FIG. 2 is a fragmented right side view thereof;

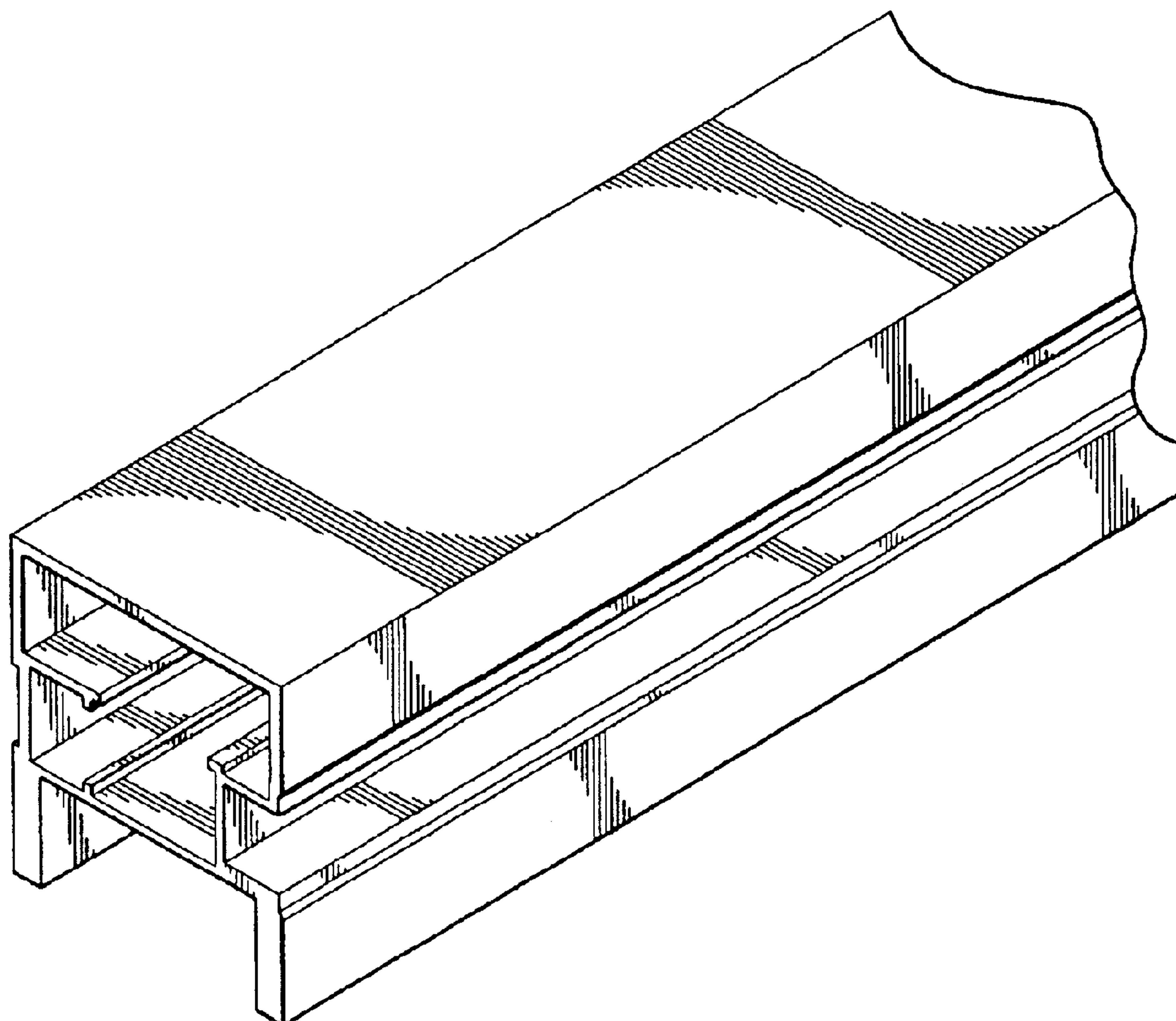
