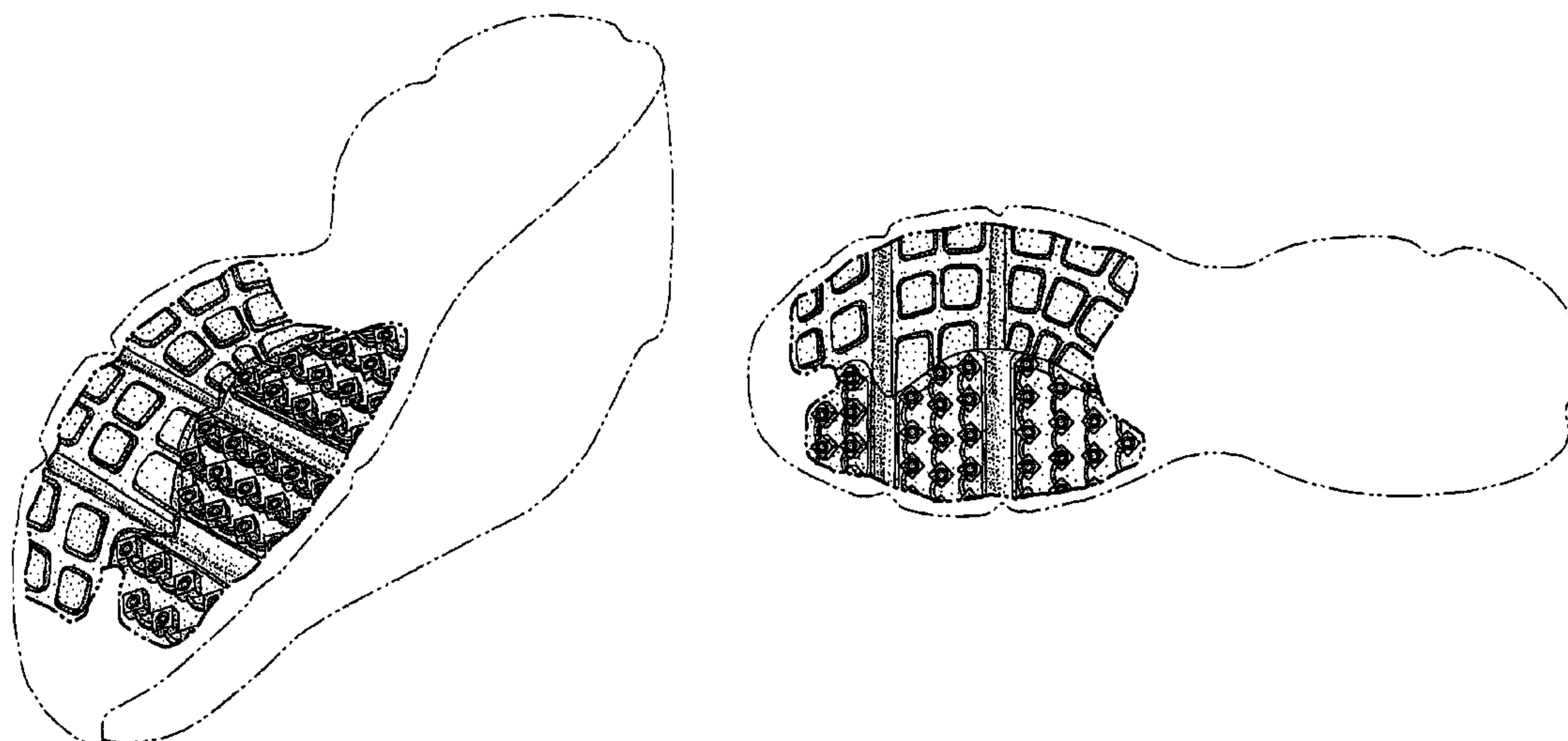
The ornamental design for an outsole of a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a shoe outsole showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the outsole of a shoe shown in FIG. 1.

