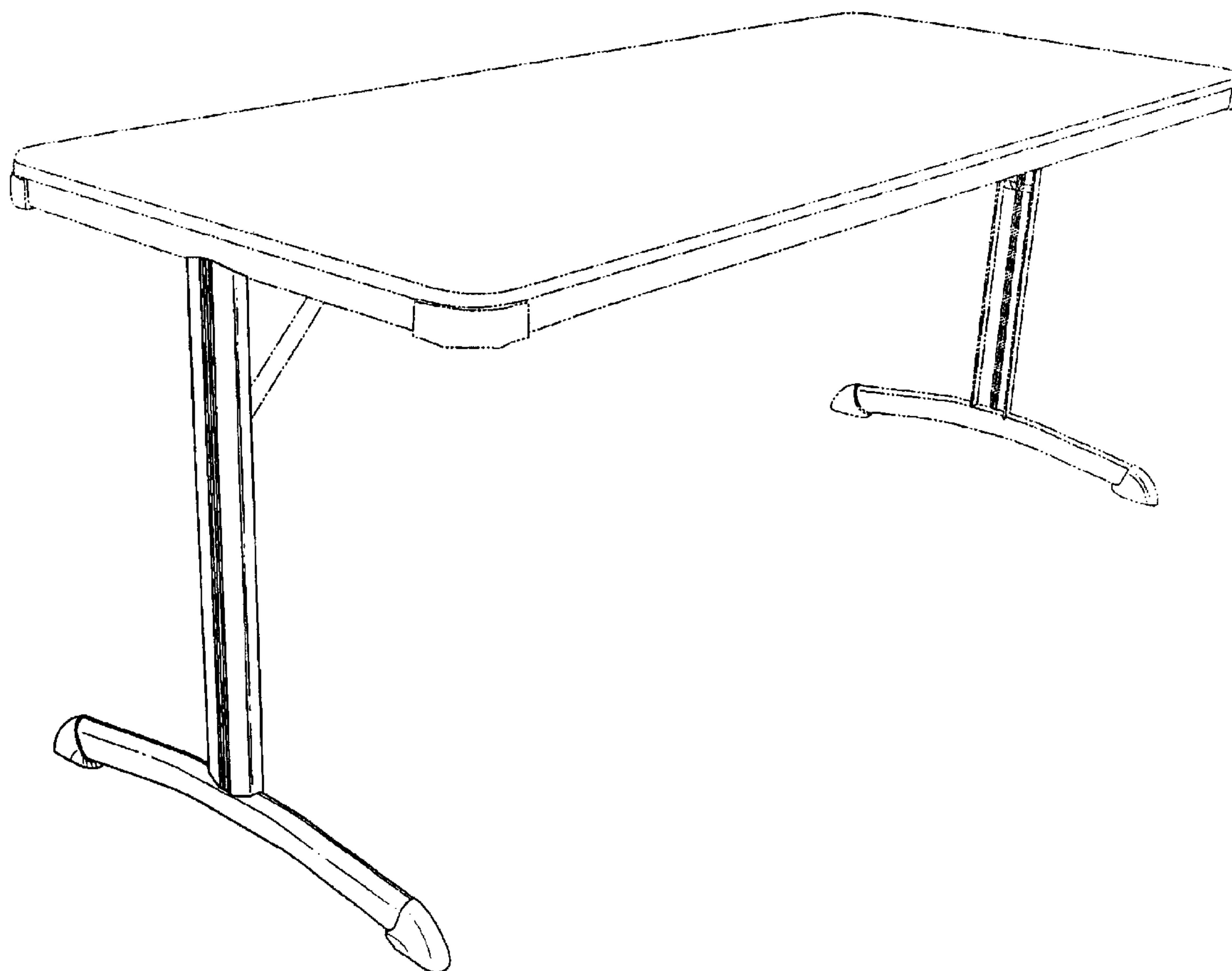
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a table leg, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a