FIG. 3 is a fragmented back view thereof;

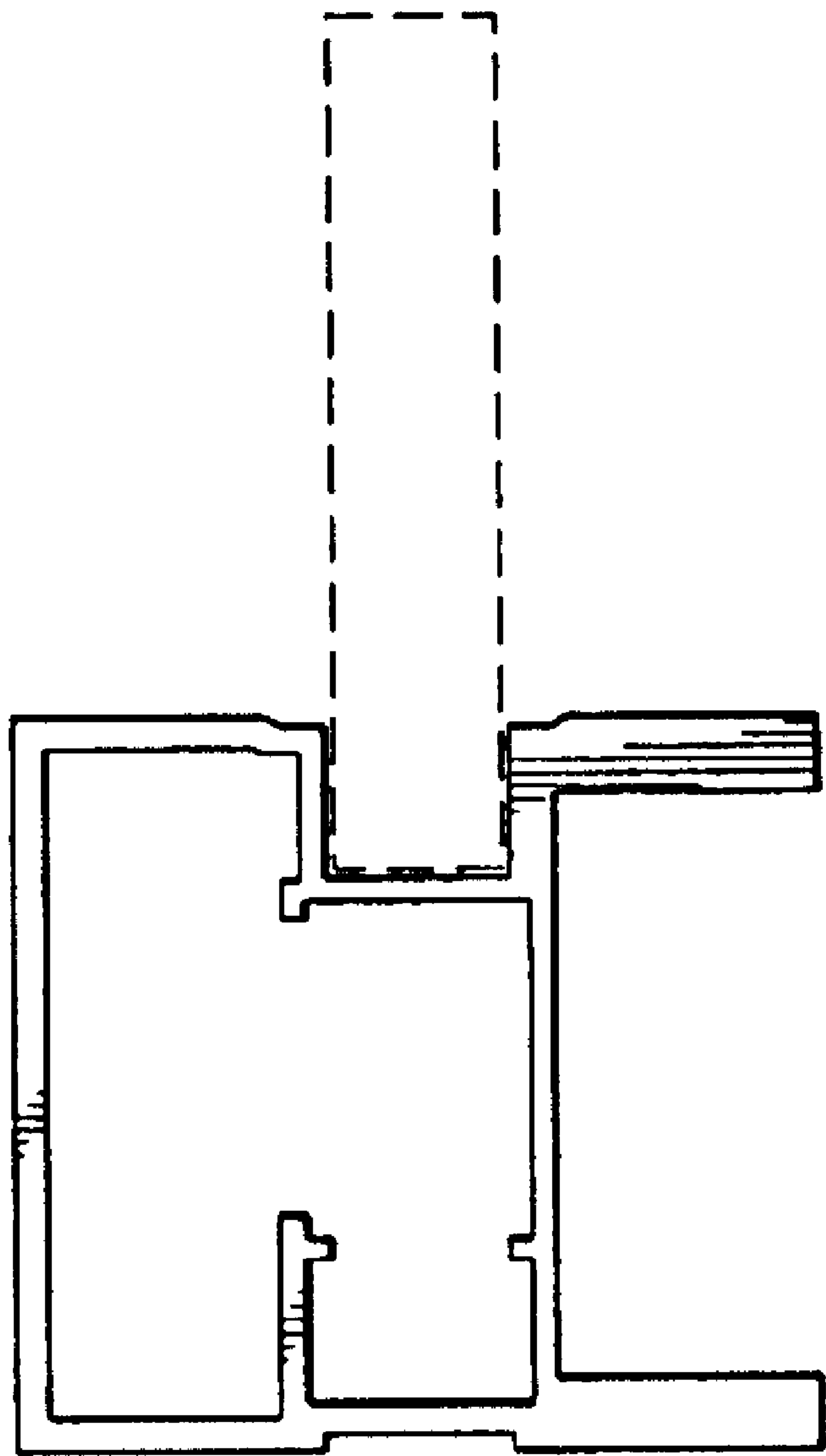

