(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy race car with bobble head
helmet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

of FIG. 6;

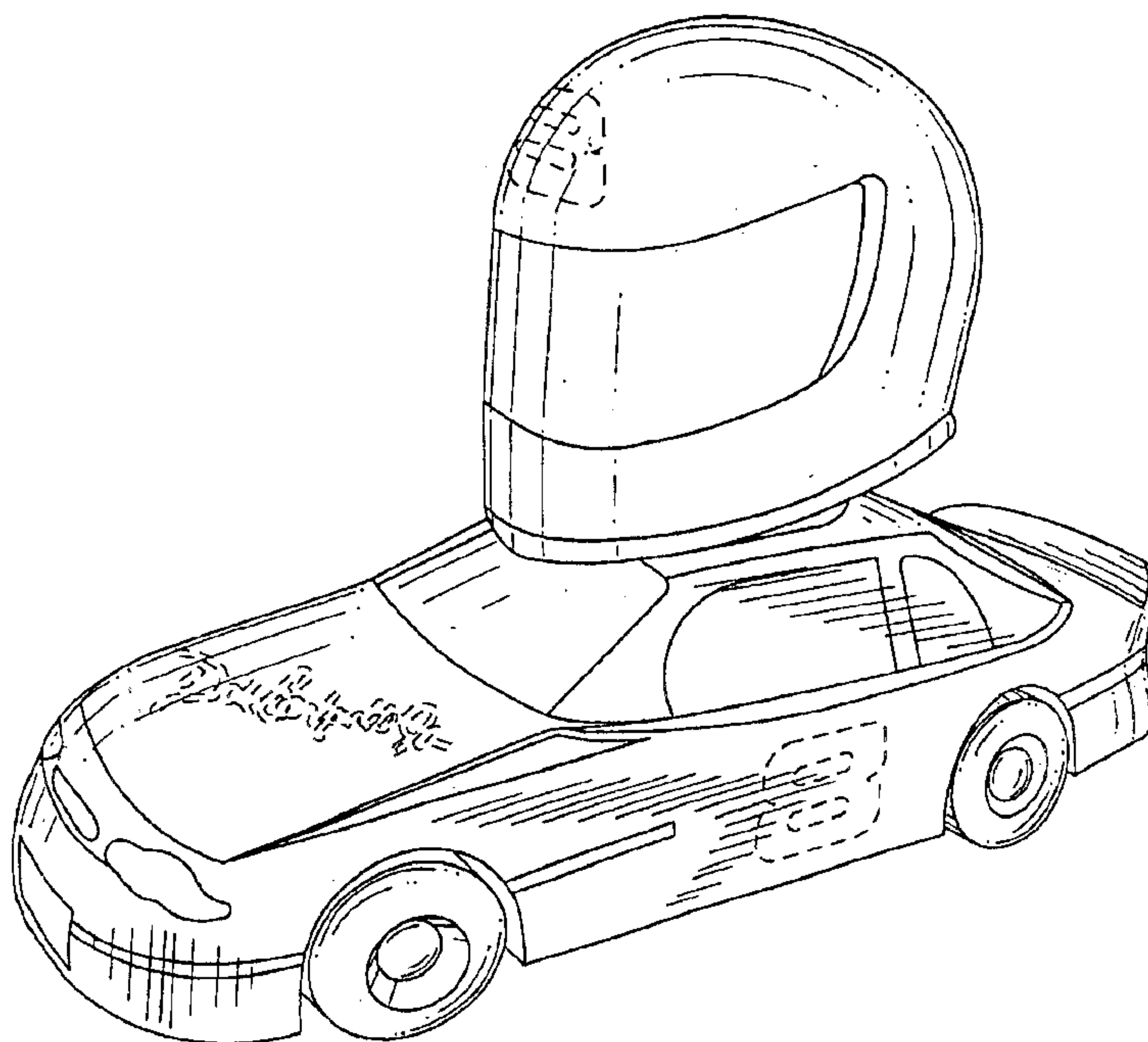
FIG. 8 shows a right side elevational view of the alternative

