DESCRIPTION

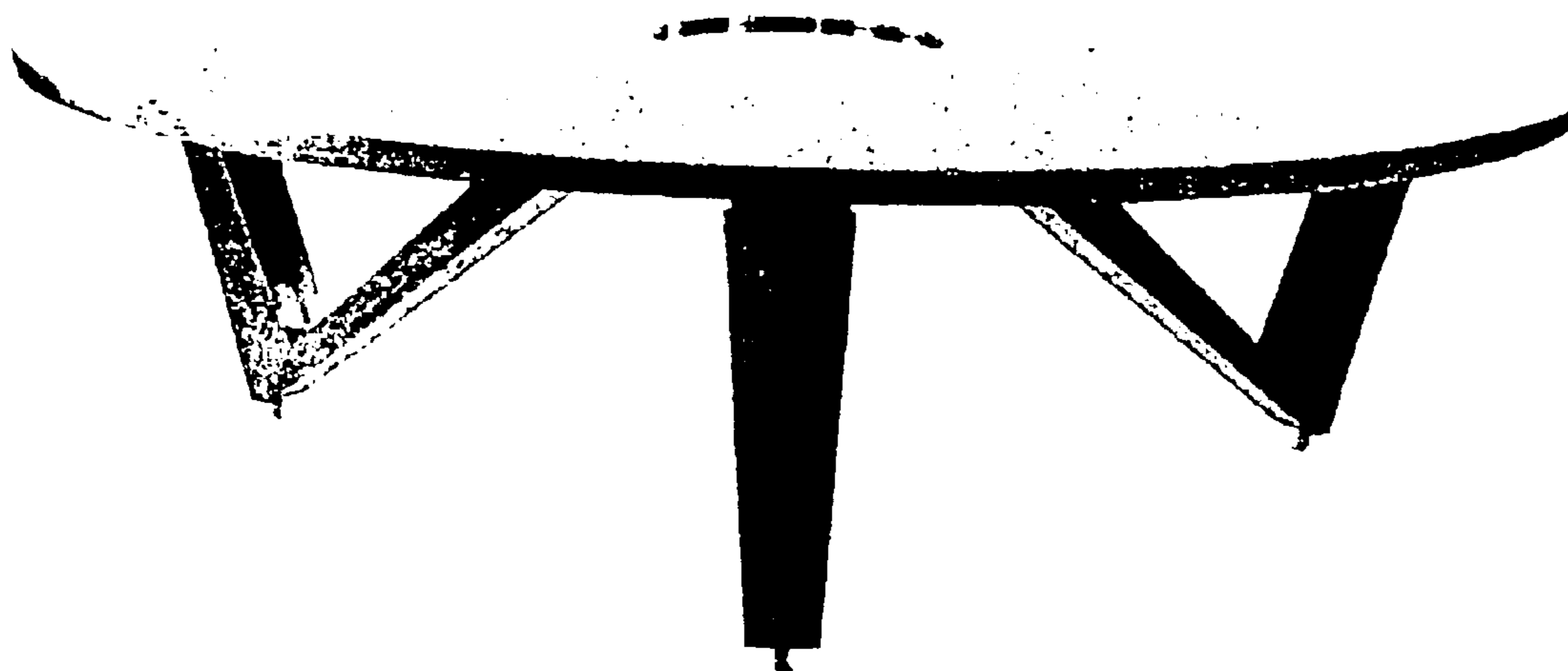
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a