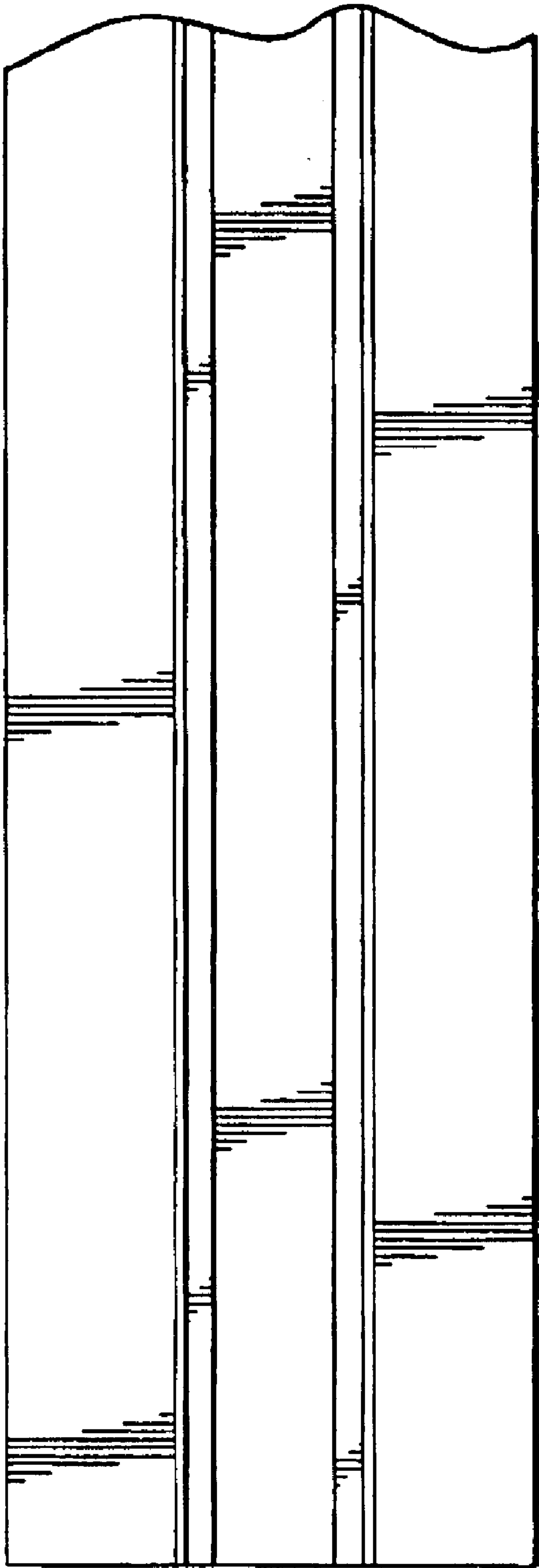

