DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cocktail shaker of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is front view of the cocktail shaker of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a back view of the cocktail shaker of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is a top view of the cocktail shaker of the present invention.

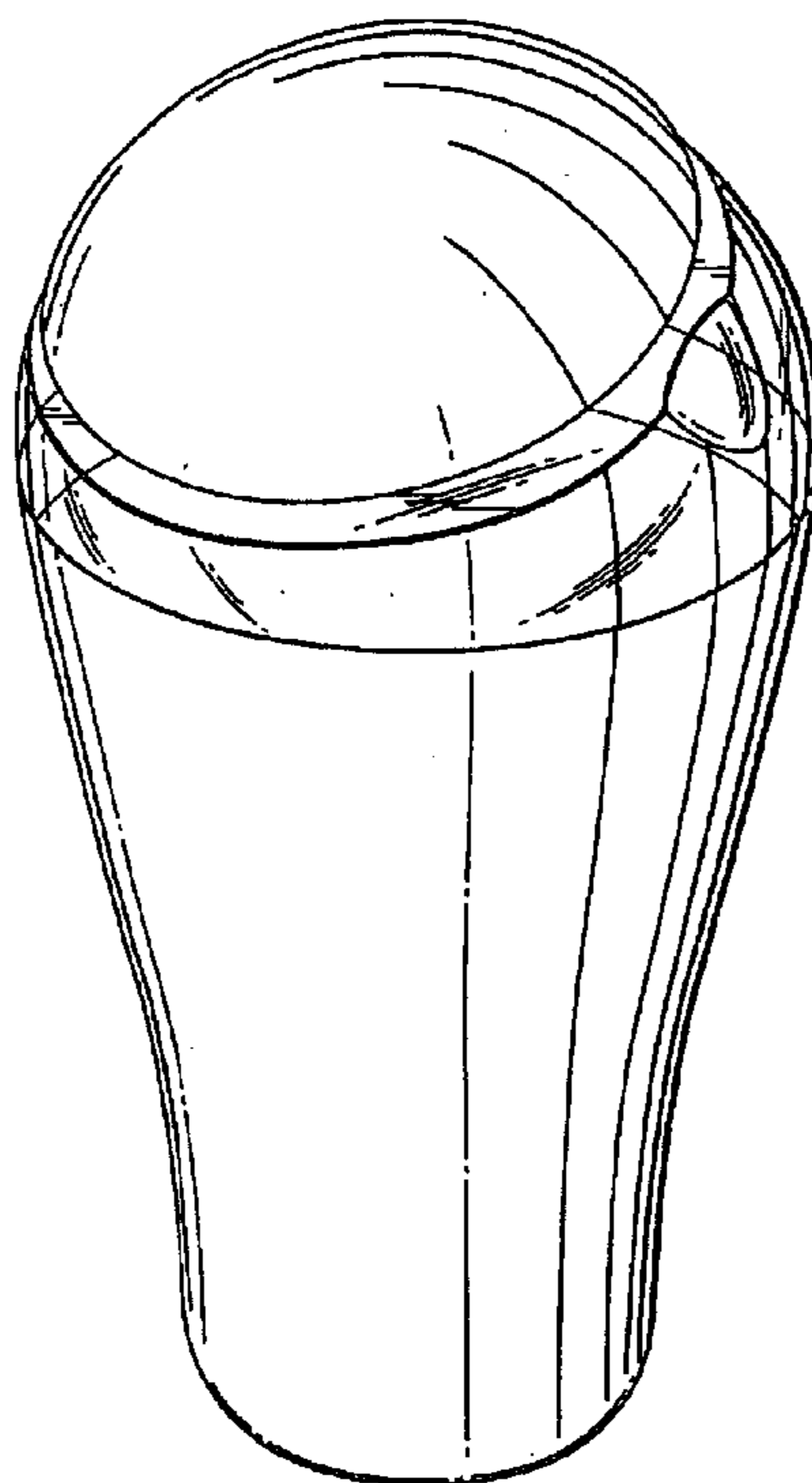
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the cocktail shaker of the present invention.

