FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 7.

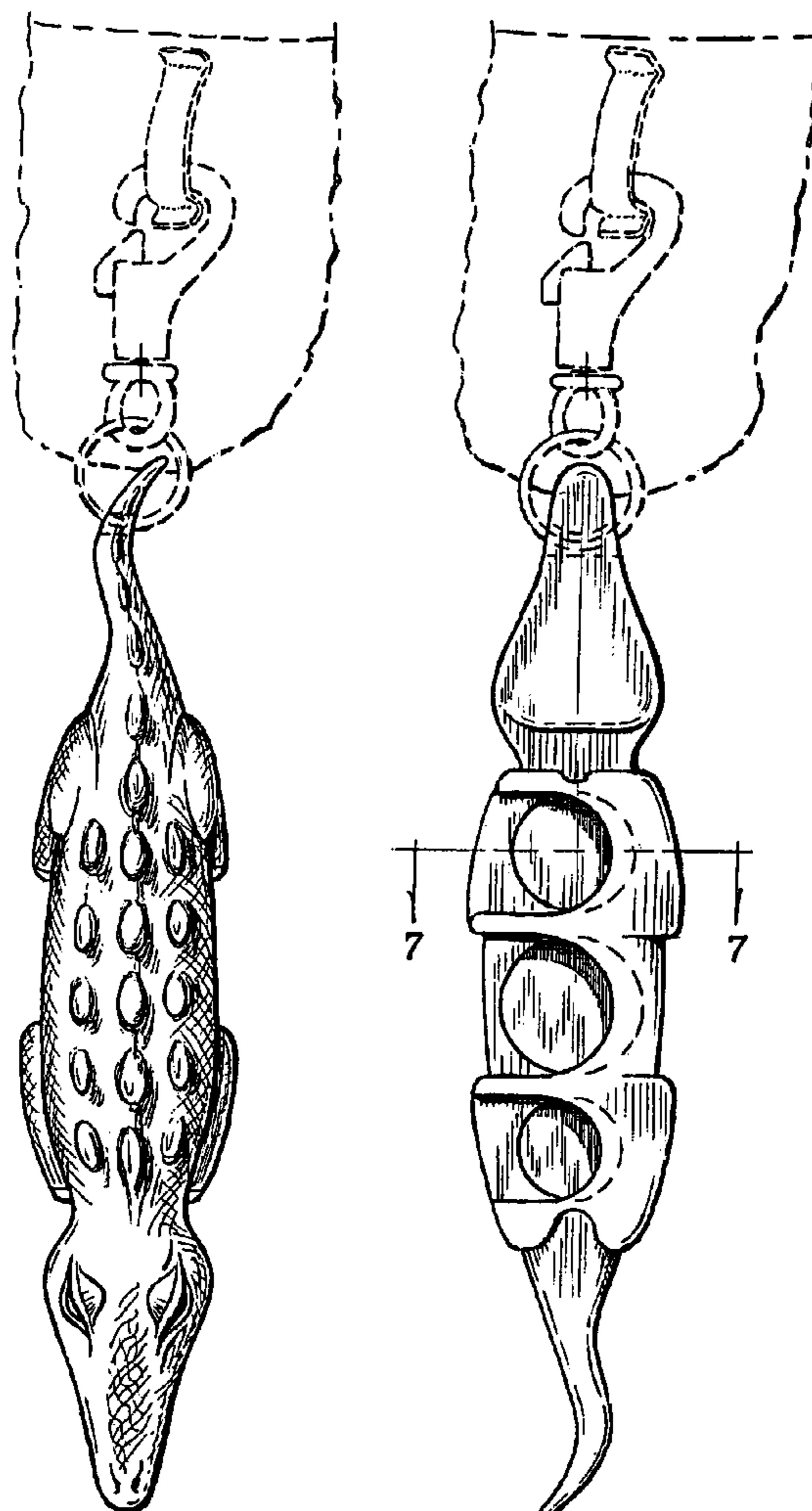

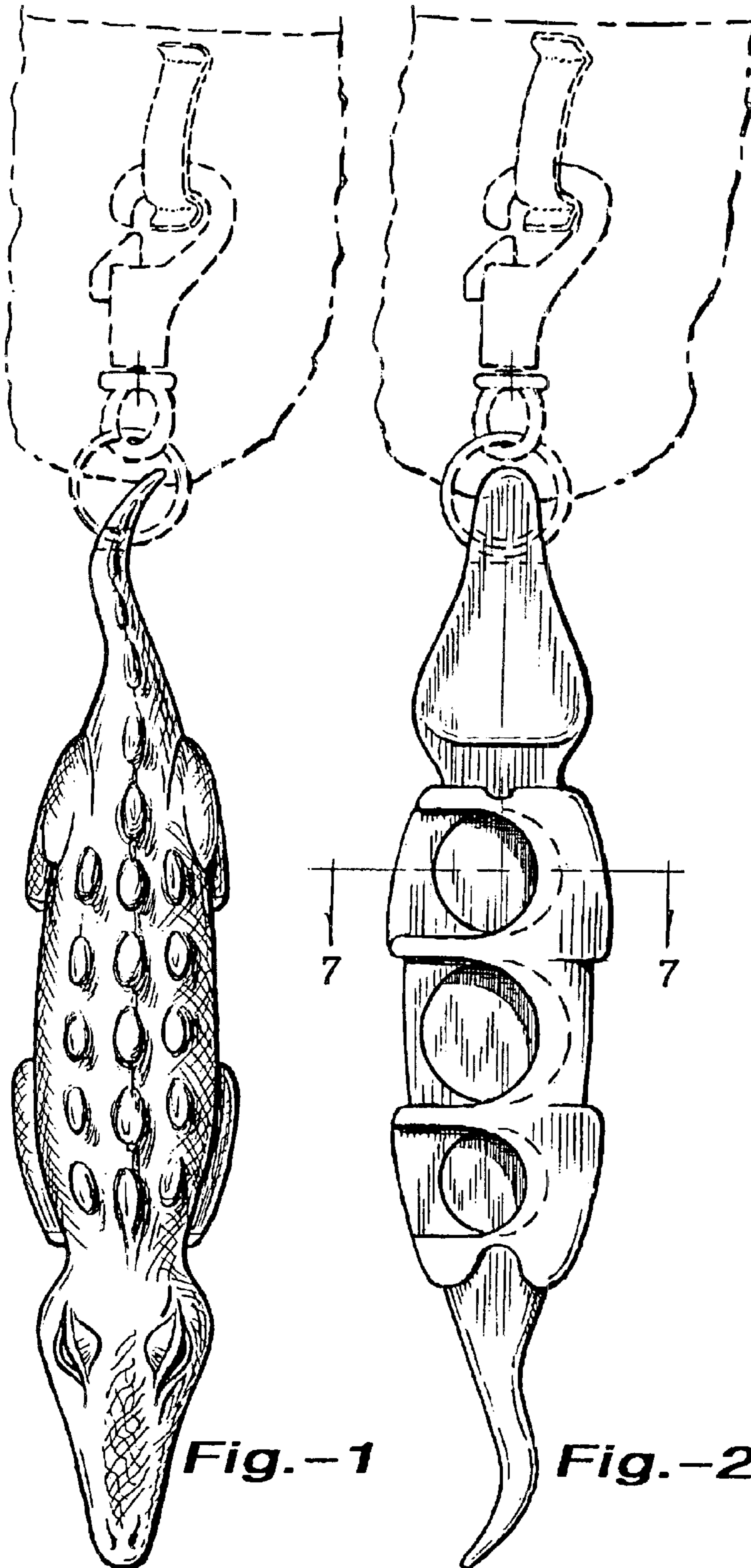

