(57) **CLAIM**

An ornamental design for a roman shade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front, top and left side of the roman shade.

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof with the broken line showing of lift cords and spacer cords being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof.

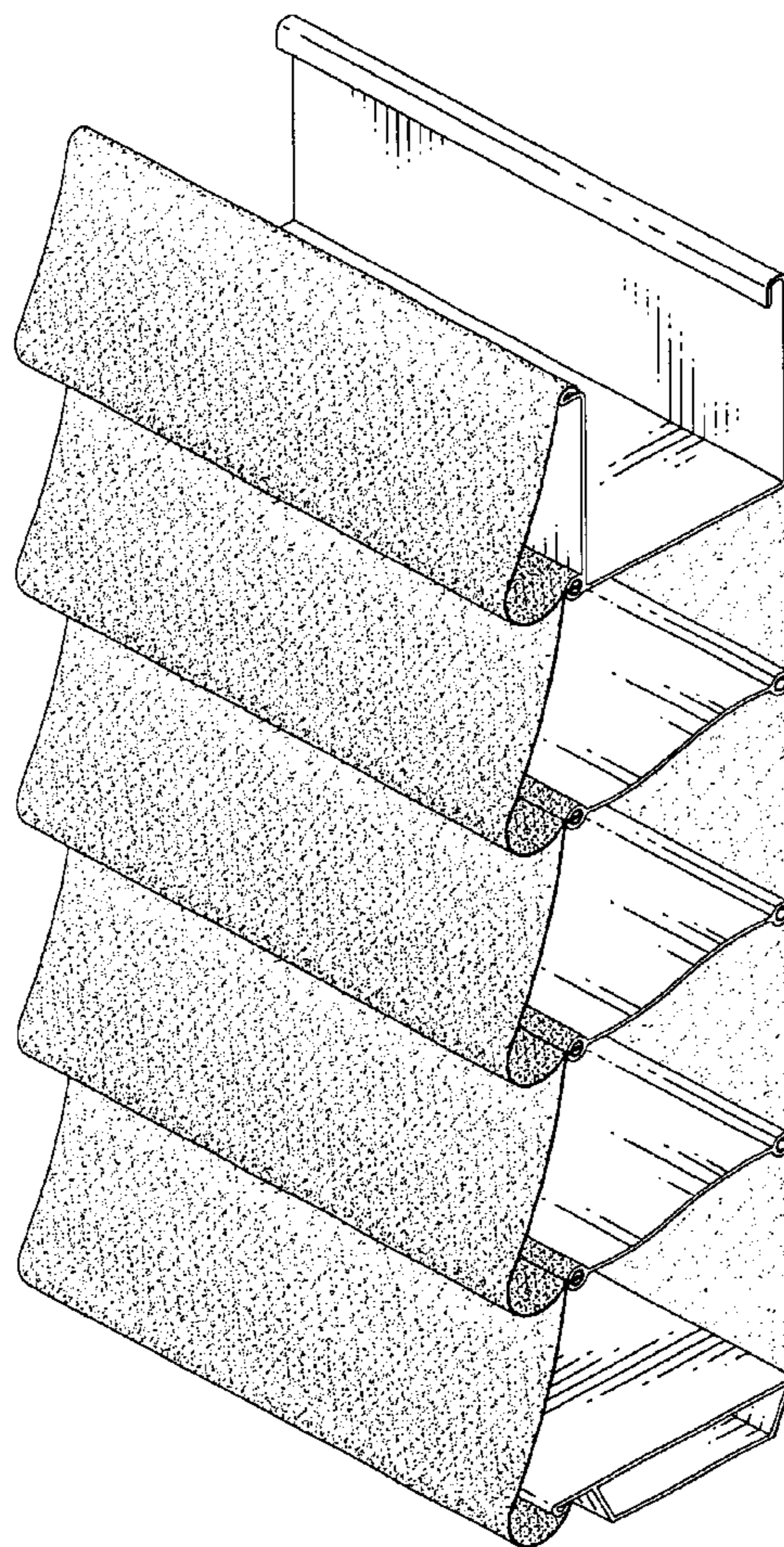
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

The contrasting shading on the shade portion represents a cloth-like material.

