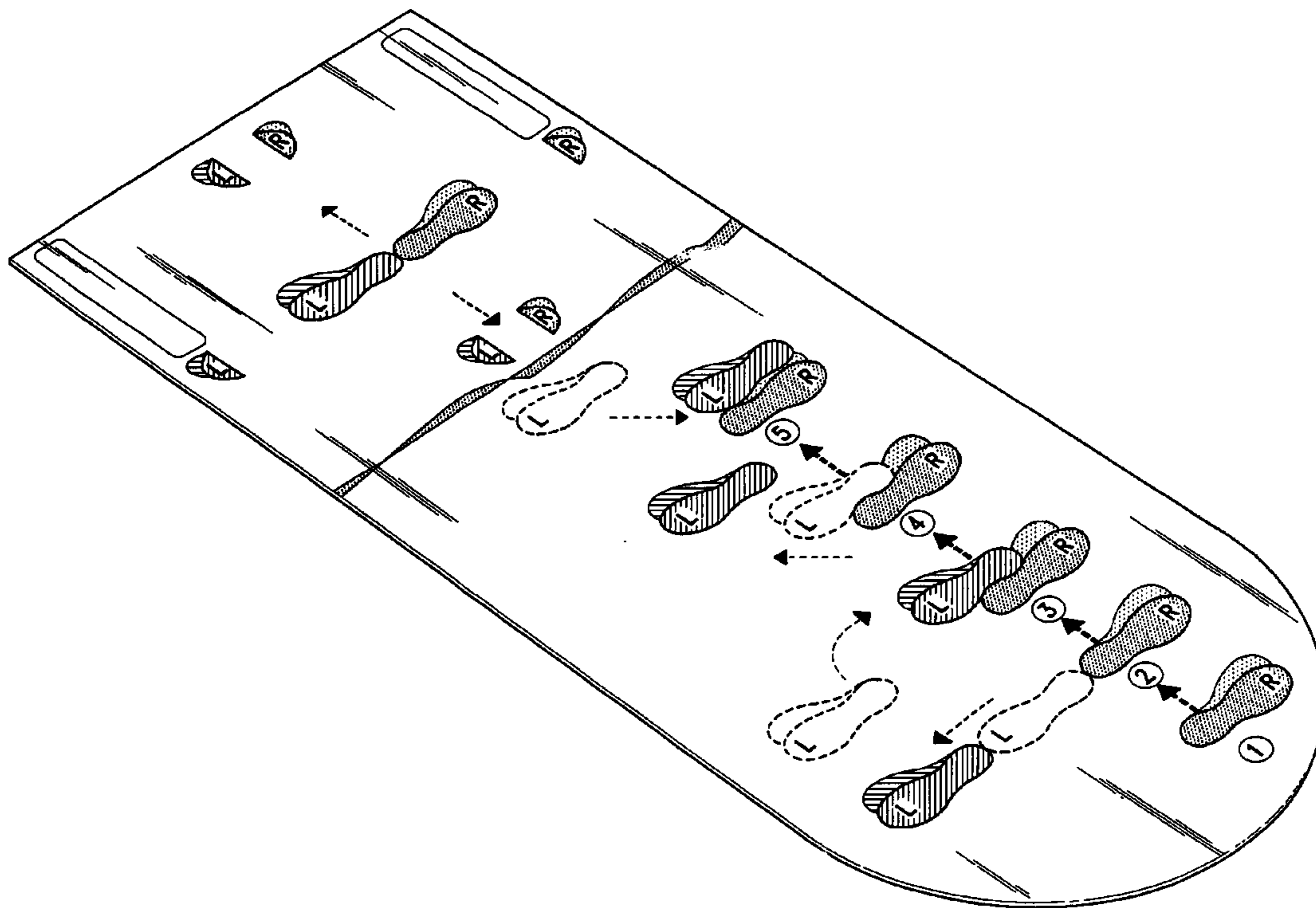
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ballet training mat showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

The broken lines outlining shoeprints and the broken lines with directional arrows are understood to be part of the surface pattern of the ballet training mat.