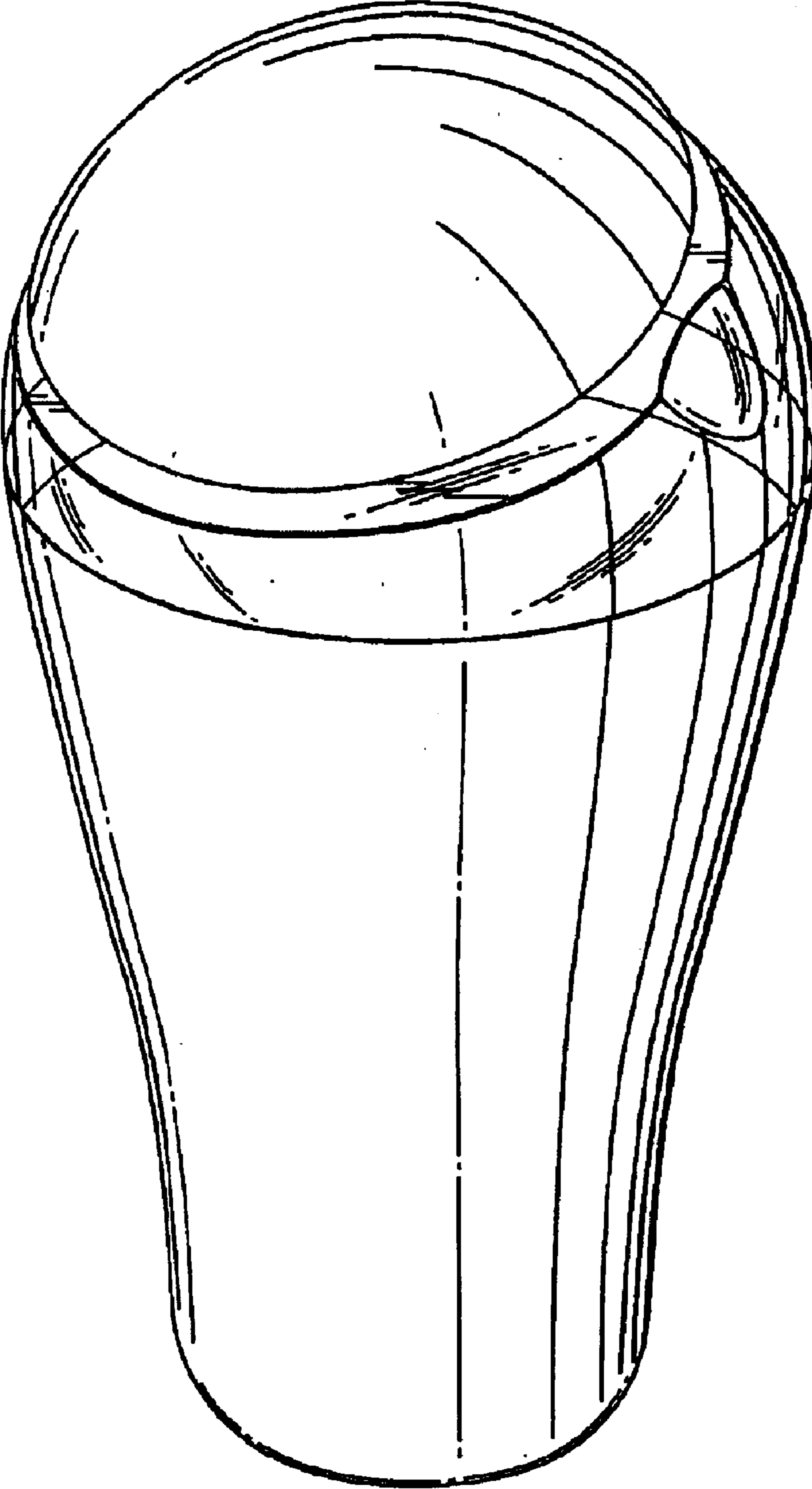

