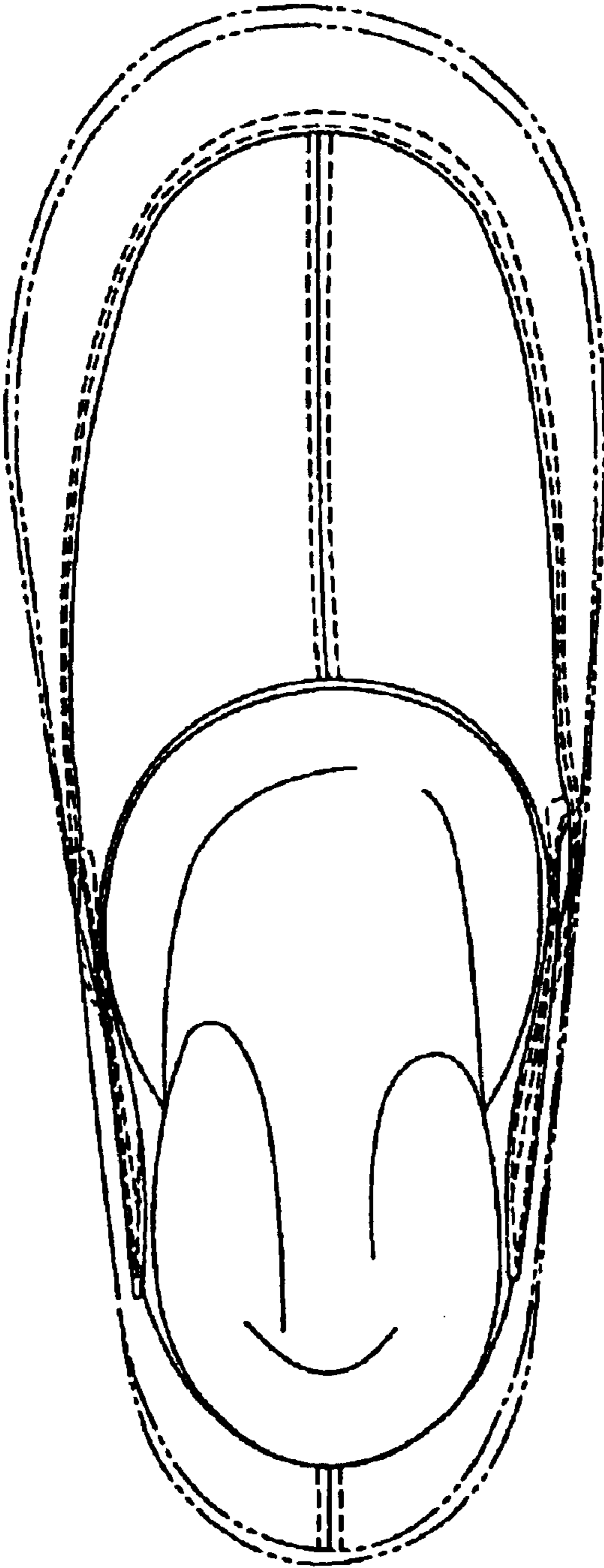

