DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a paint roller bracket in full lines with a paint roller shown in broken lines representing environmental association matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed invention.

FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view of the paint roller bracket.

FIG. 3 is a reduced rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a reduced left side elevational view thereof.

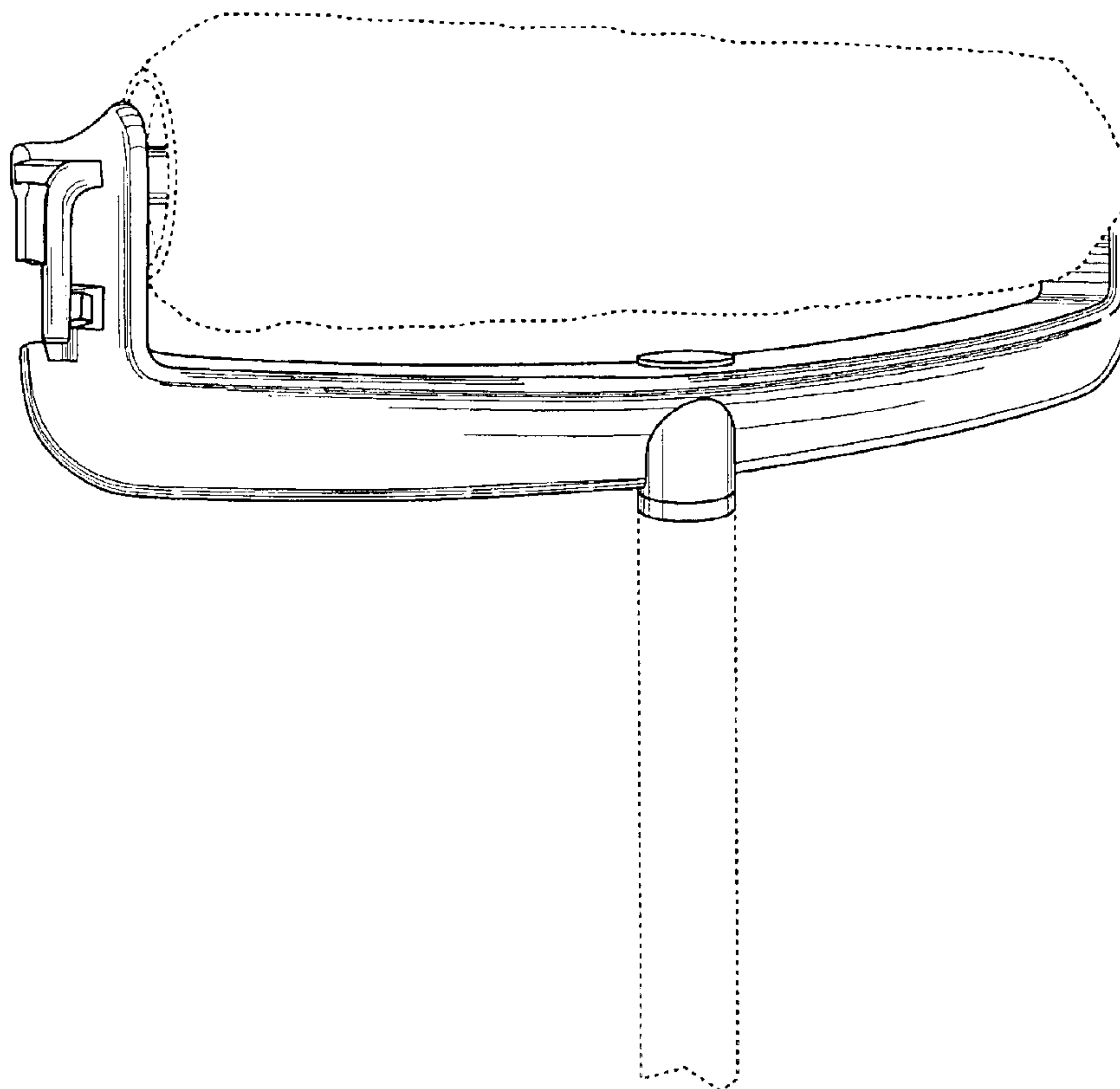
FIG. 5 is a reduced right side elevational view thereof.

