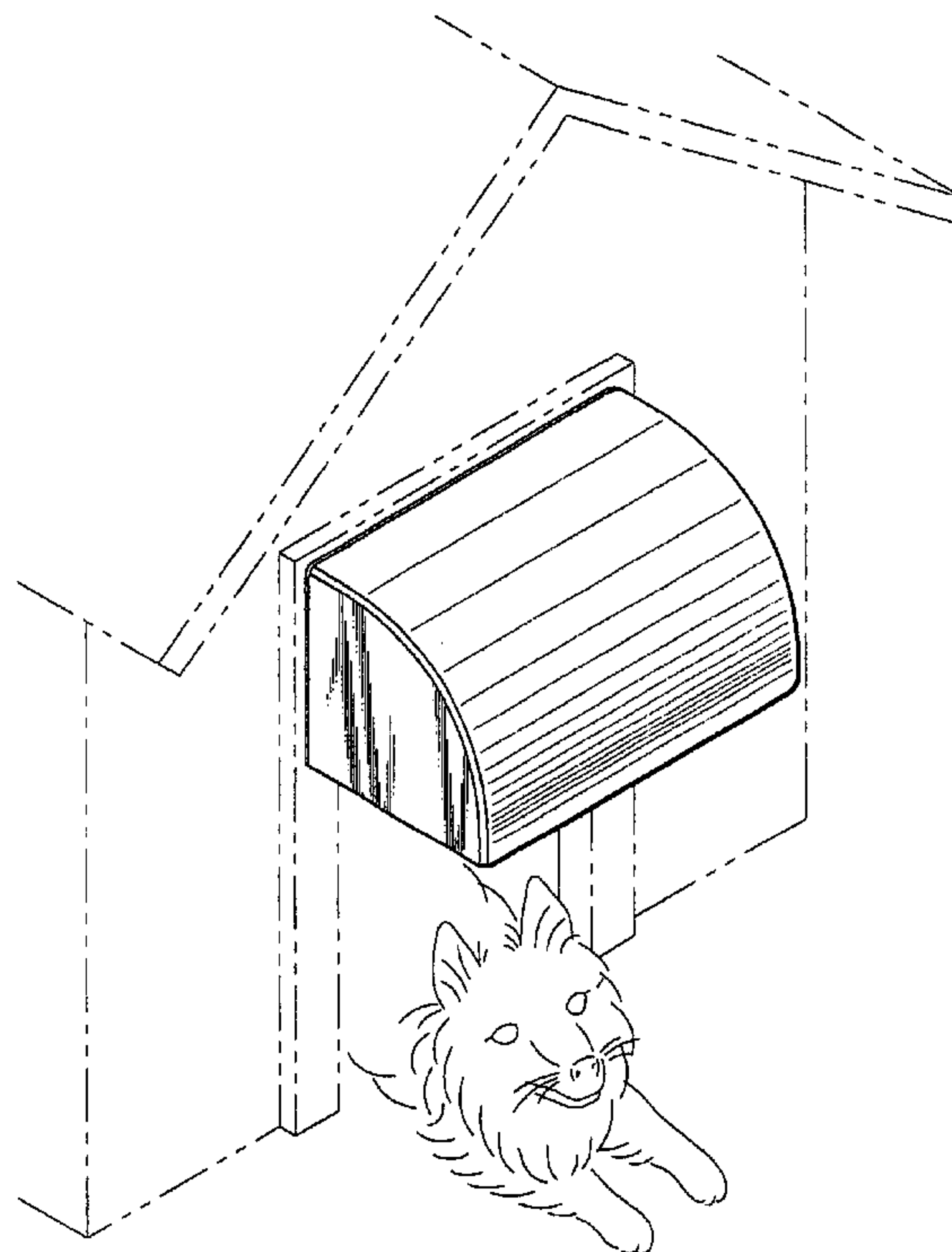

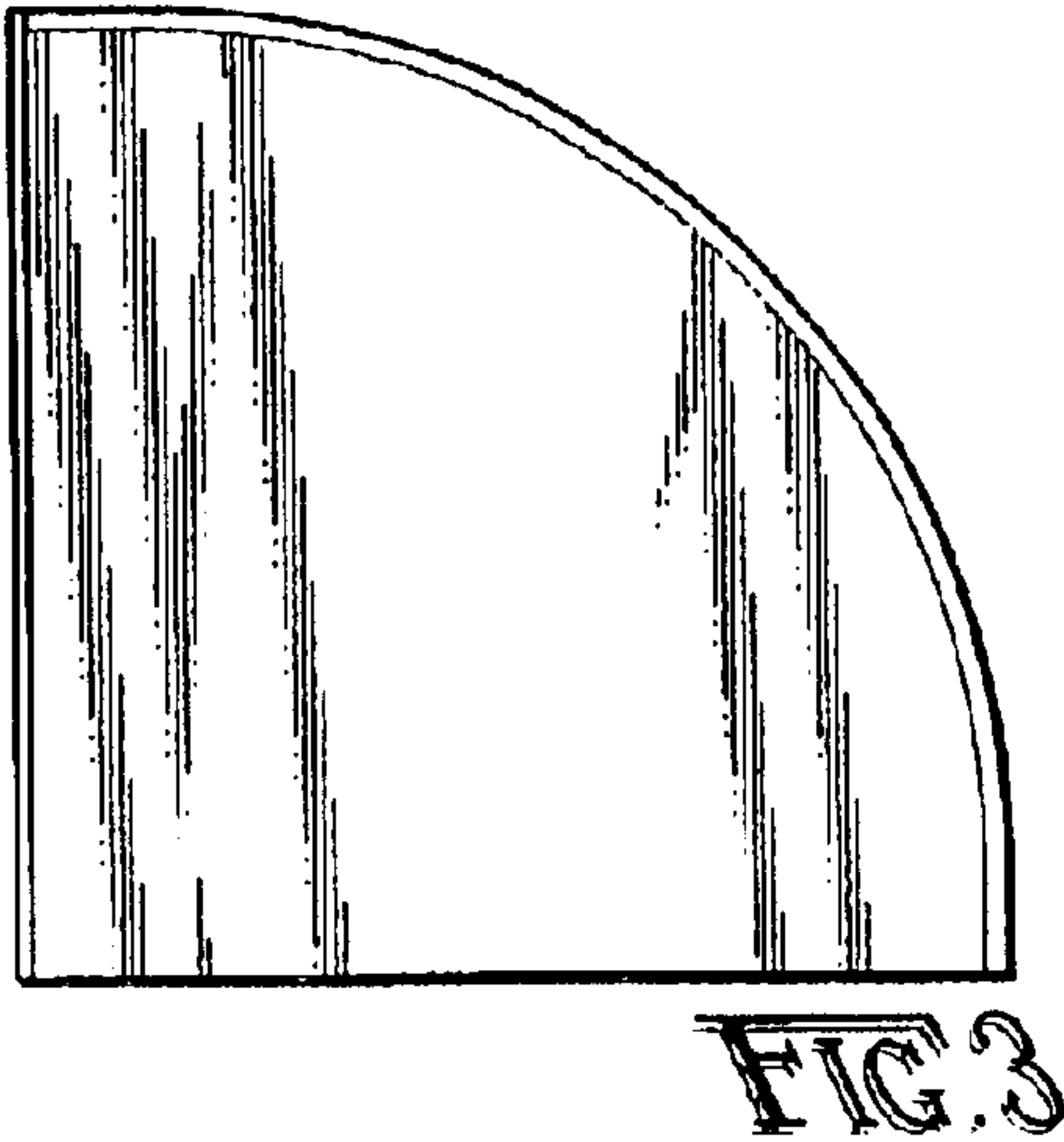
