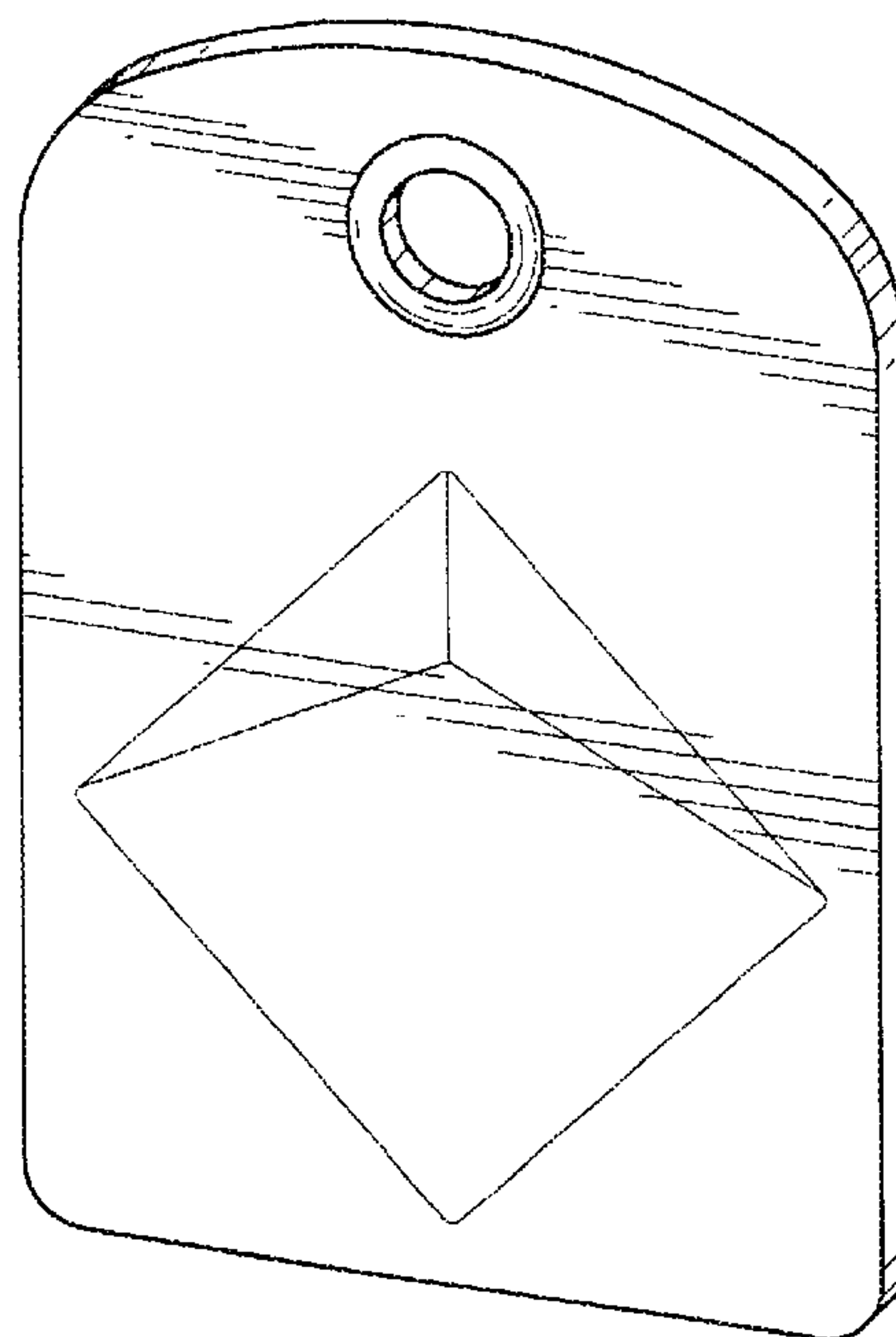
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a