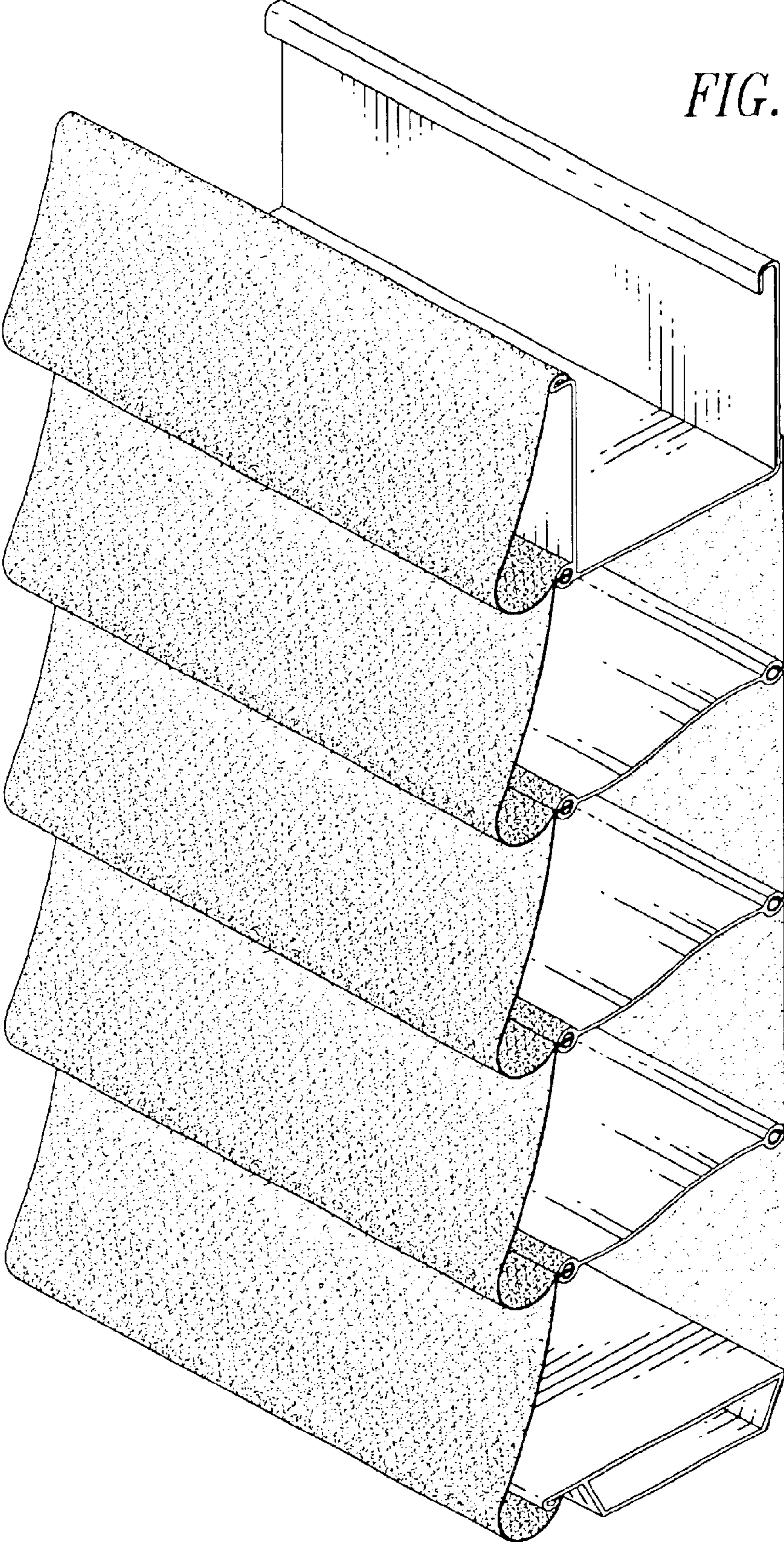

