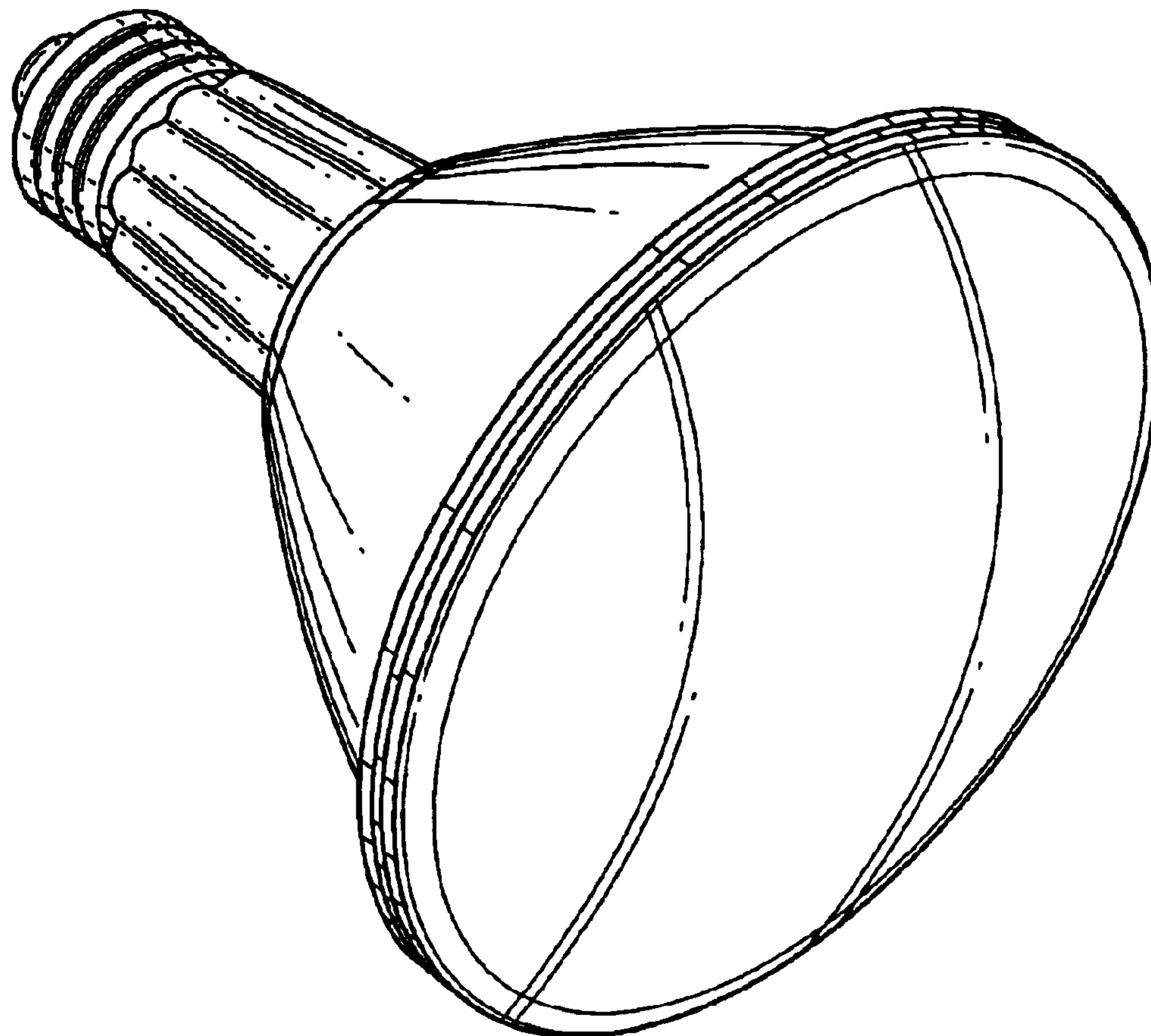