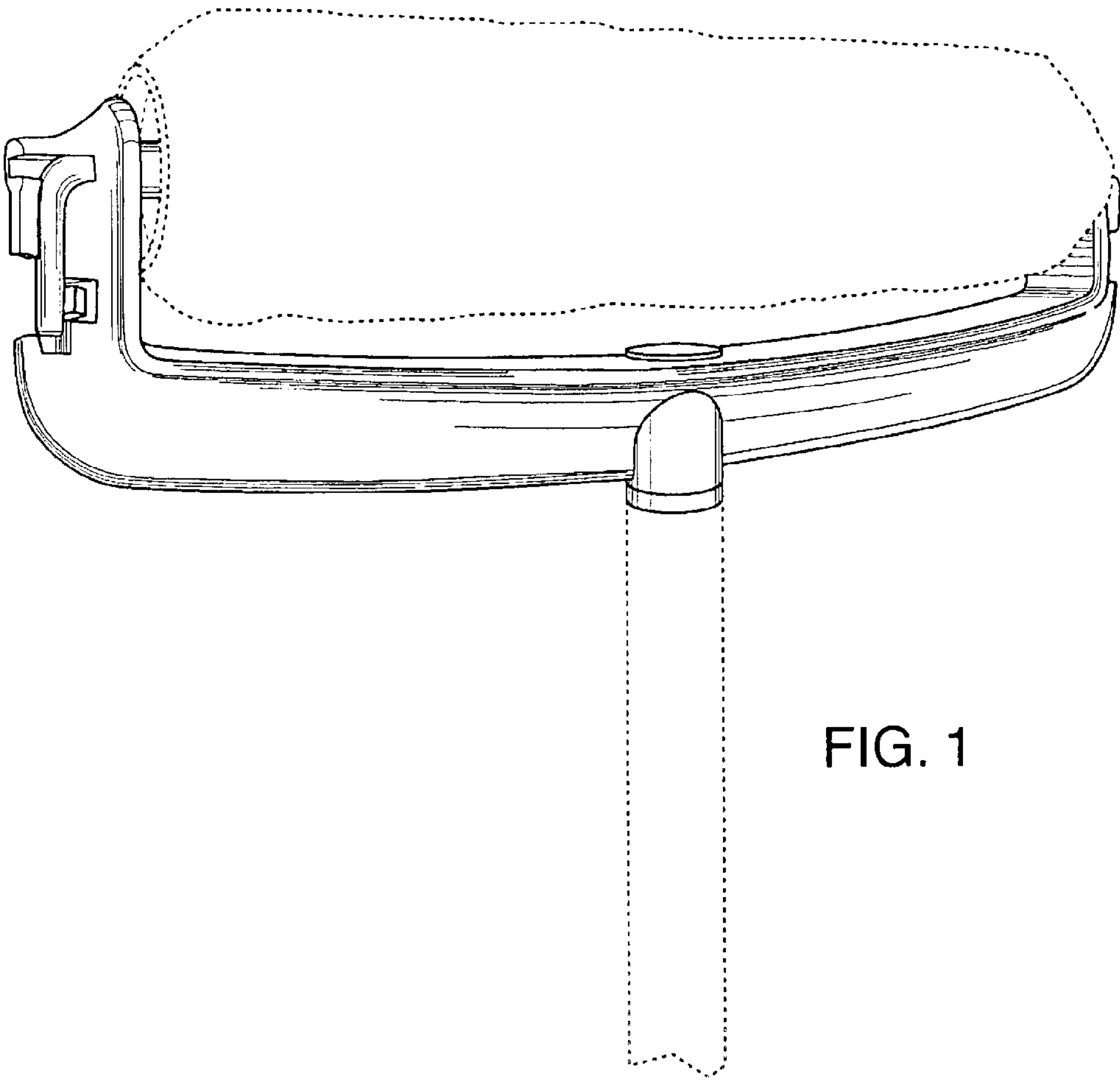

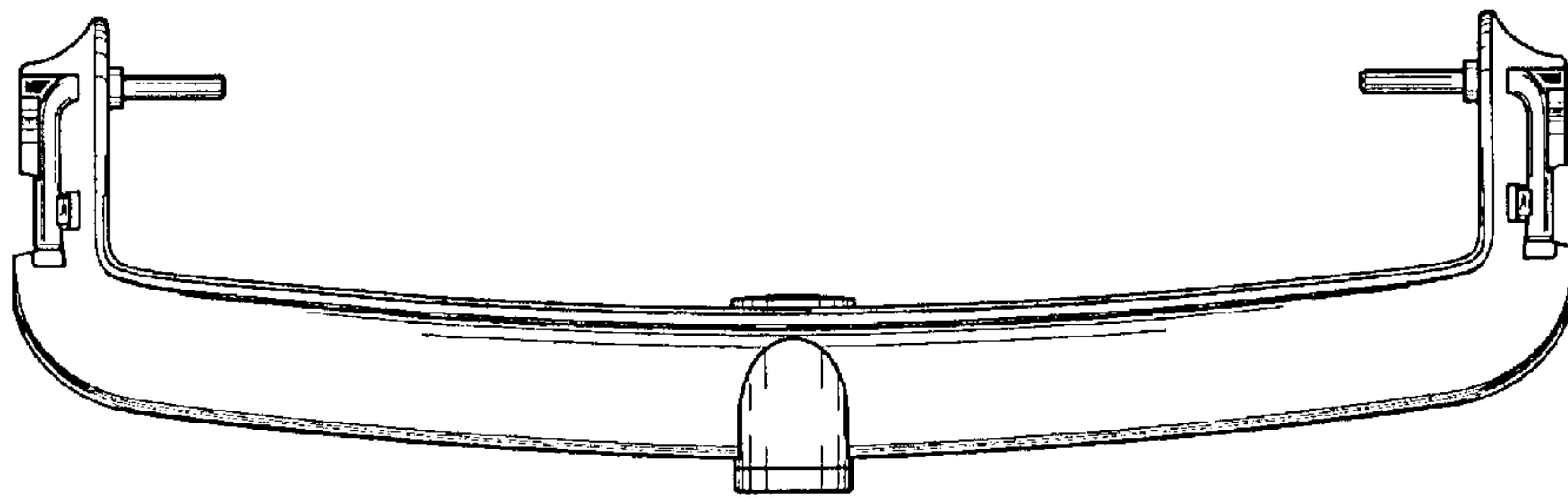