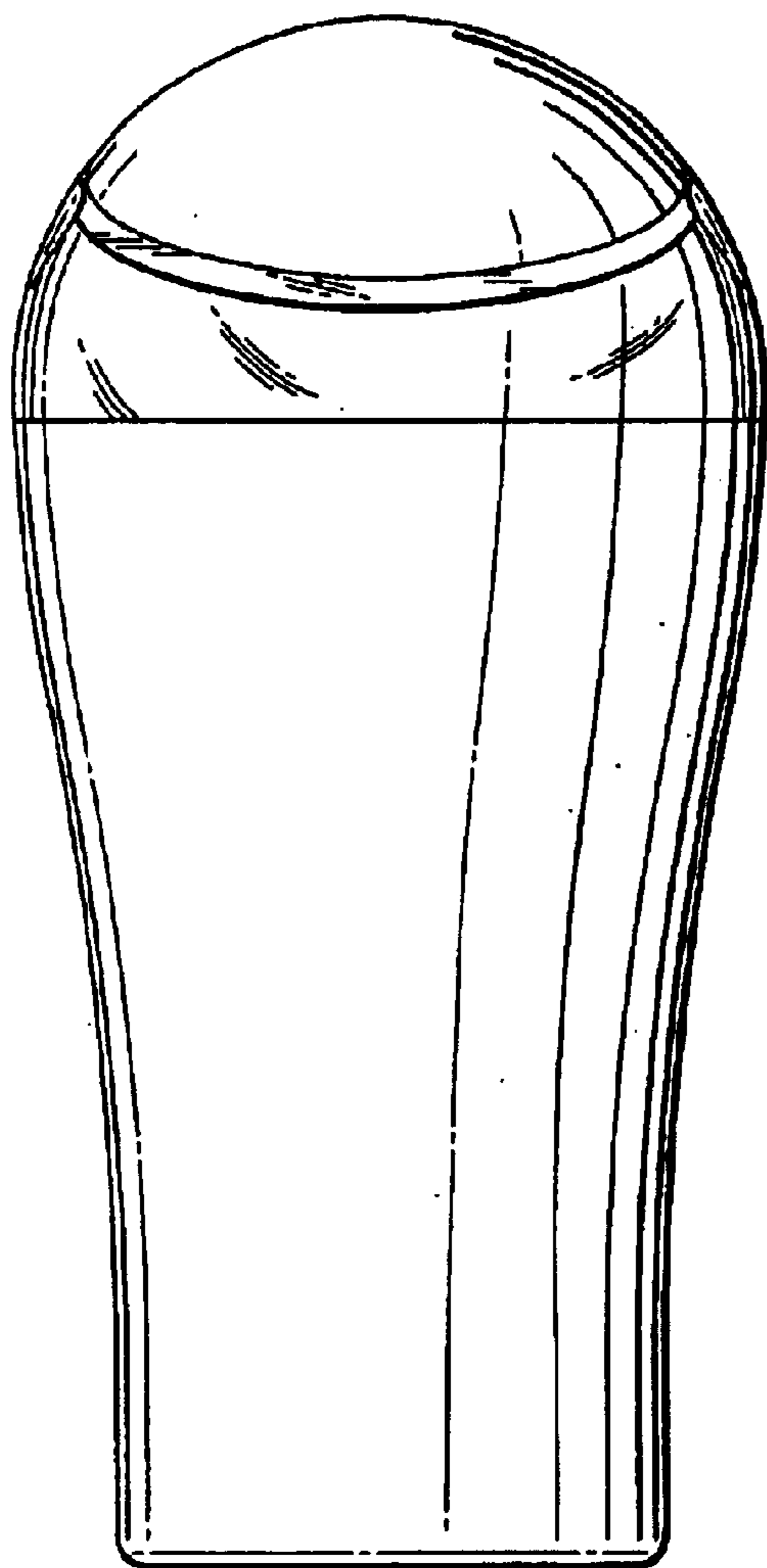