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electric par lamp illustrating my new design;

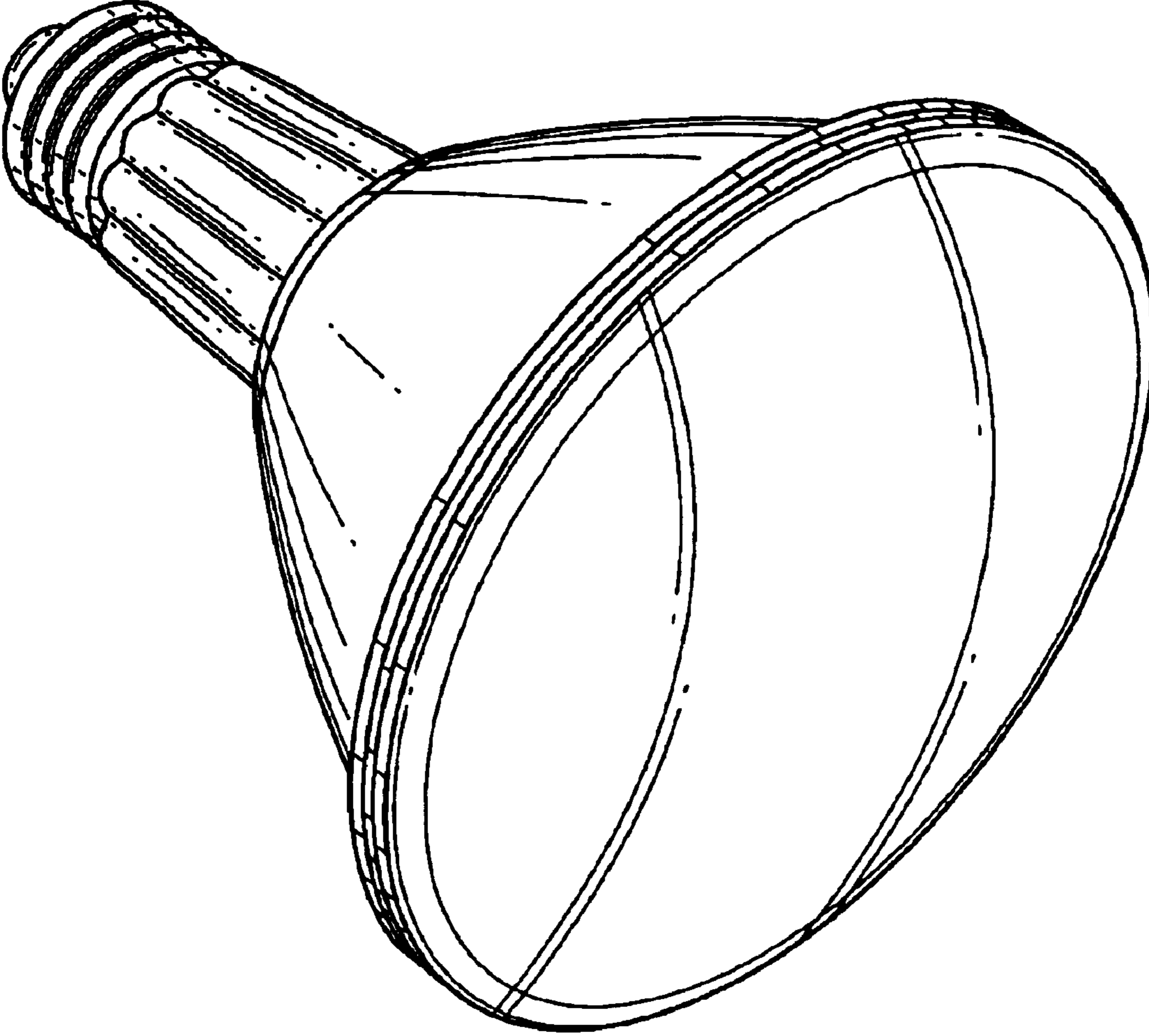