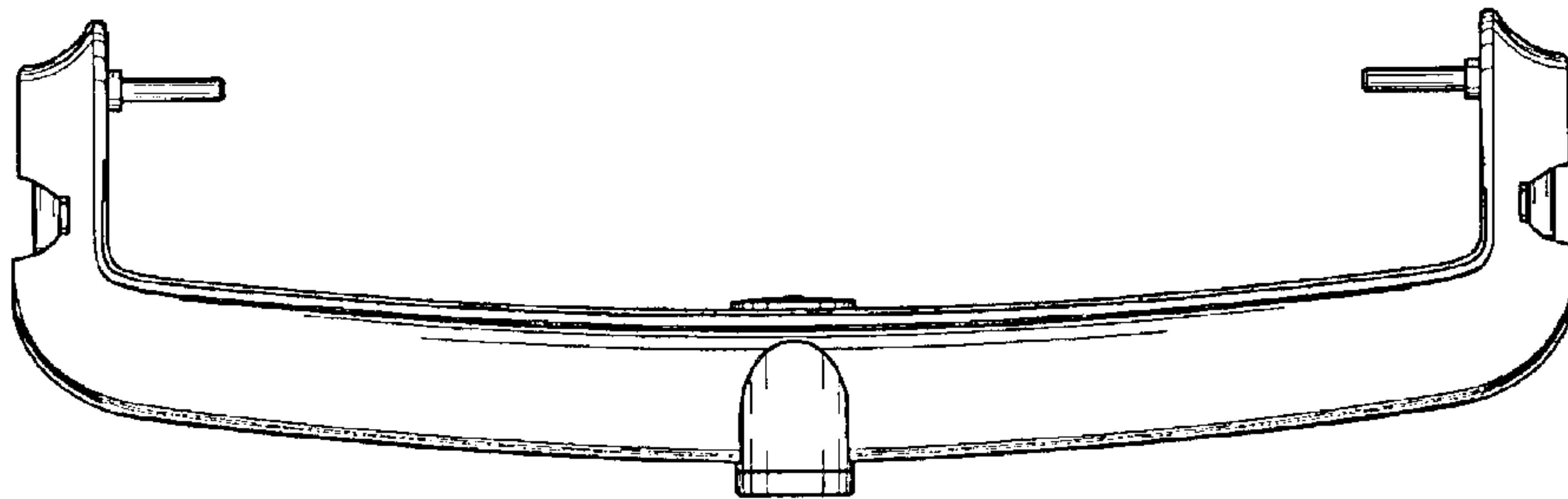

