We claim the ornamental design for a portion of a gun case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a portion of a gun case embodying the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the portion of the gun case shown in FIG. 1;

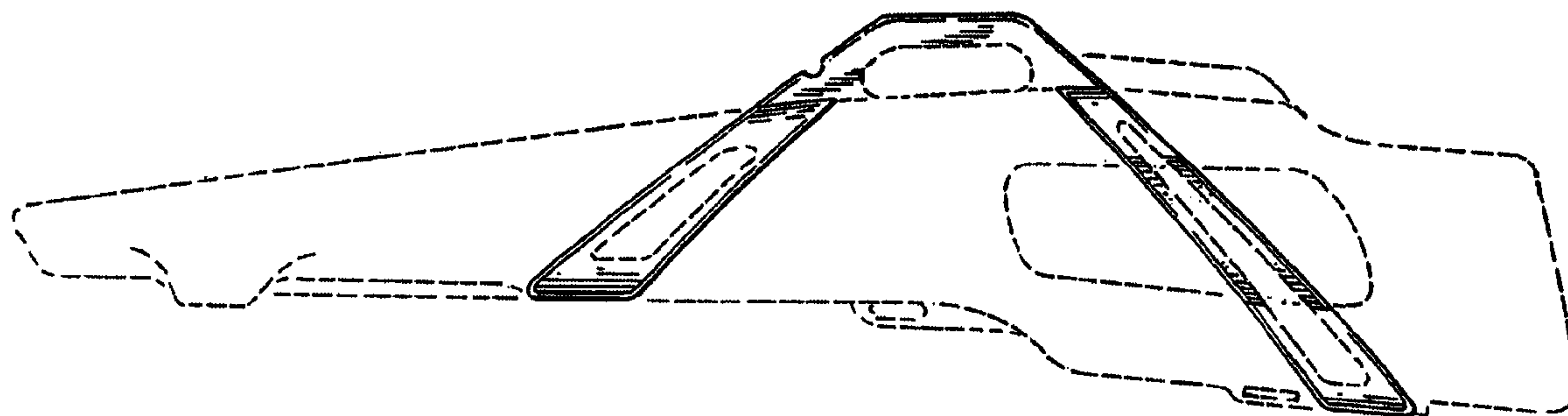
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the portion of the gun case shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the portion of the gun case shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the portion of the gun case shown in FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of the environment is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines which define the boundaries of the claimed design form no part thereof. The broken lines are differentiated to clarify the claimed design. Even broken lines having dashes of uniform length define environmental structure, and uneven broken lines having a long dash—short dash—long dash pattern define boundaries of the claimed surfaces.