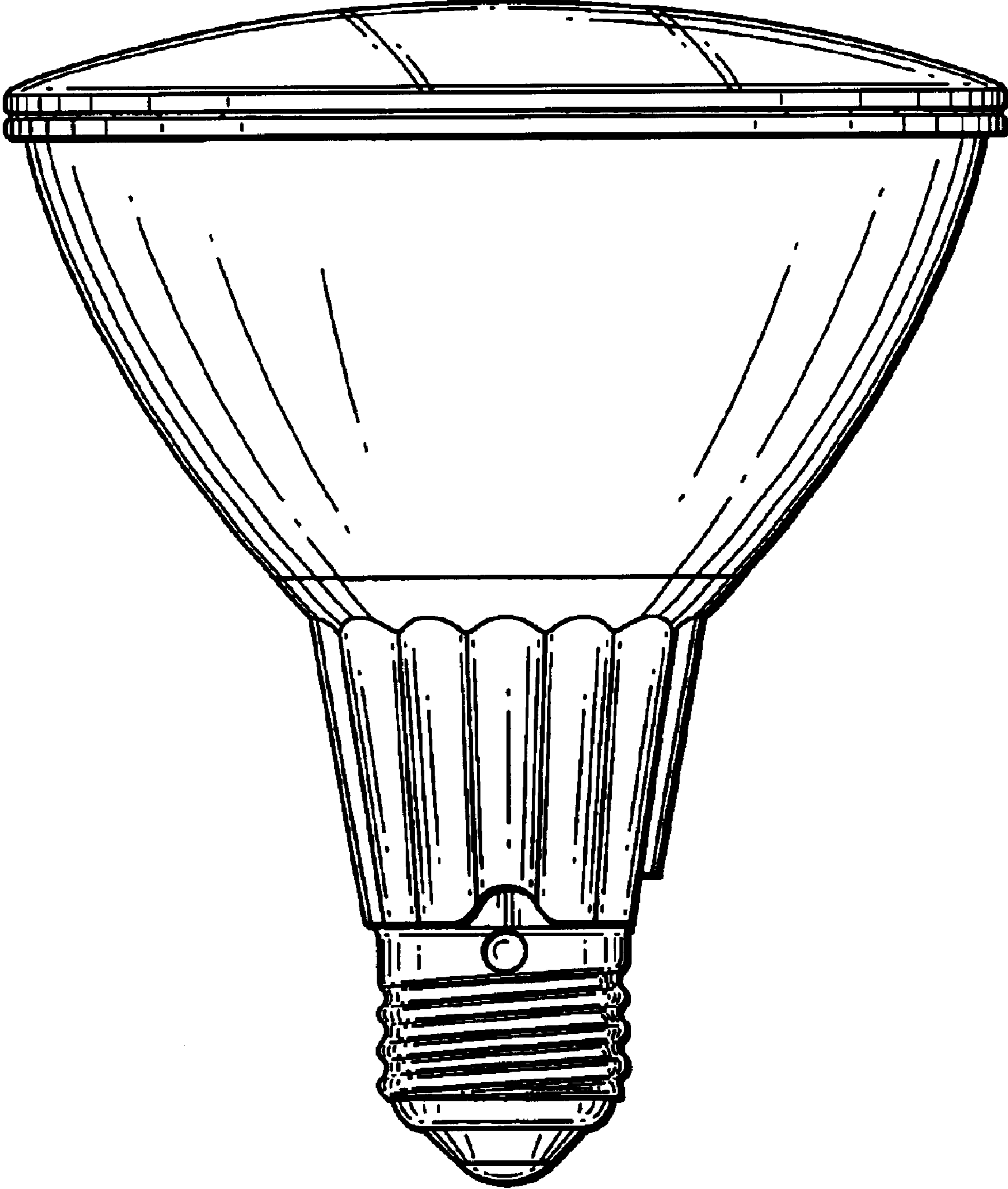

