The ornamental design for a necklace portion, as shown and described.

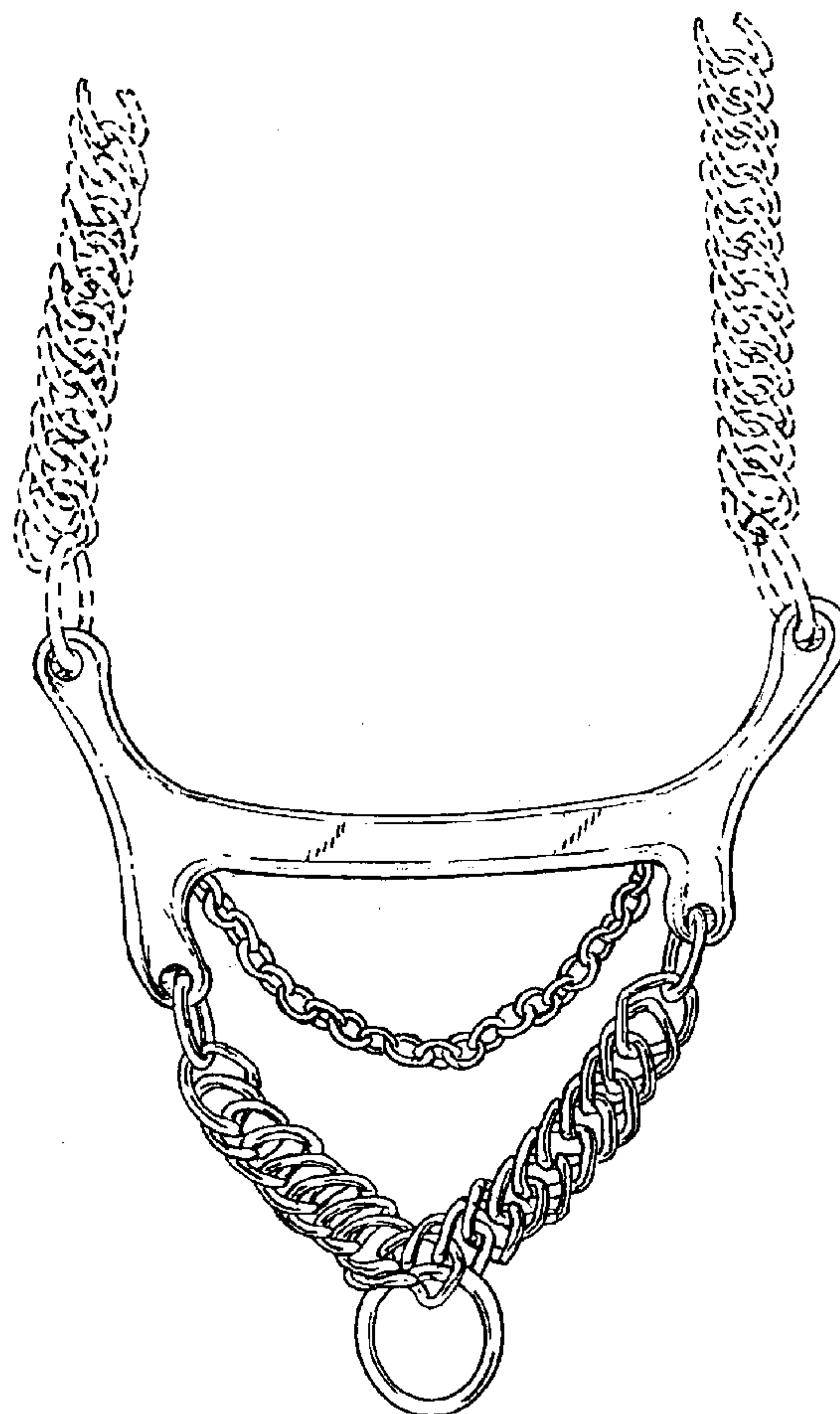
DESCRIPTION

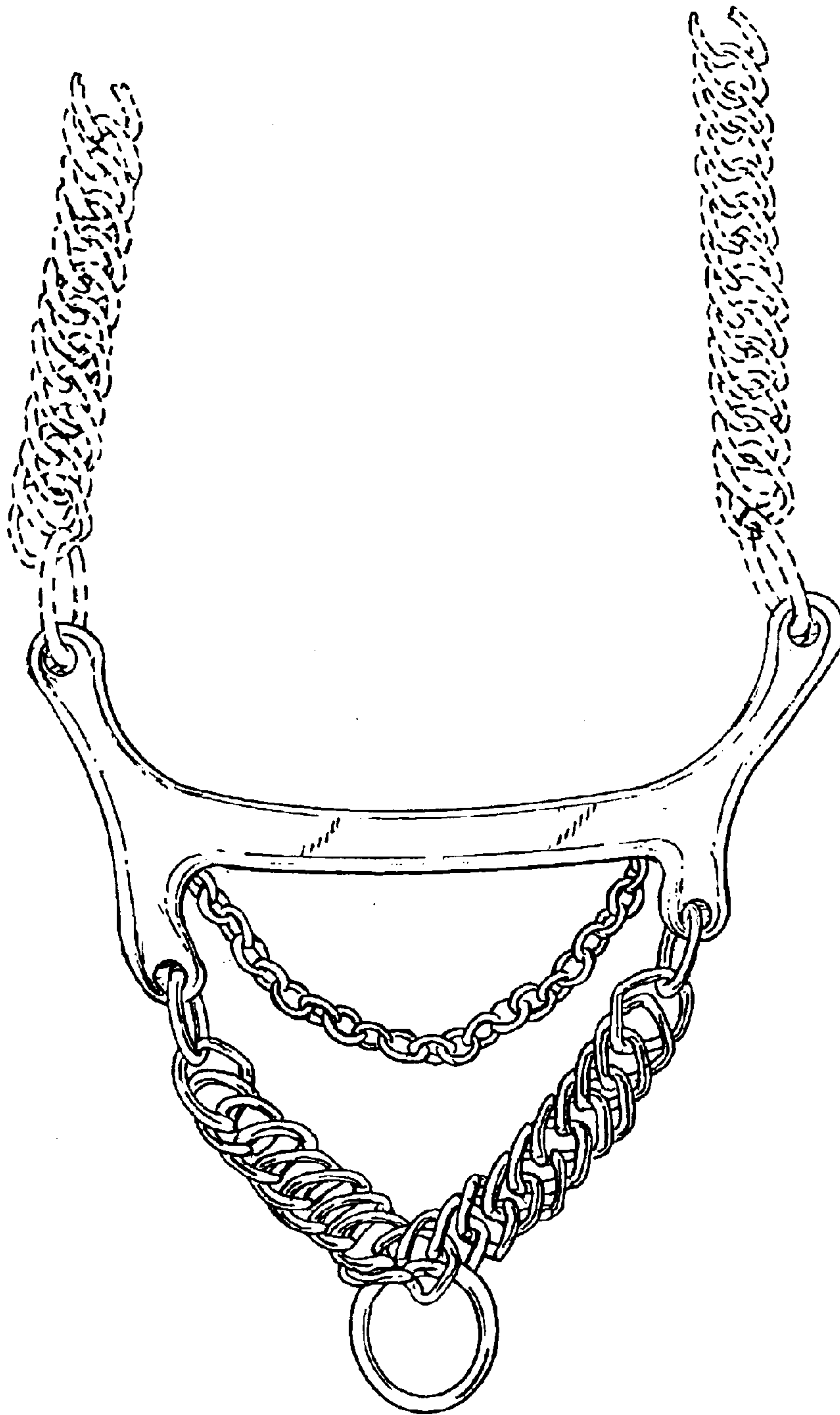