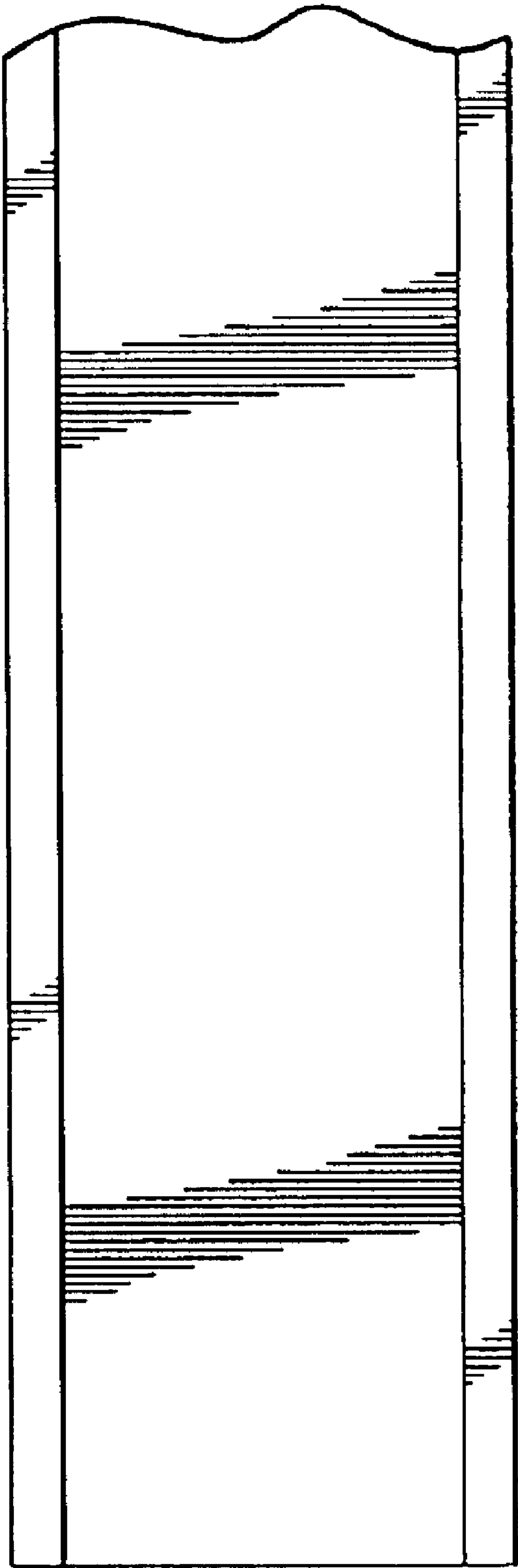

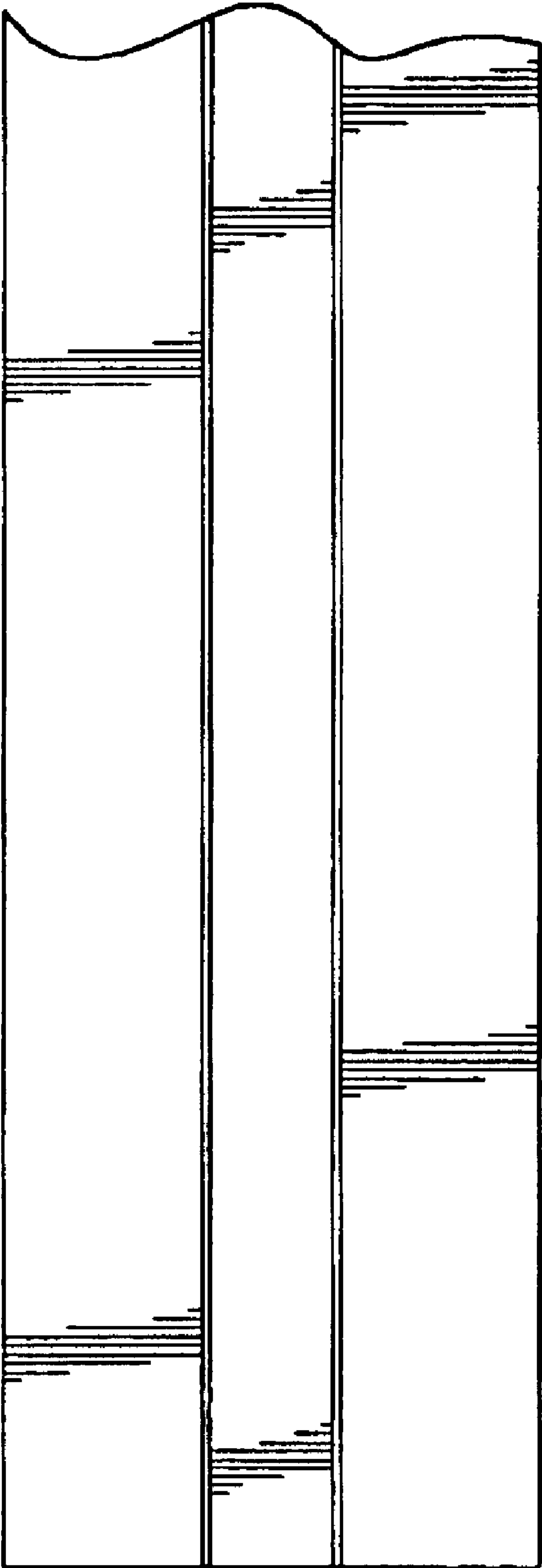