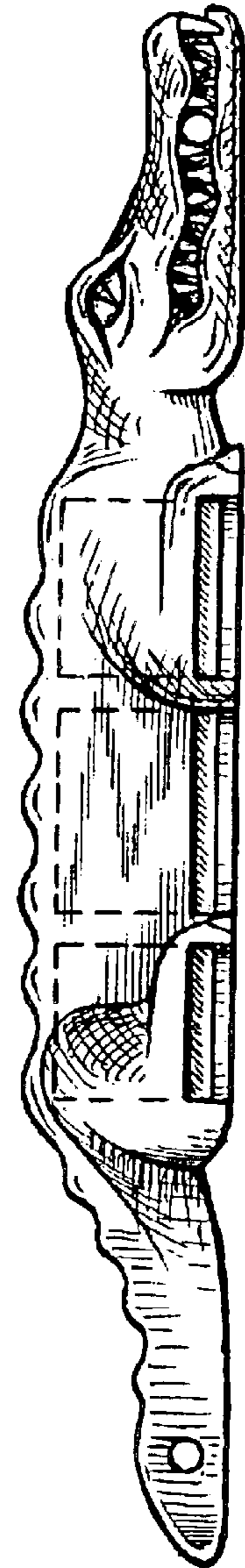

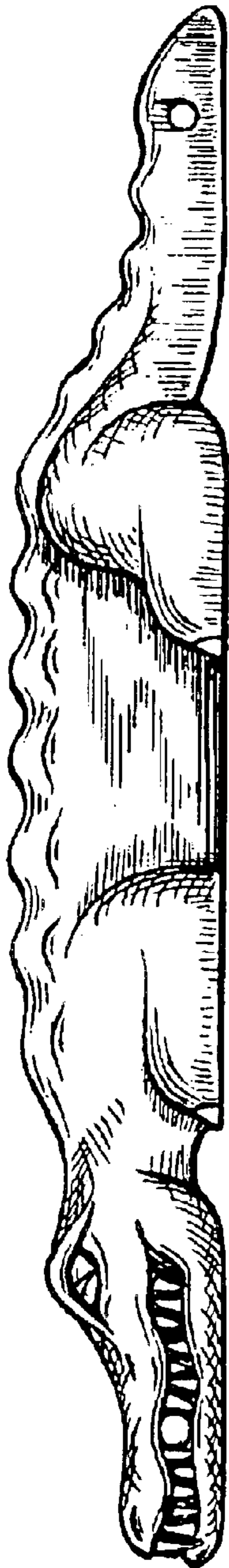