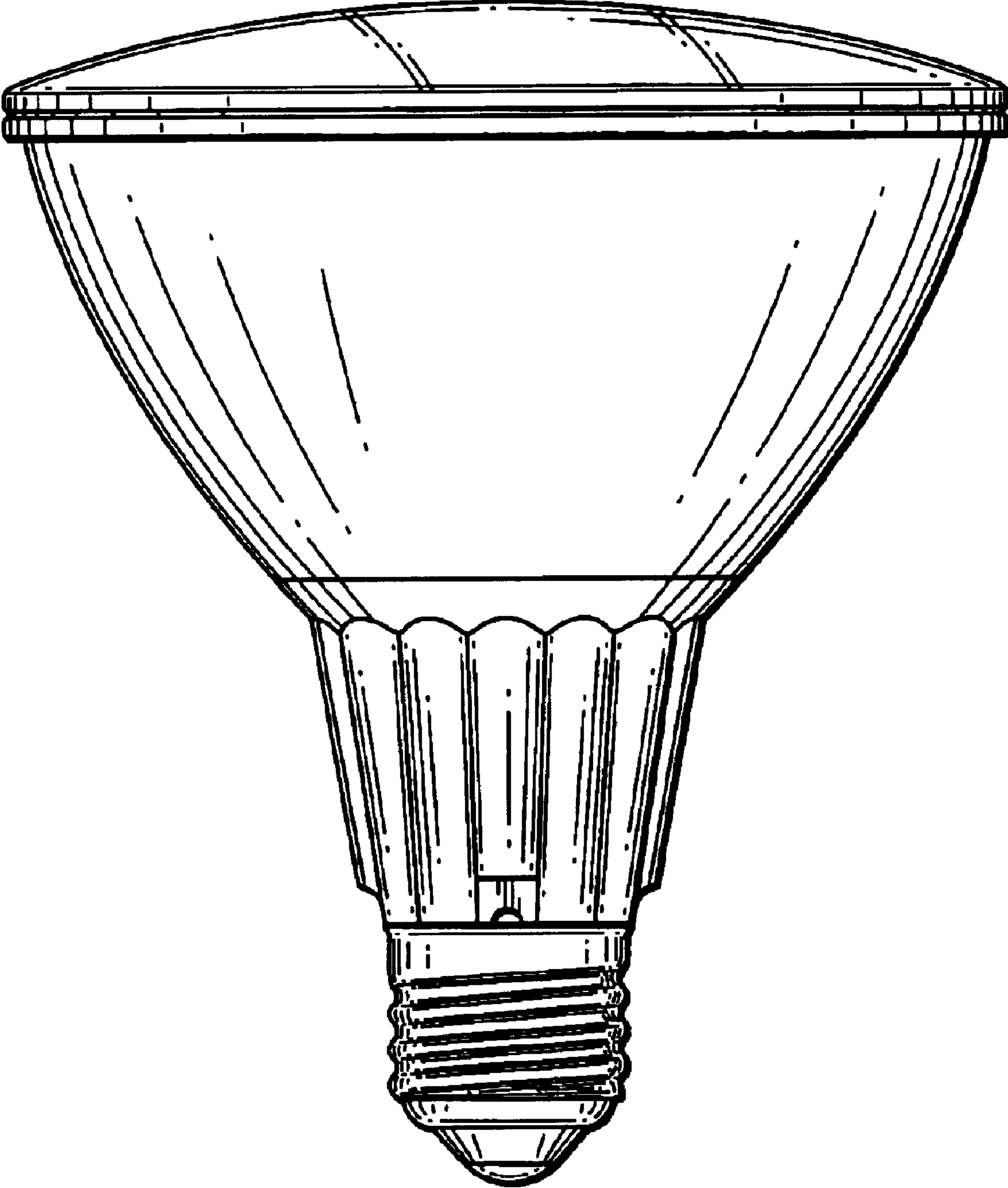