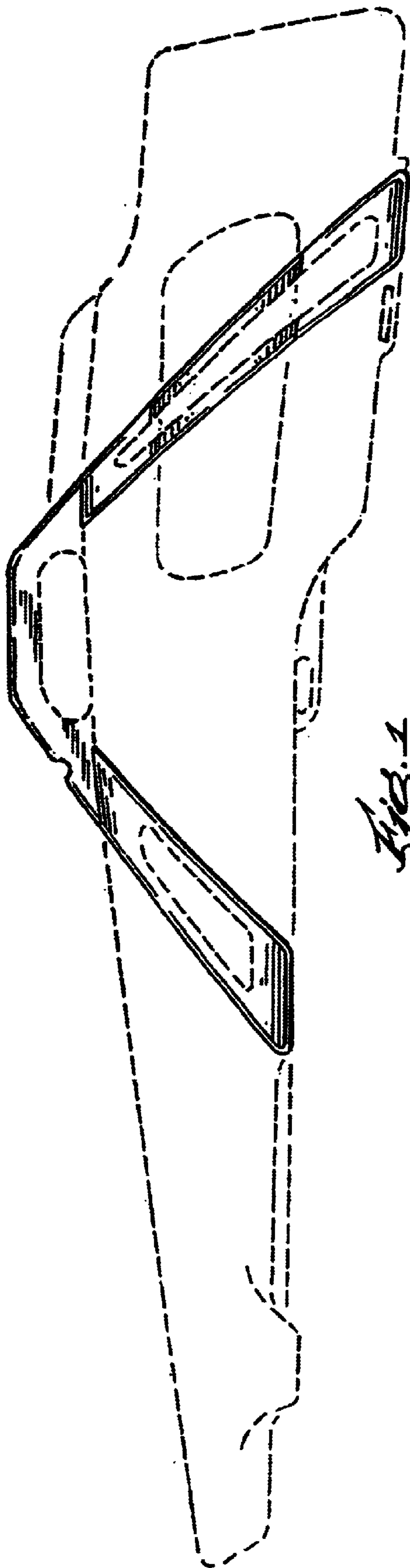

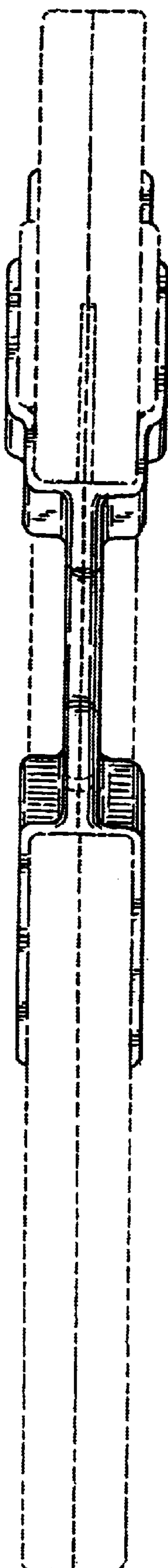