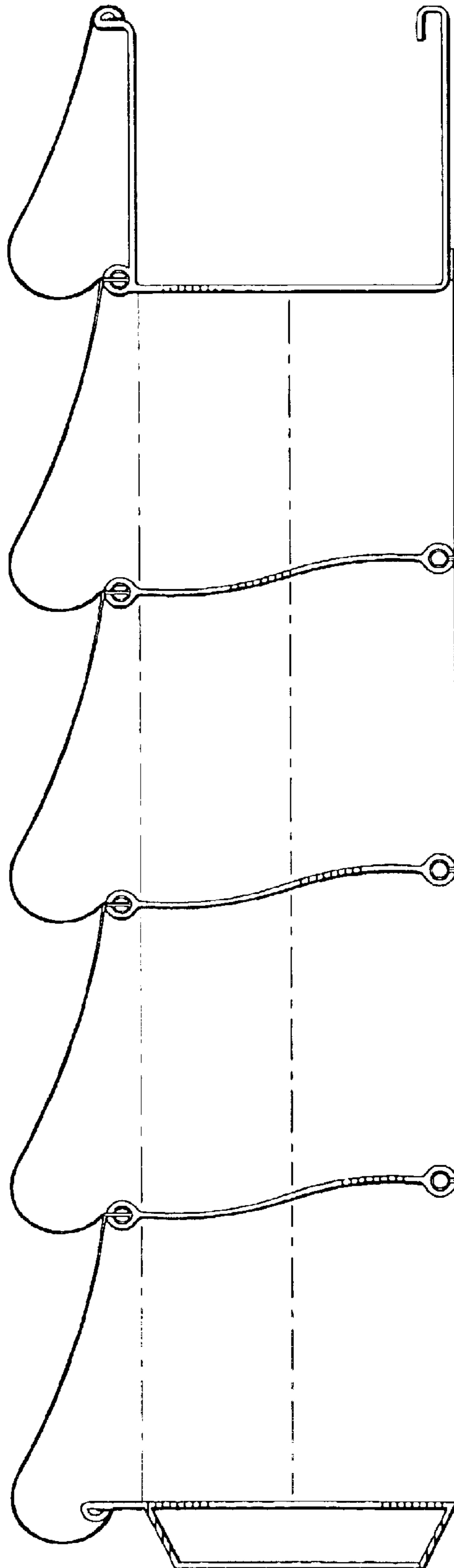

