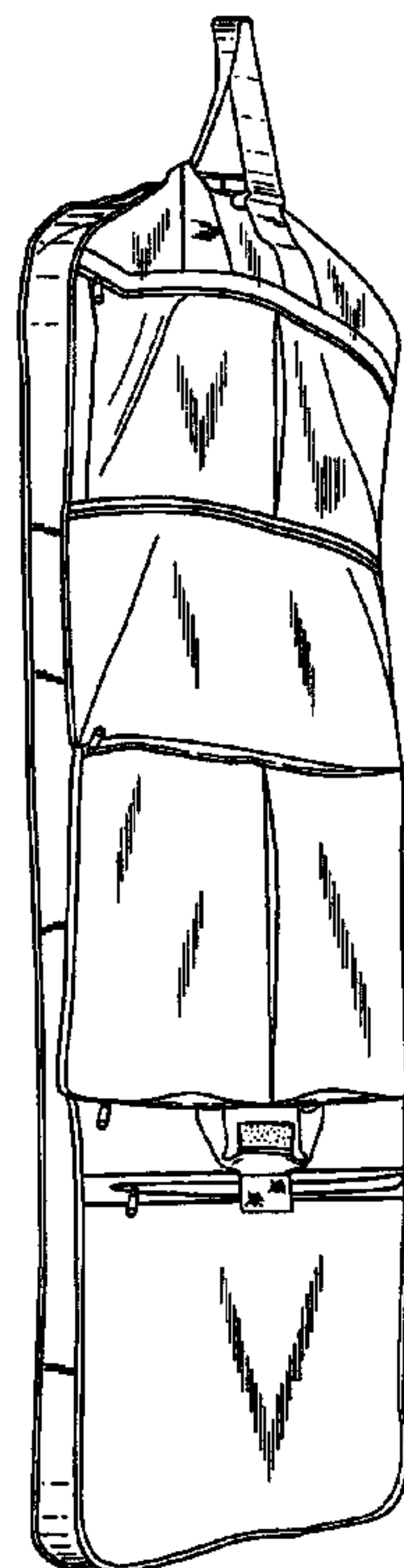
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a flexible tri-fold garment bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a flexible tri-fold garment bag in an unfolded configuration, taken from the back and left side of the bag showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof