(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a motorcycle taillight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The nature and intended use of the article in which the design is embodied comprises a light fixture for attachment to the rear of a motorcycle for signaling motorcycle braking.

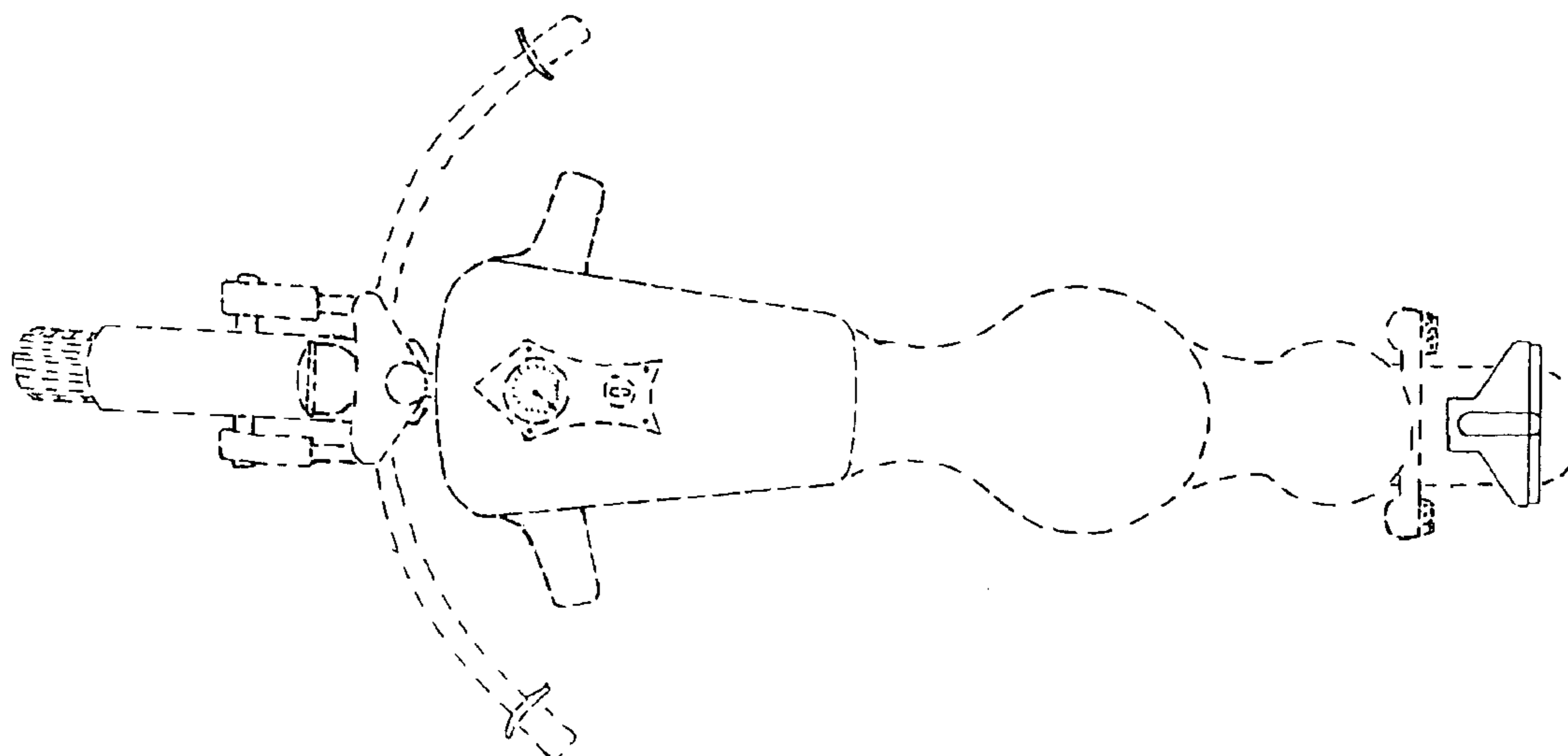
FIG. 1 is a plan view of the article in which the design is embodied.

