We claim the ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair showing the new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a top view thereof.

The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat and backrest is understood to represent fabric.

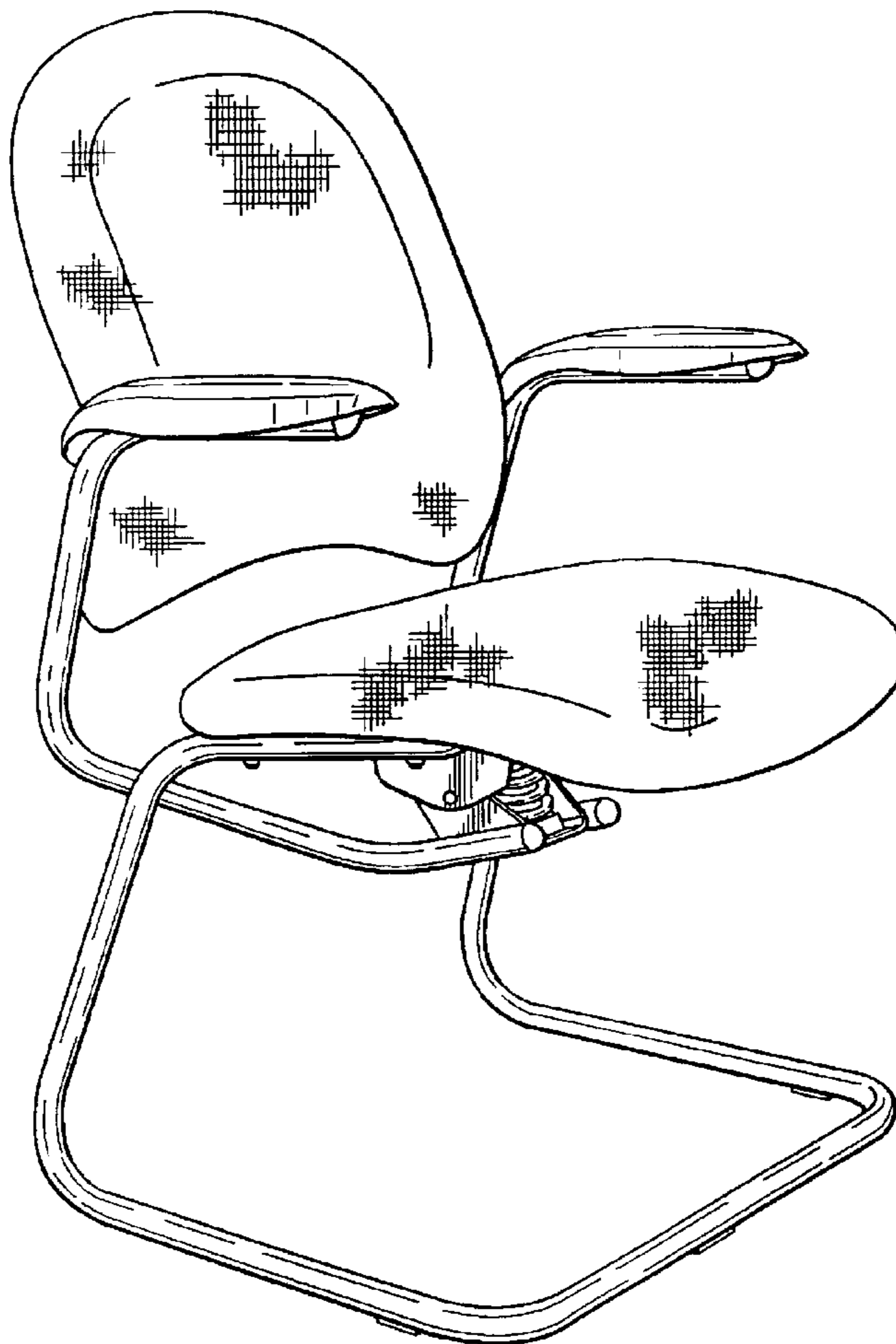