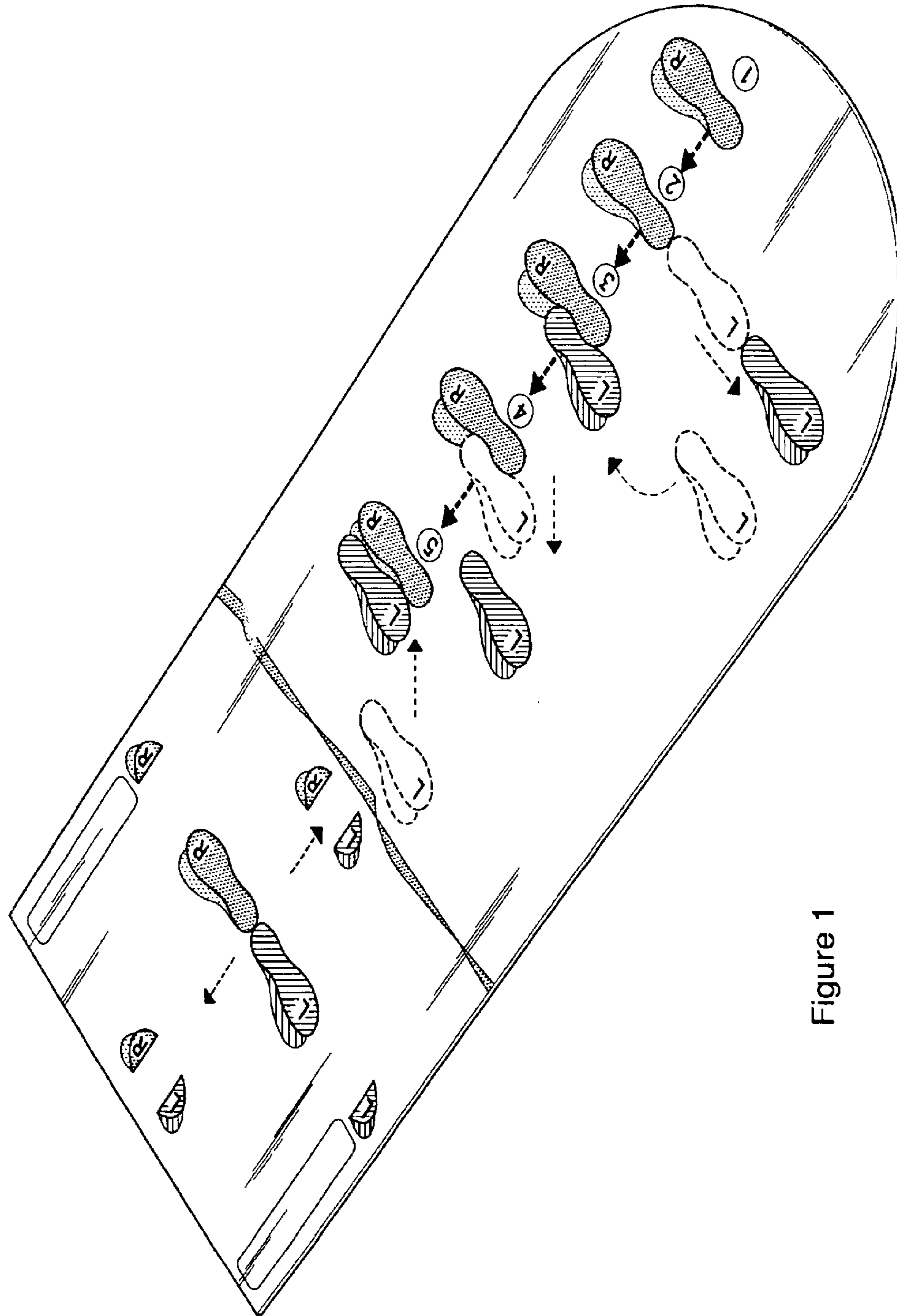

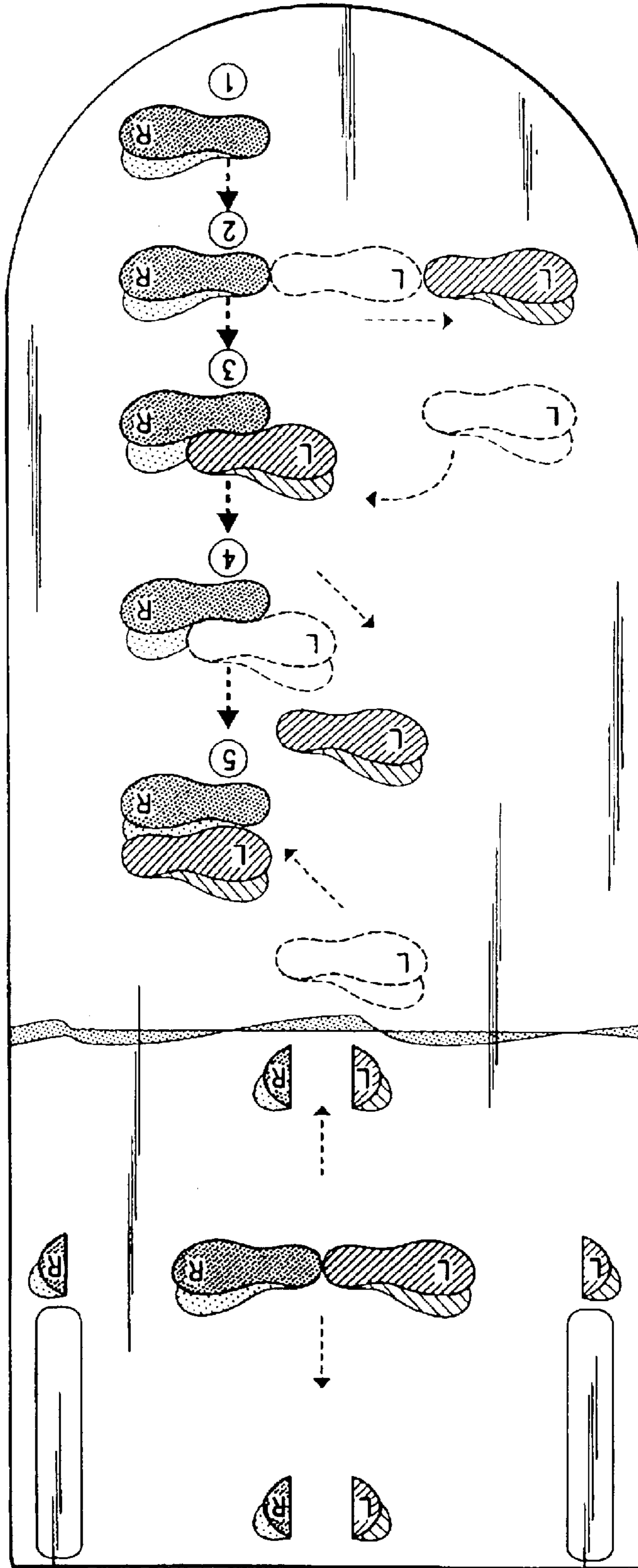