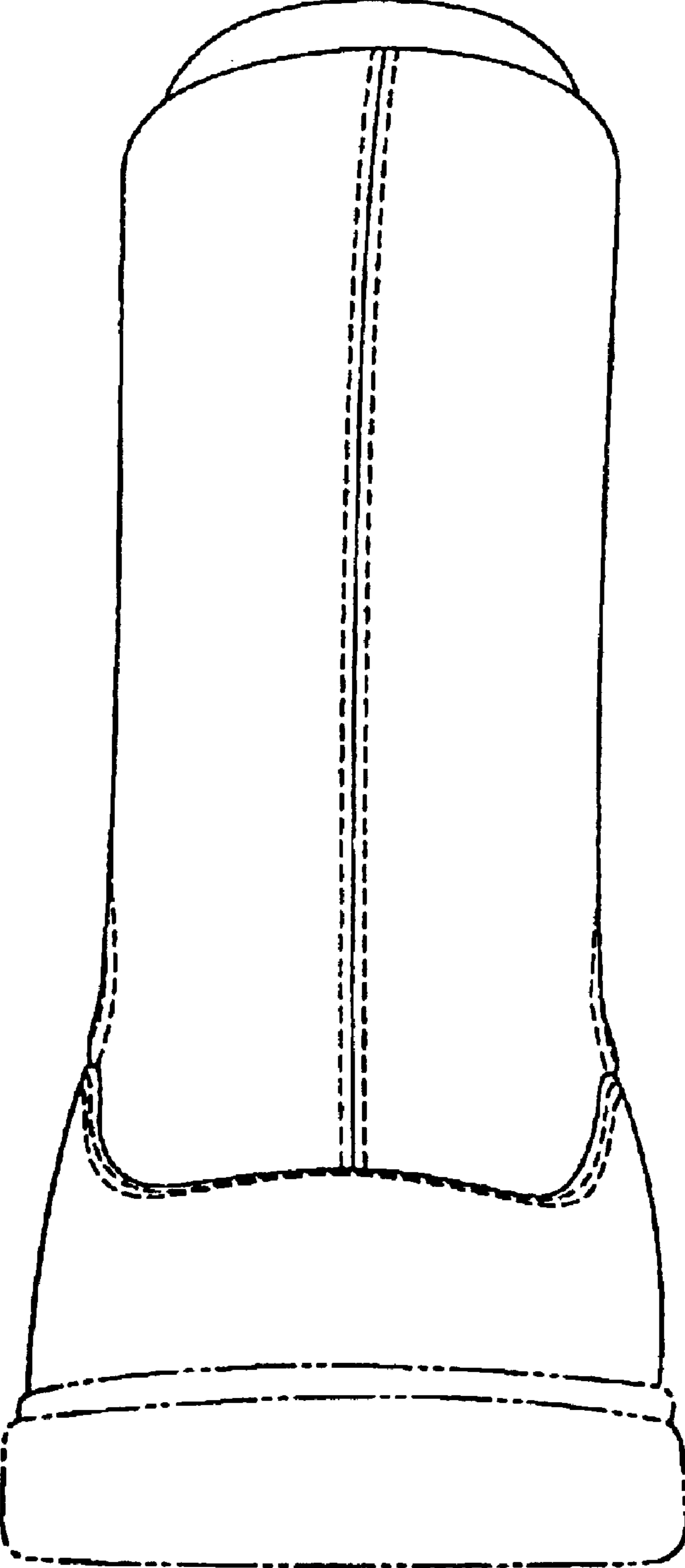

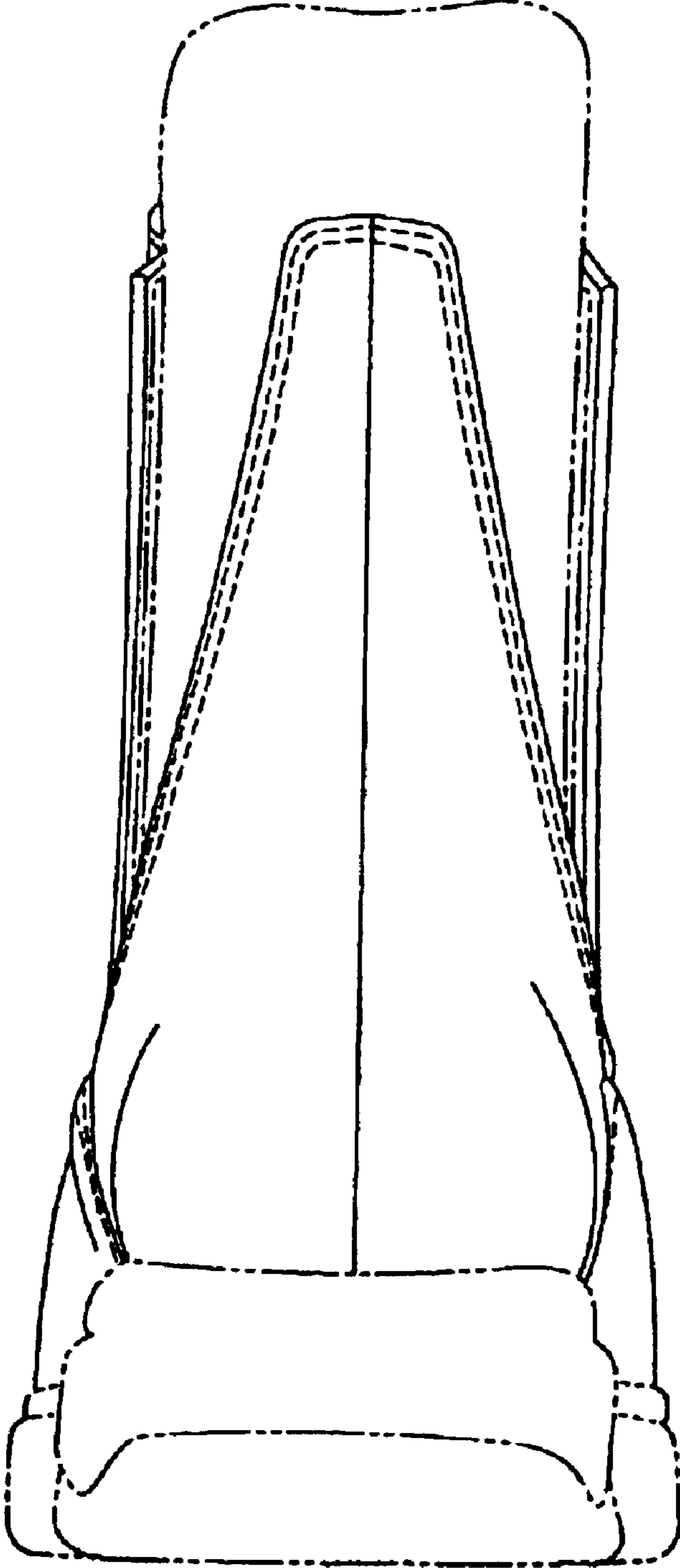
