DESCRIPTION

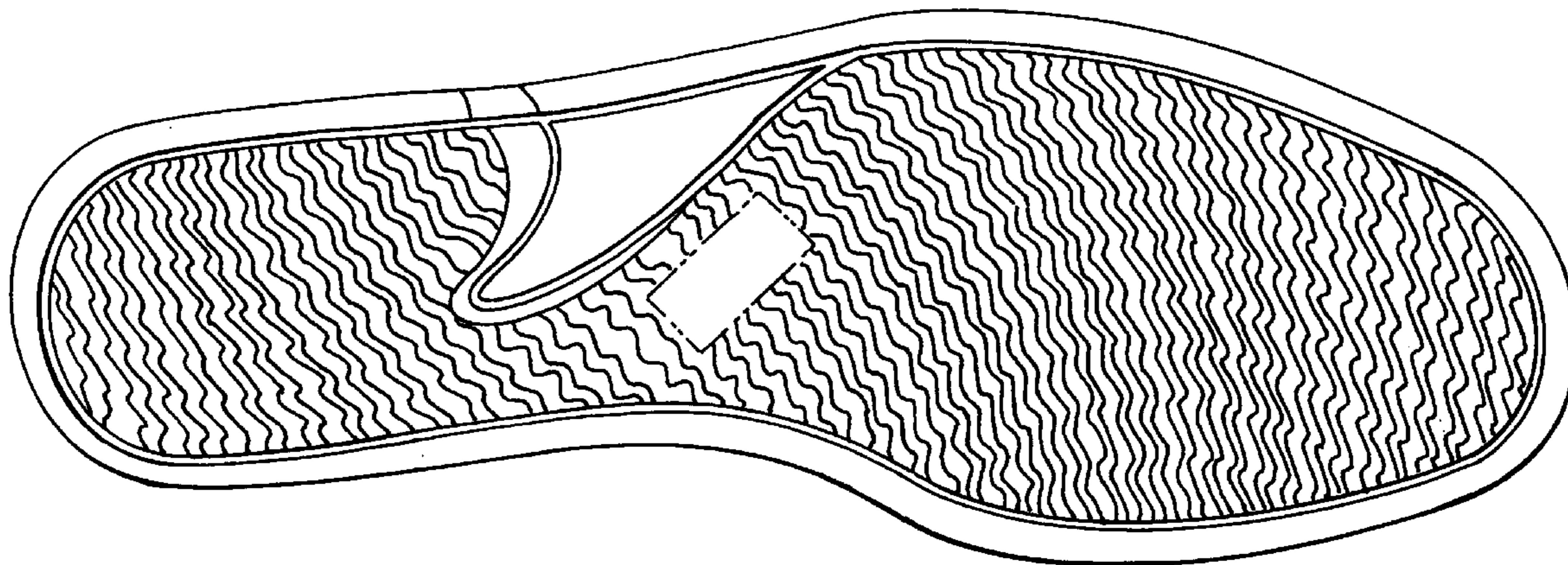

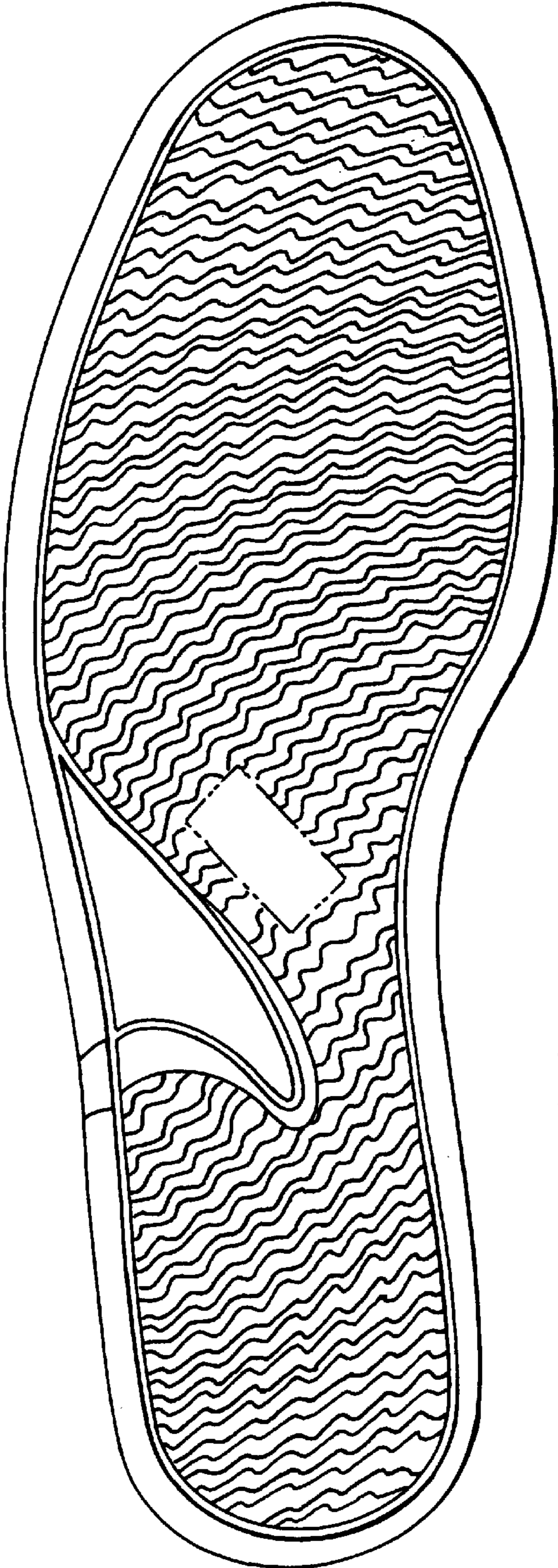