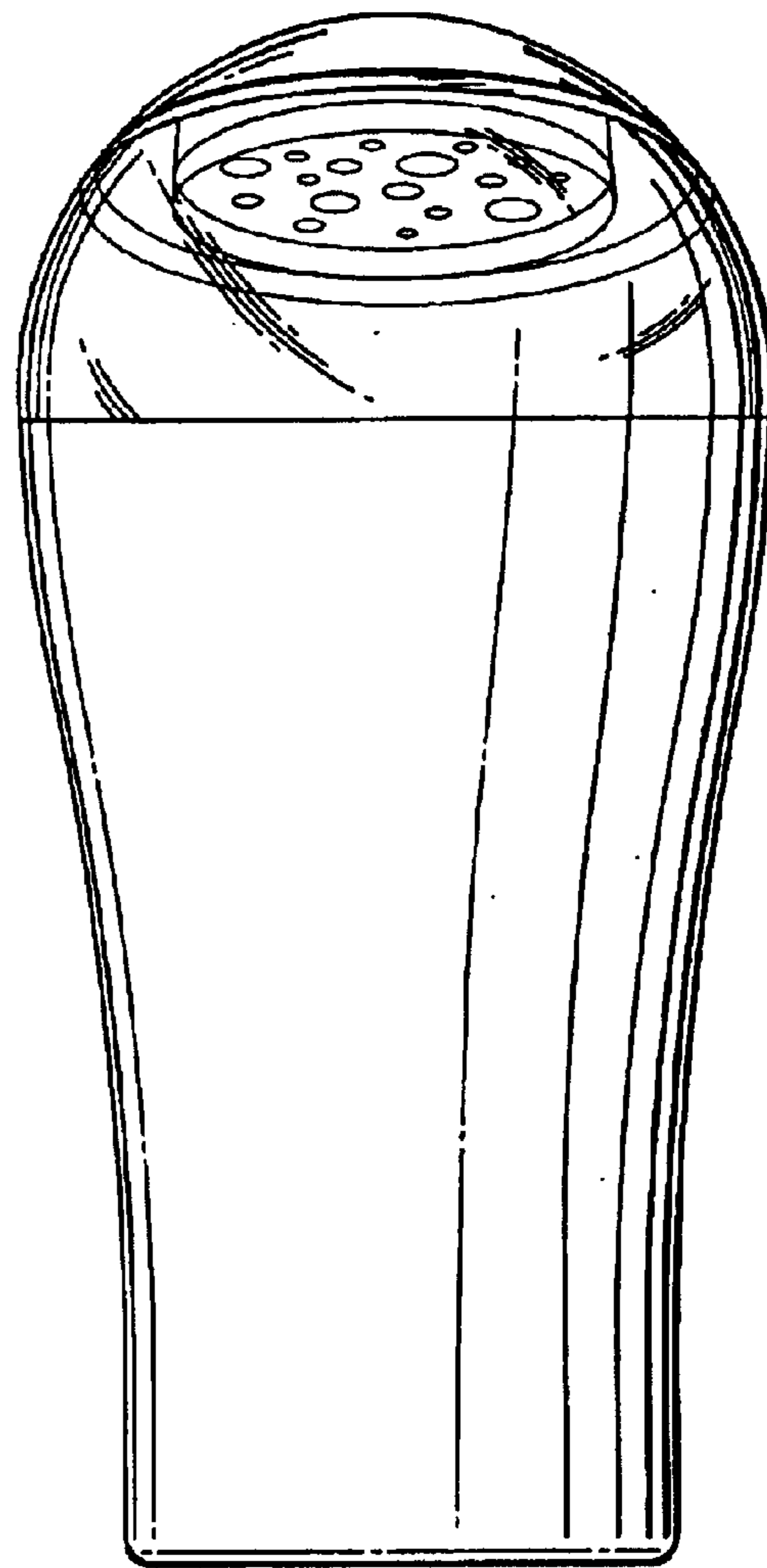