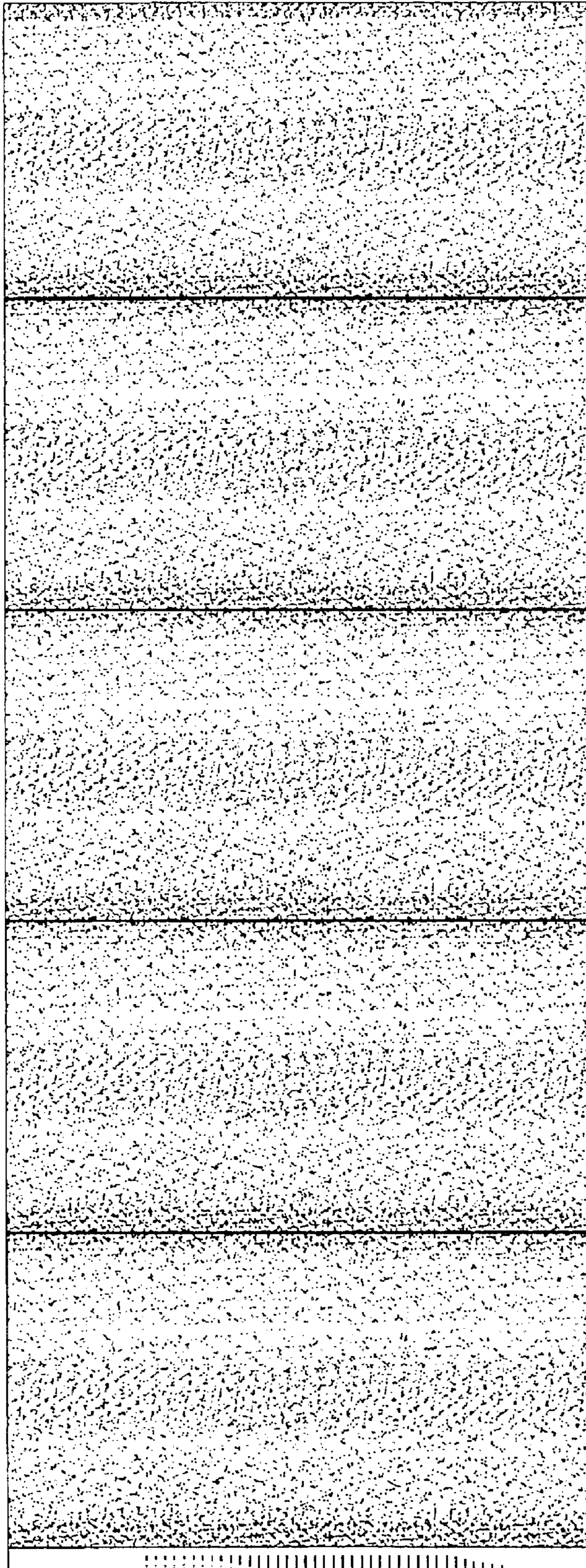

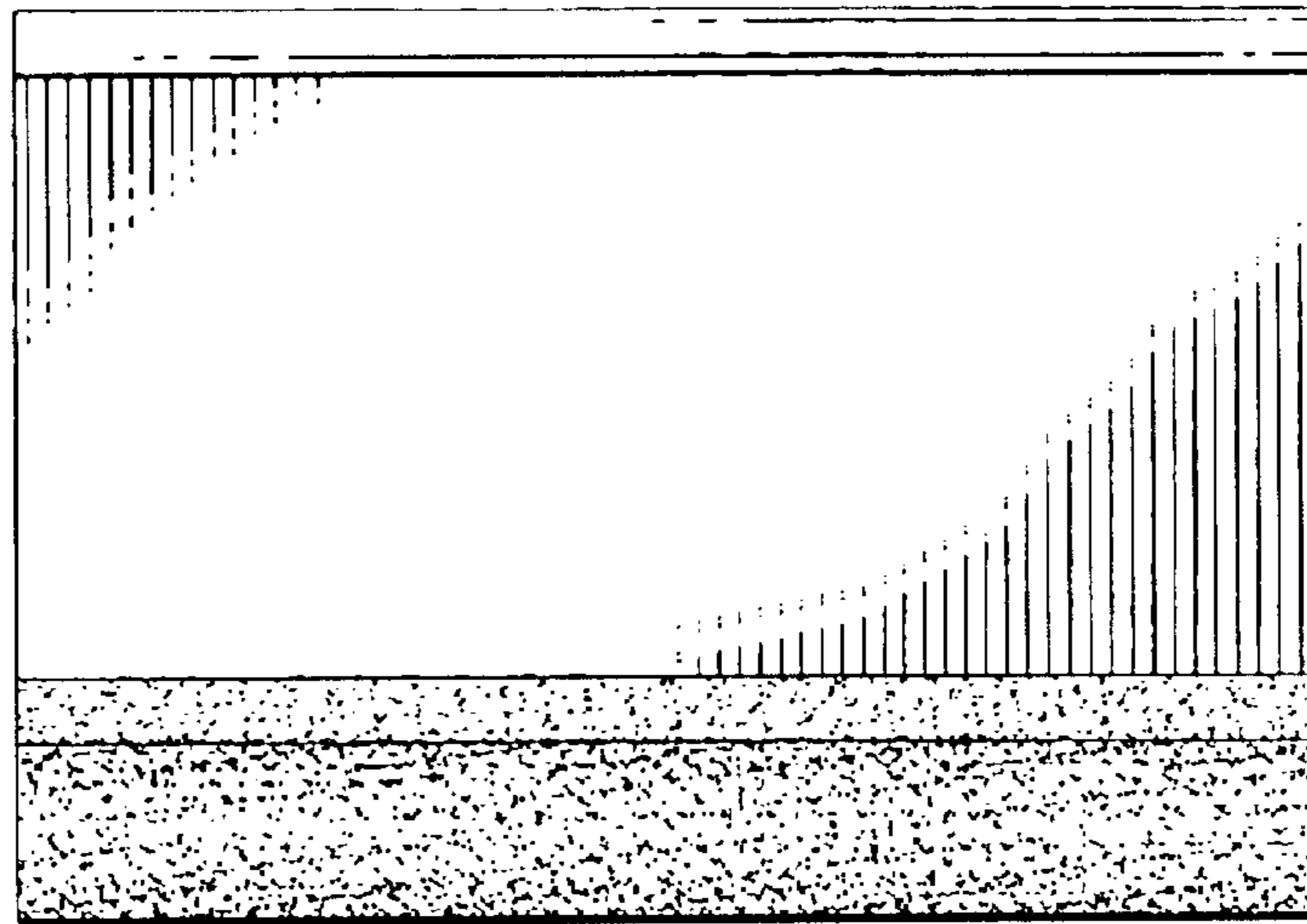