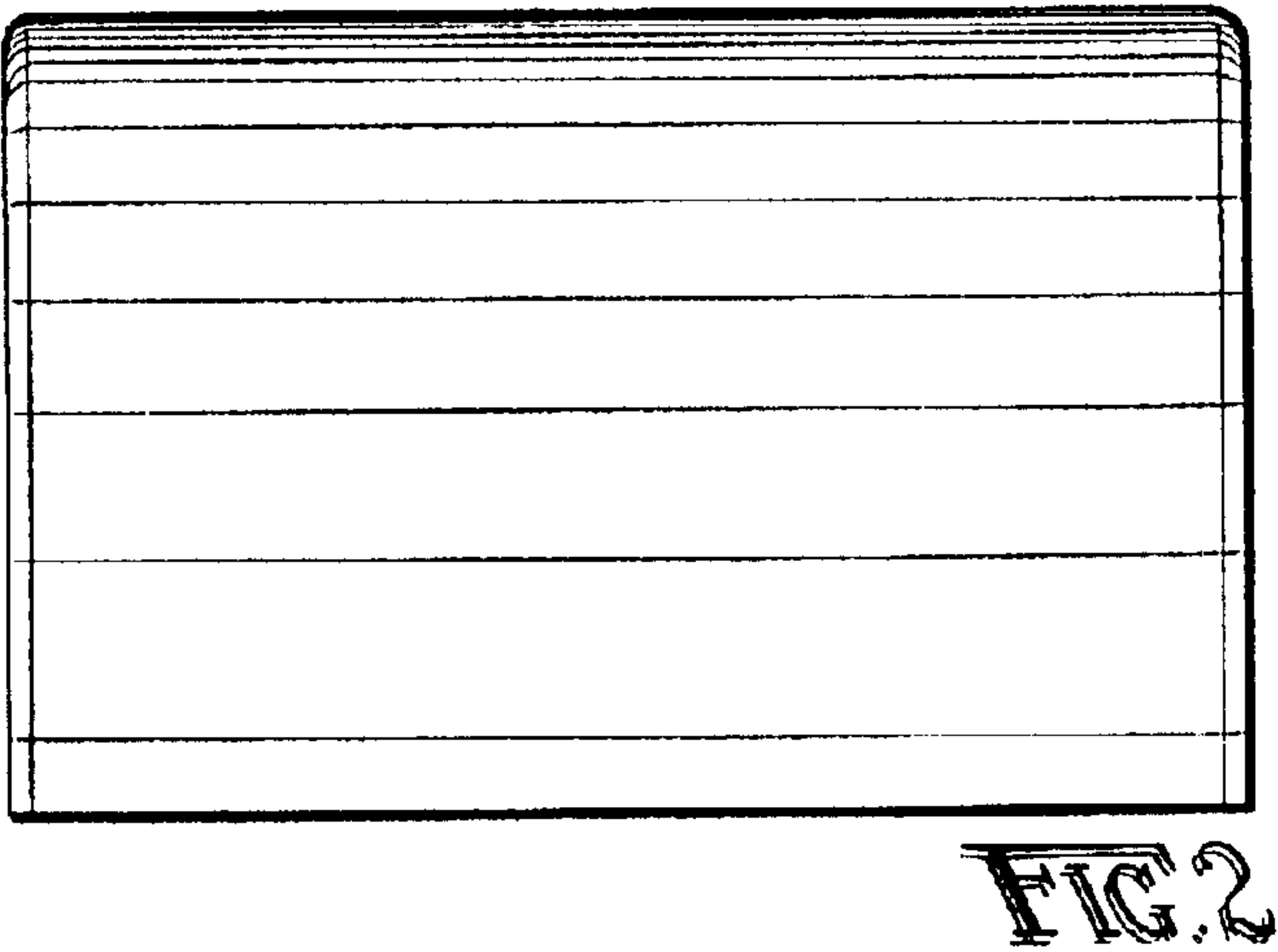
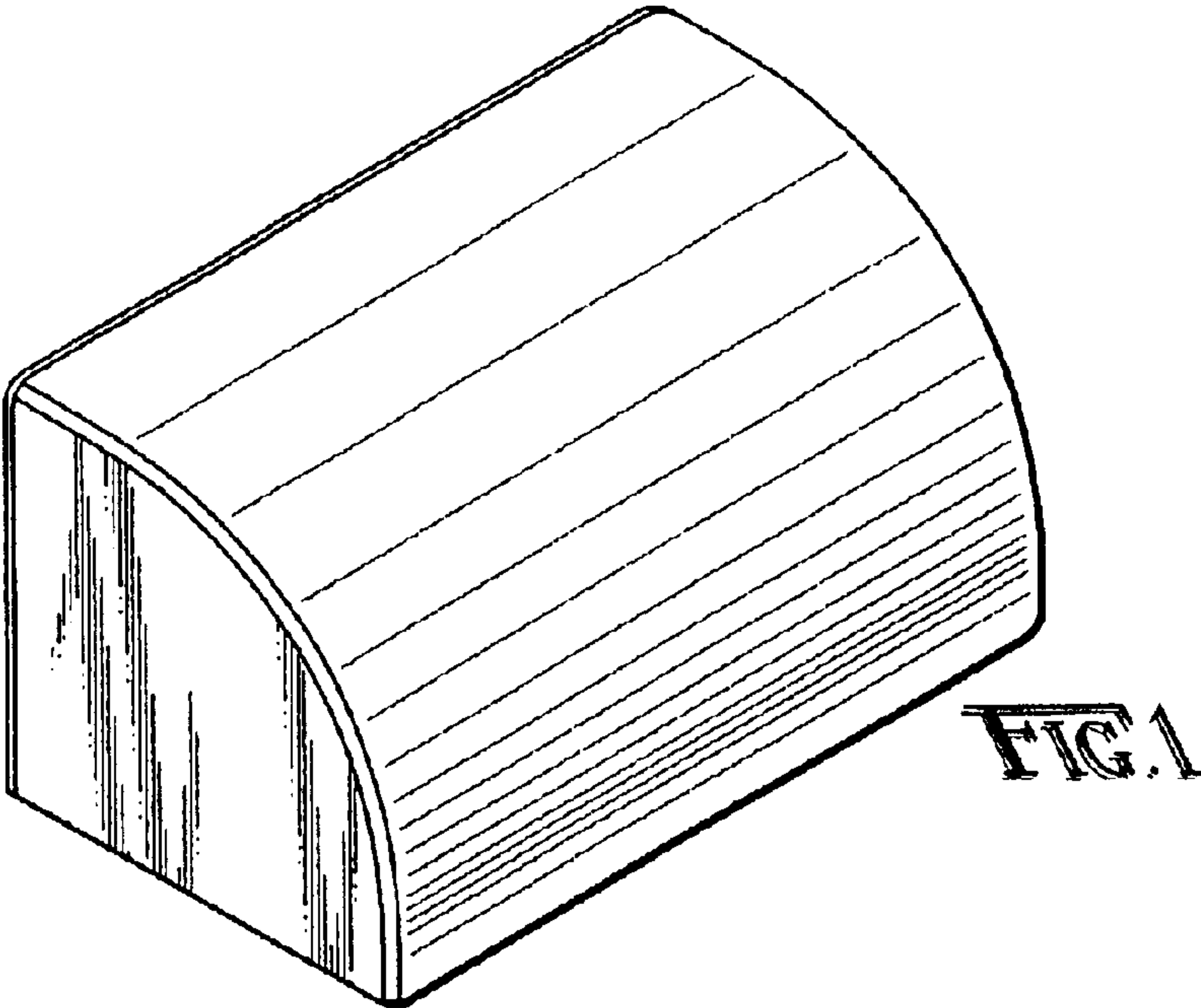
We claim the ornamental design for