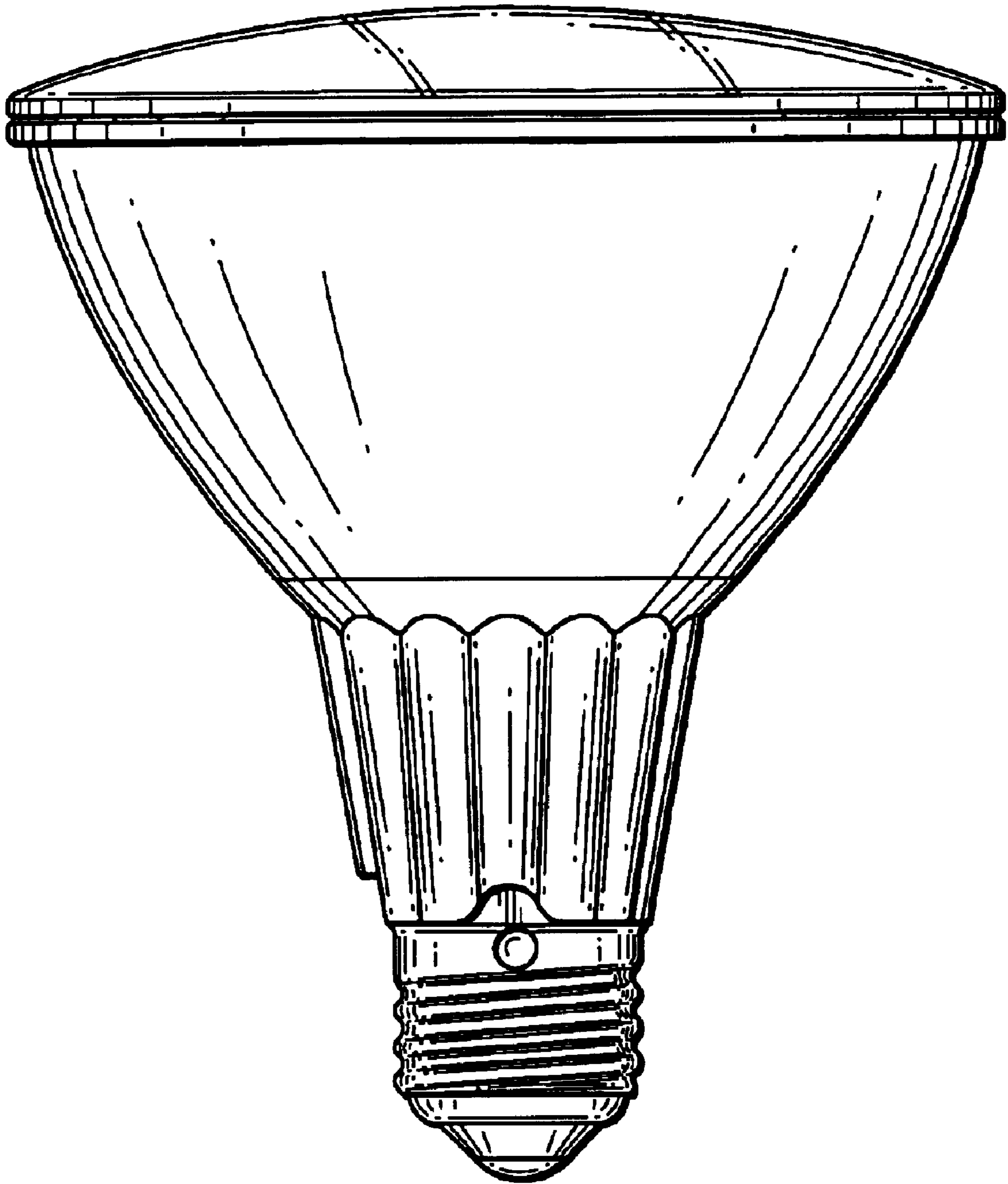