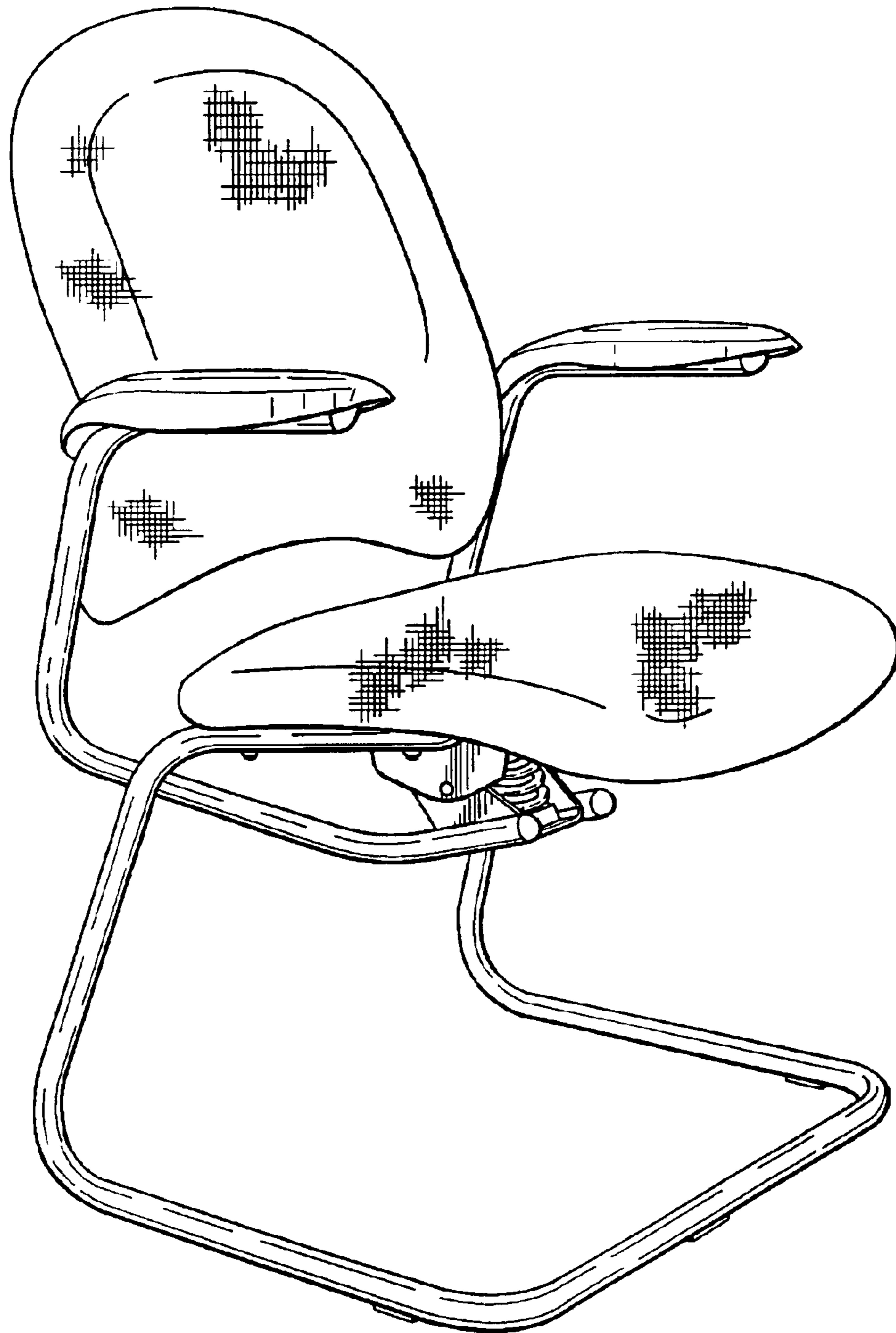

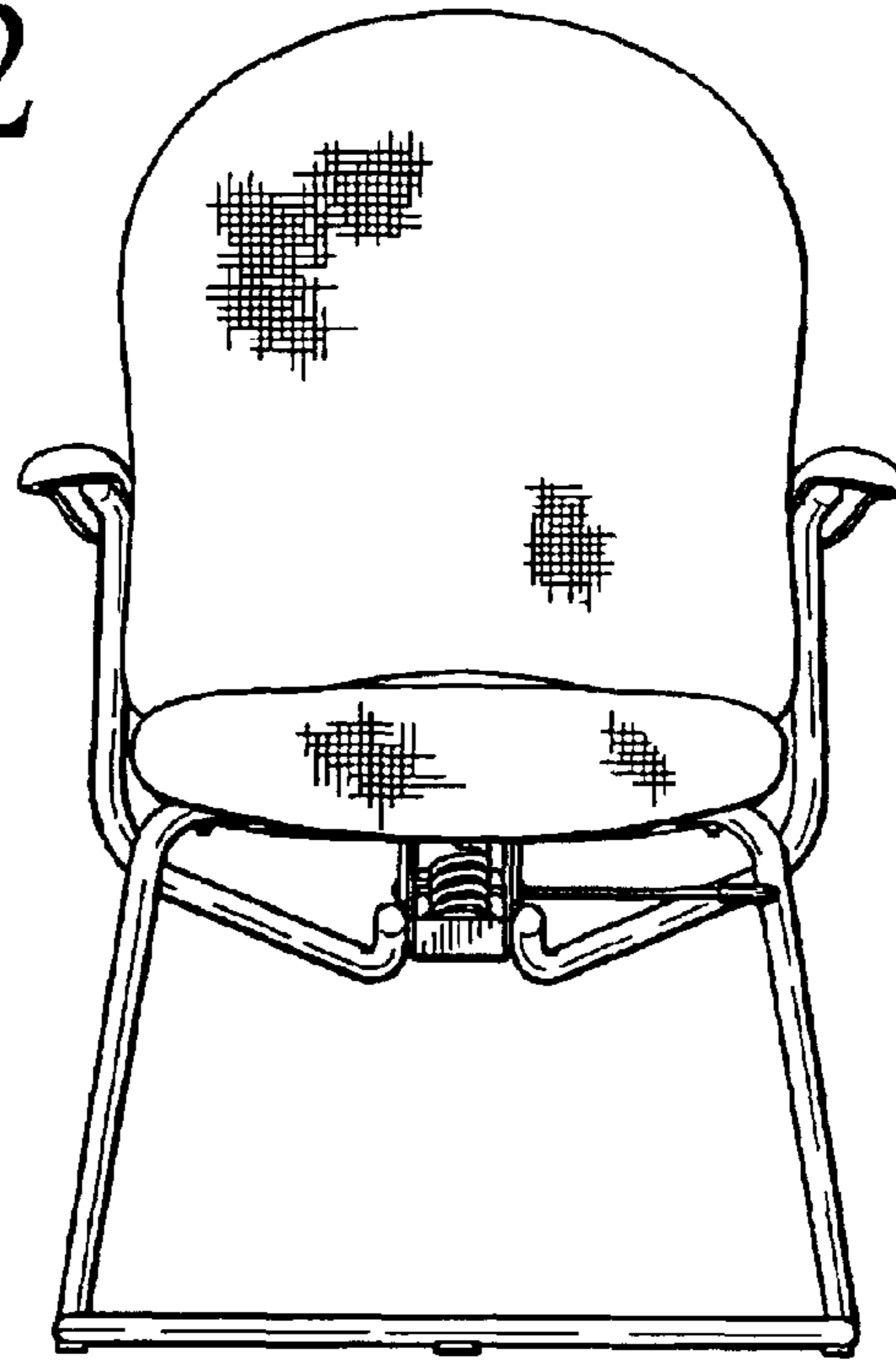