an awning for pet entrance, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and side perspective view of an awning for pet entrance showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear and side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a perspective view showing the awning for pet entrance in use; the broken lines depict environmental structure for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

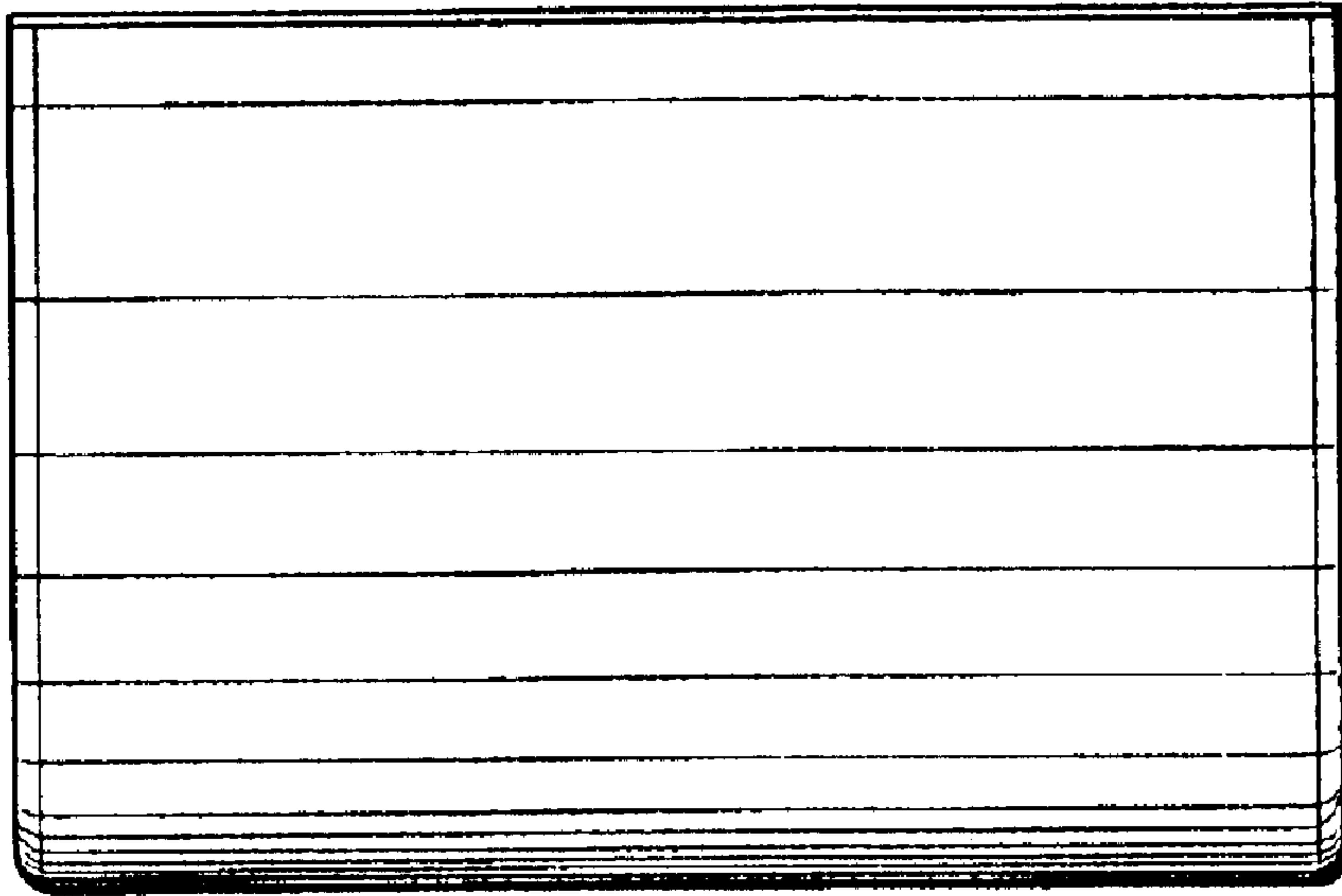

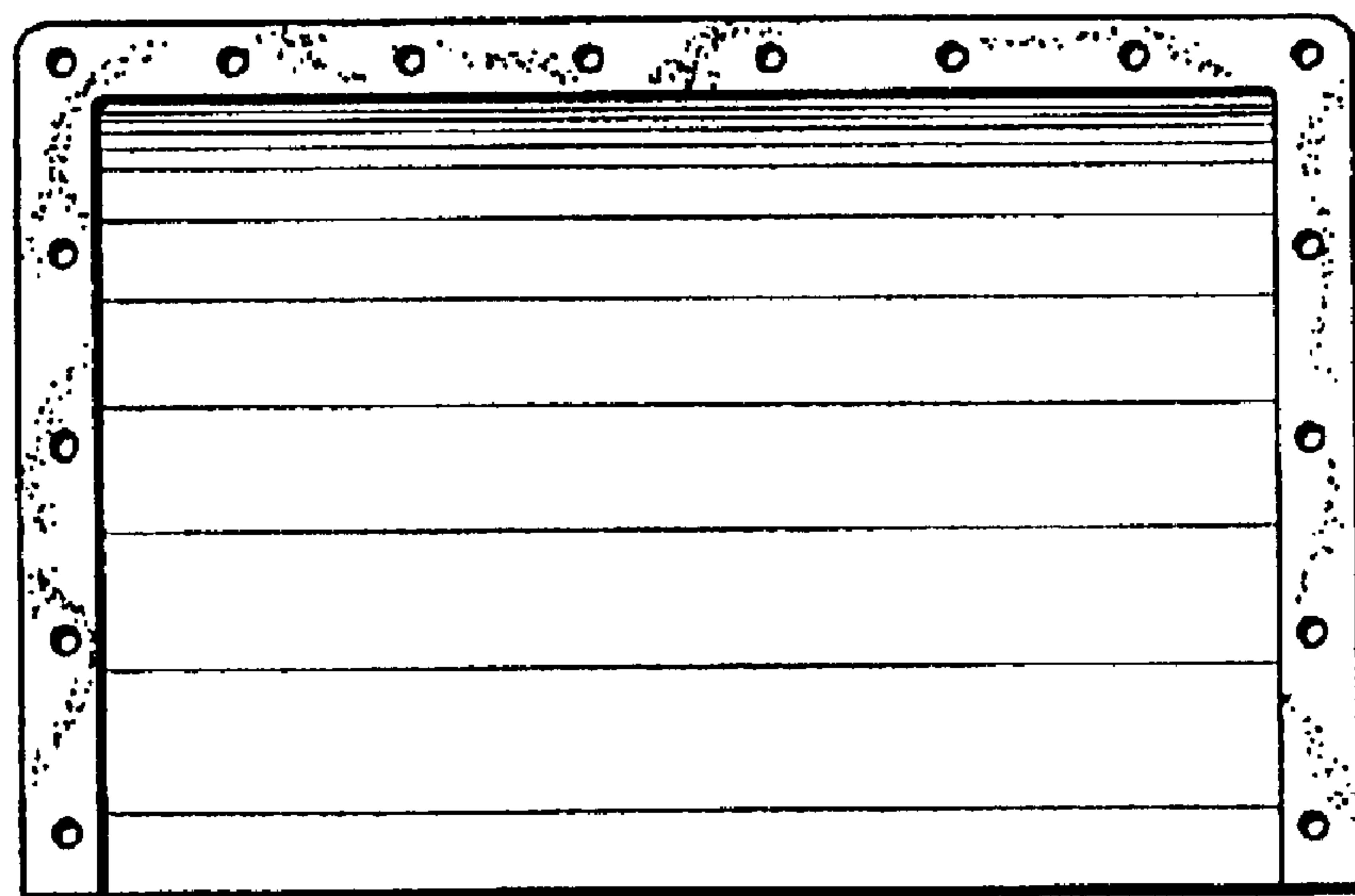

