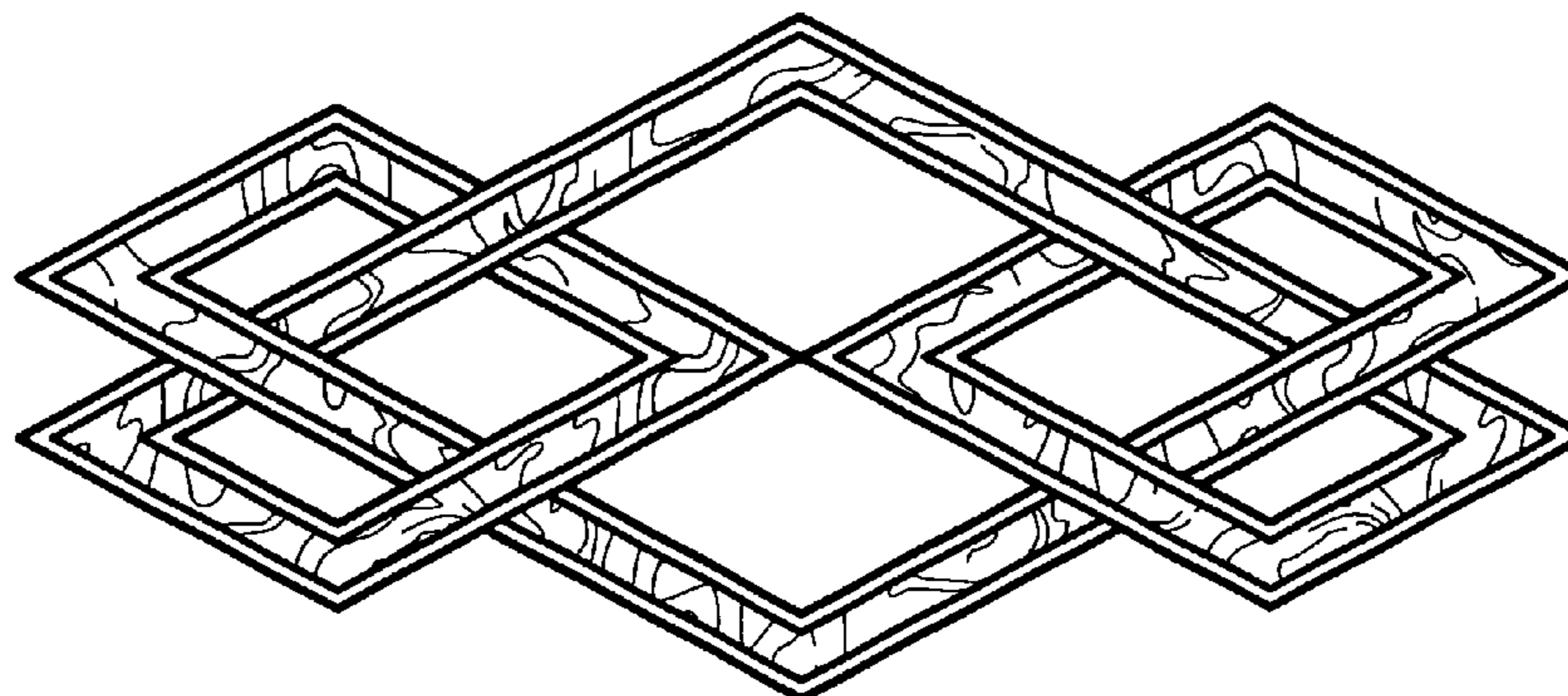
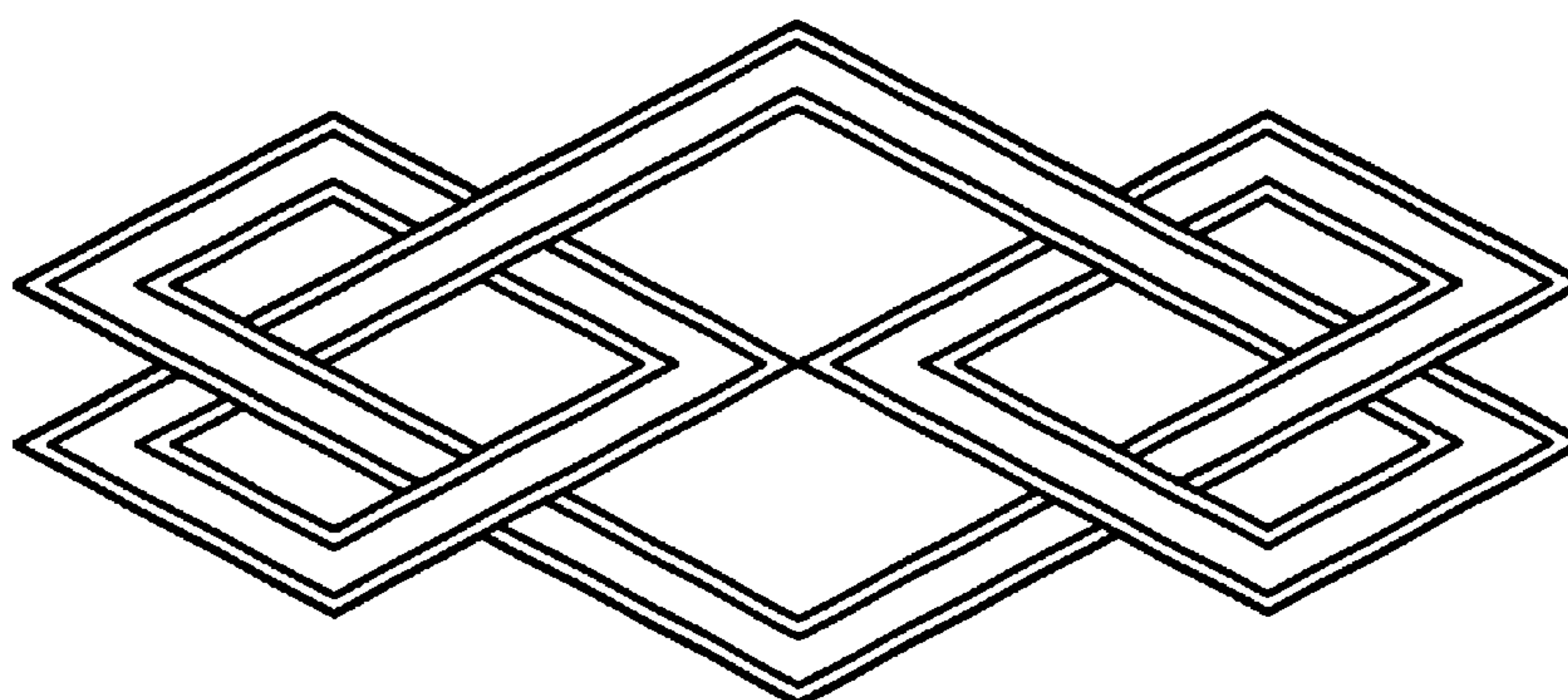
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for surface ornamentation for