FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dog collar showing my new design, the broken lines shown are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; and, FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, it being understood that both ends are shown so as to represent indeterminate length.

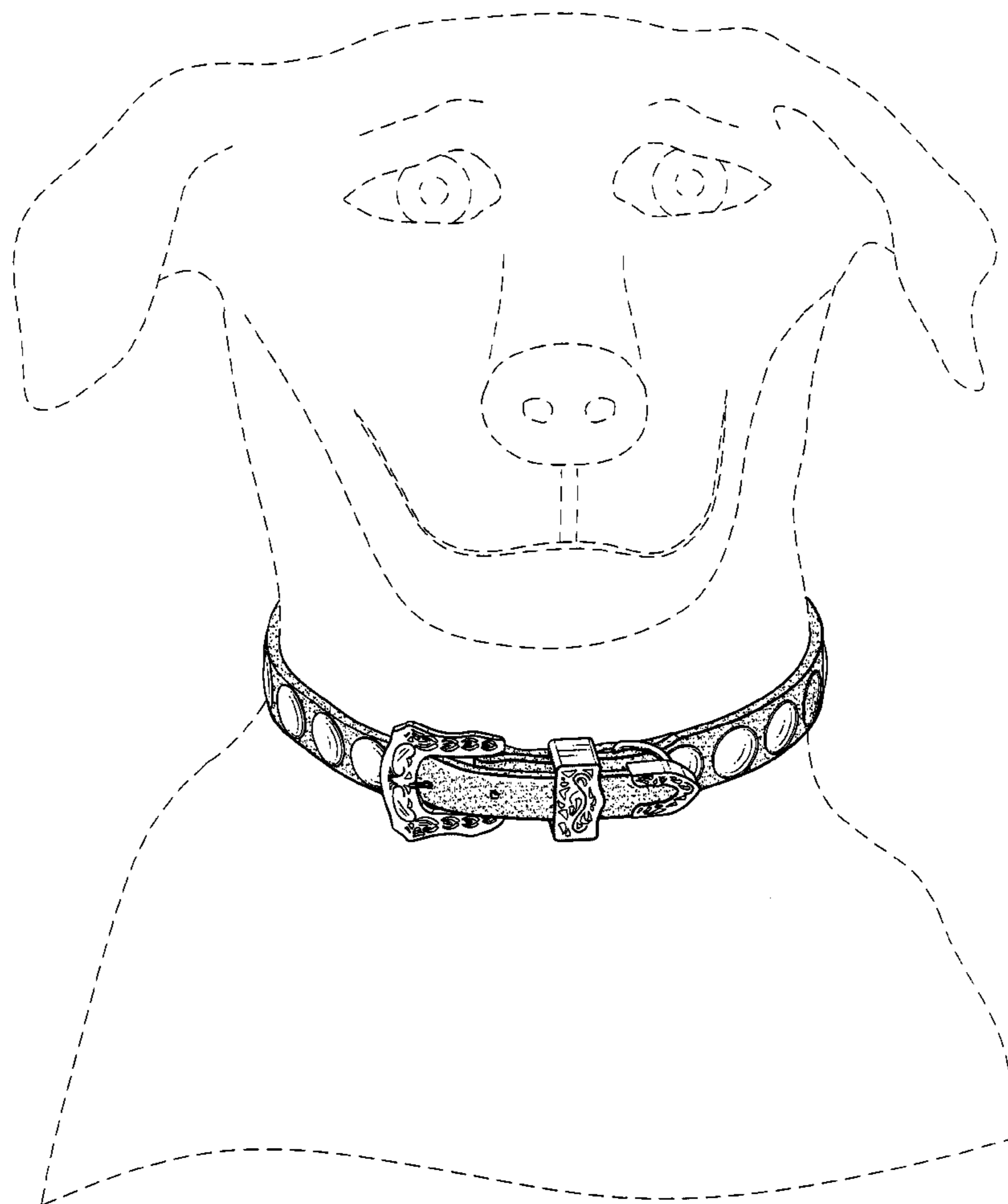

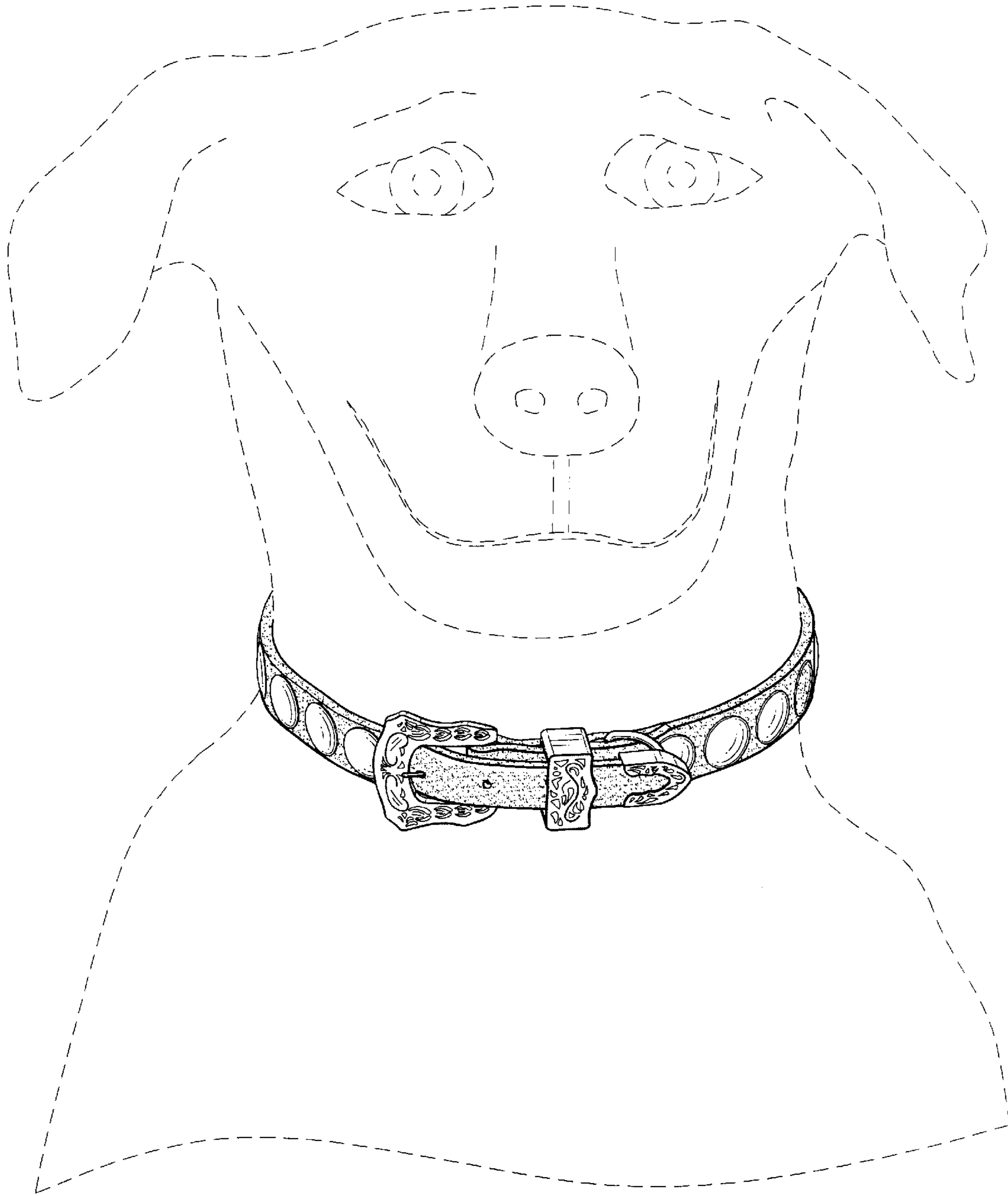

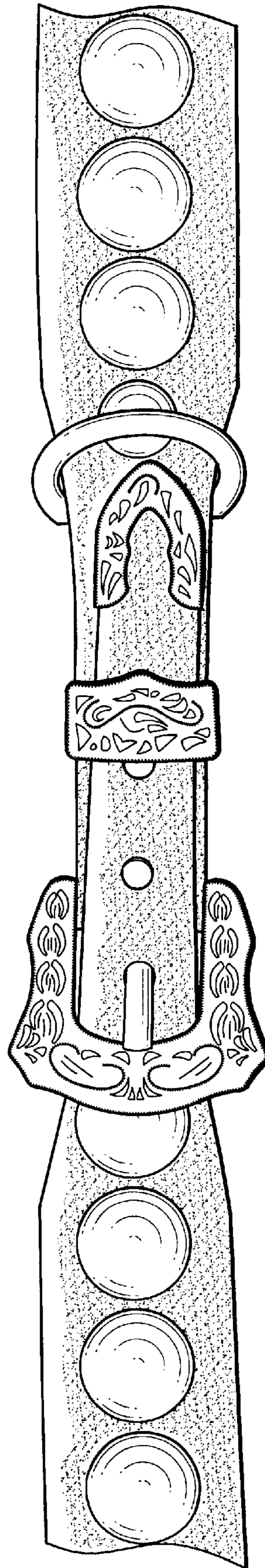