table base showing my new design;

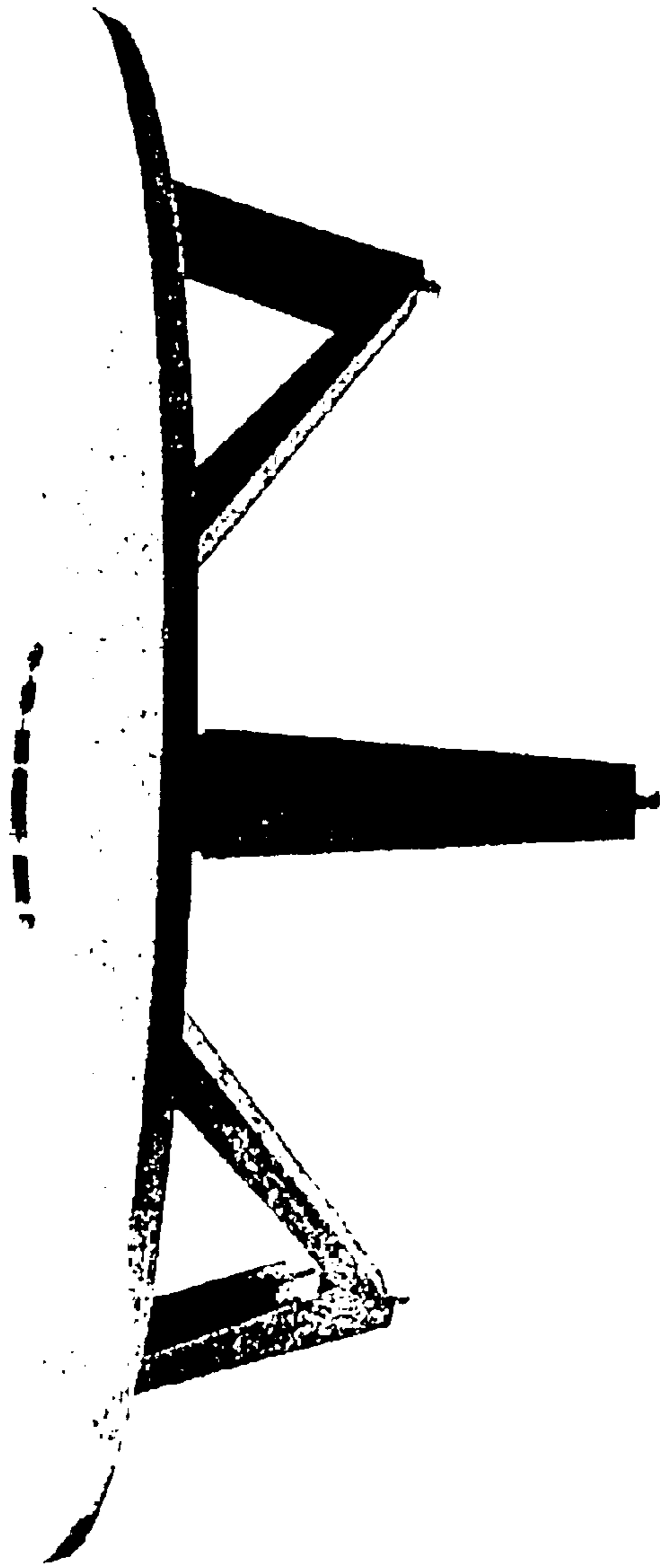
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