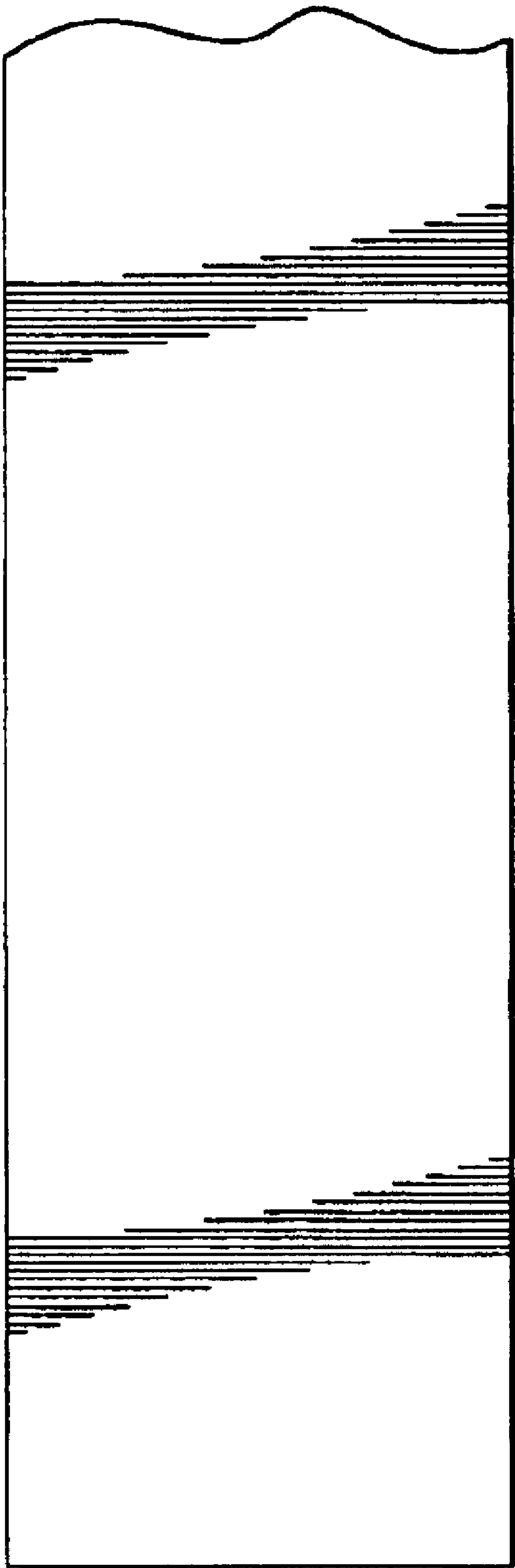

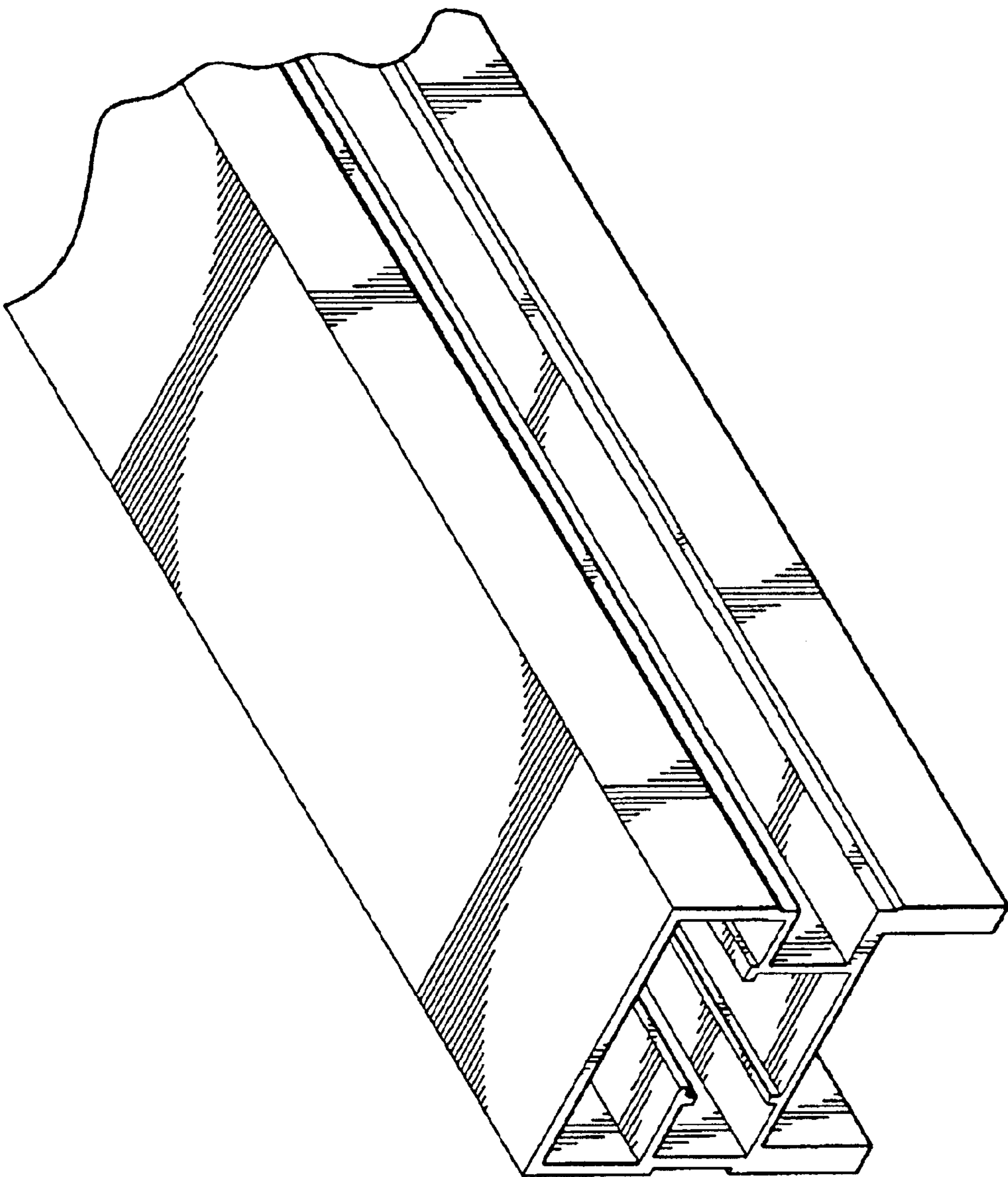