caskets, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the first embodiment of surface ornamentation for caskets showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a second embodiment thereof. The depicted contrast in shading represents a contrast in appearance via color, texture, material and/or luminance.

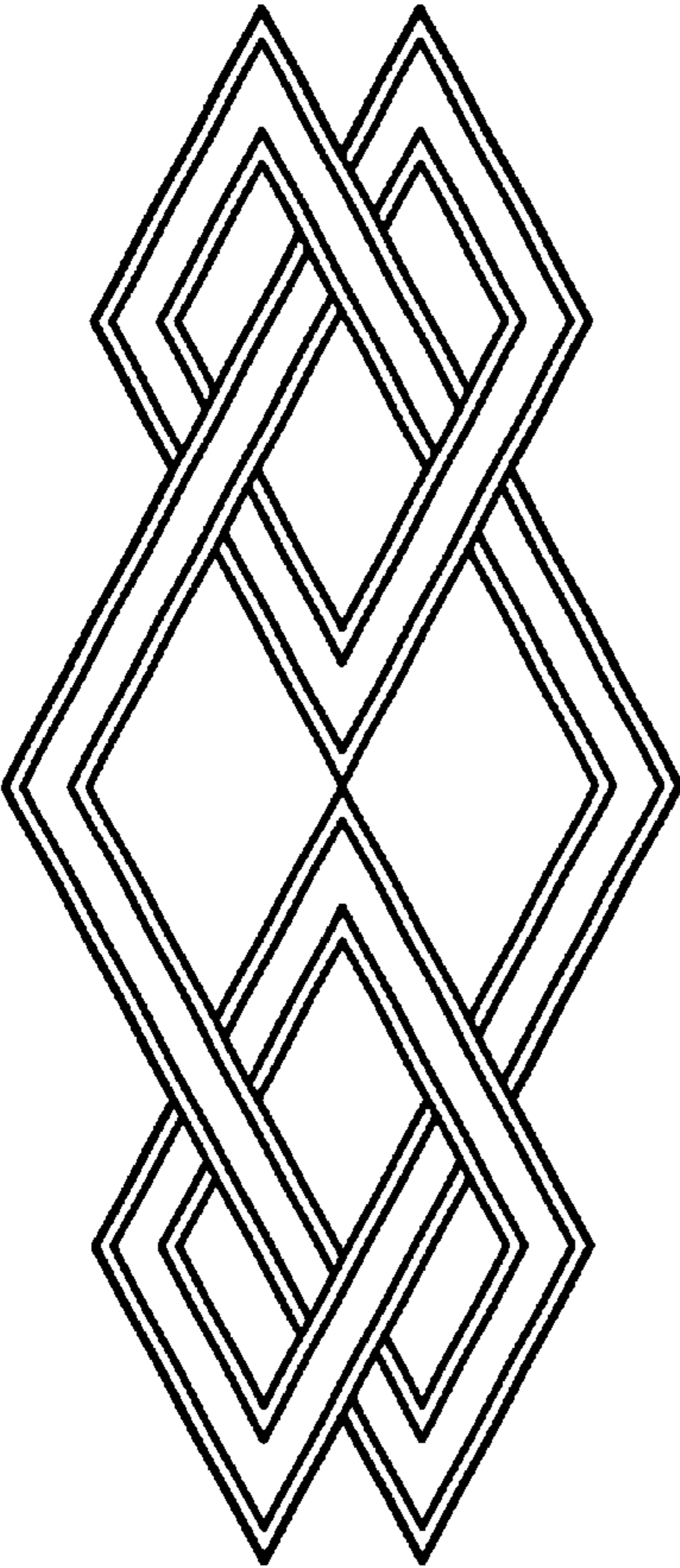

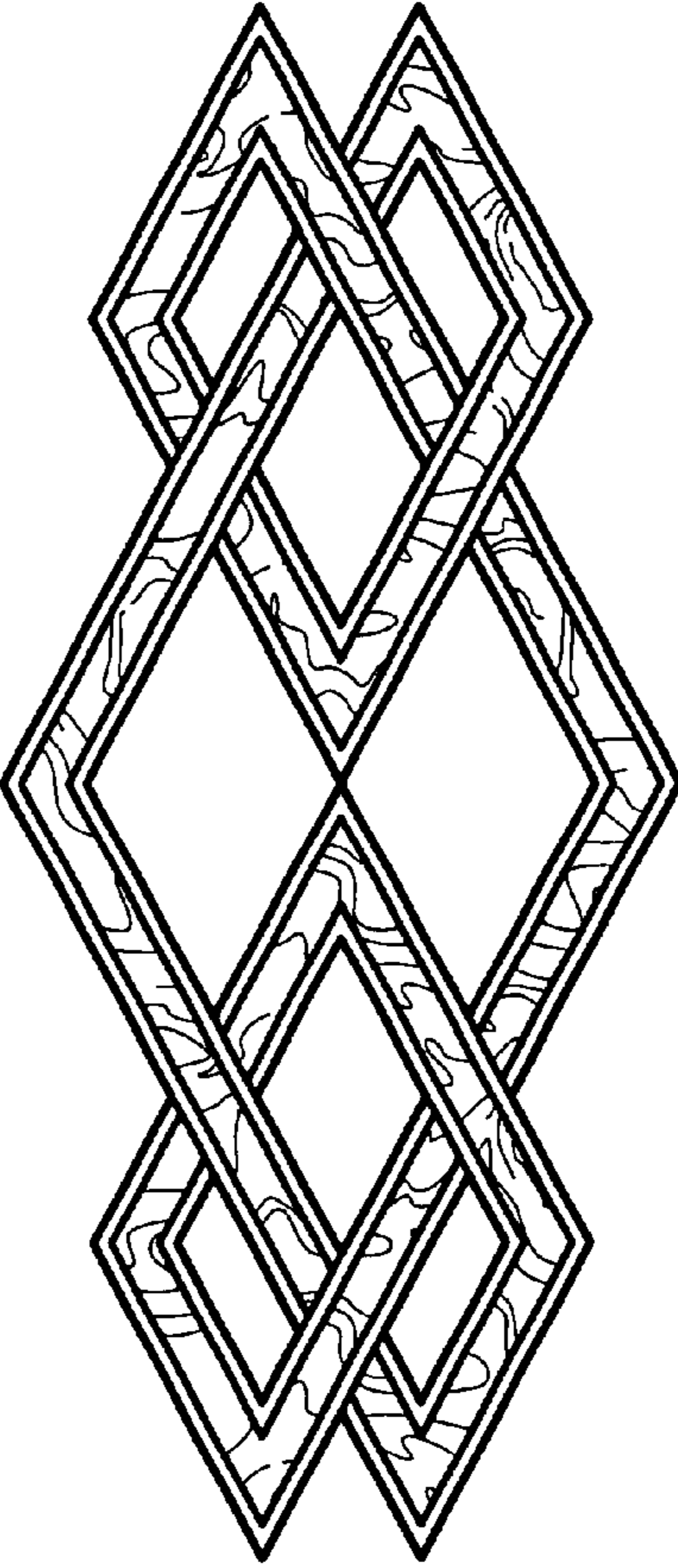