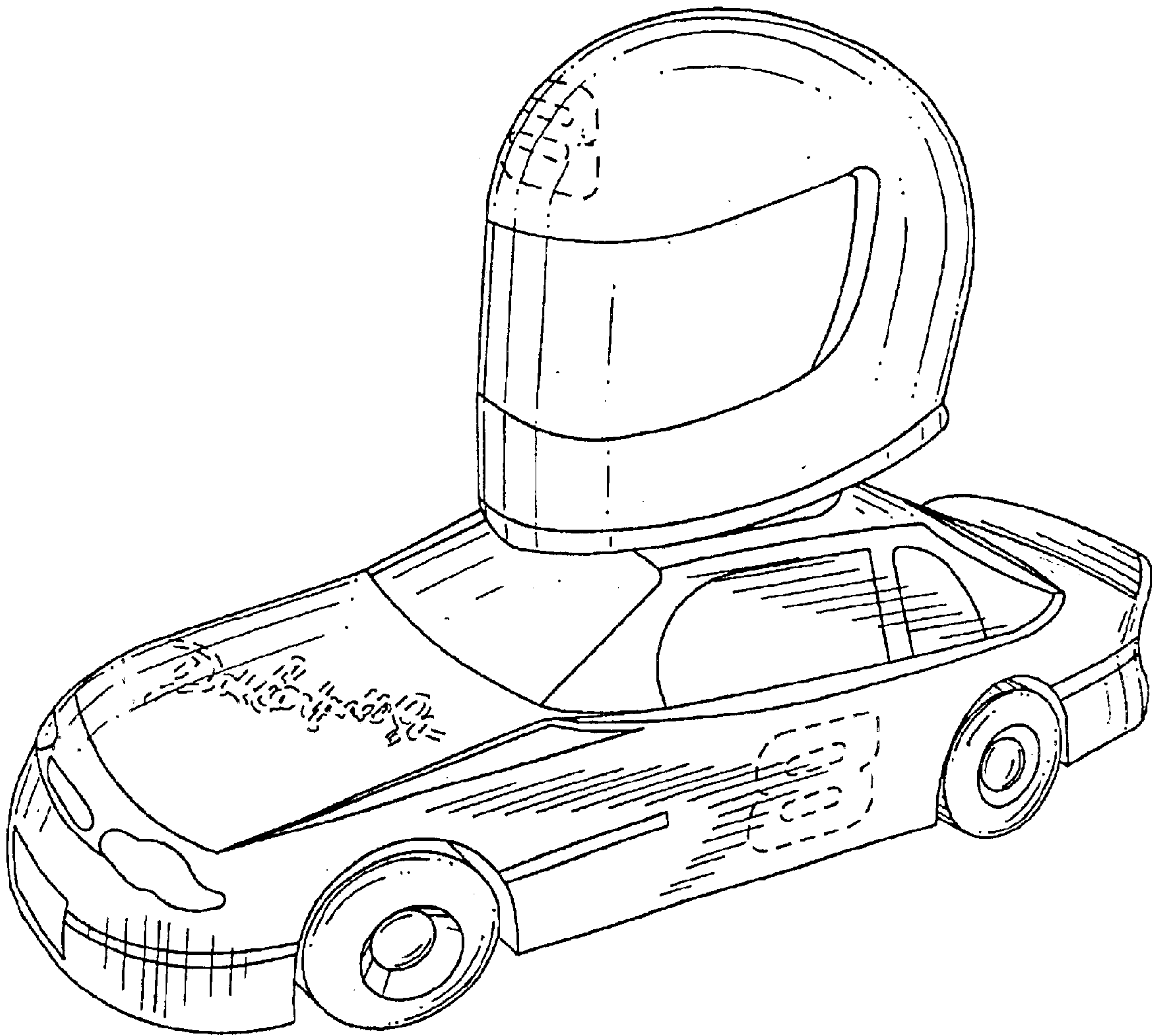
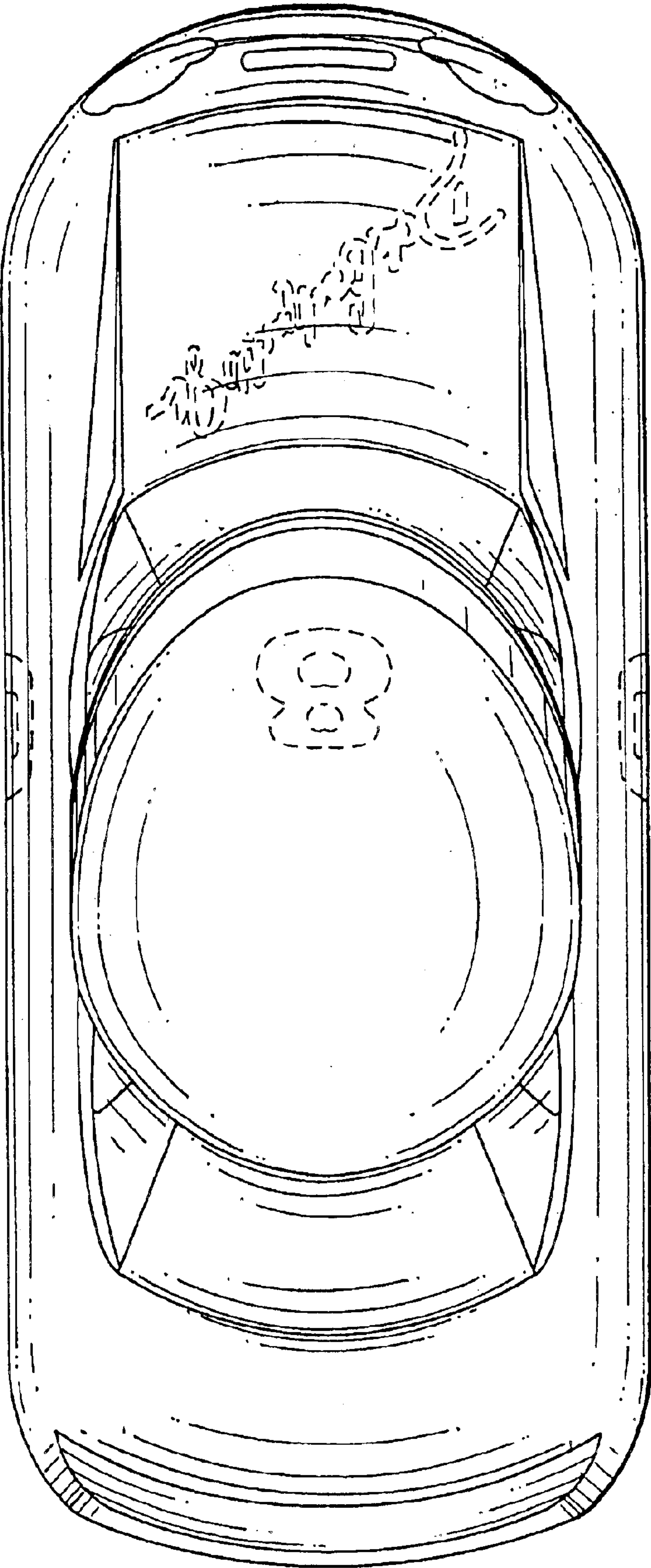

