(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a dual compartment holder for eyeglasses and contact lens case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the dual compartment holder for eyeglasses and contact lens case showing my new design.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

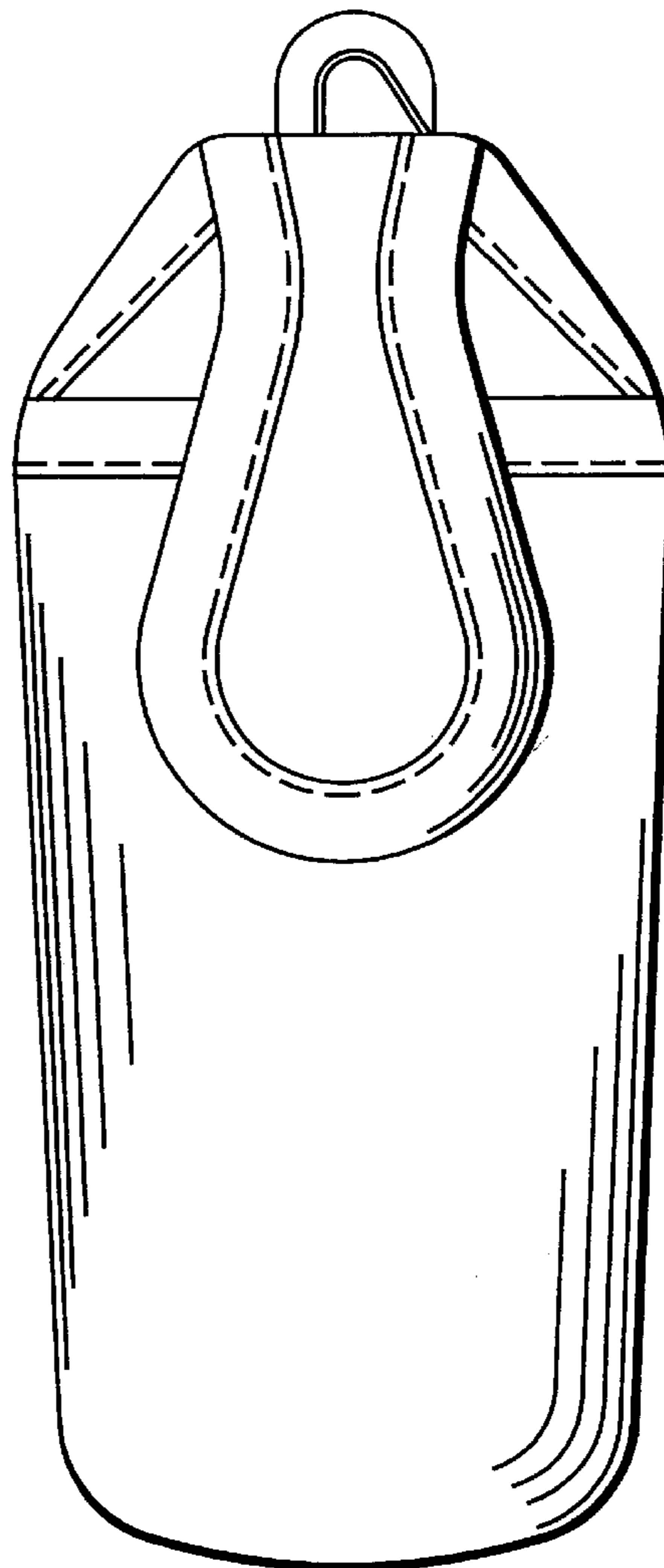
