(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a storage shelf for infant items, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective of a storage shelf for infant items, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, thereof;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, thereof, the opposite side elevational view being substantially a mirror image, thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view, thereof;