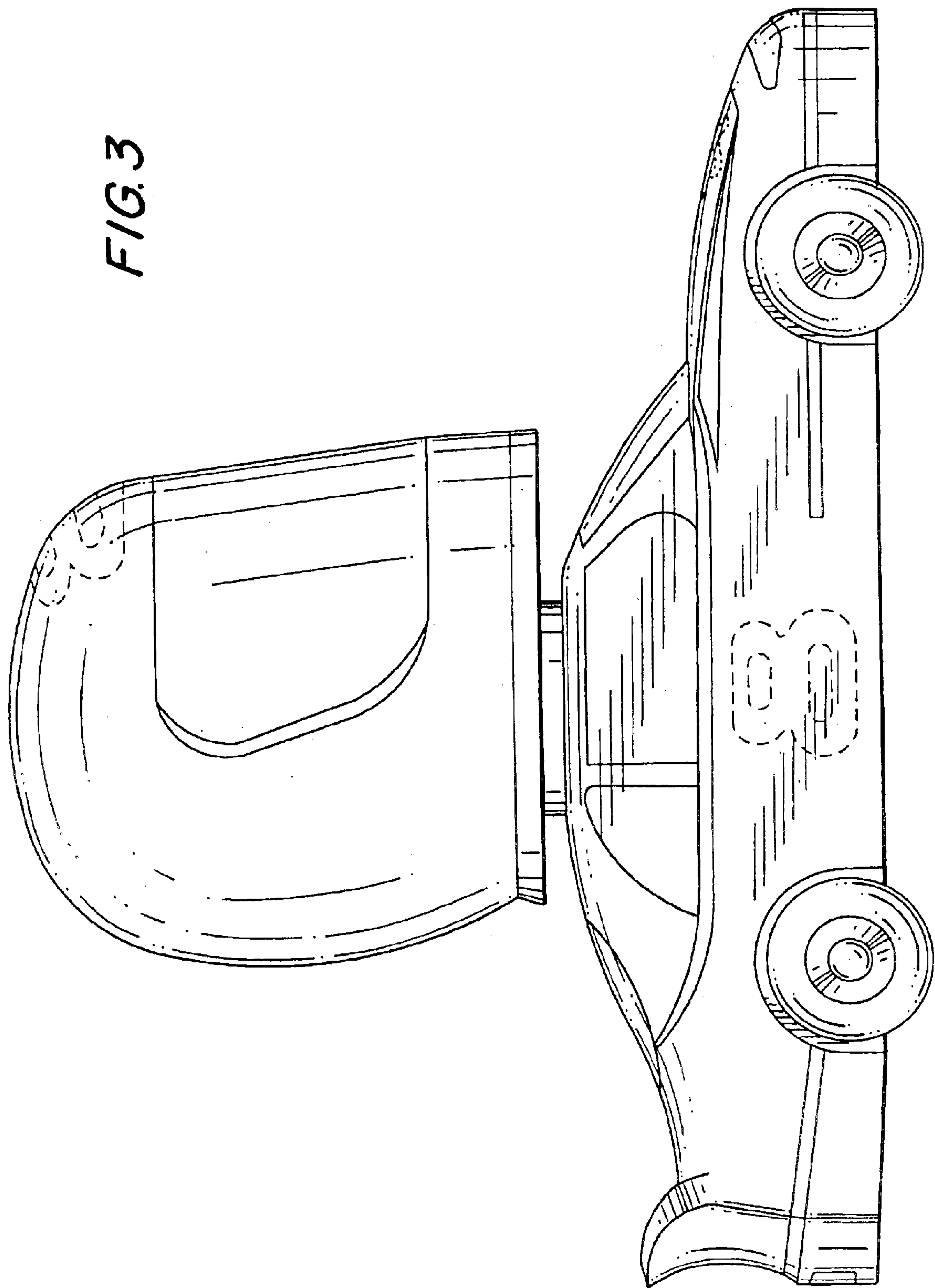

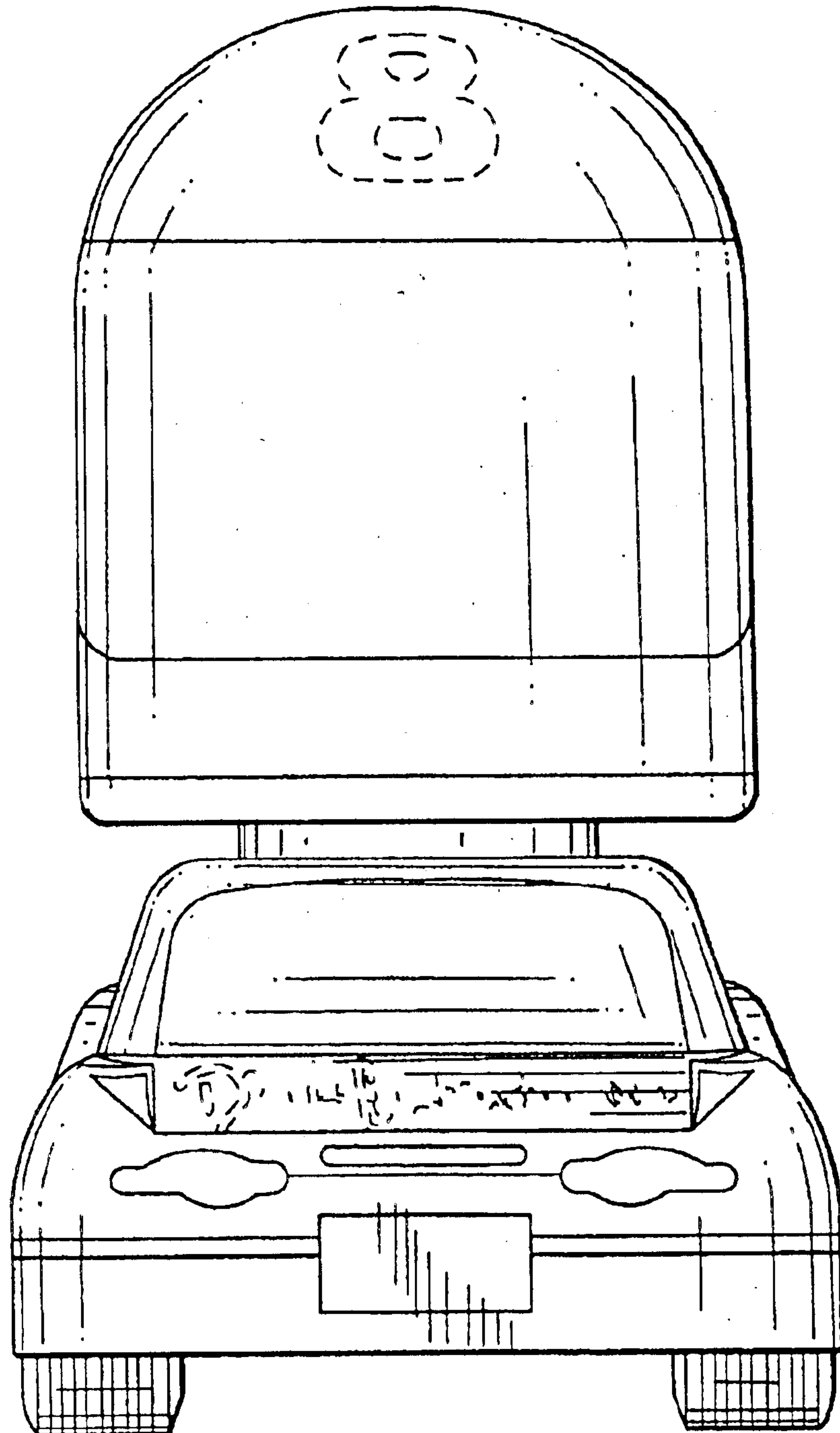

