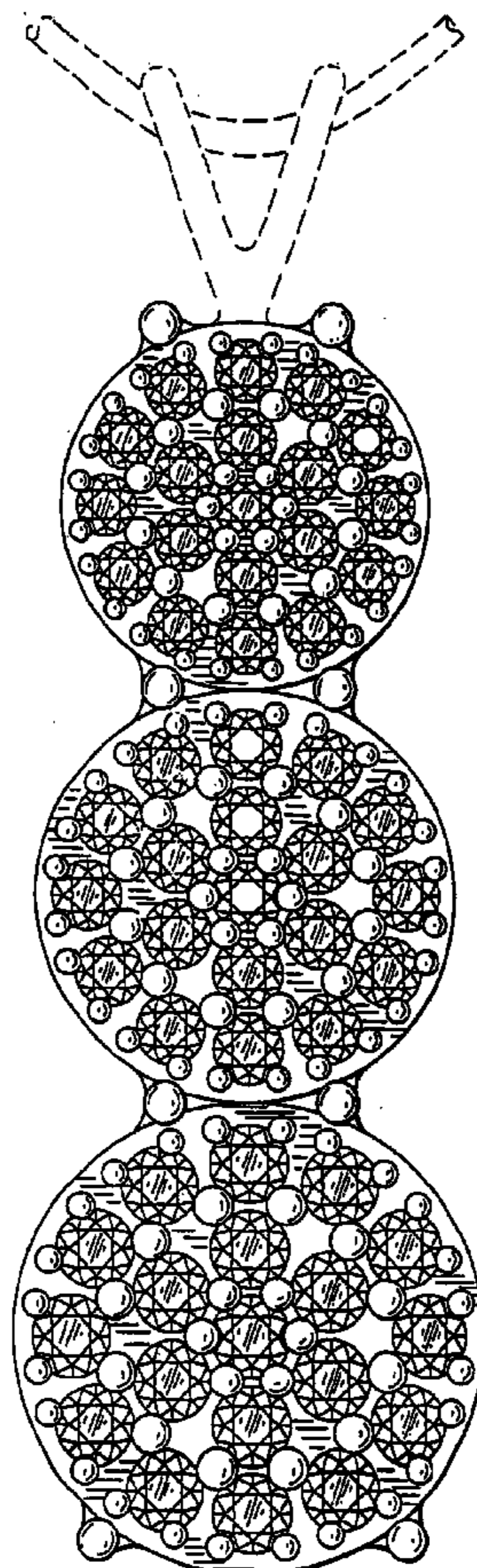
The ornamental jewelry cluster design, as shown and

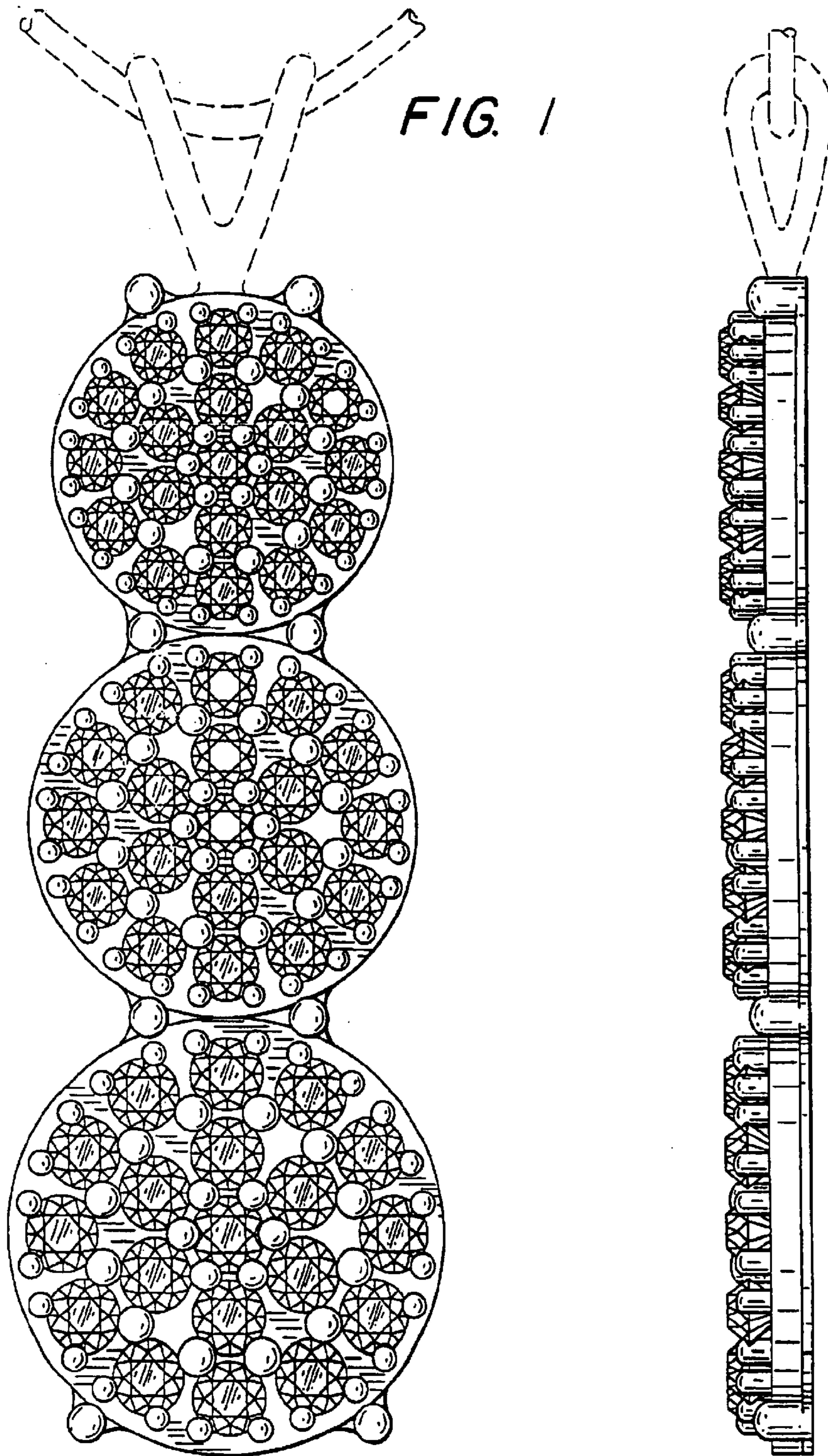