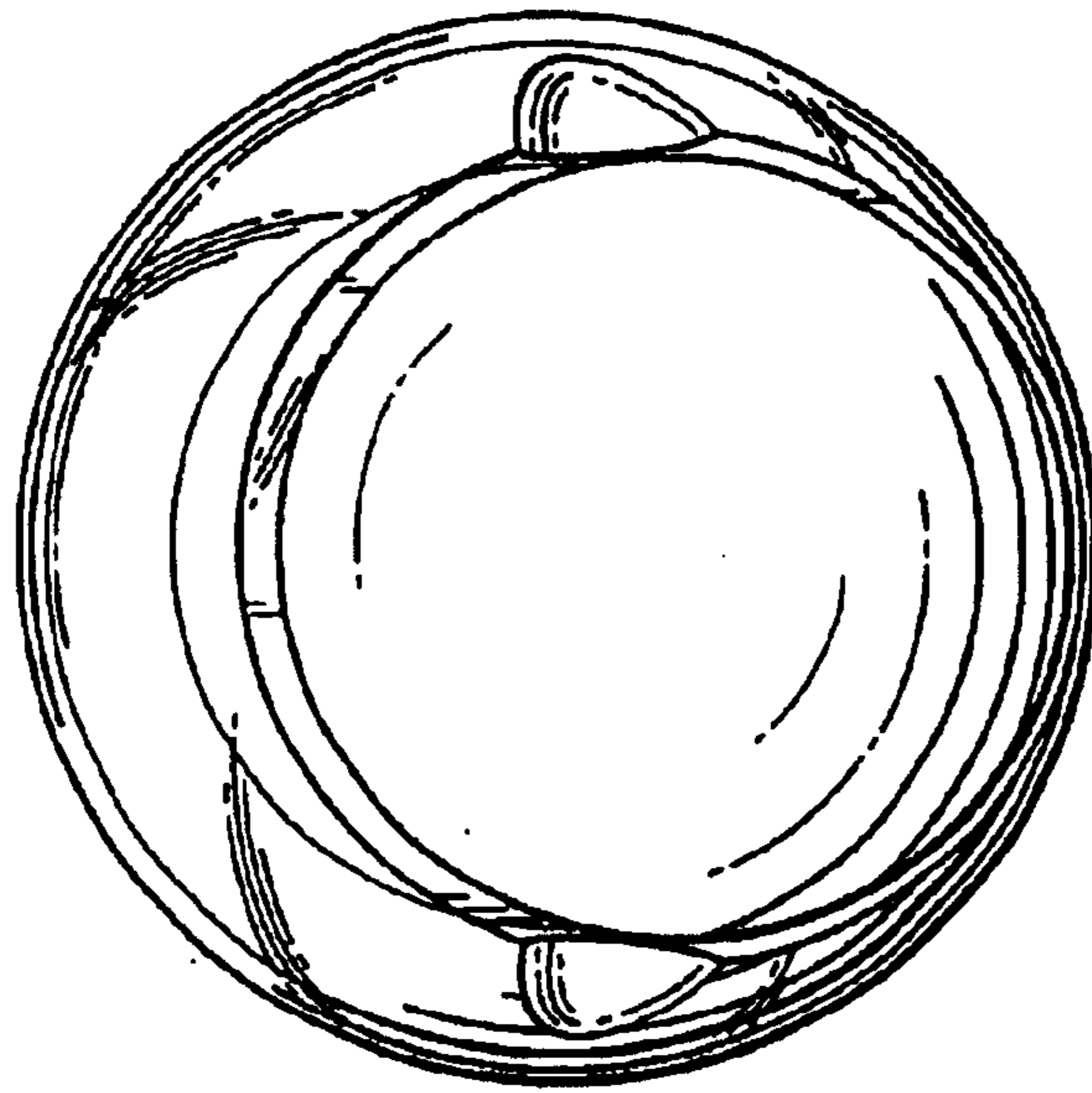

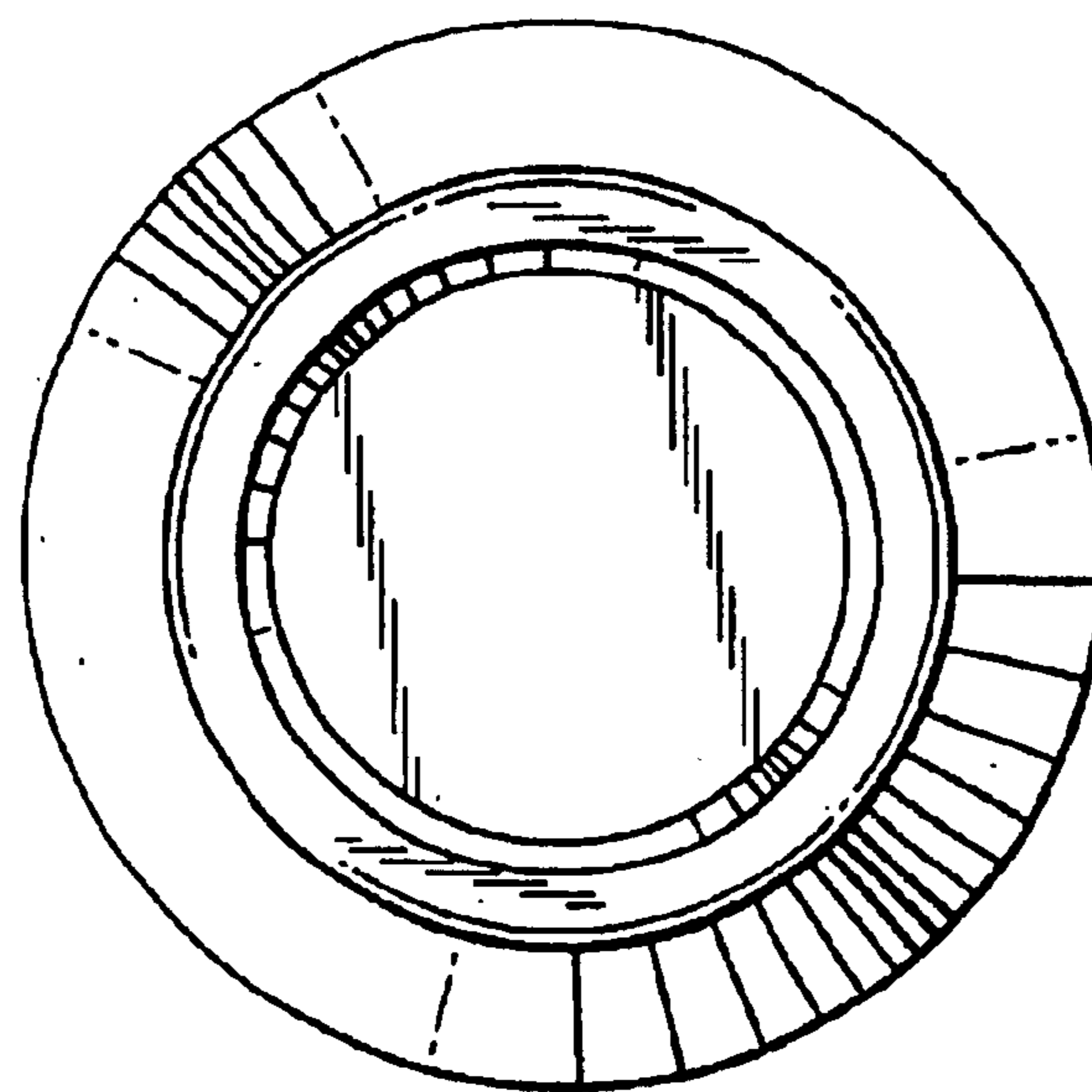