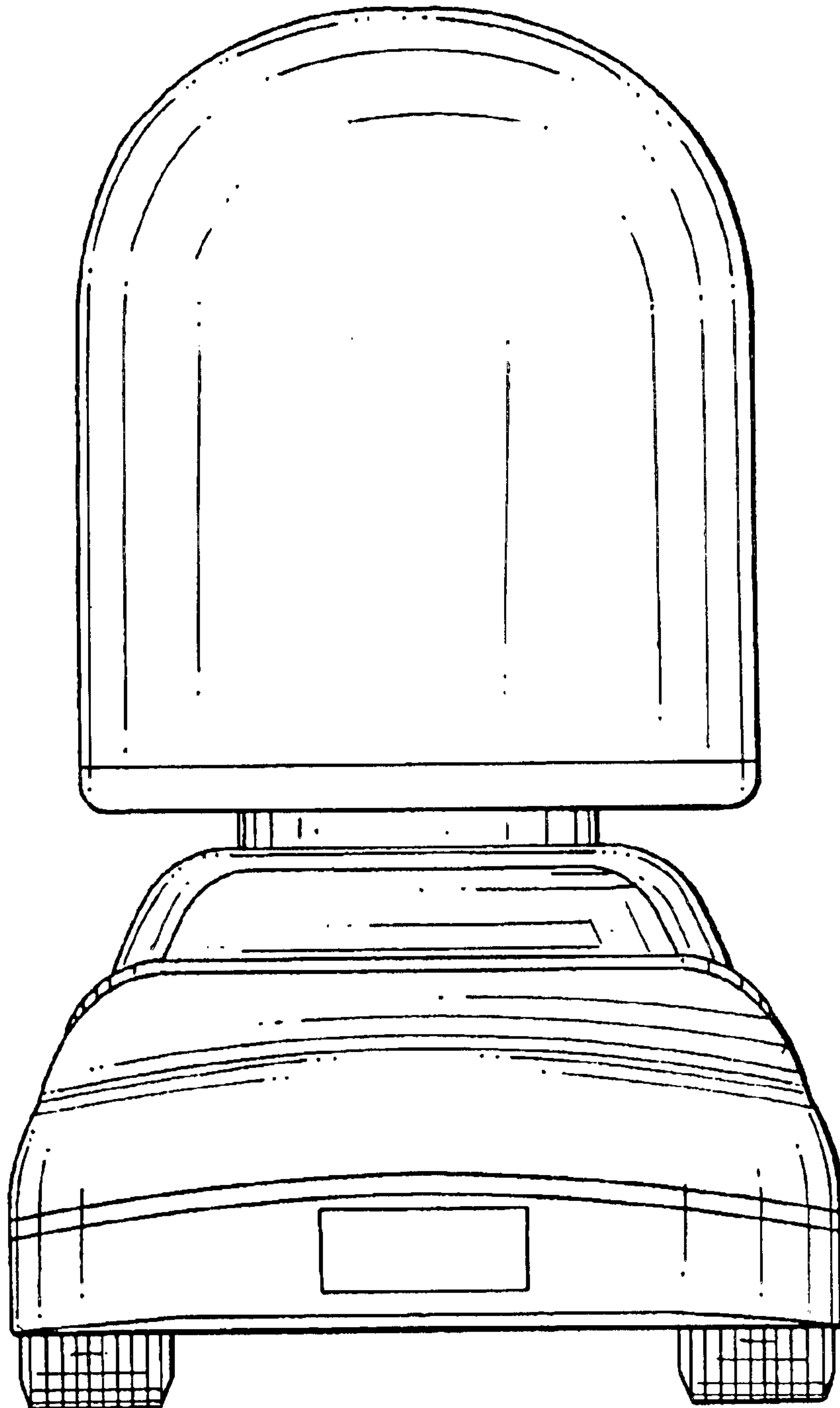

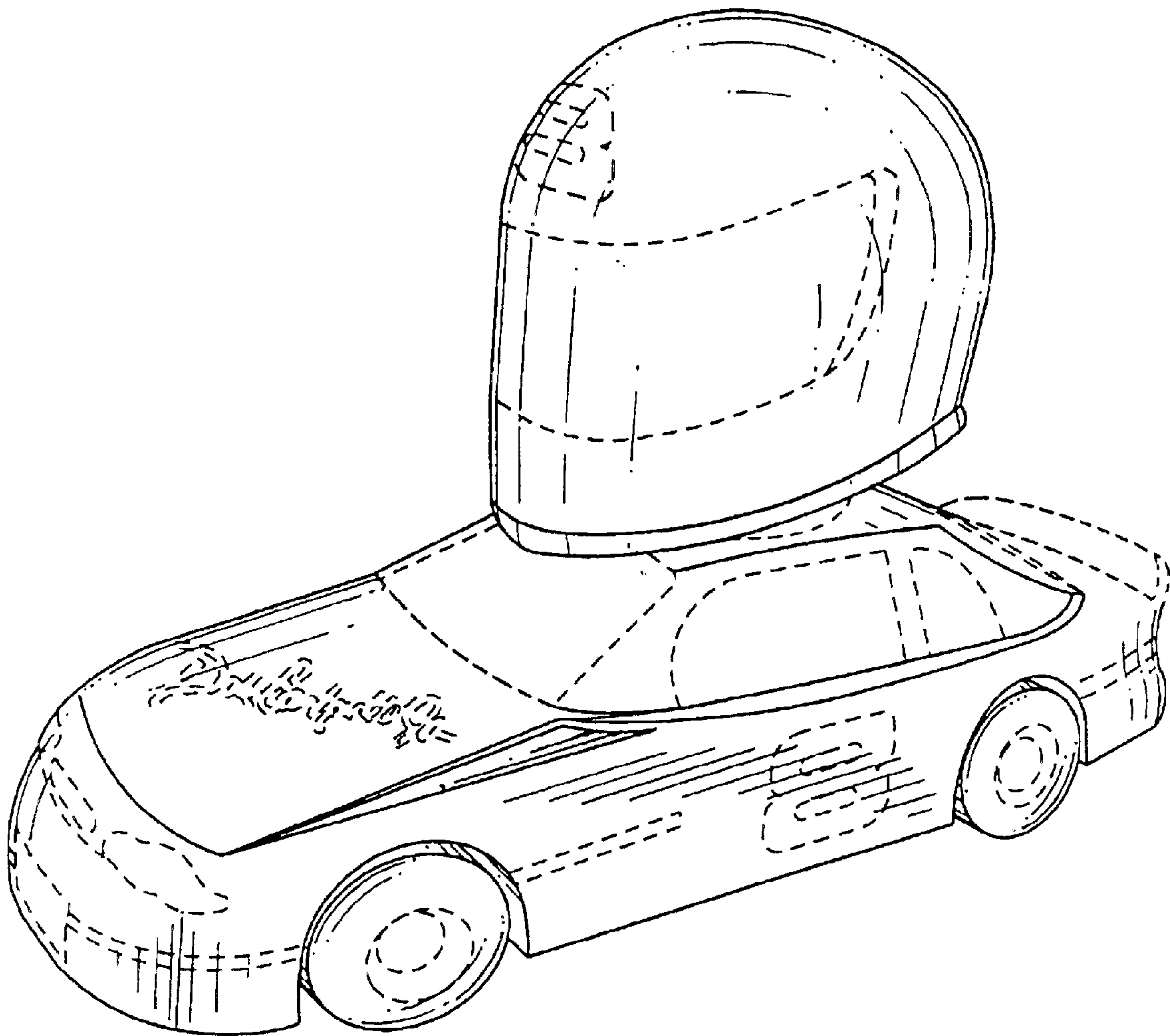