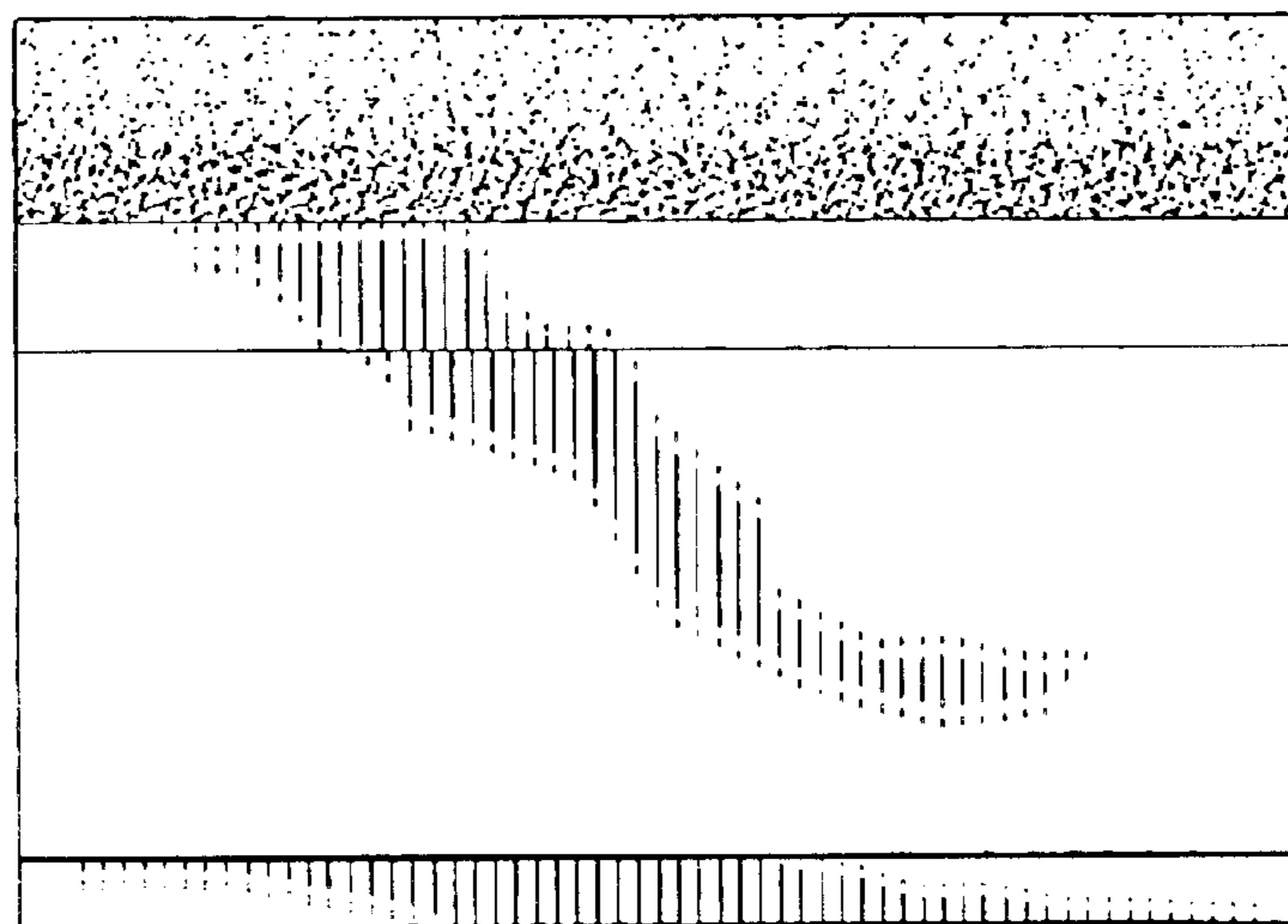