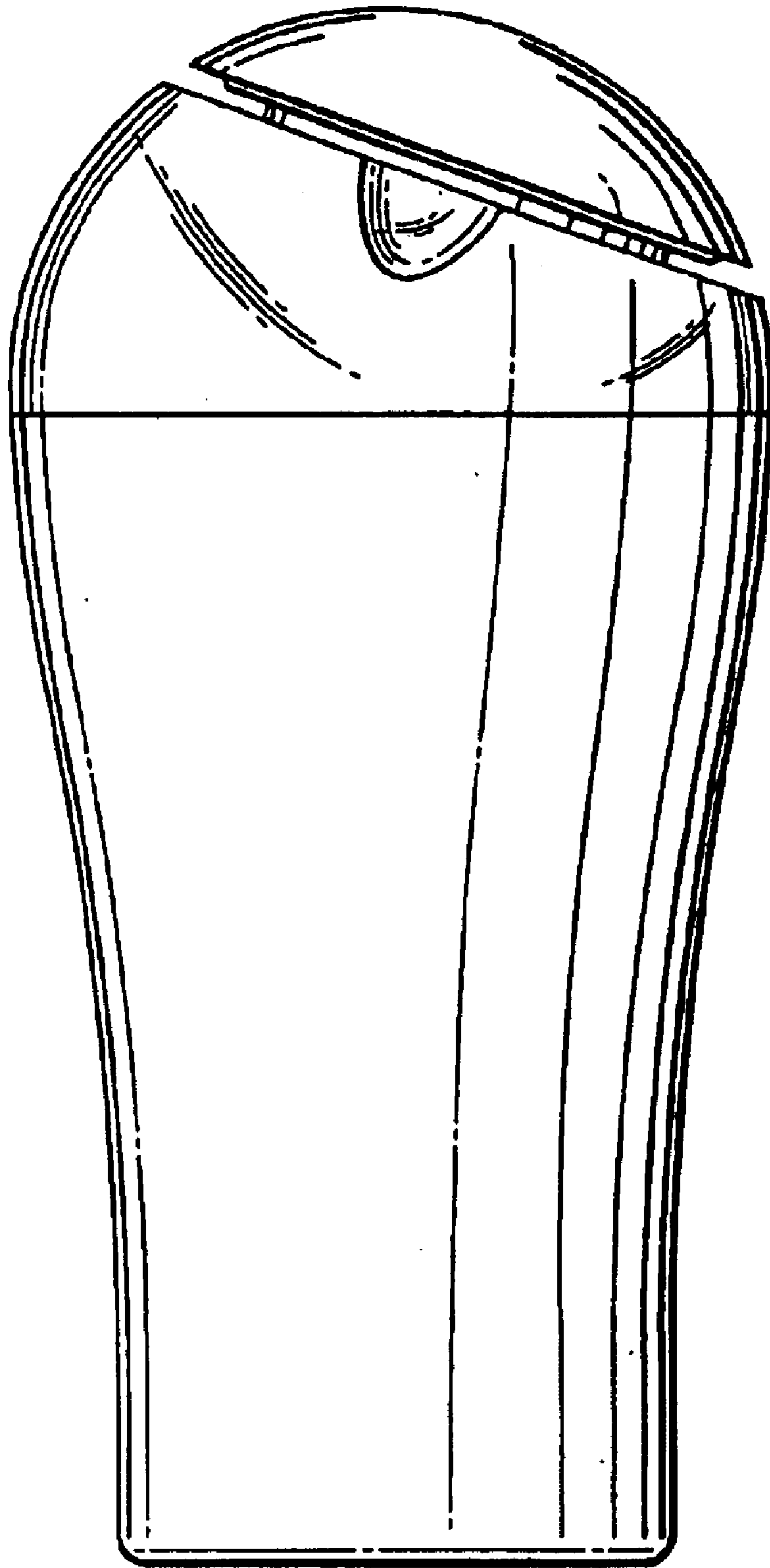