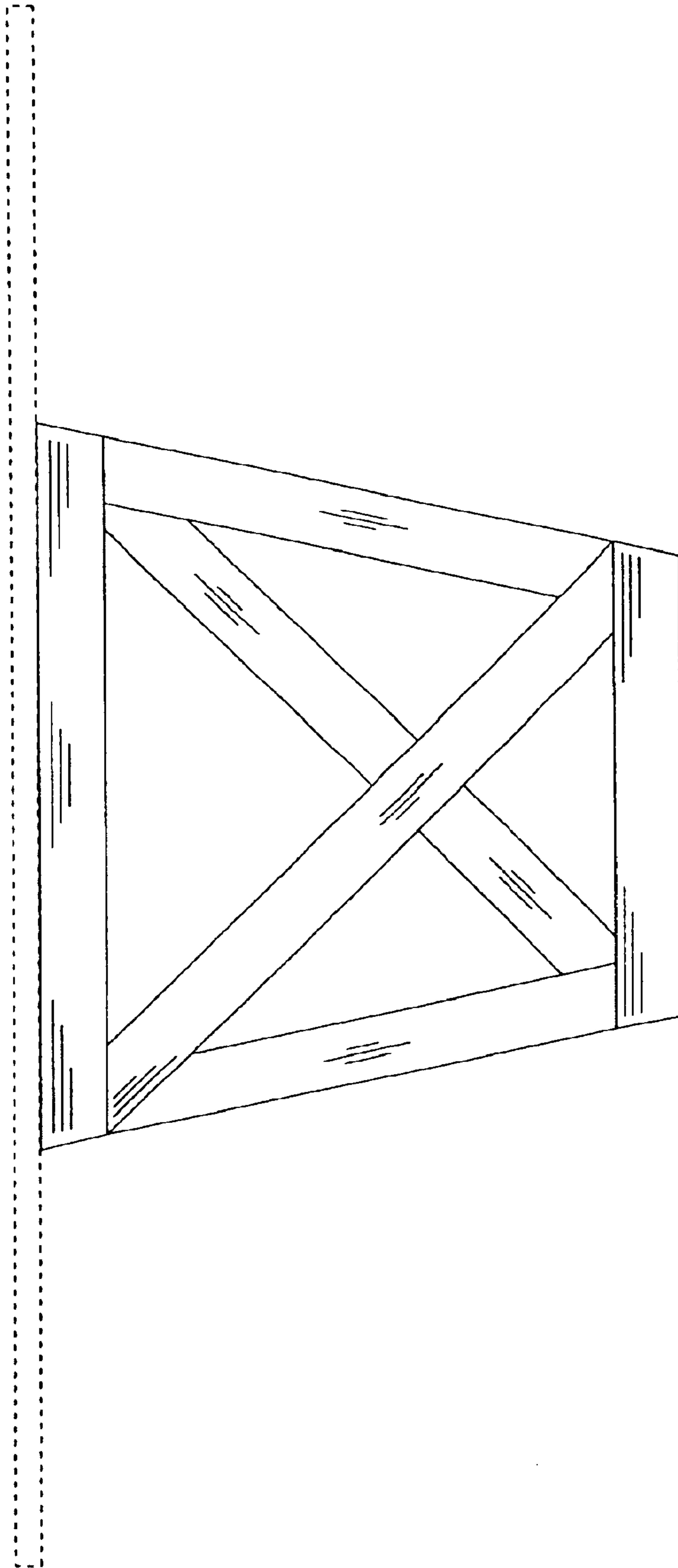

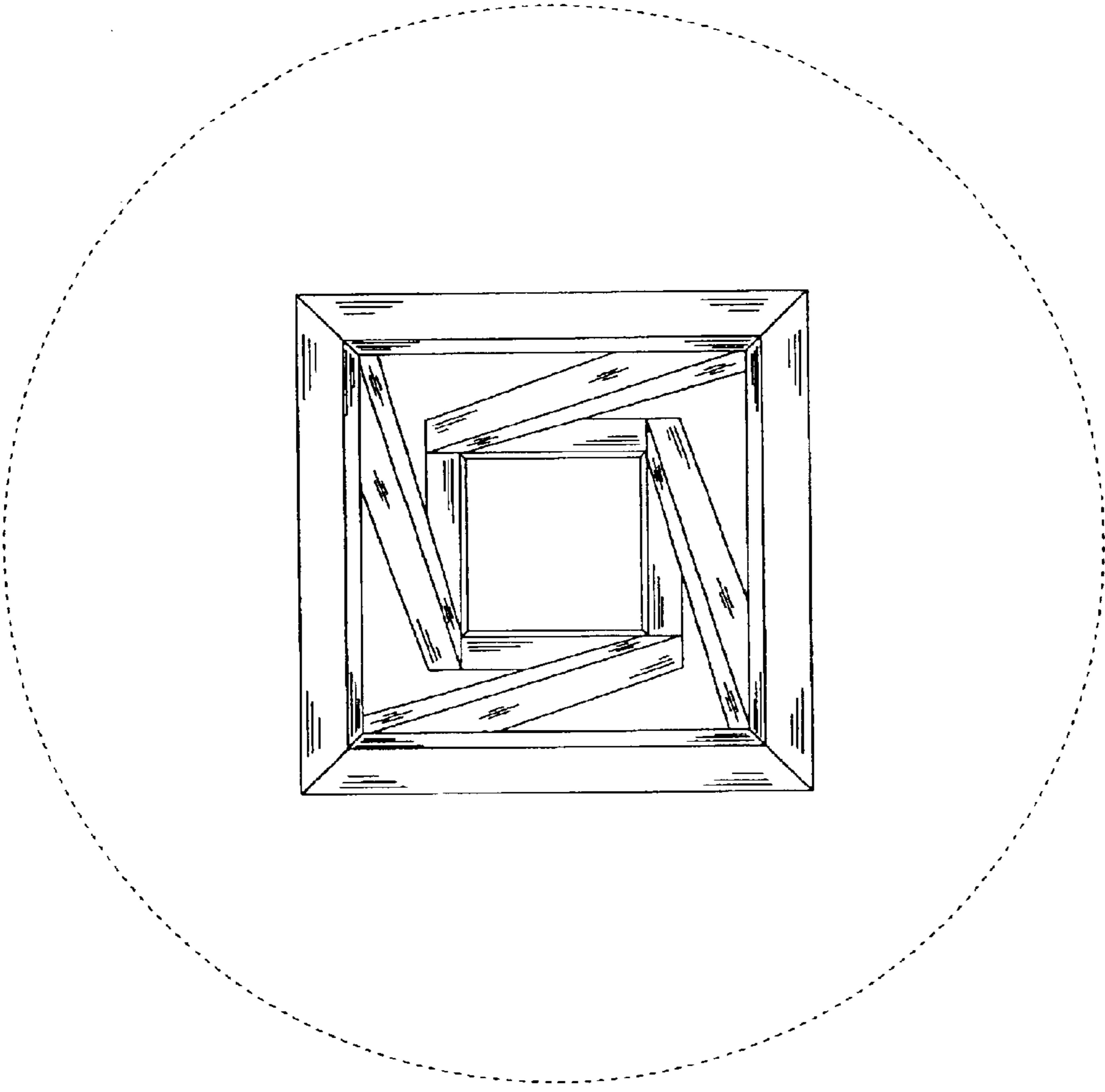