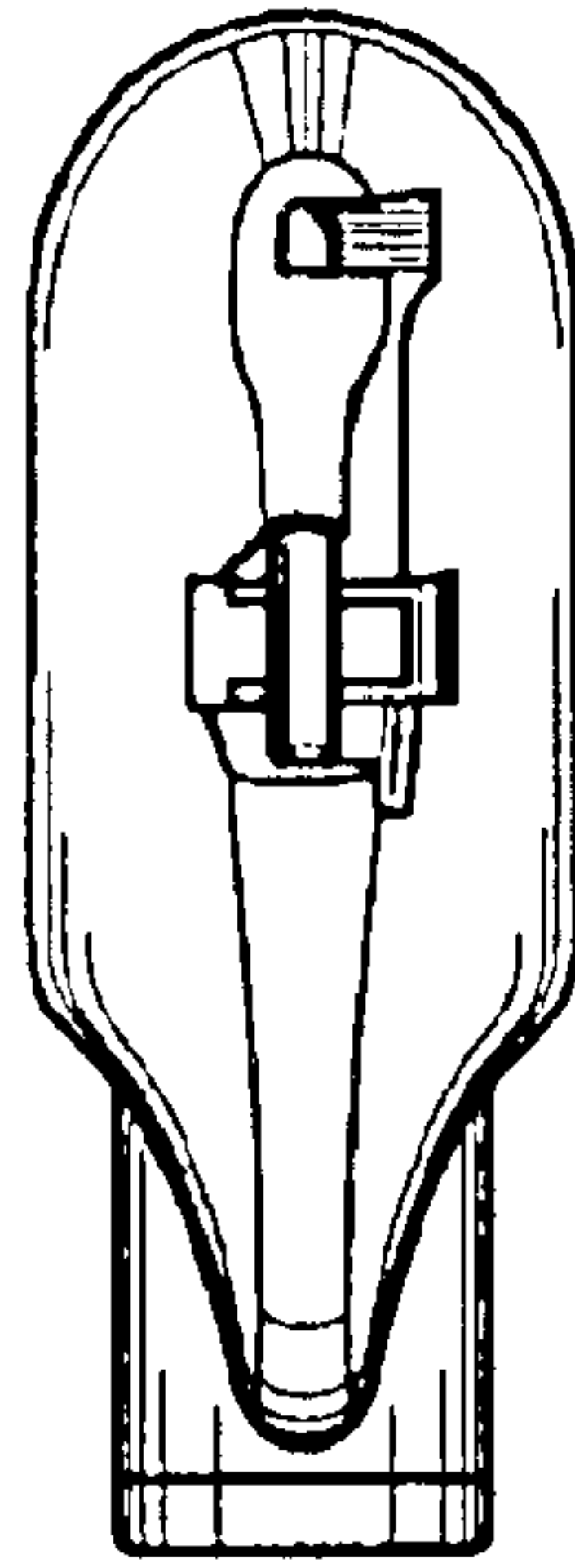

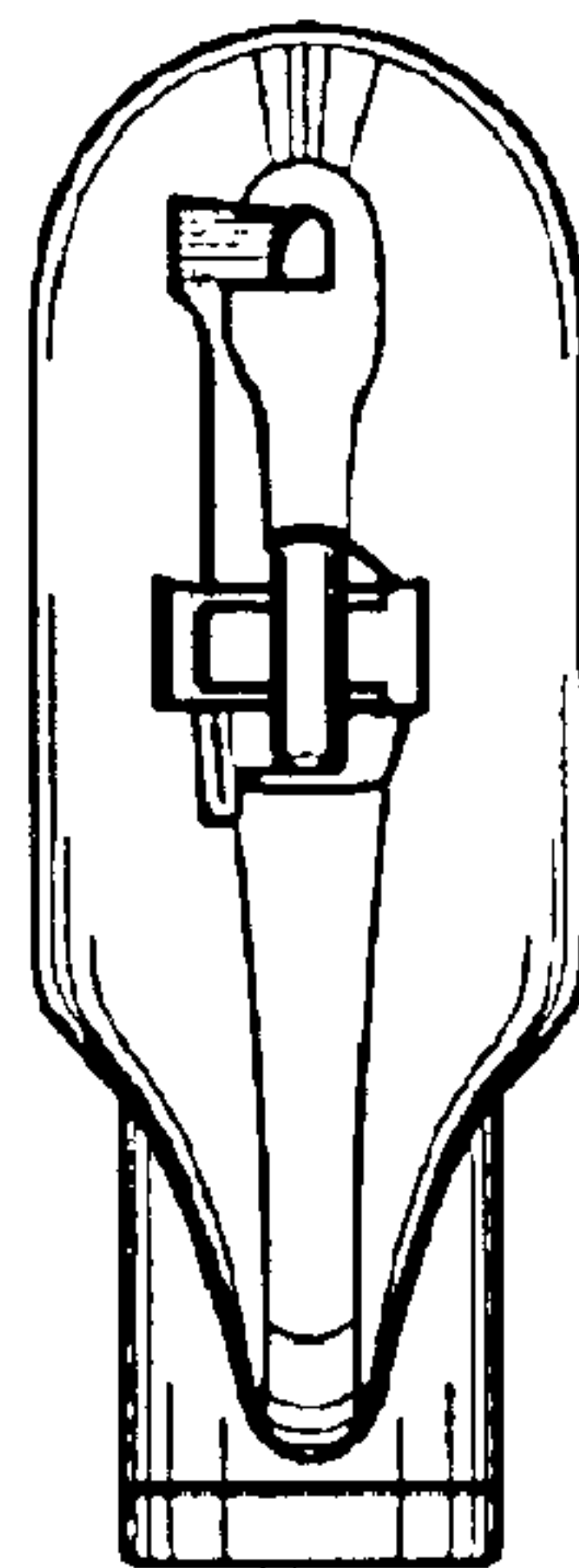