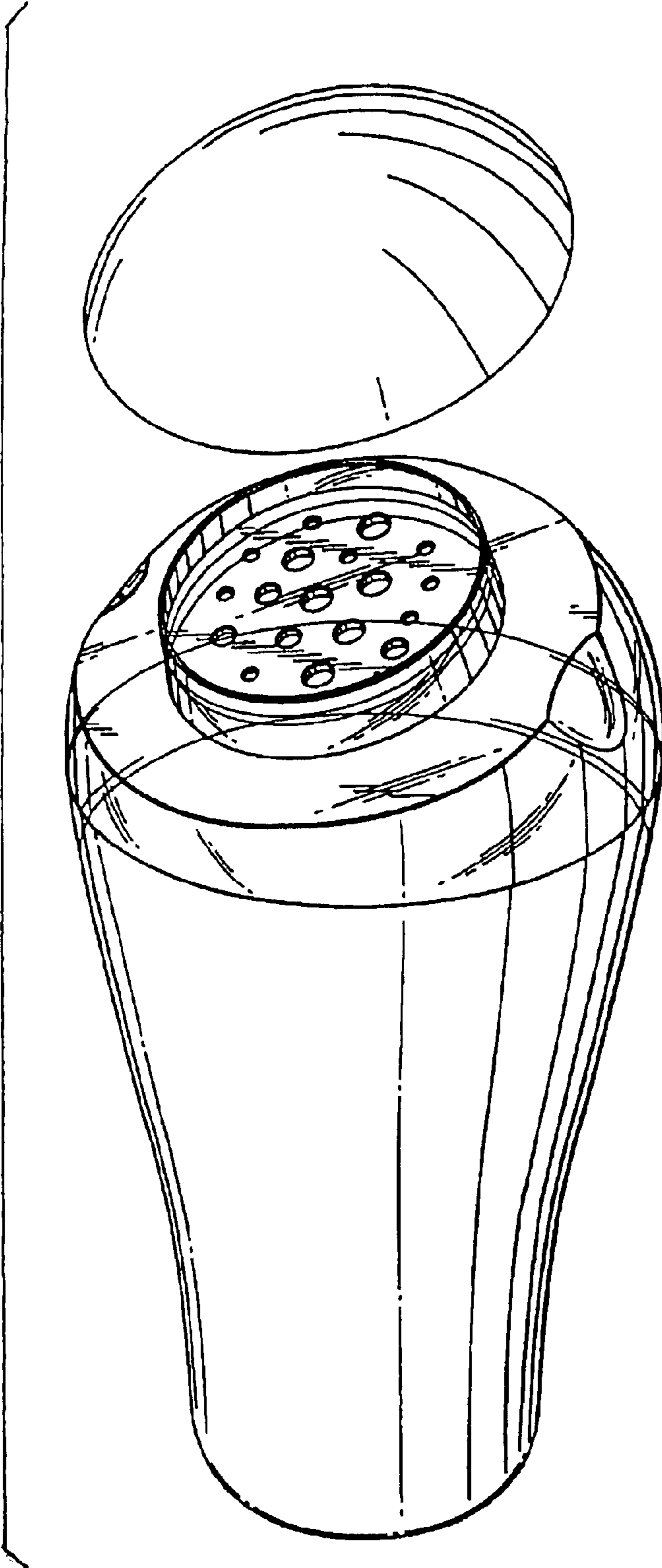