payment device in accordance with our new design;

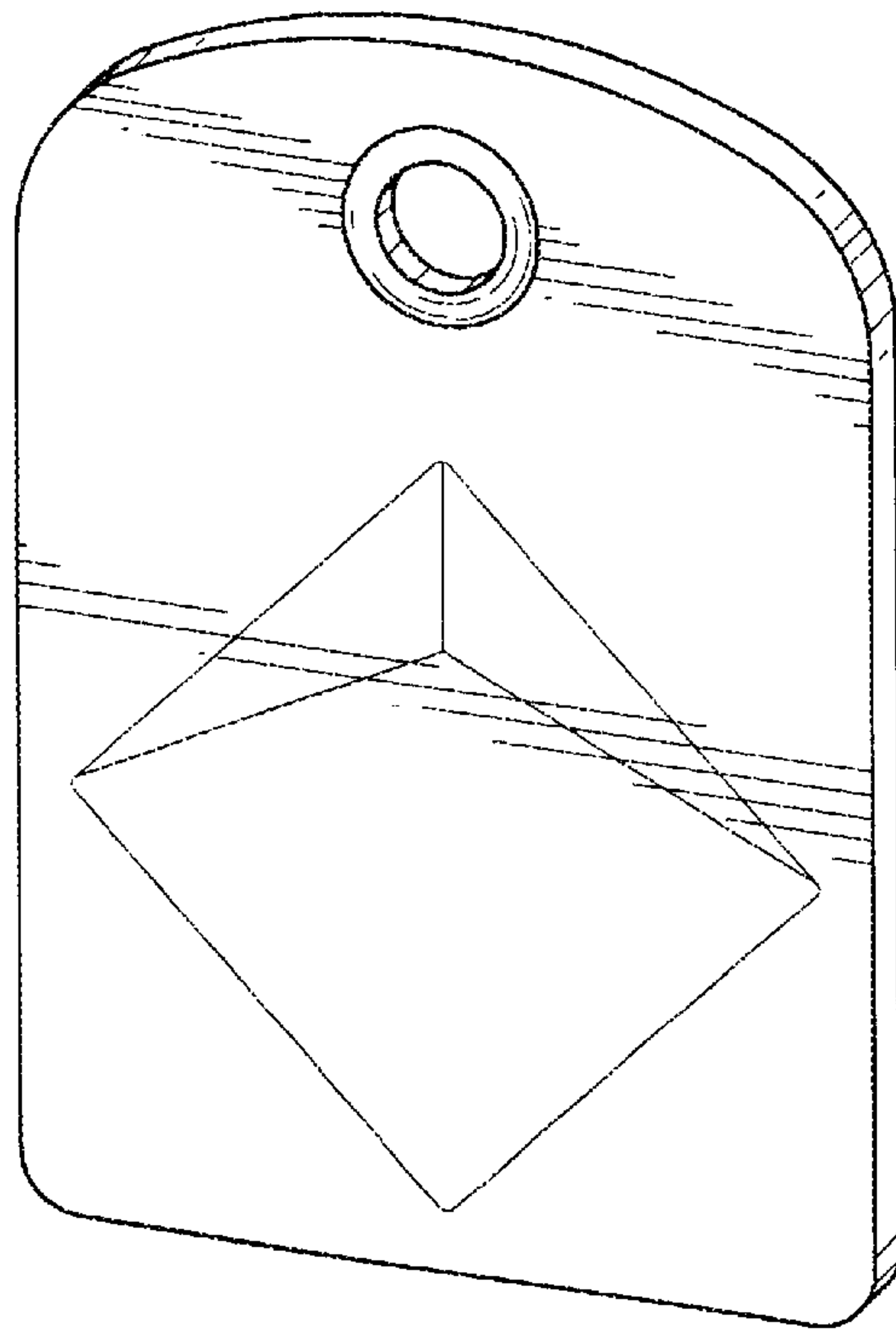