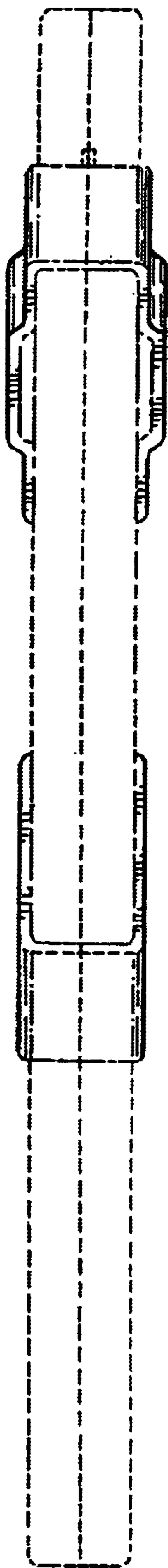

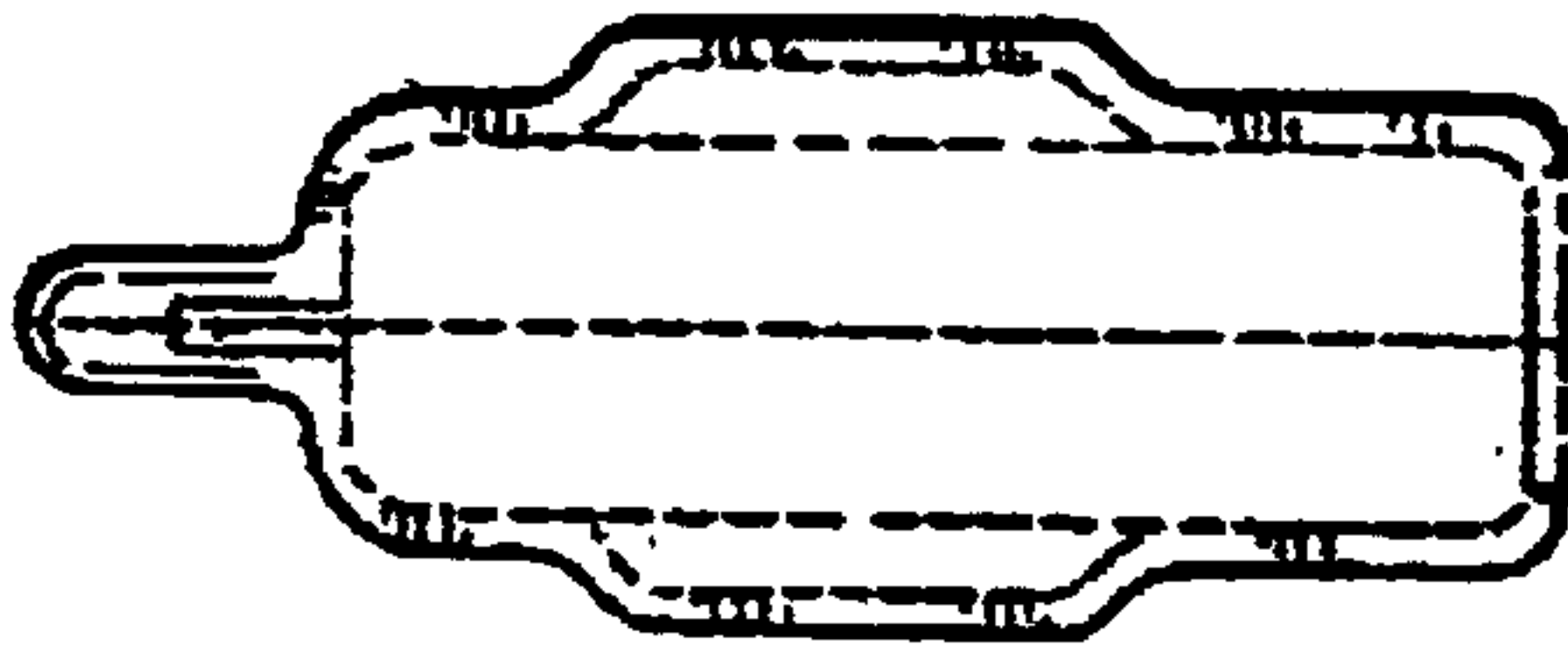

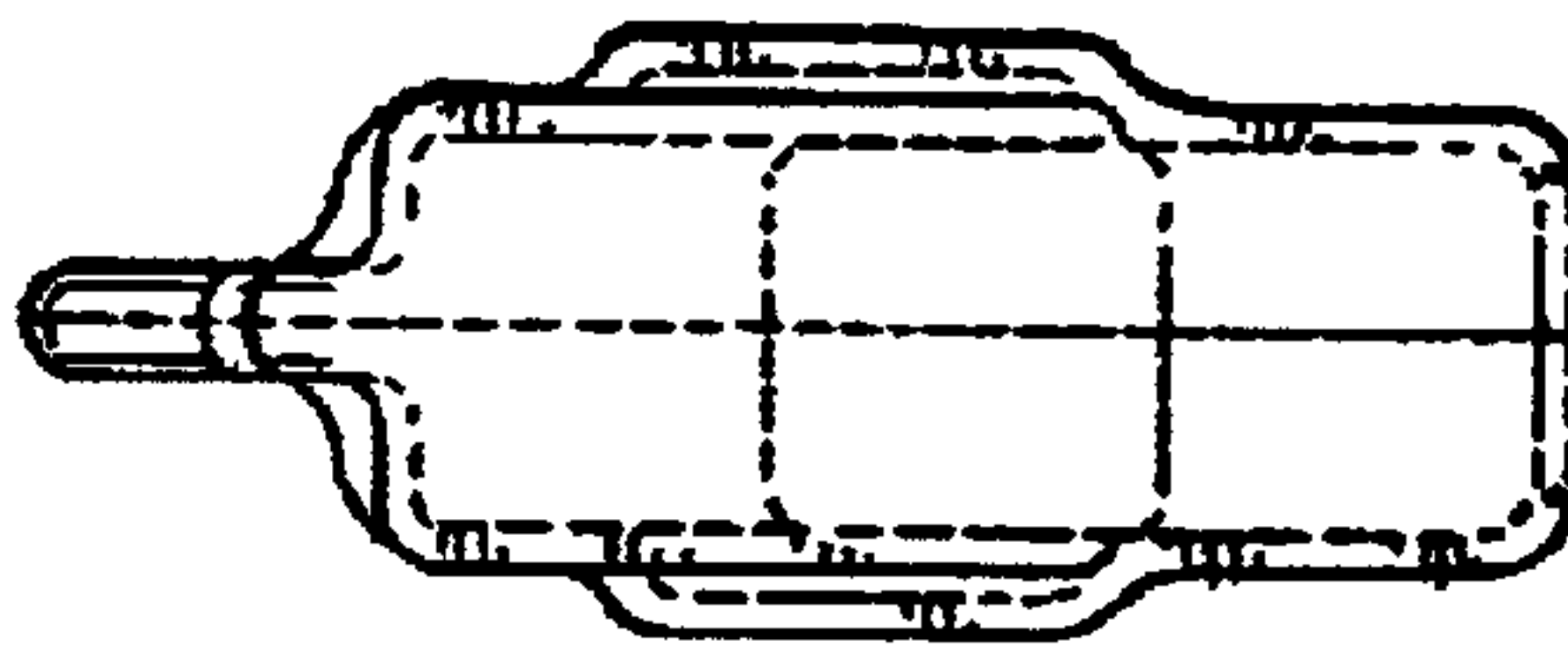