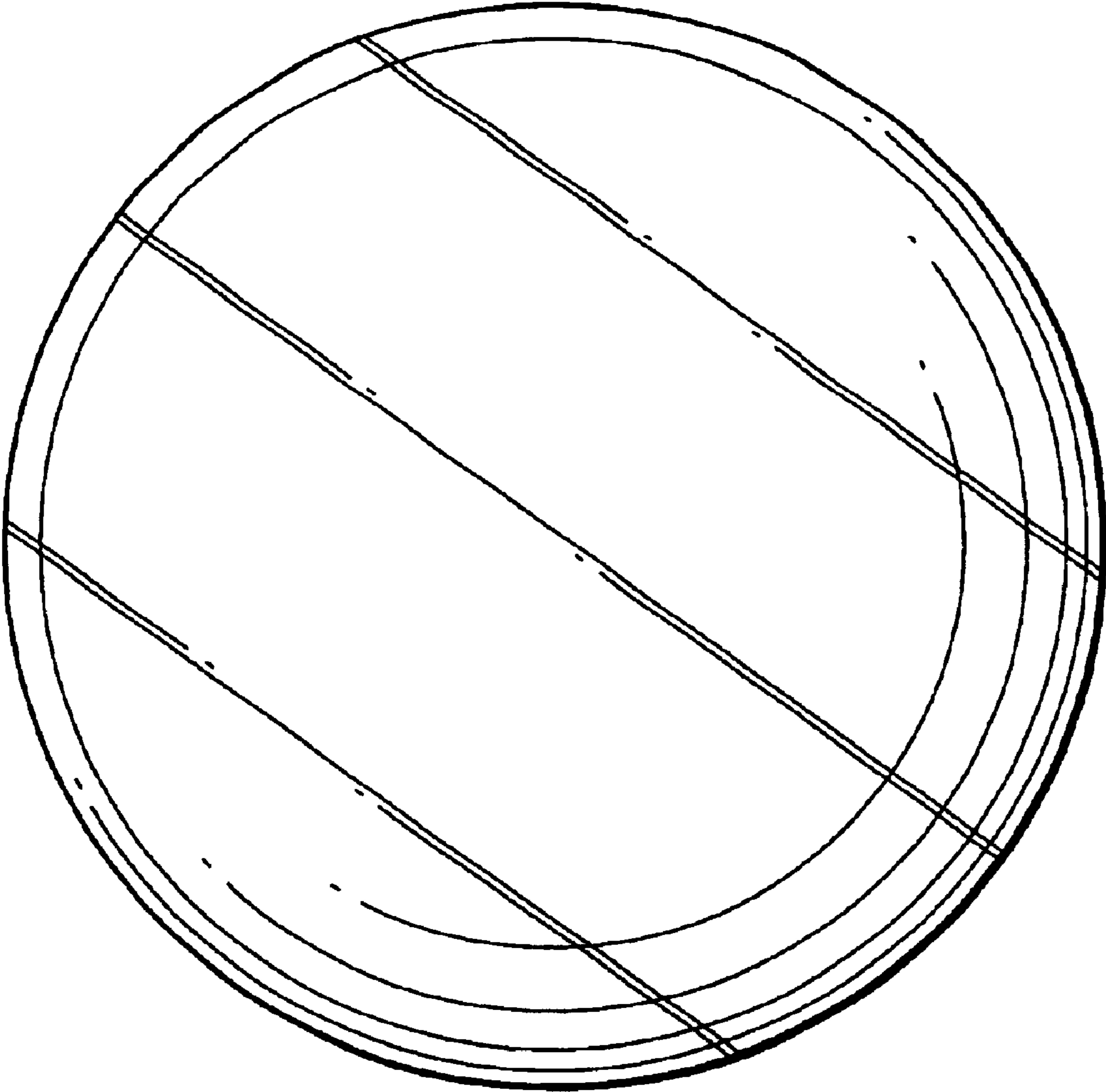

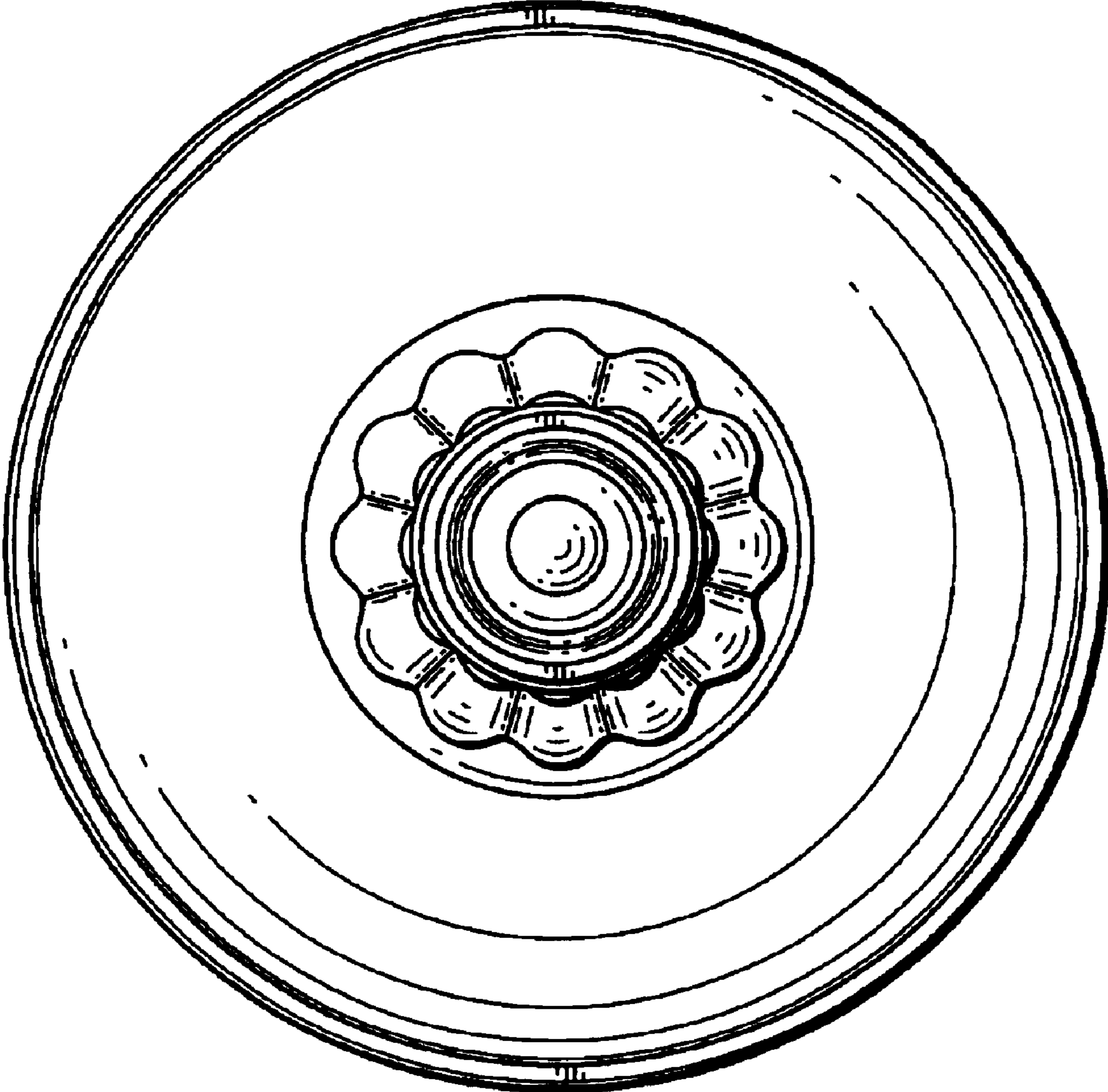