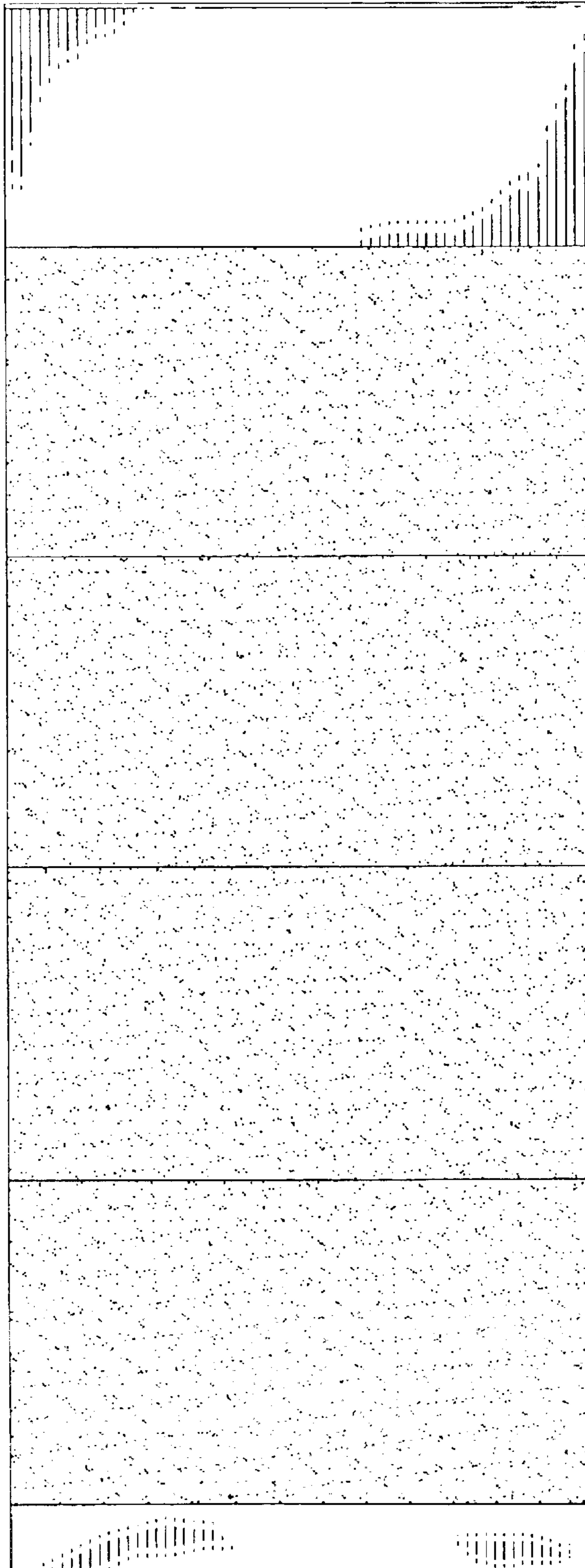