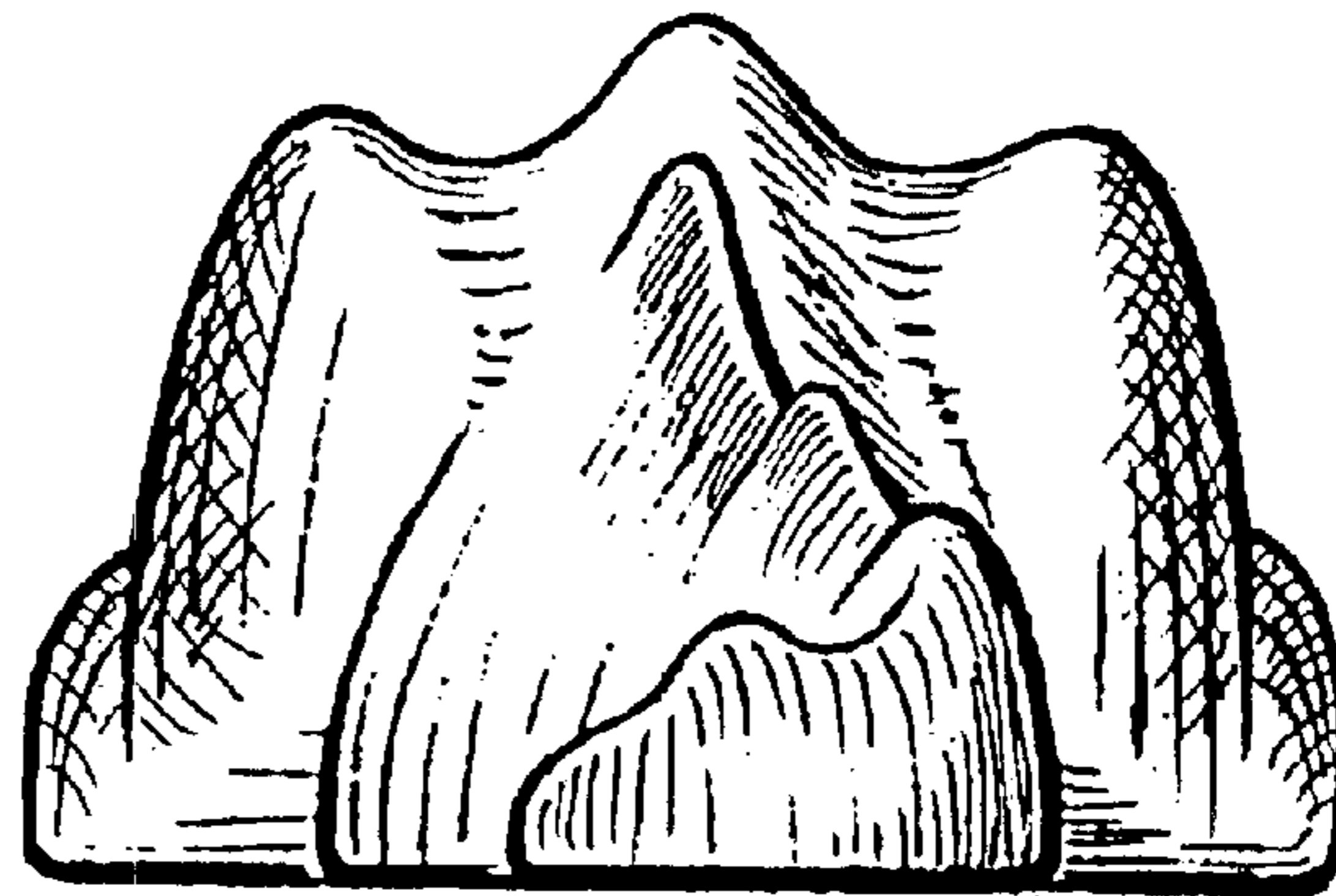

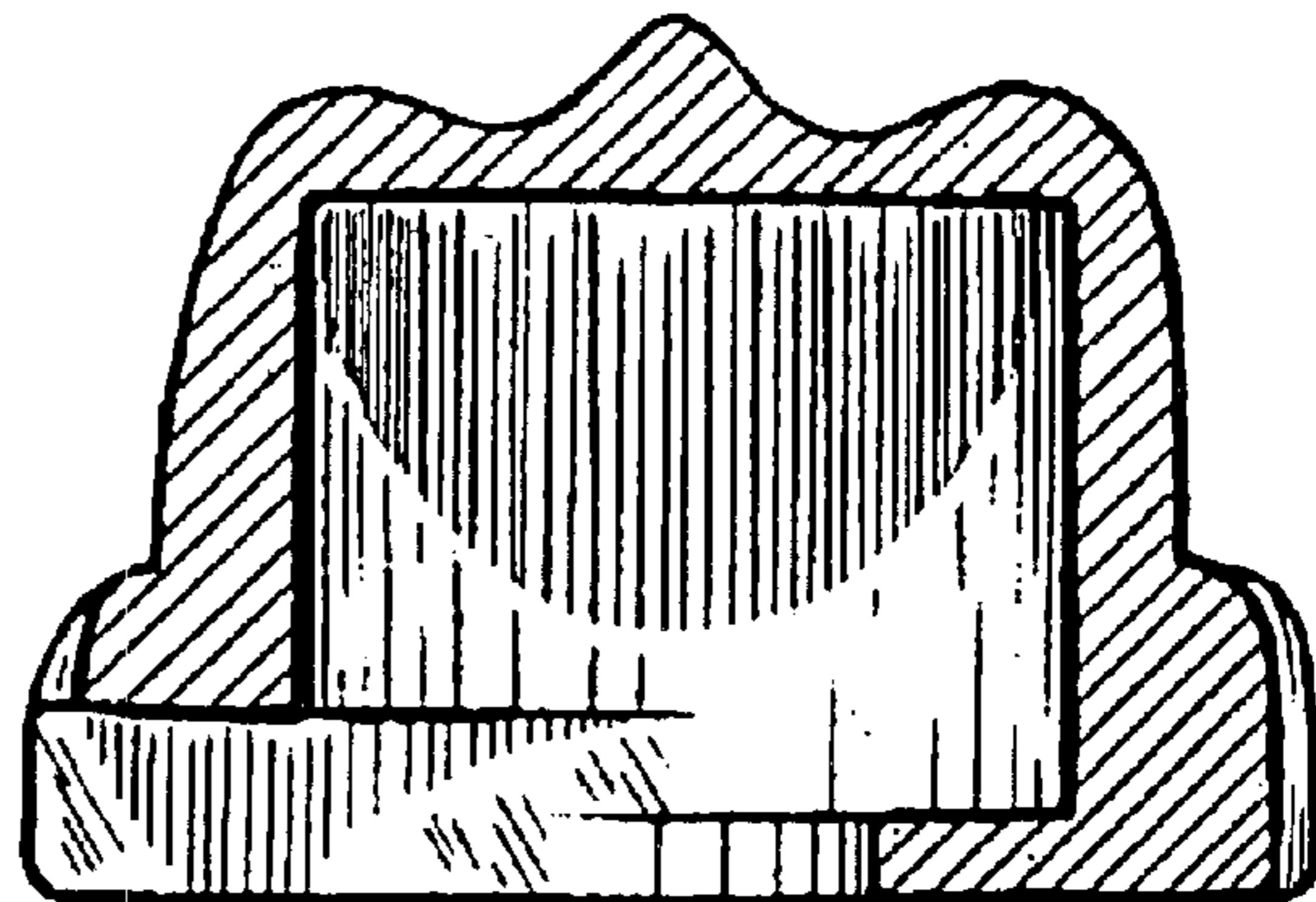