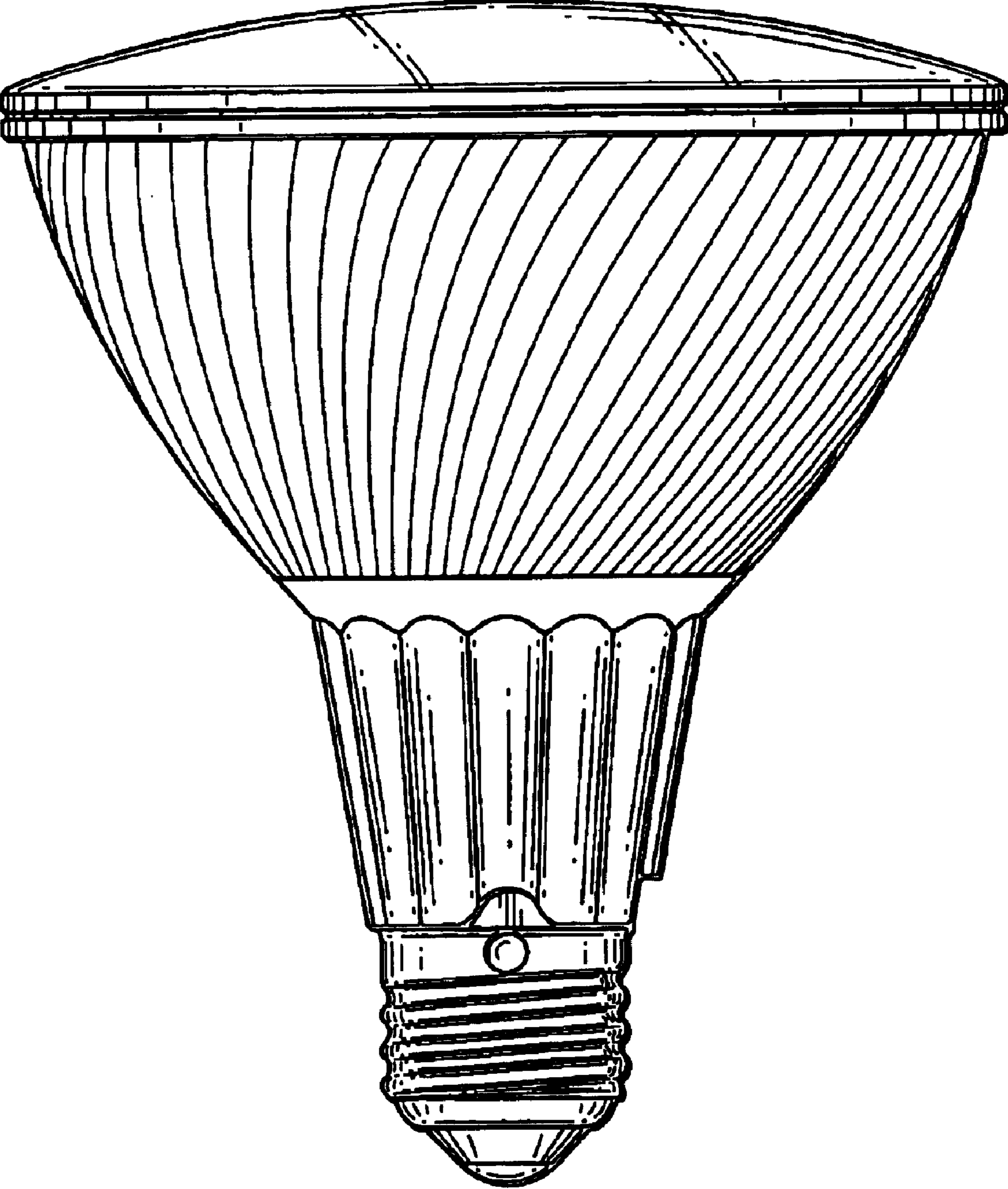