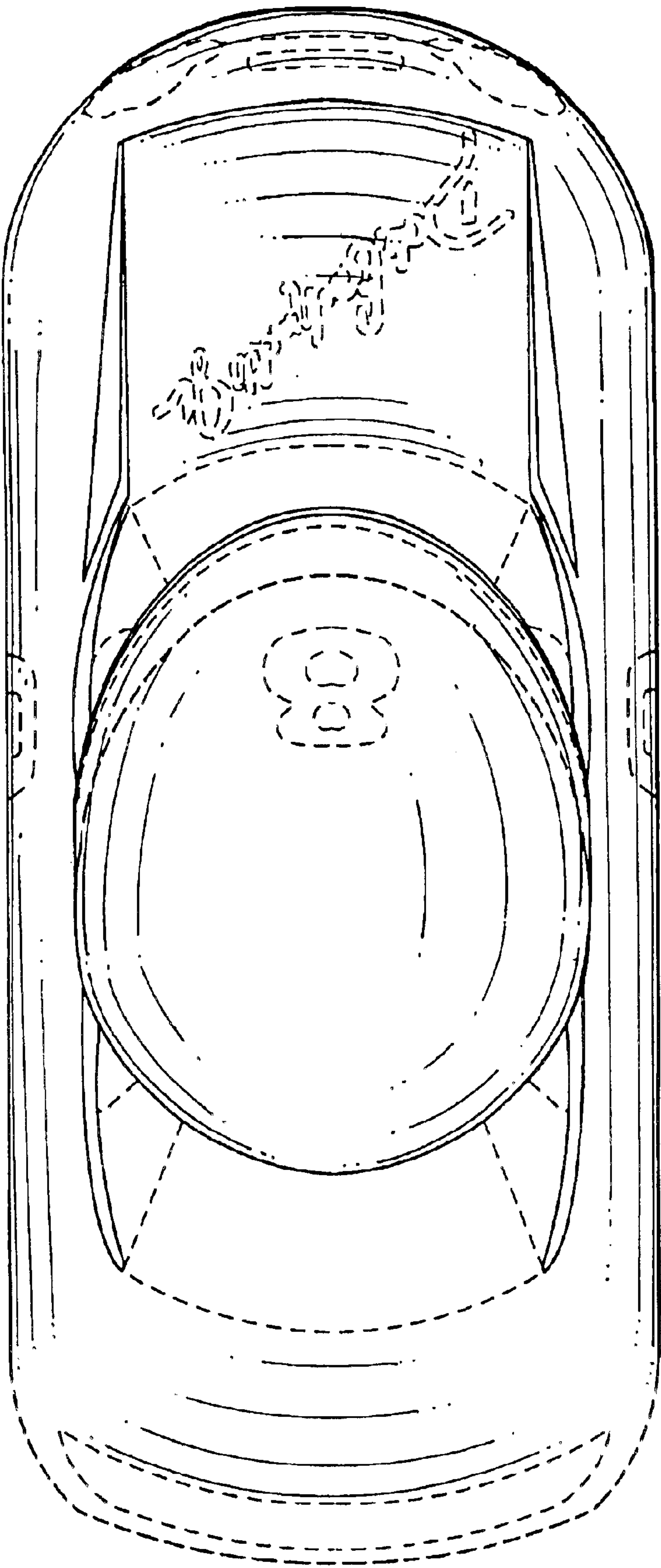

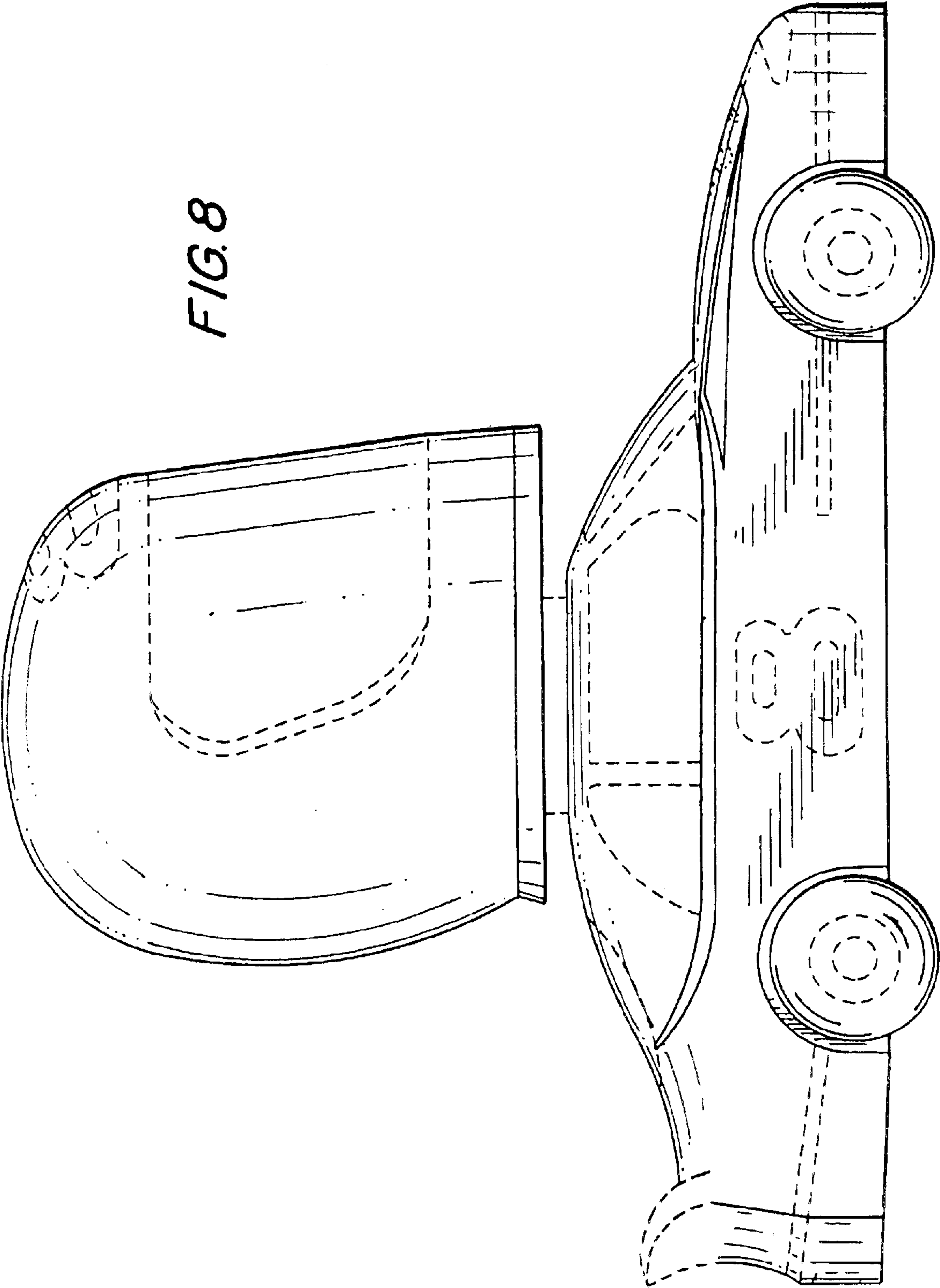