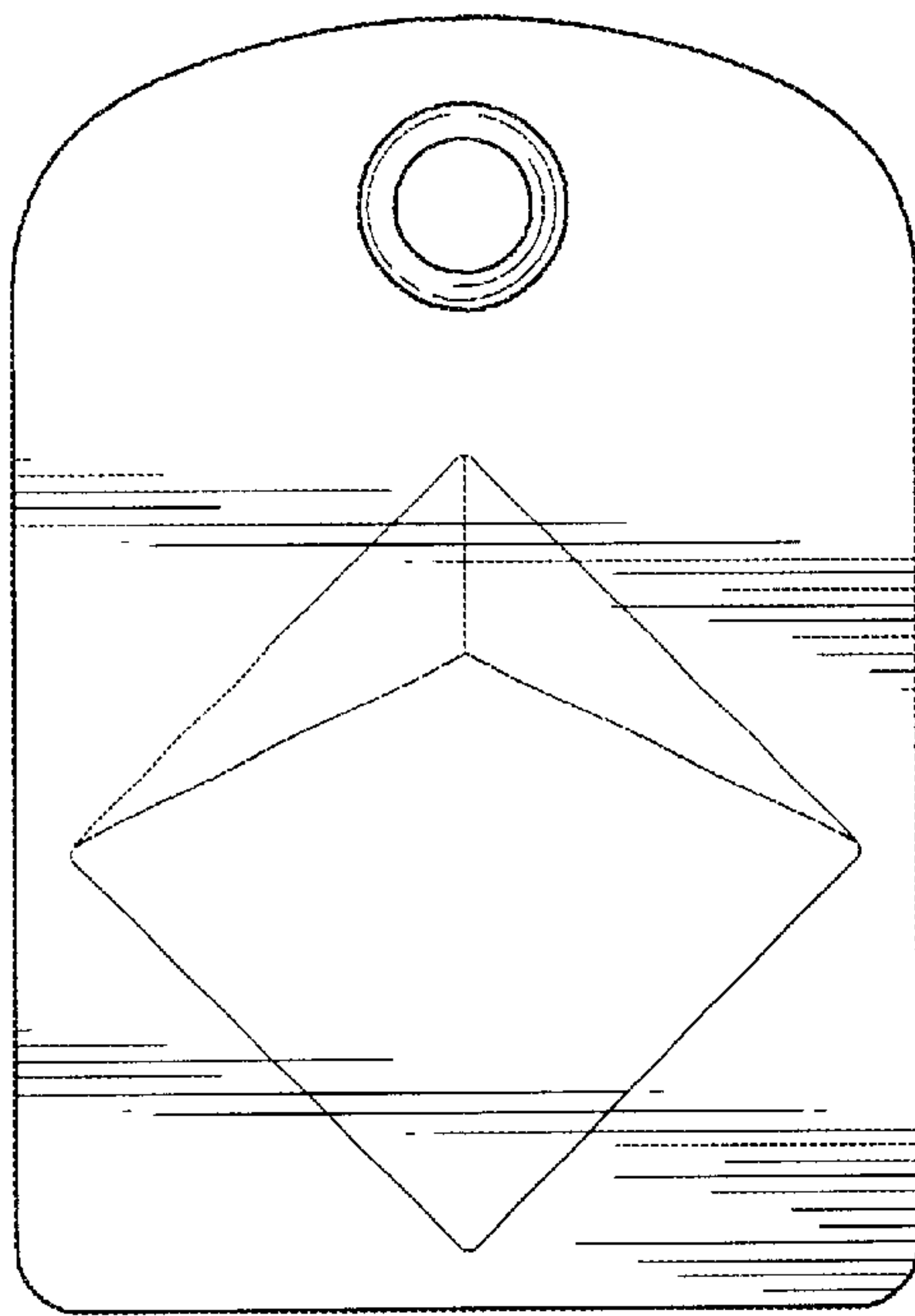

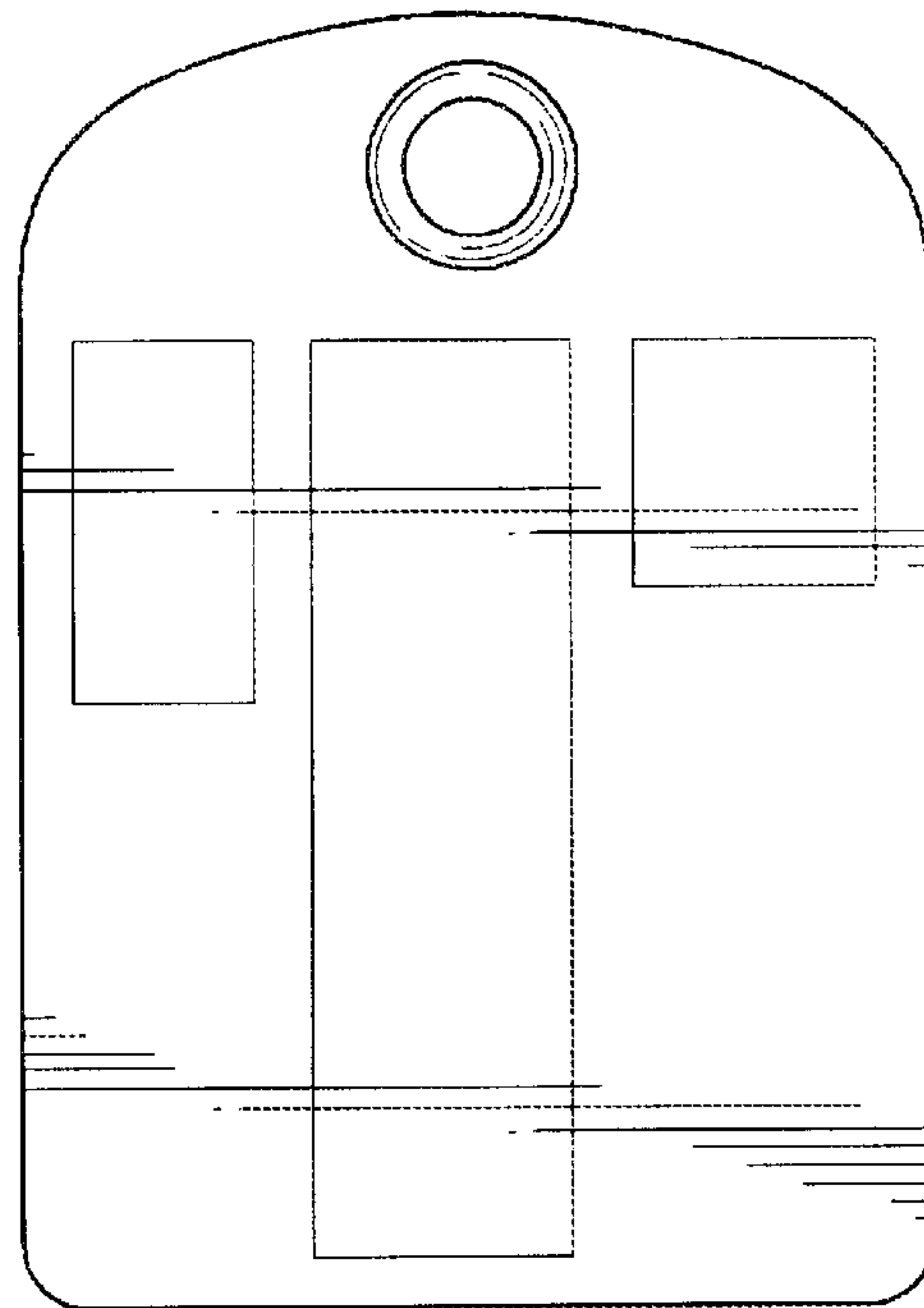

