CLAIM

The ornamental designs for a cardholder mounted on the back of a picture frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a cardholder mounted on the back of a picture frame. FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a cardholder mounted on the back of a picture frame. FIG. 3 is an enlarged view of the cardholder shown in FIG. 2. FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a cardholder and a card partially disposed in the cardholder of FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the cardholder of FIG. 1. FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the cardholder of FIG. FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view of the cardholder of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a rear elevation view of the cardholder of FIG. 1. FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the cardholder of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the cardholder of FIG. 1. The broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
