FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a headboard showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross section taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 1 thereof.


The views of the headboard not shown form no part of the claimed design.