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

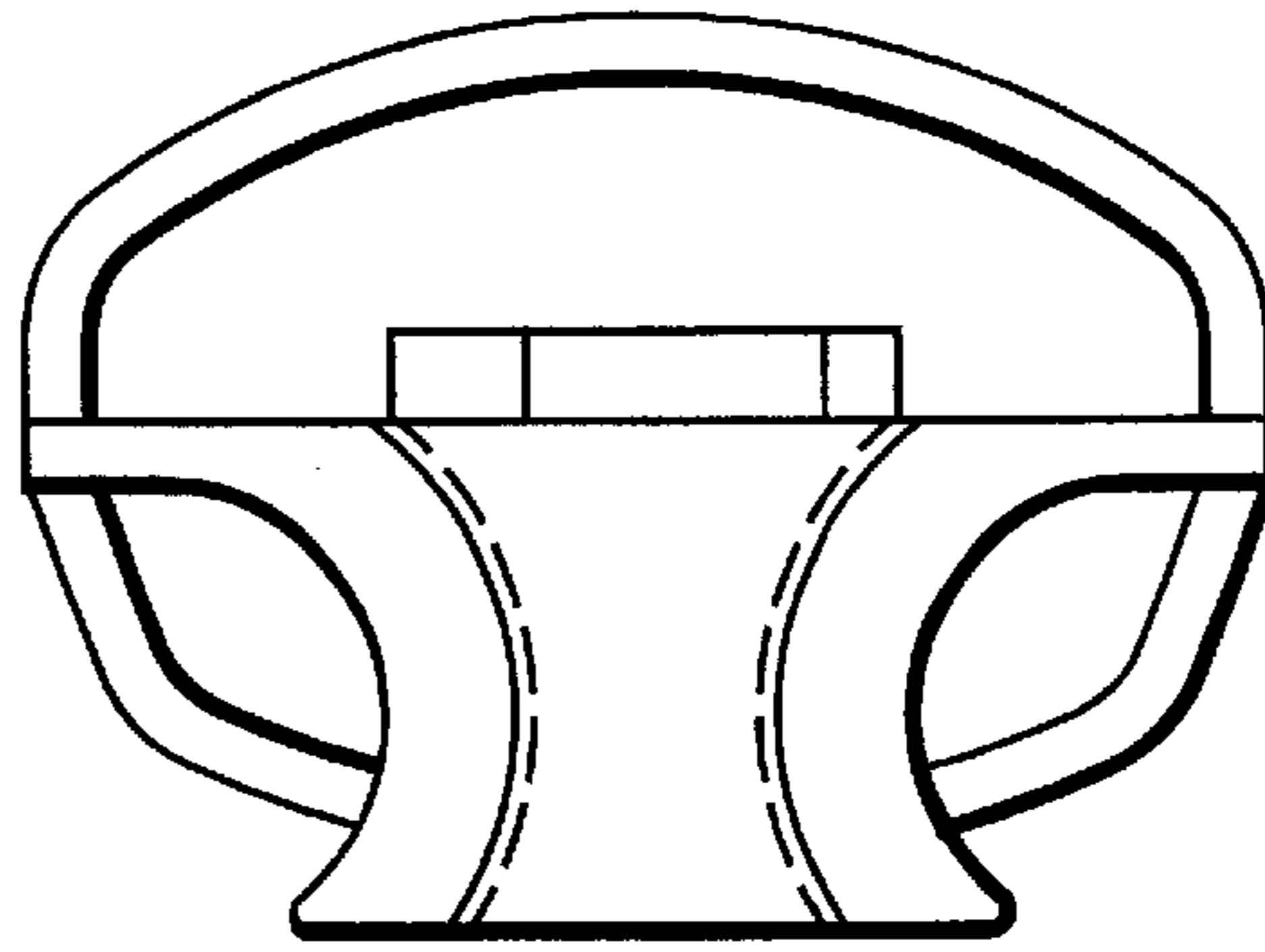