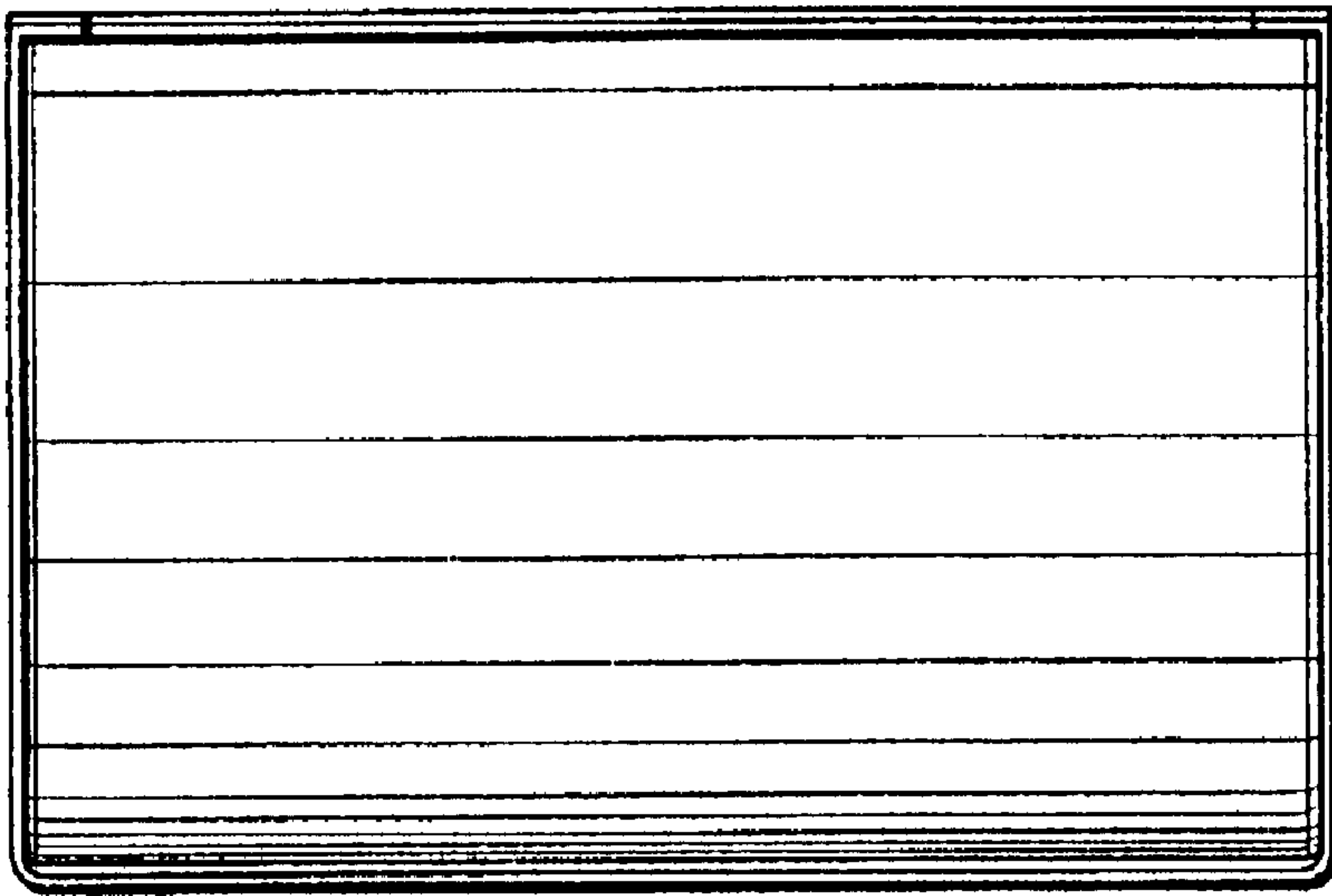

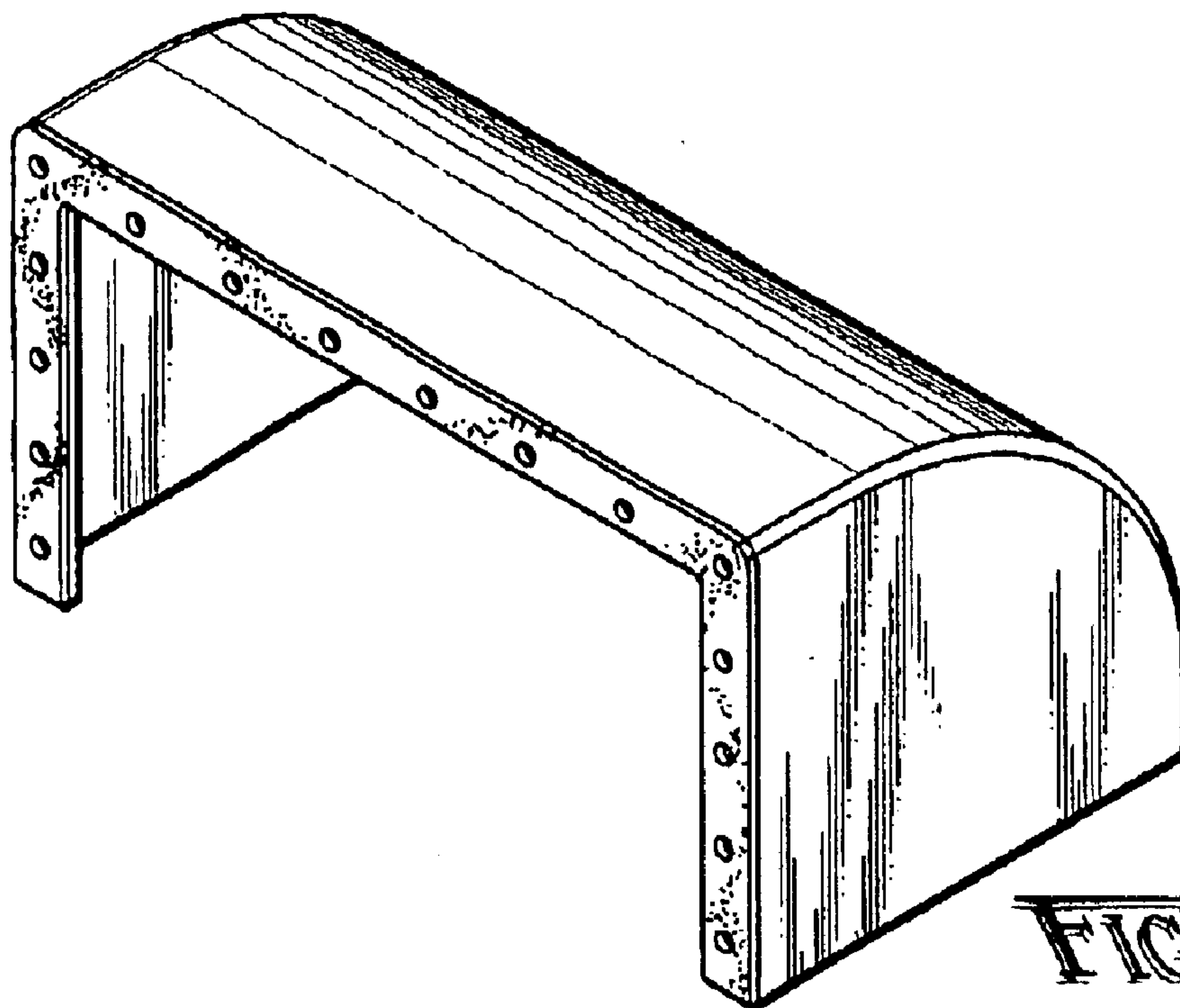