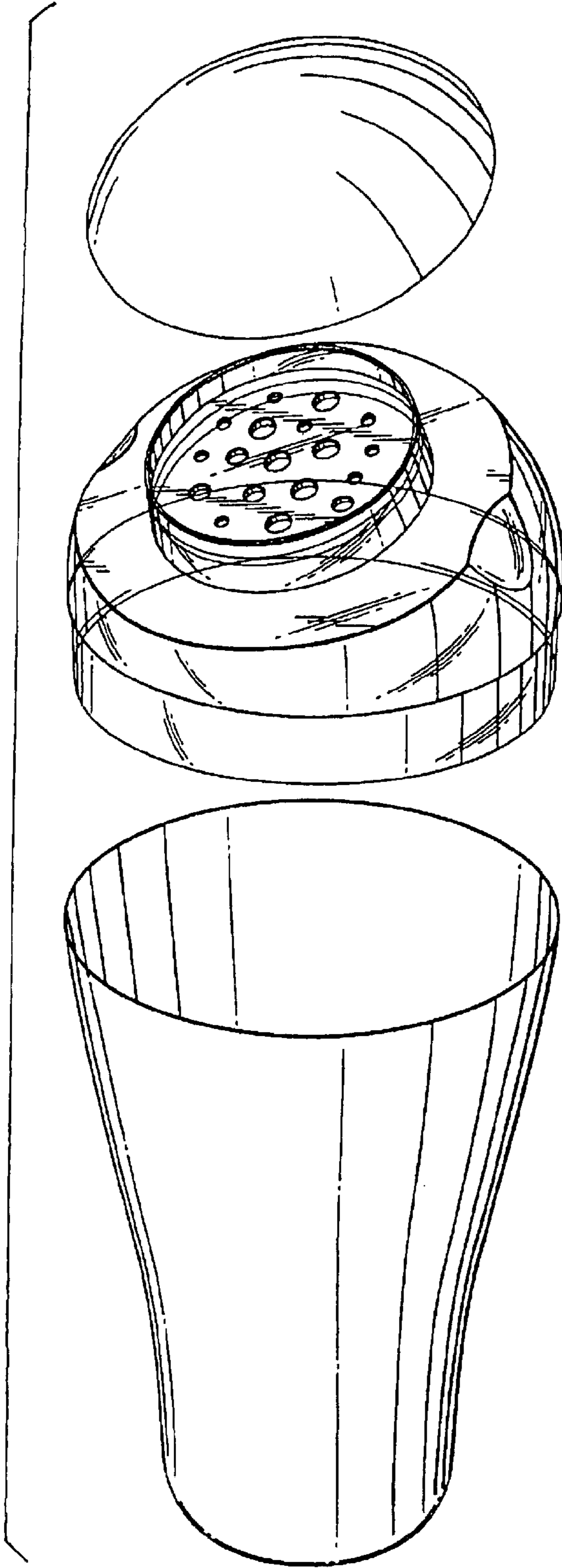