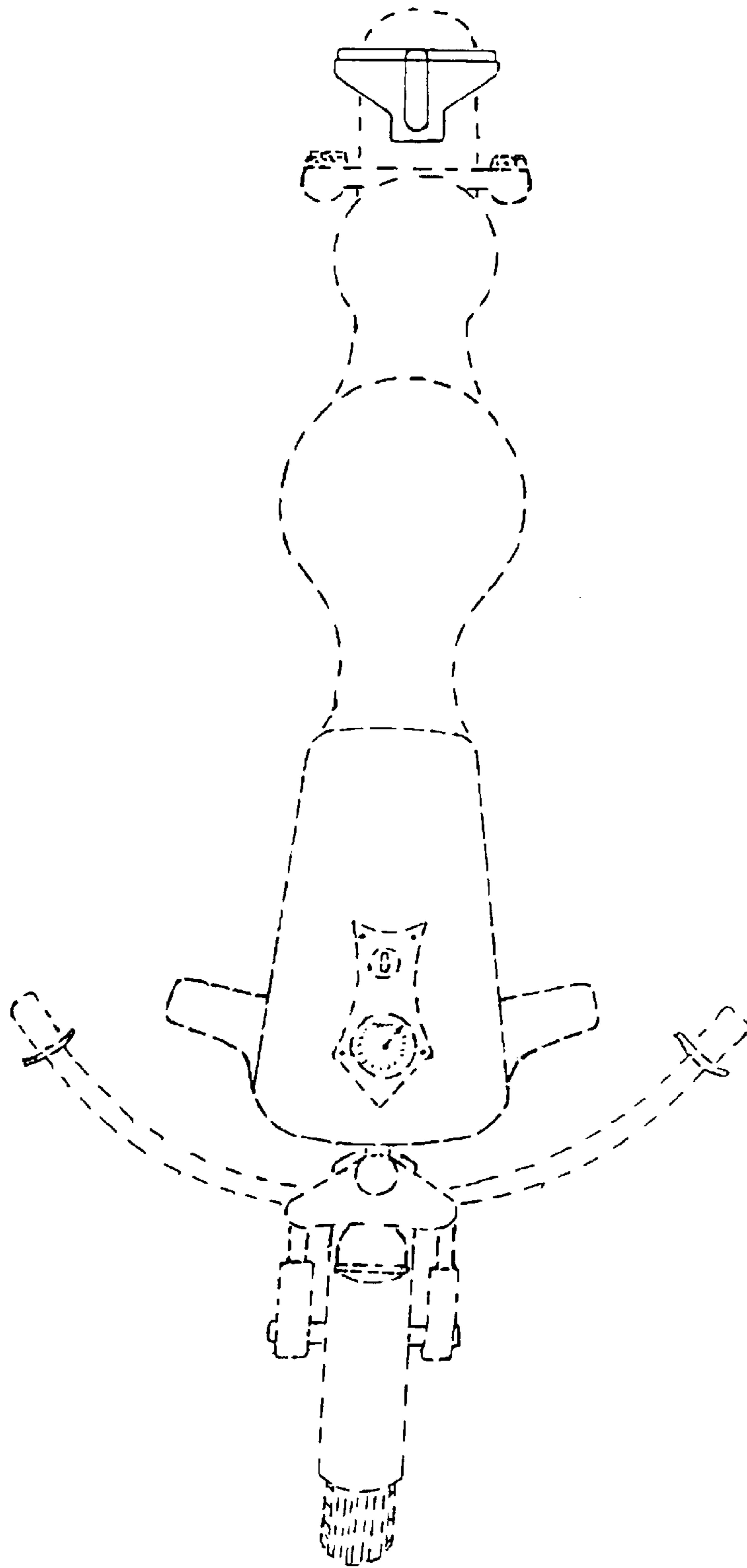

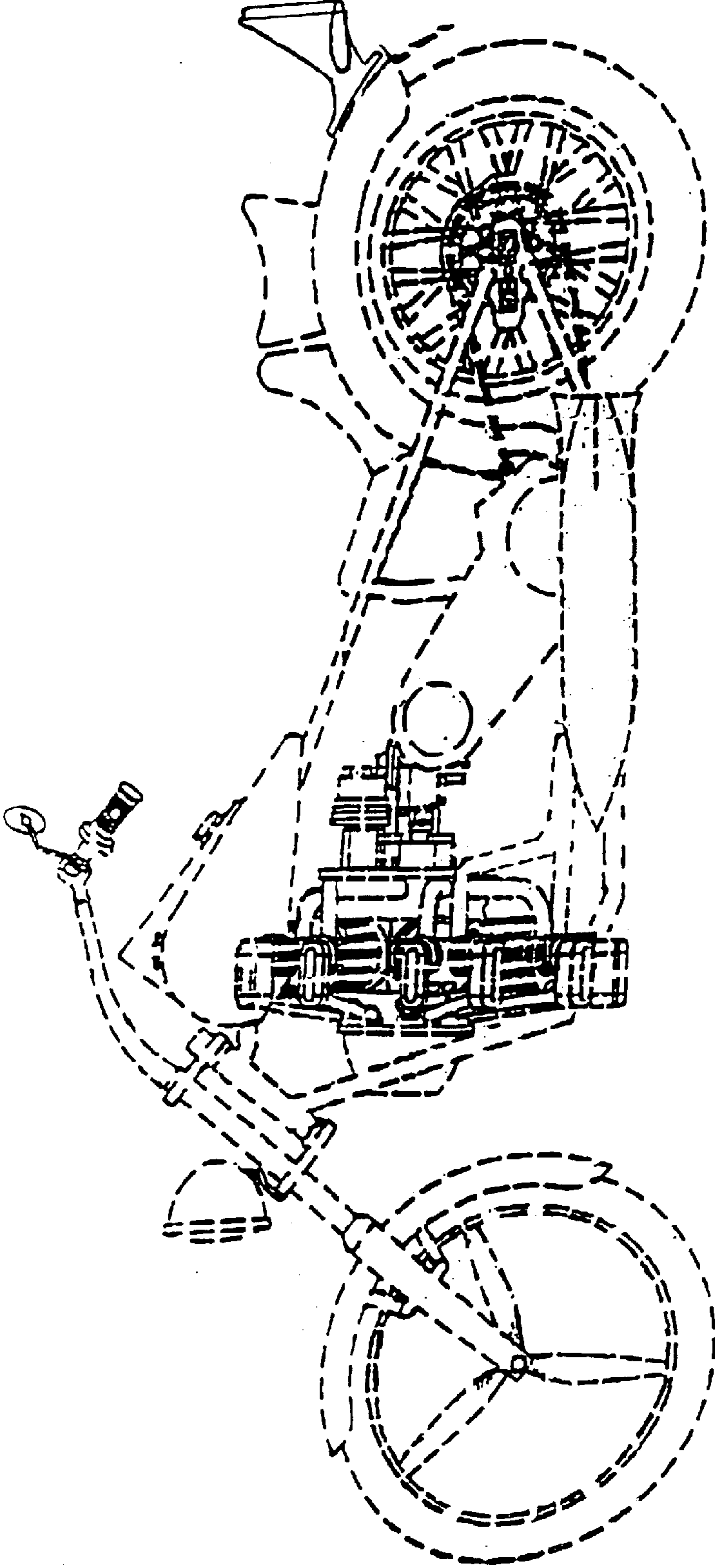