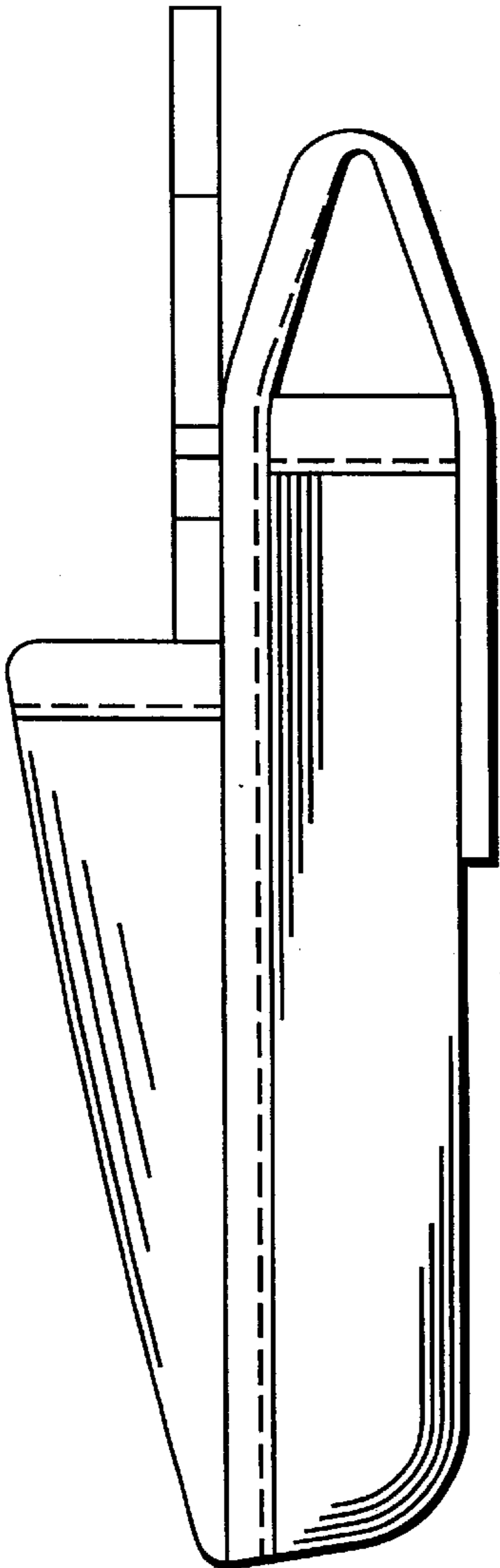

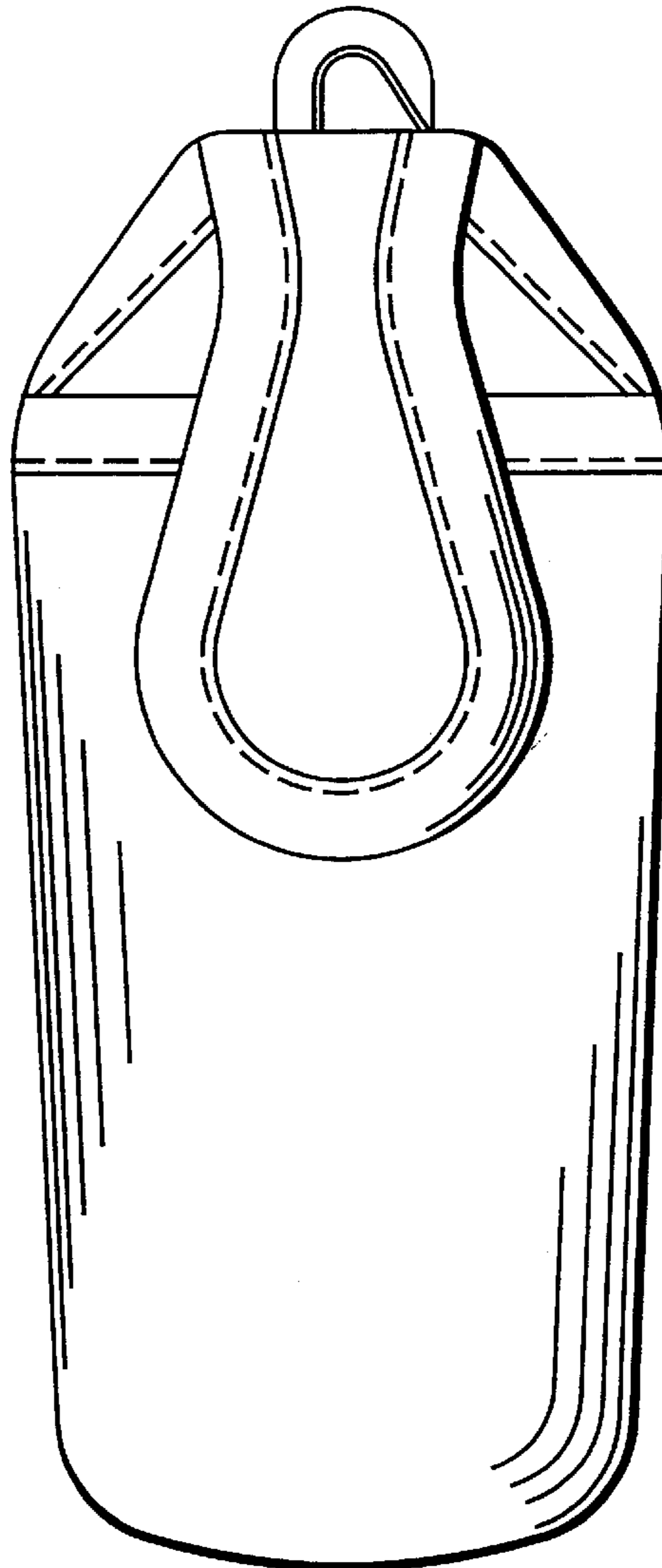

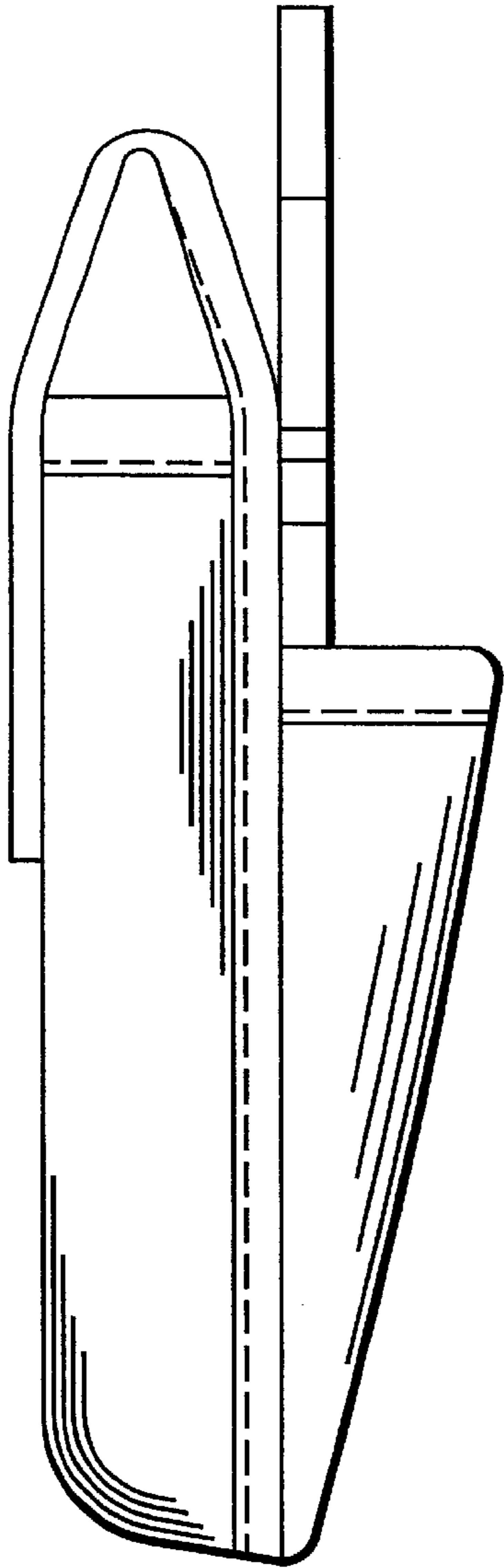

