
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the hollow heel portion for a high-heeled shoe of the present invention;


FIG. 2 is a side view of the hollow heel portion for a high-heeled shoe of the present invention.


FIG. 3 is a rear view of the hollow heel portion for a high-heeled shoe of the present invention; and,