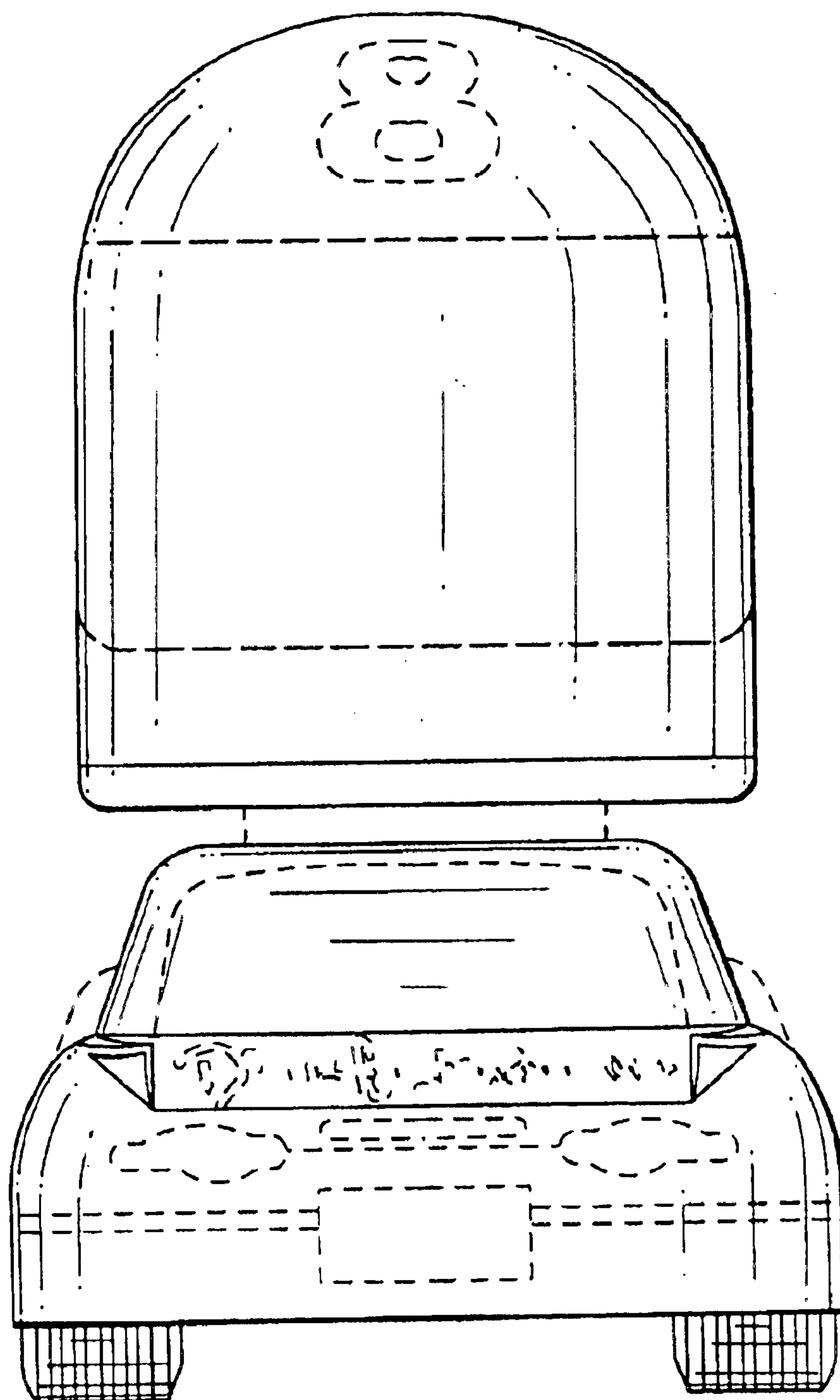
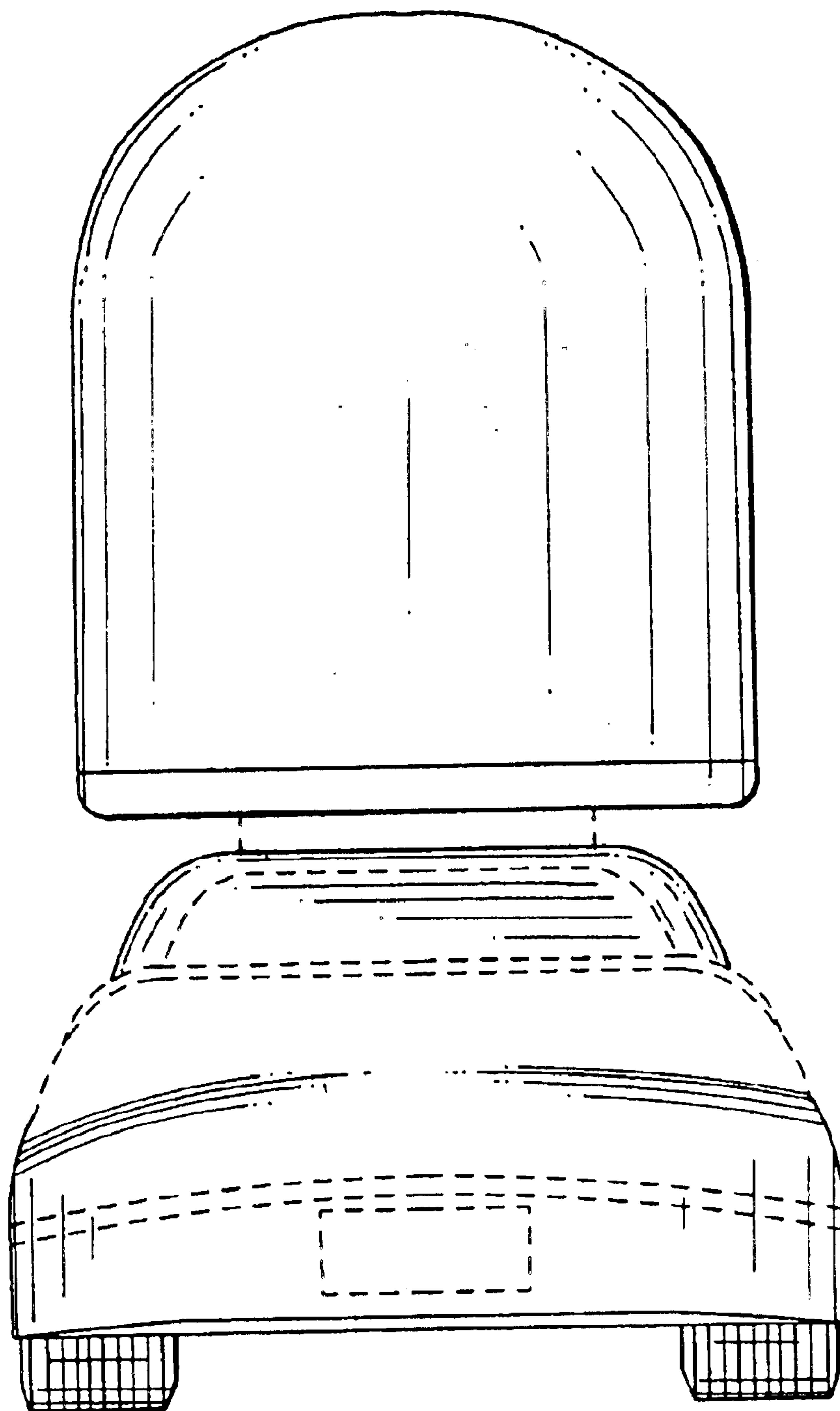