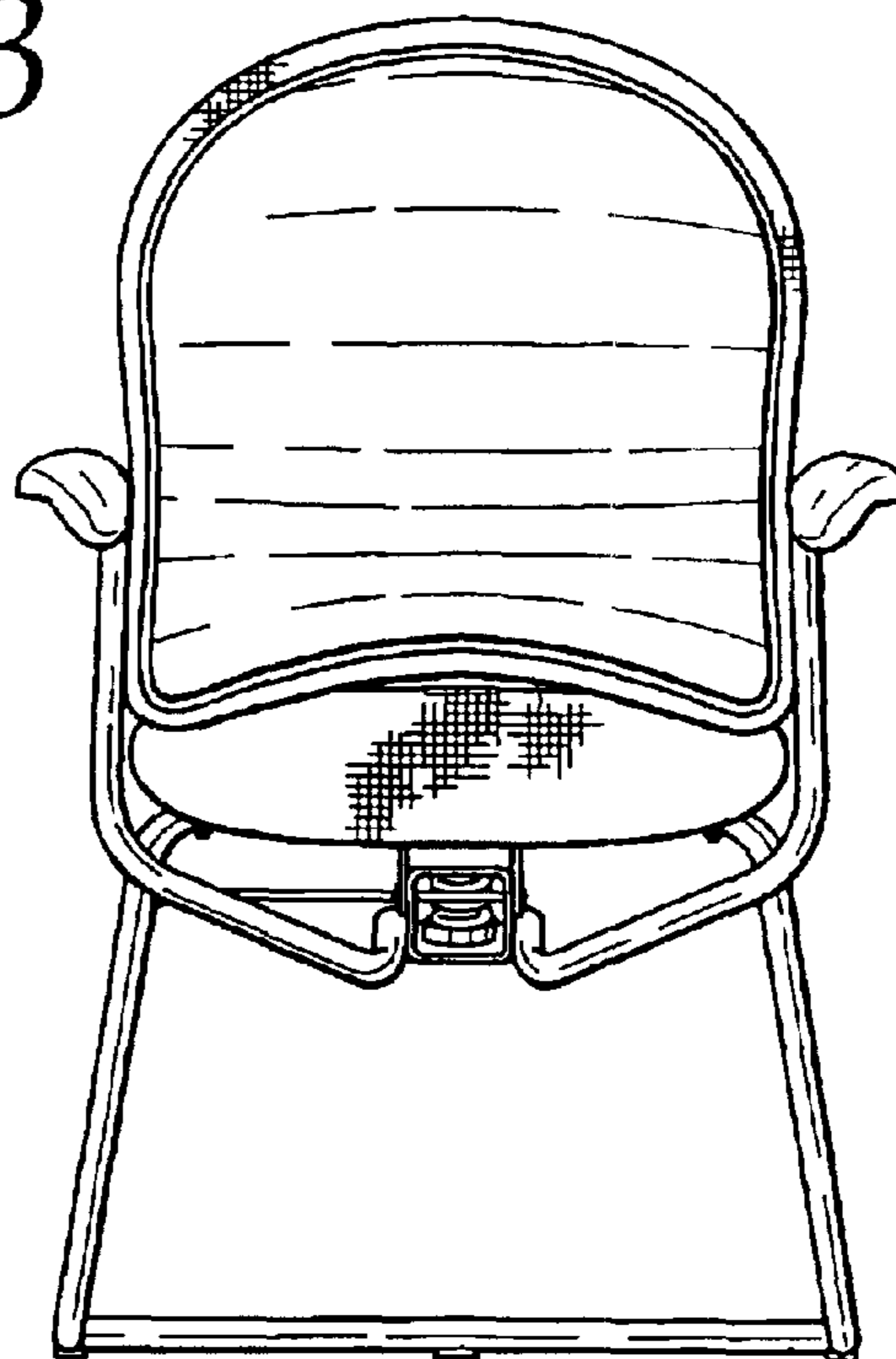

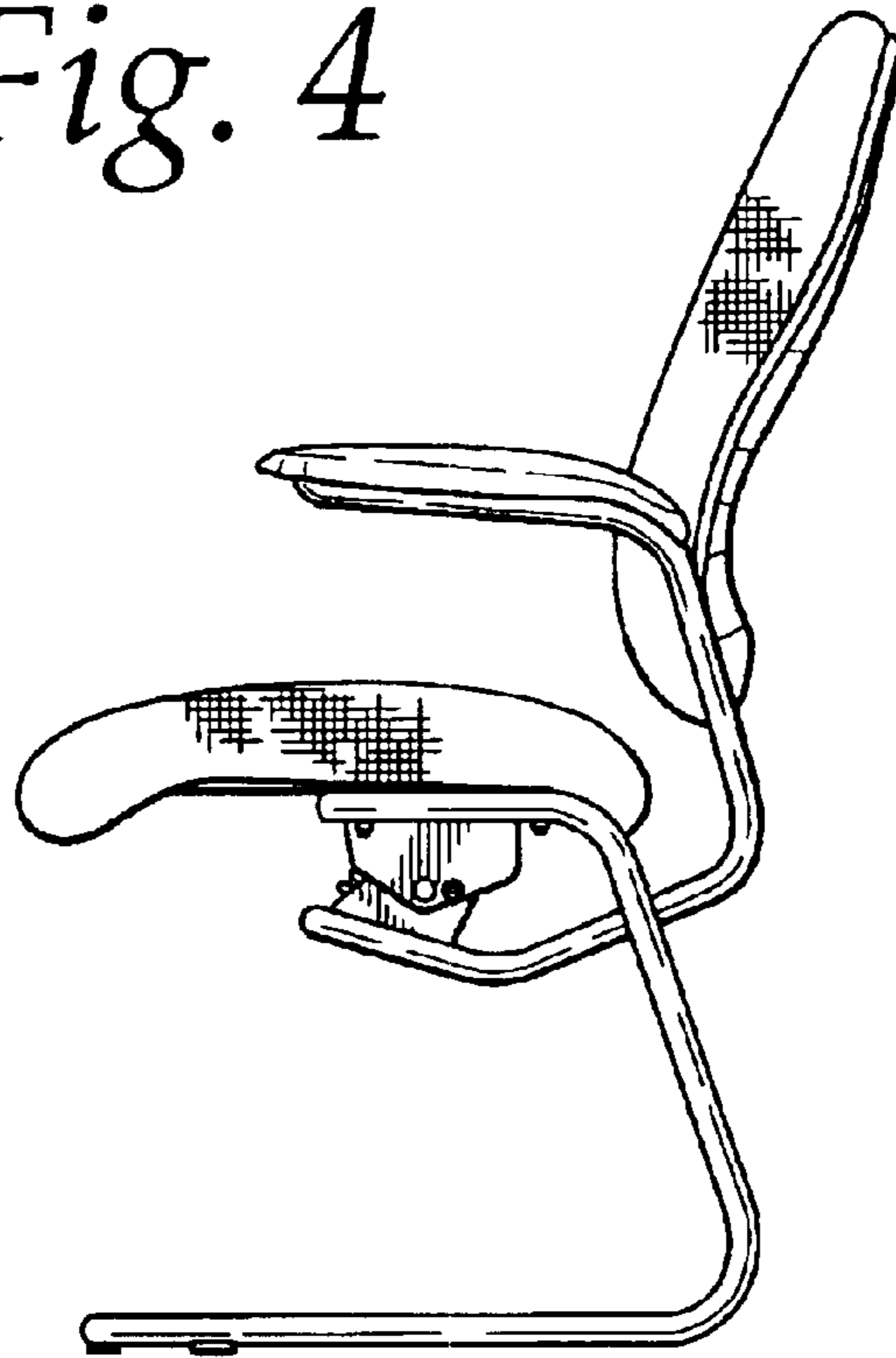