table leg in accordance with a preferred embodiment of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the table leg; FIG. 3 is a front view of the table leg; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the table leg; FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the table leg; and, FIG. 6 is a top view of the table leg. The broken lines shown in the figures are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

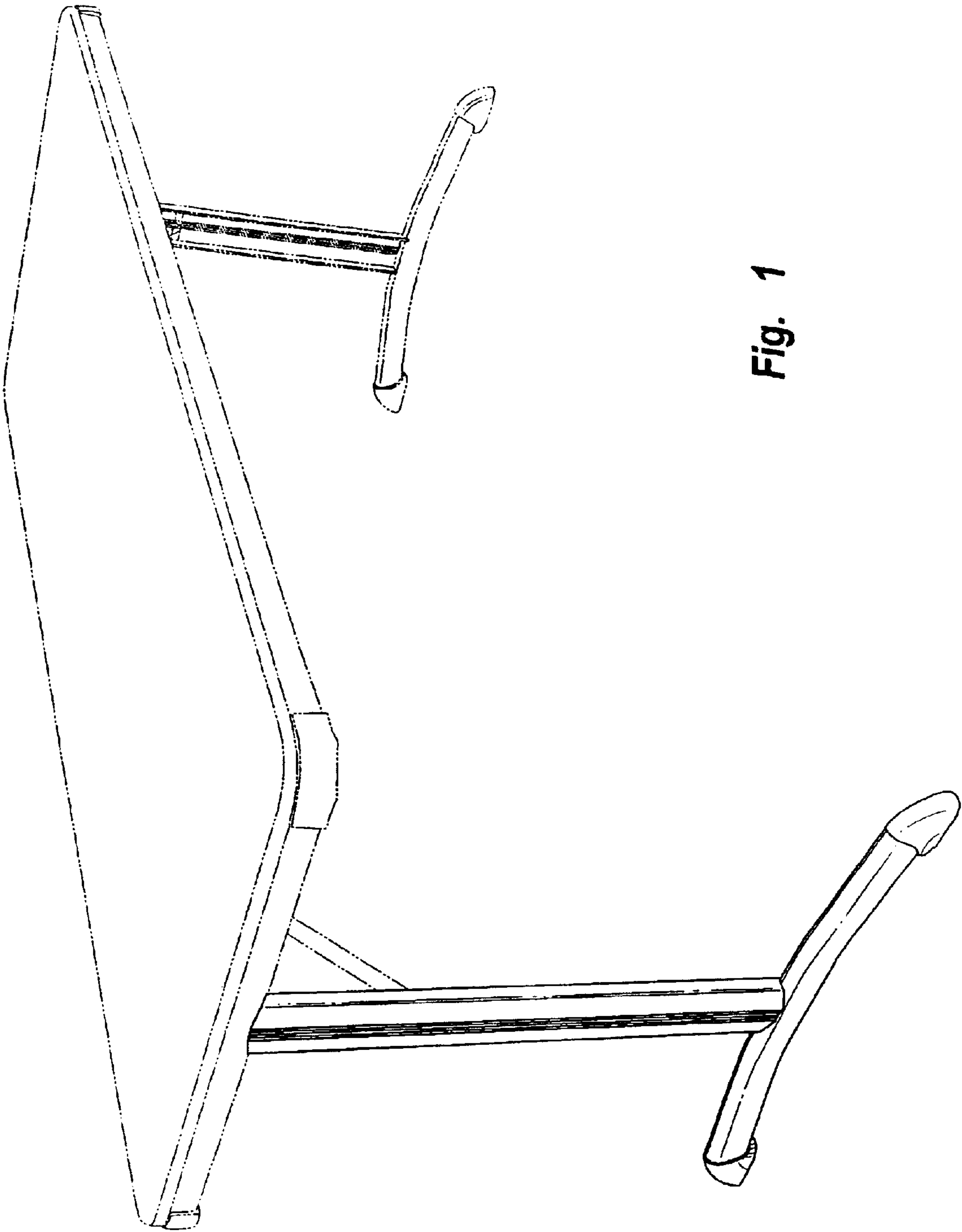

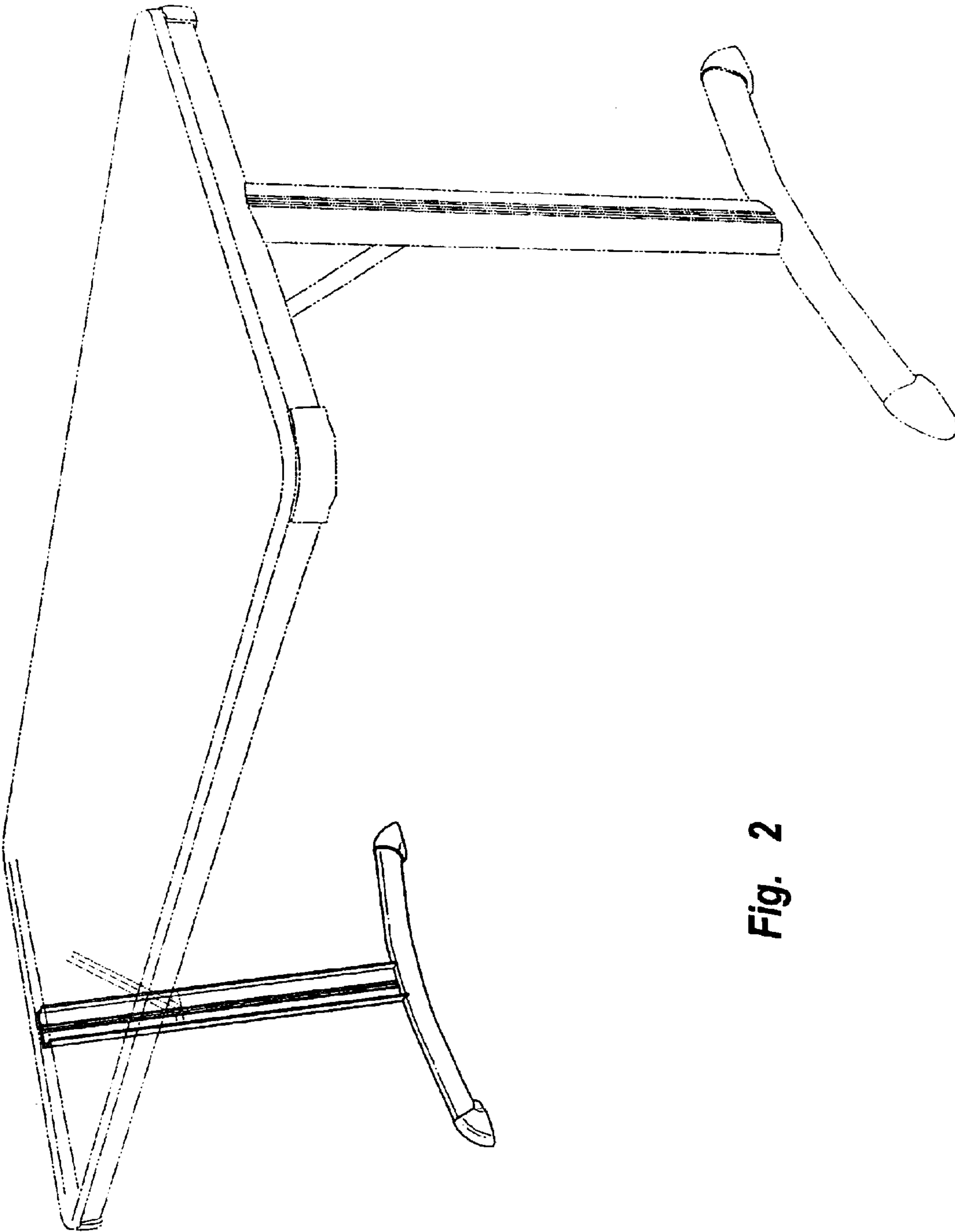

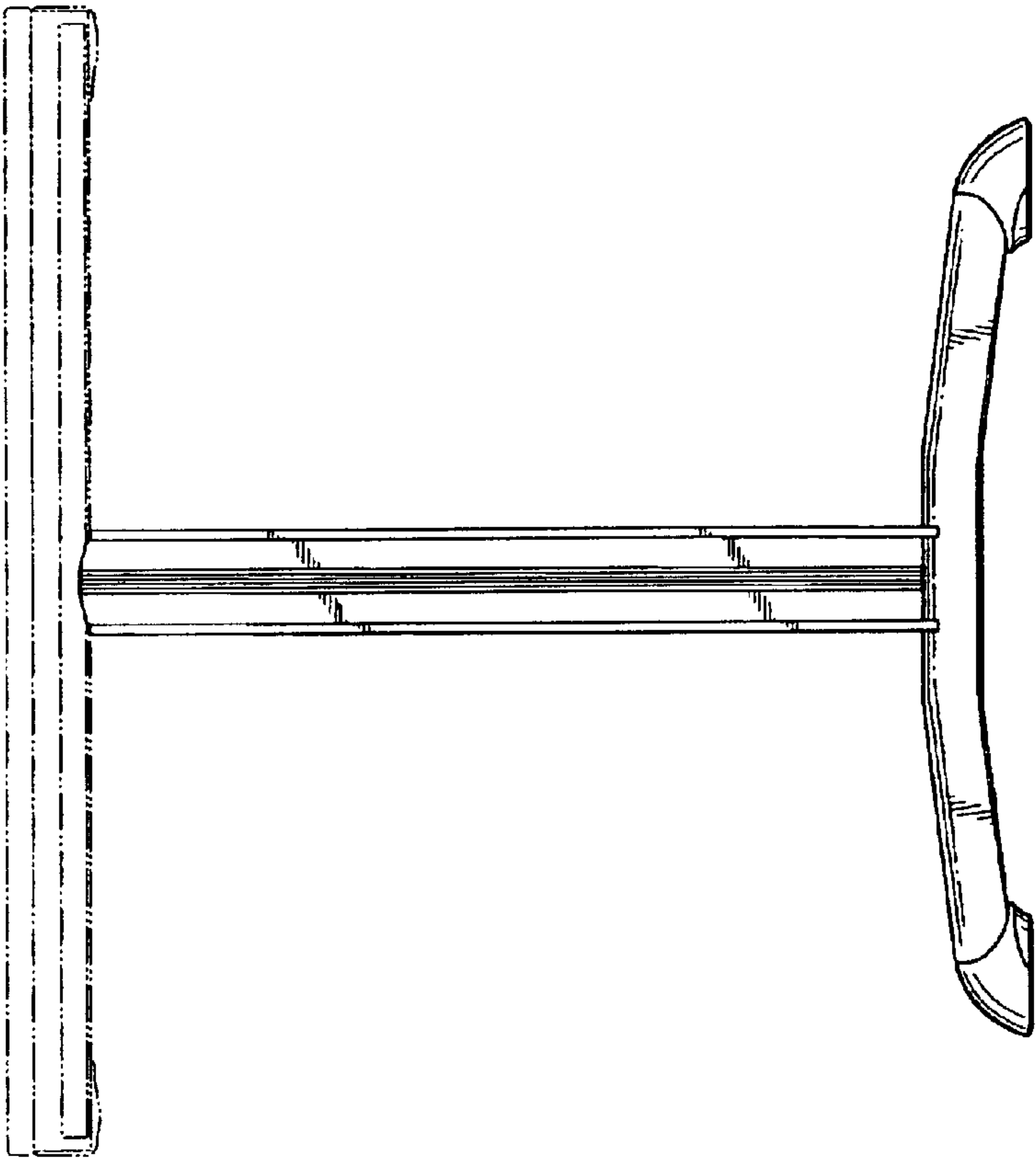

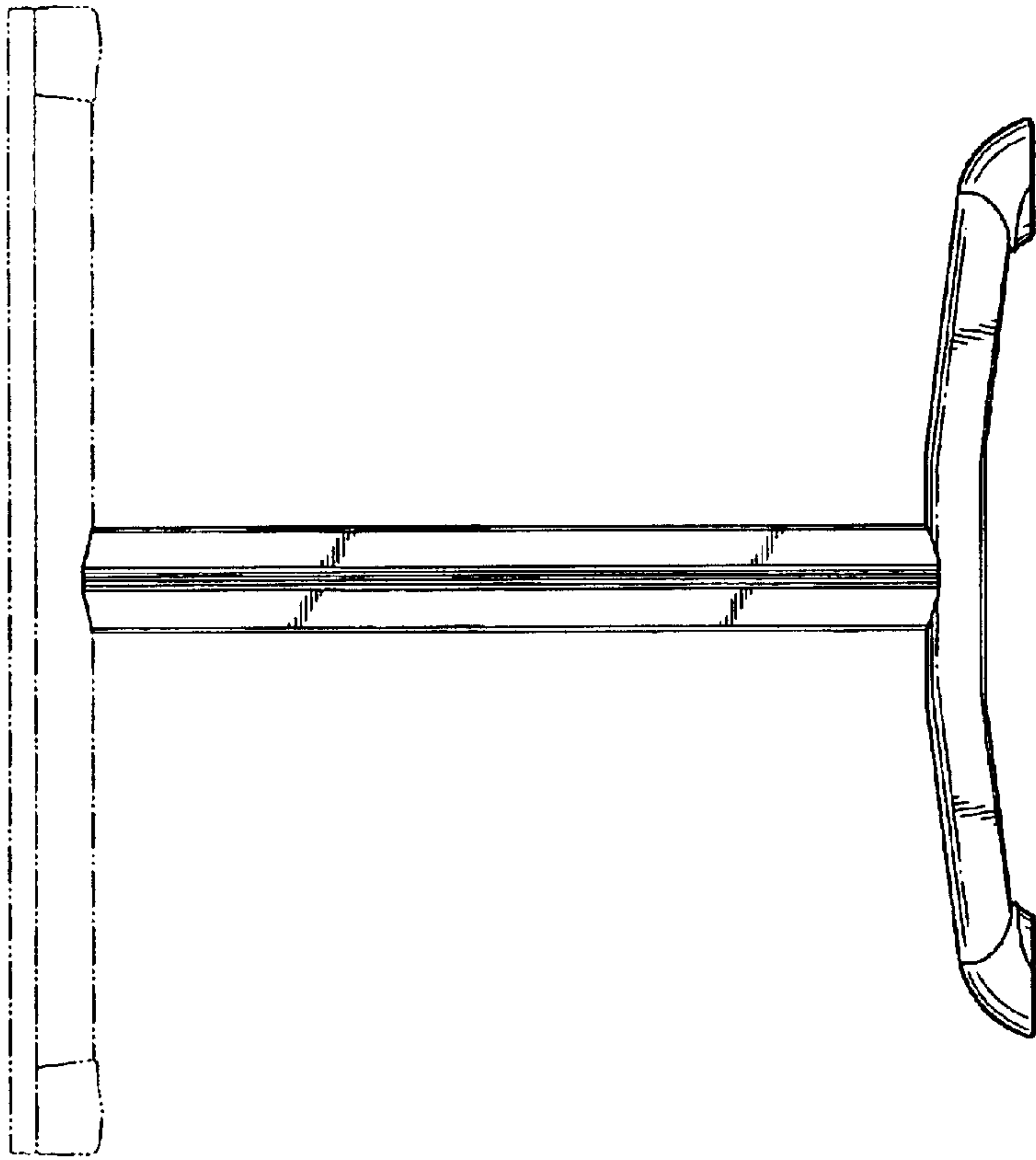