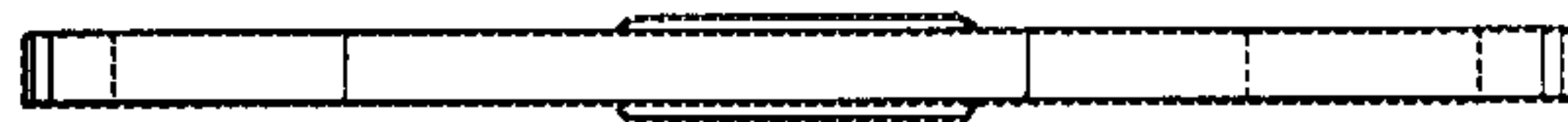

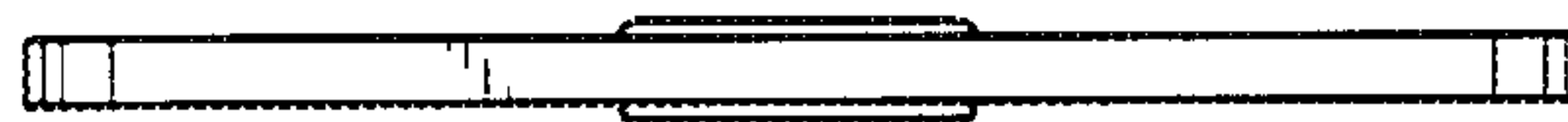