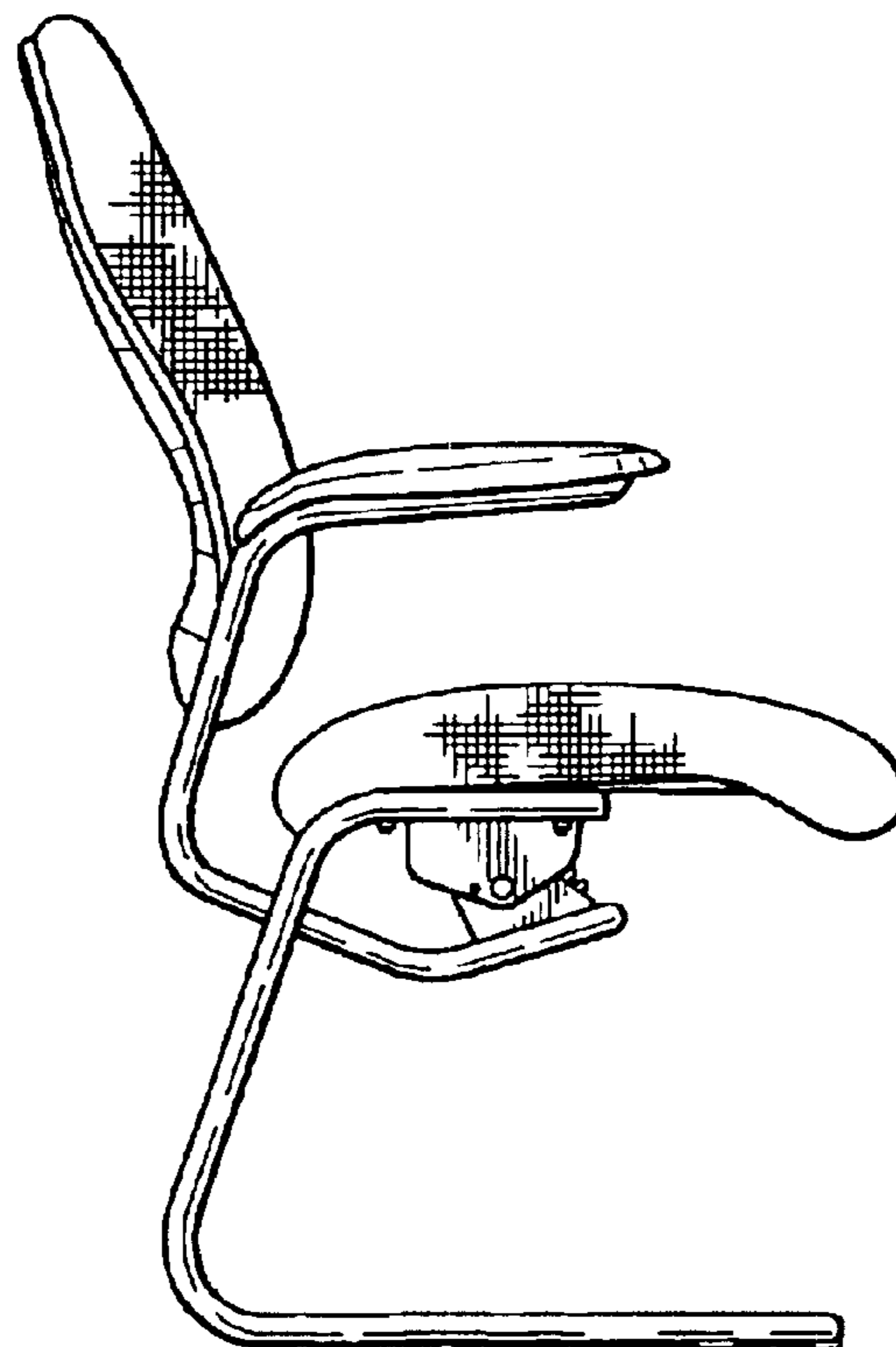

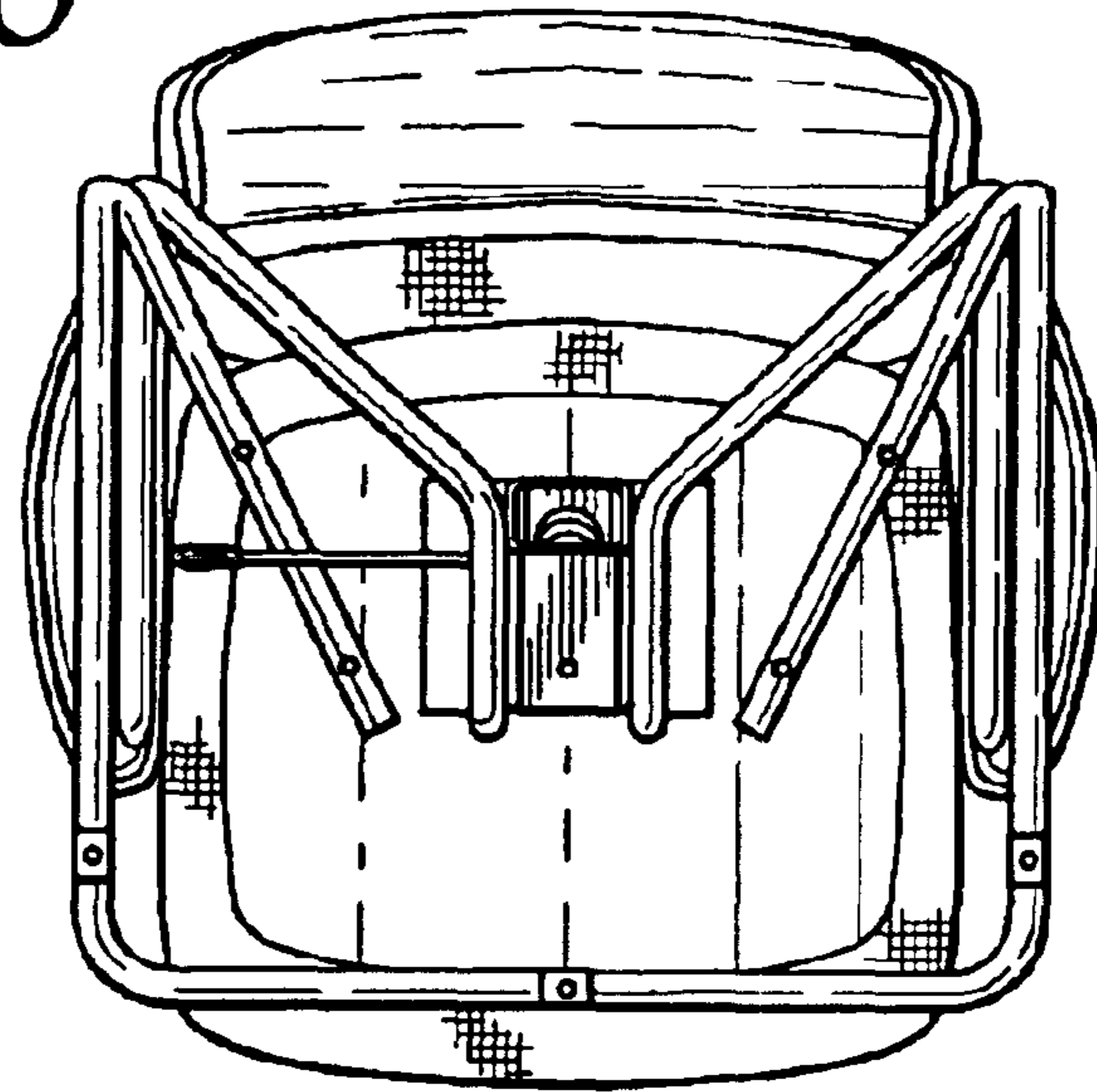