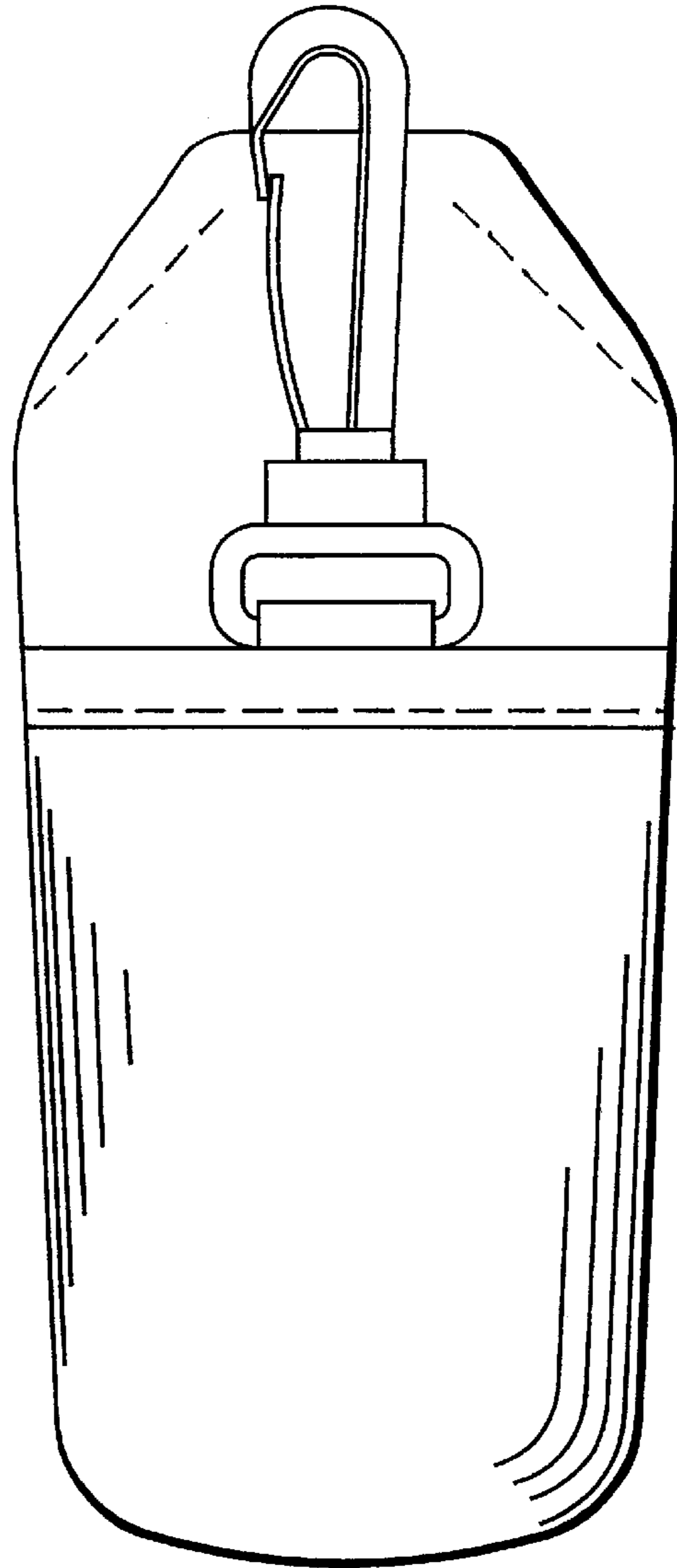

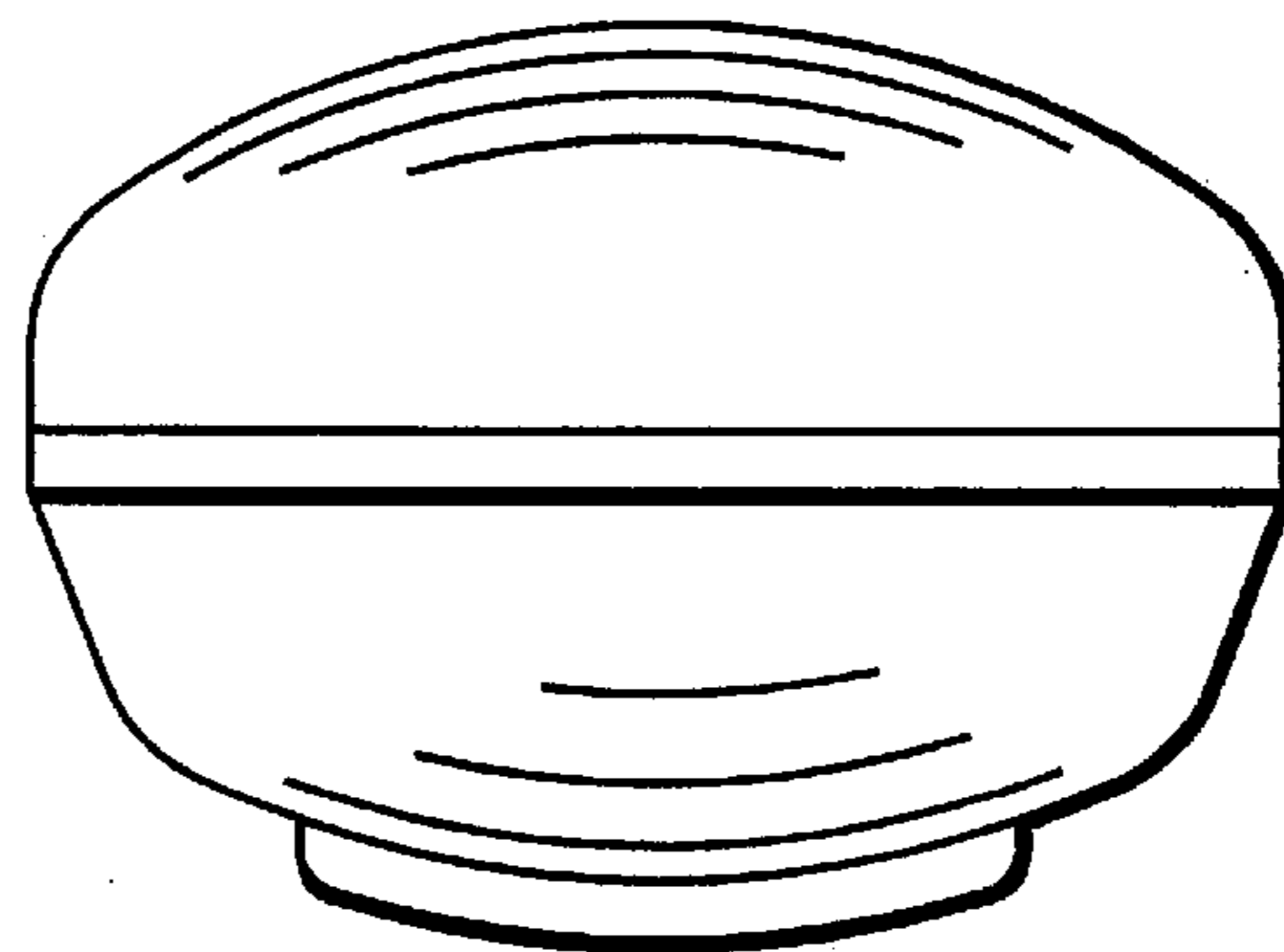

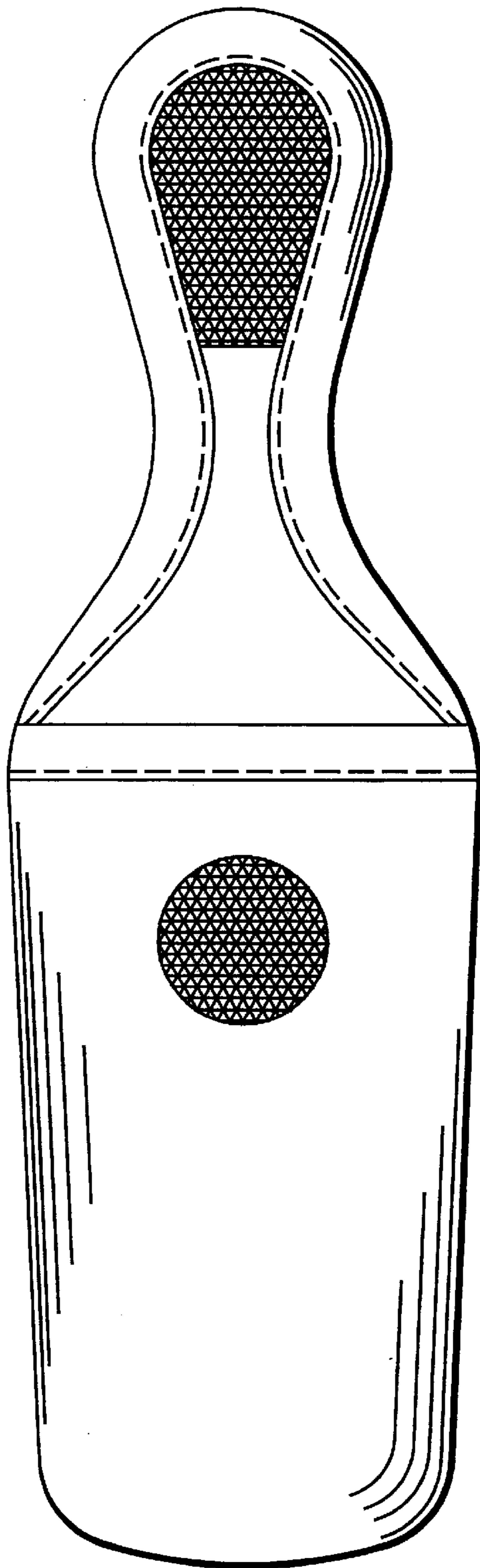