The uneven broken line immediately adjacent to the shaded area represents the bounds of the claimed design. All other uneven broken lines represent the remaining portion of the shoe. 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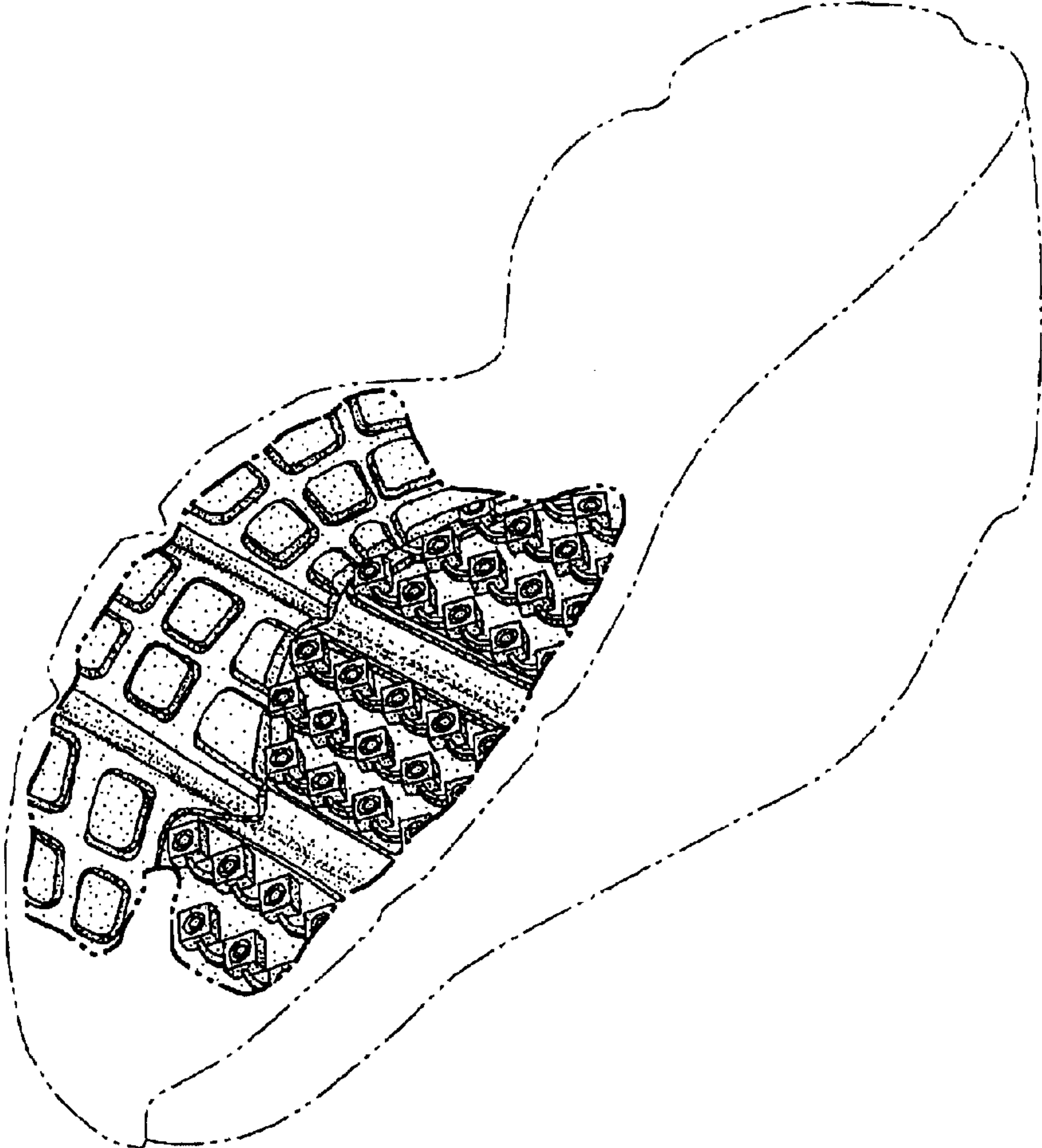

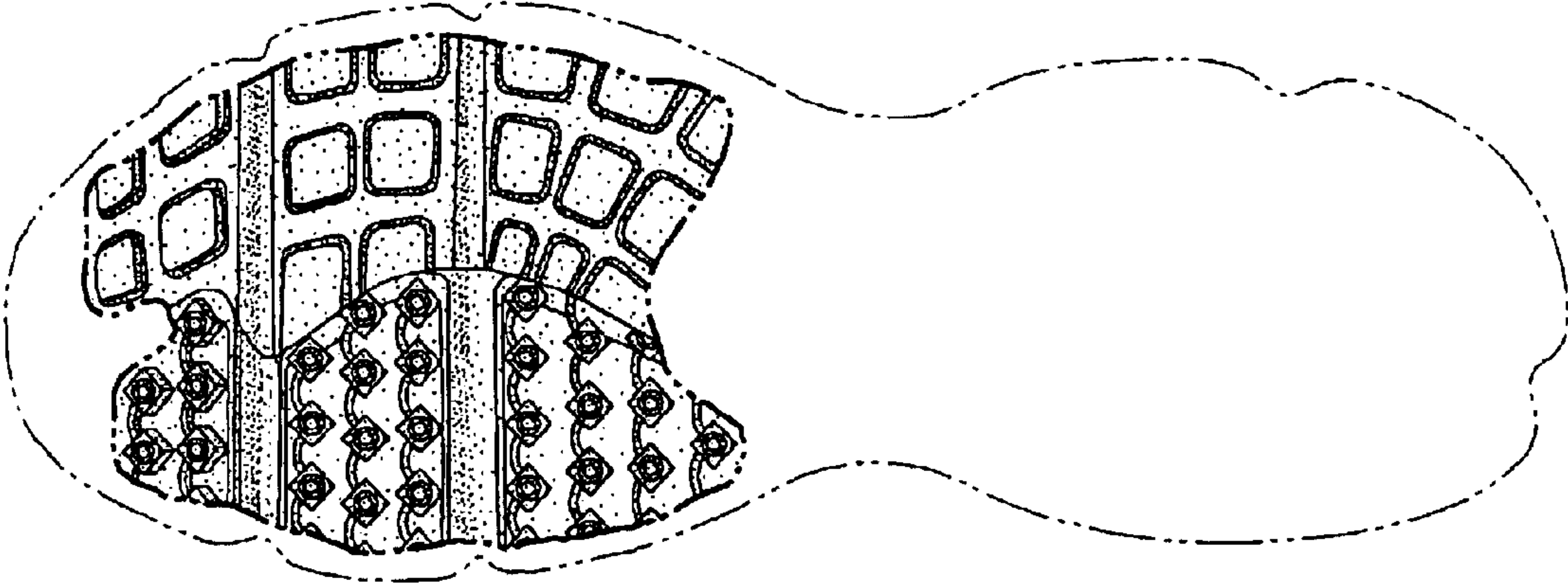