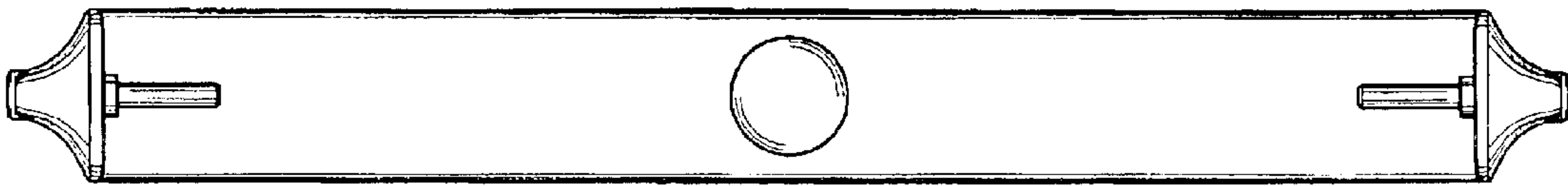

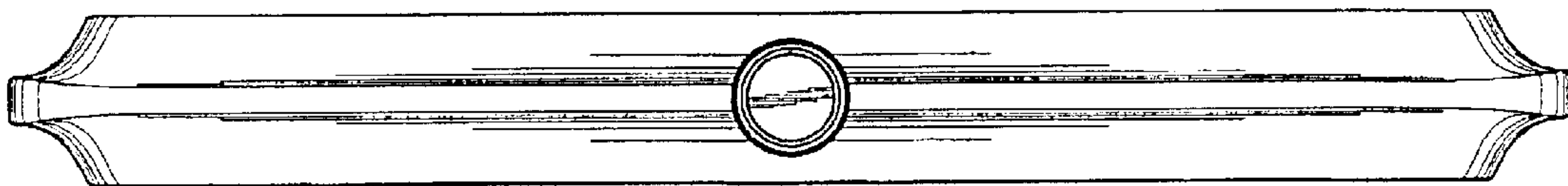

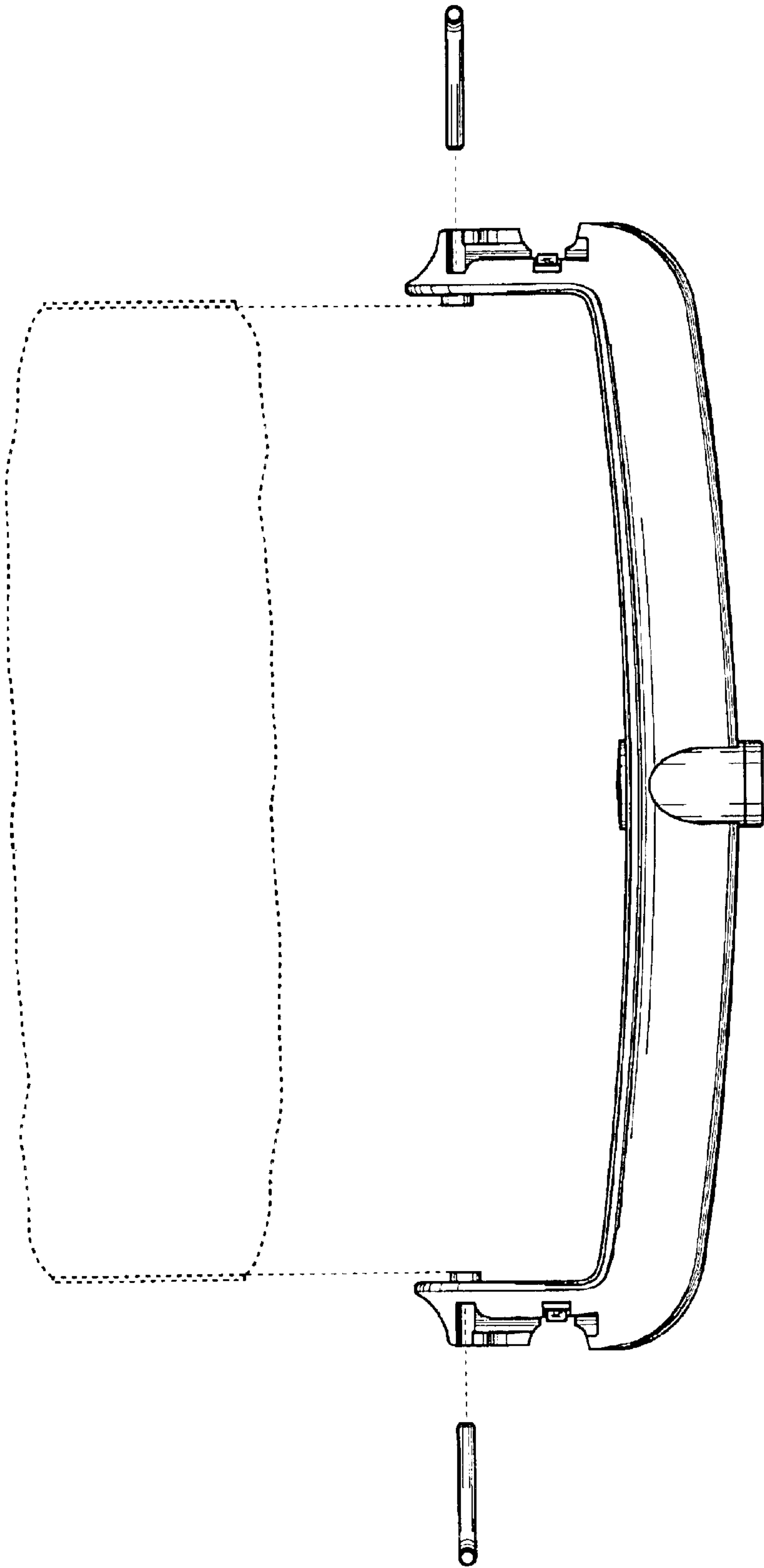