with the flexible tri-fold bag depicted in a completely folded configuration;
 FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof with the flexible tri-fold bag depicted in a completely folded configuration shown with one of the straps hanging from a hook;
 FIG. 10 is a side elevational view thereof with the flexible tri-fold bag depicted in a partially folded configuration; and,
 FIG. 11 is a perspective view, taken from above and on the left side, thereof depicted in a completely folded configuration shown with one of the straps hanging from a hook.
 The broken line portions of the disclosure are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

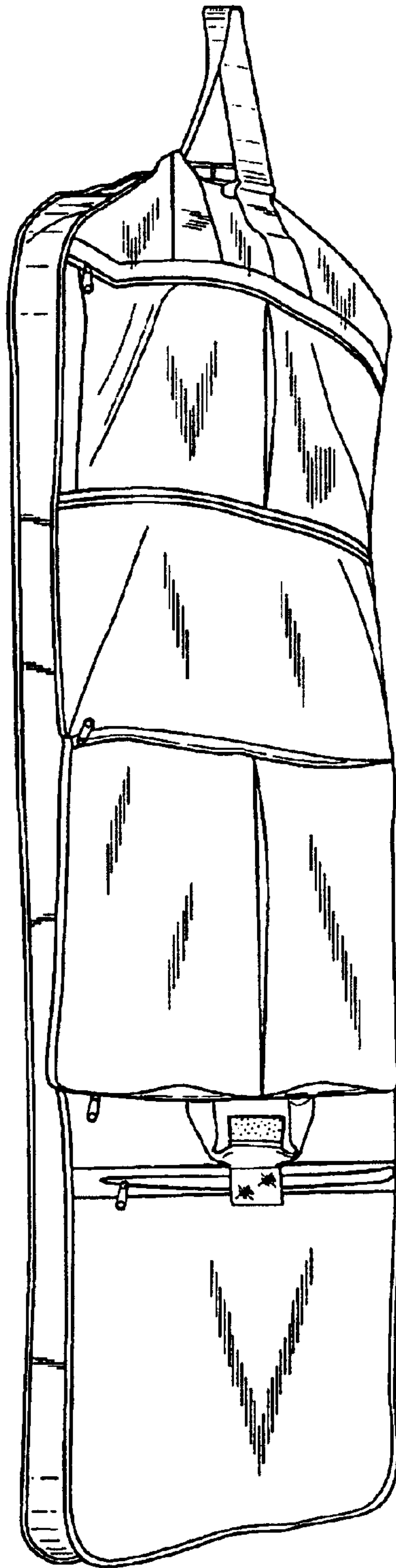

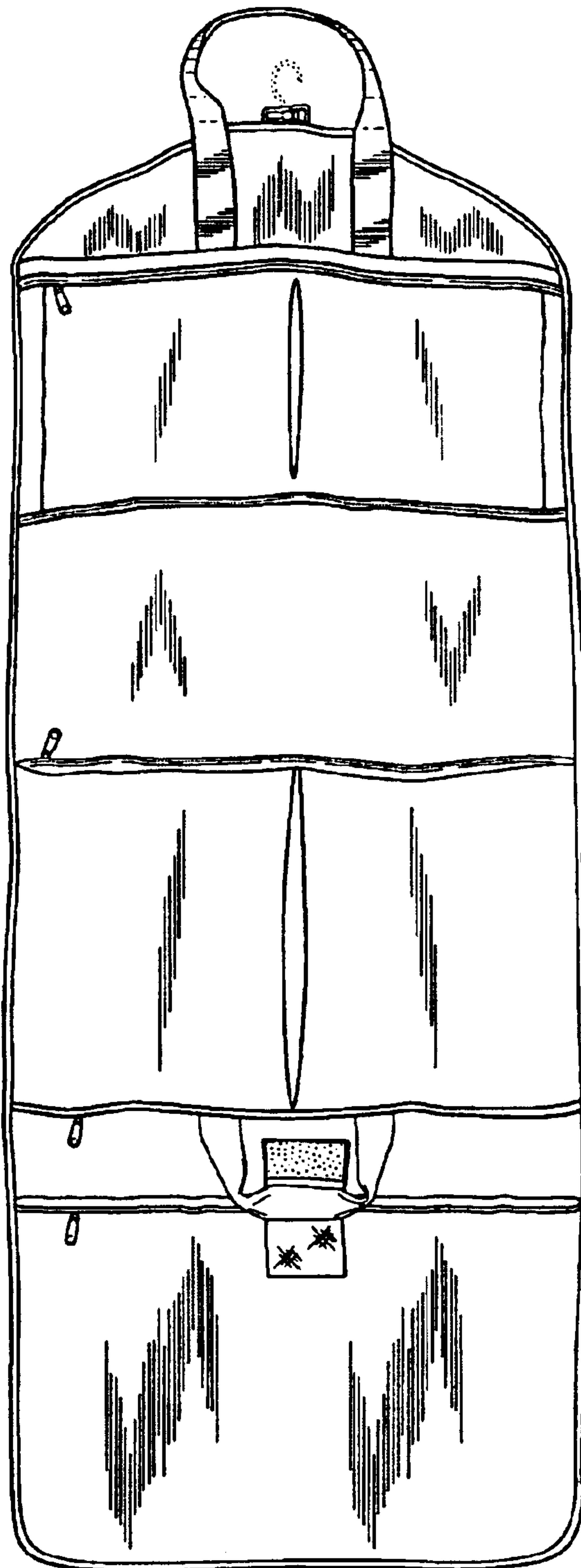

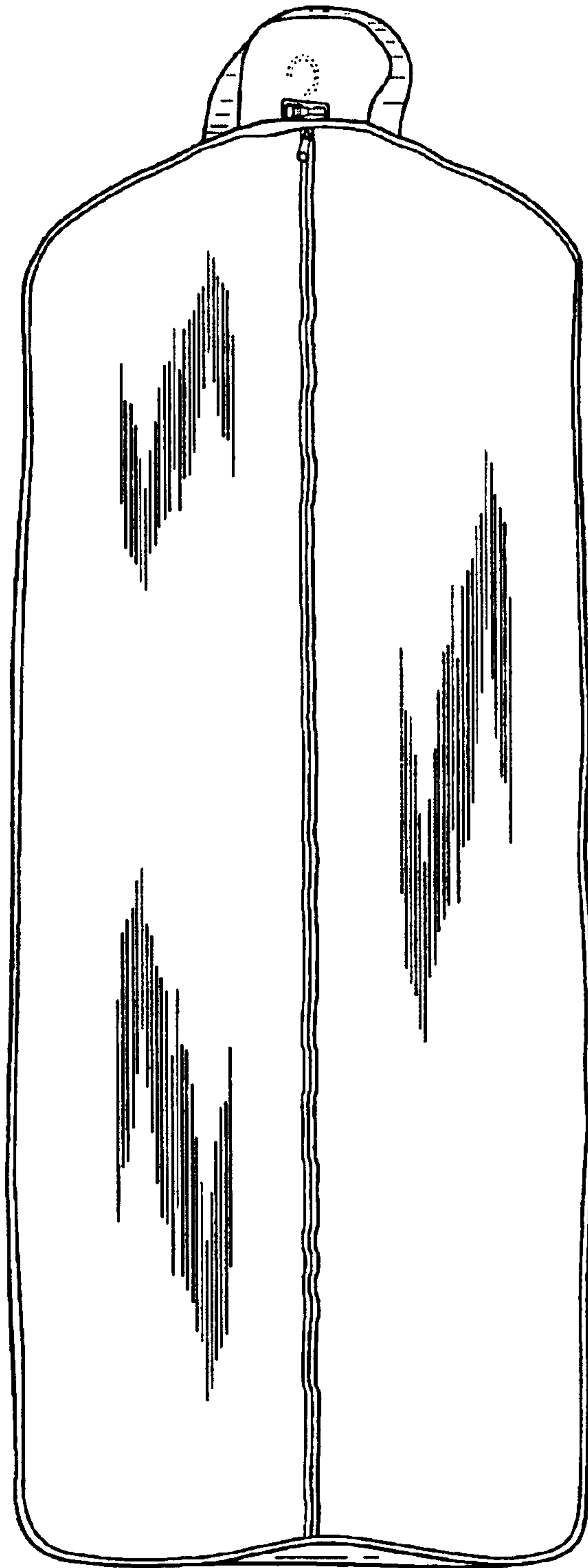

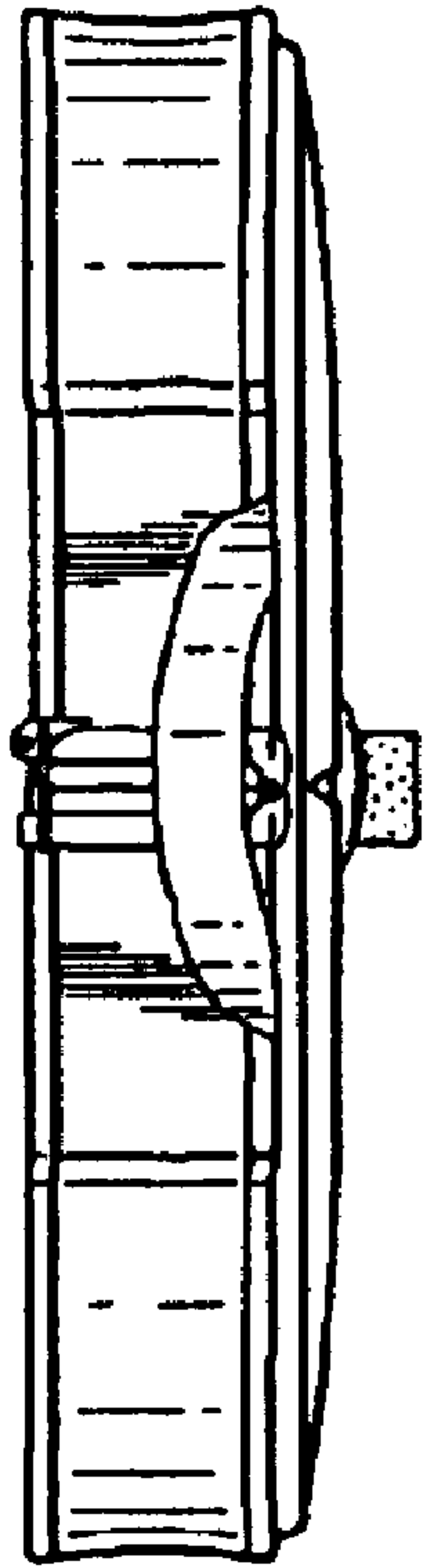

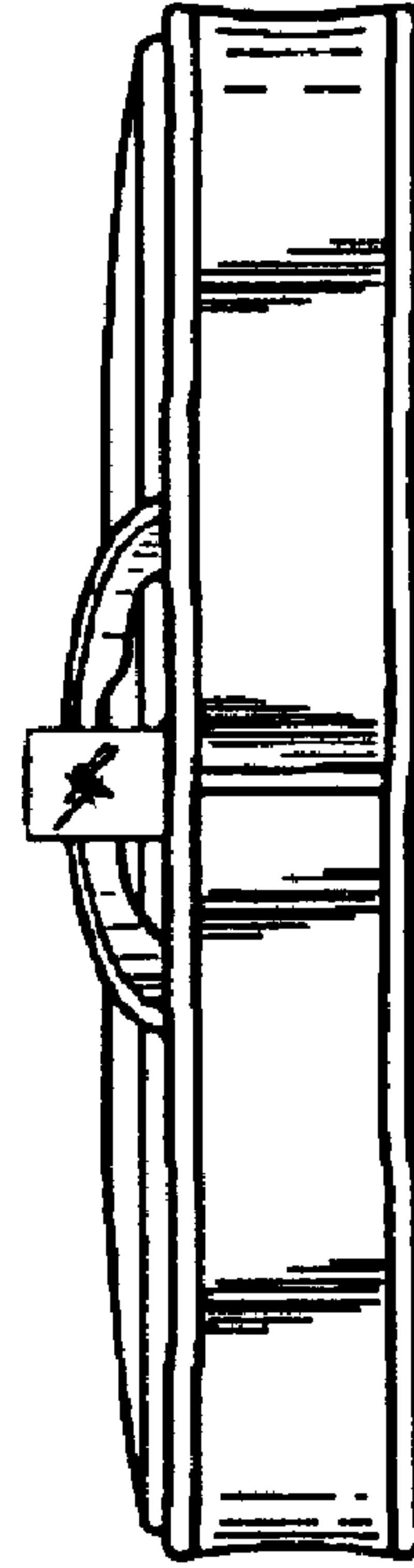

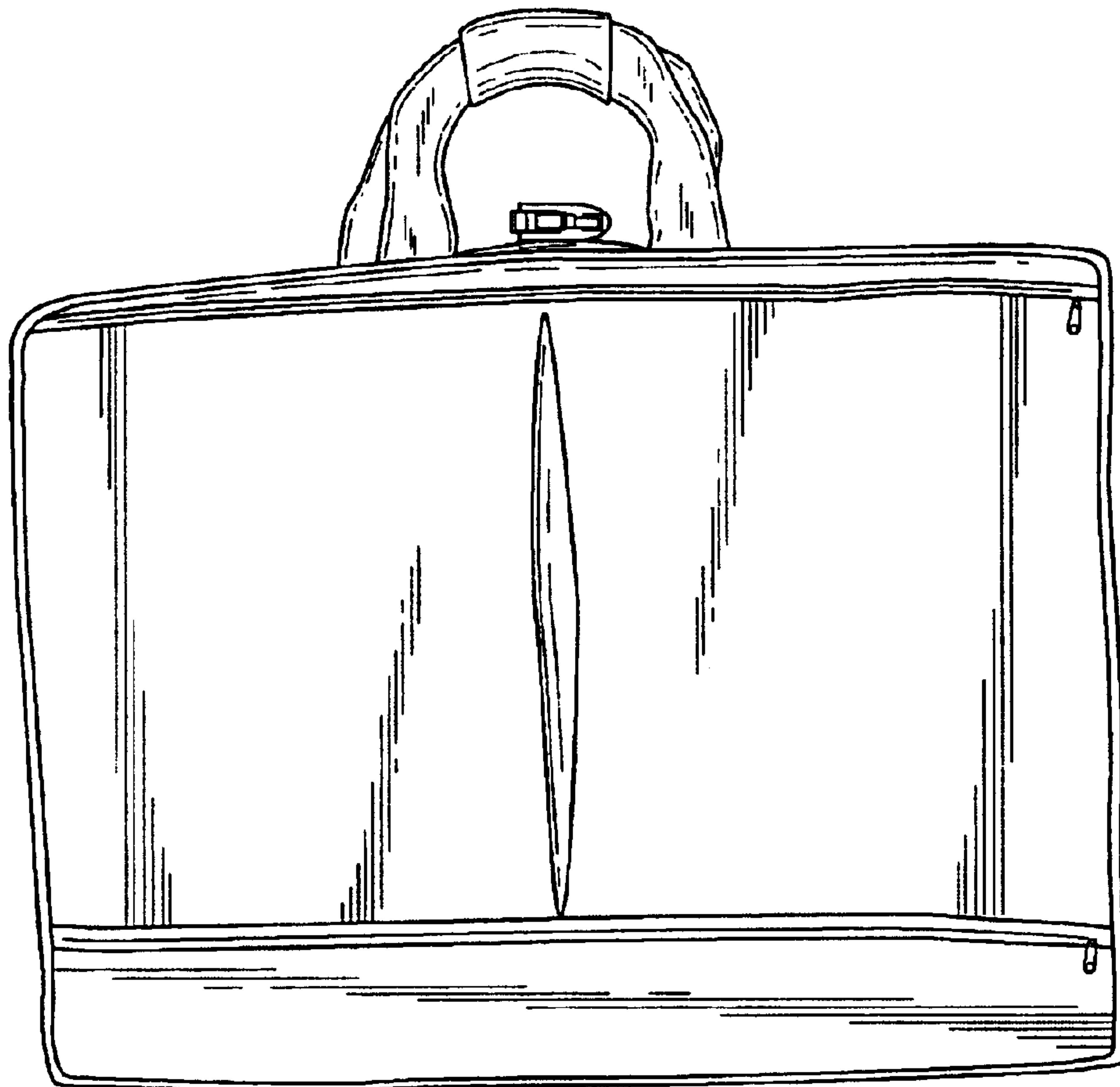

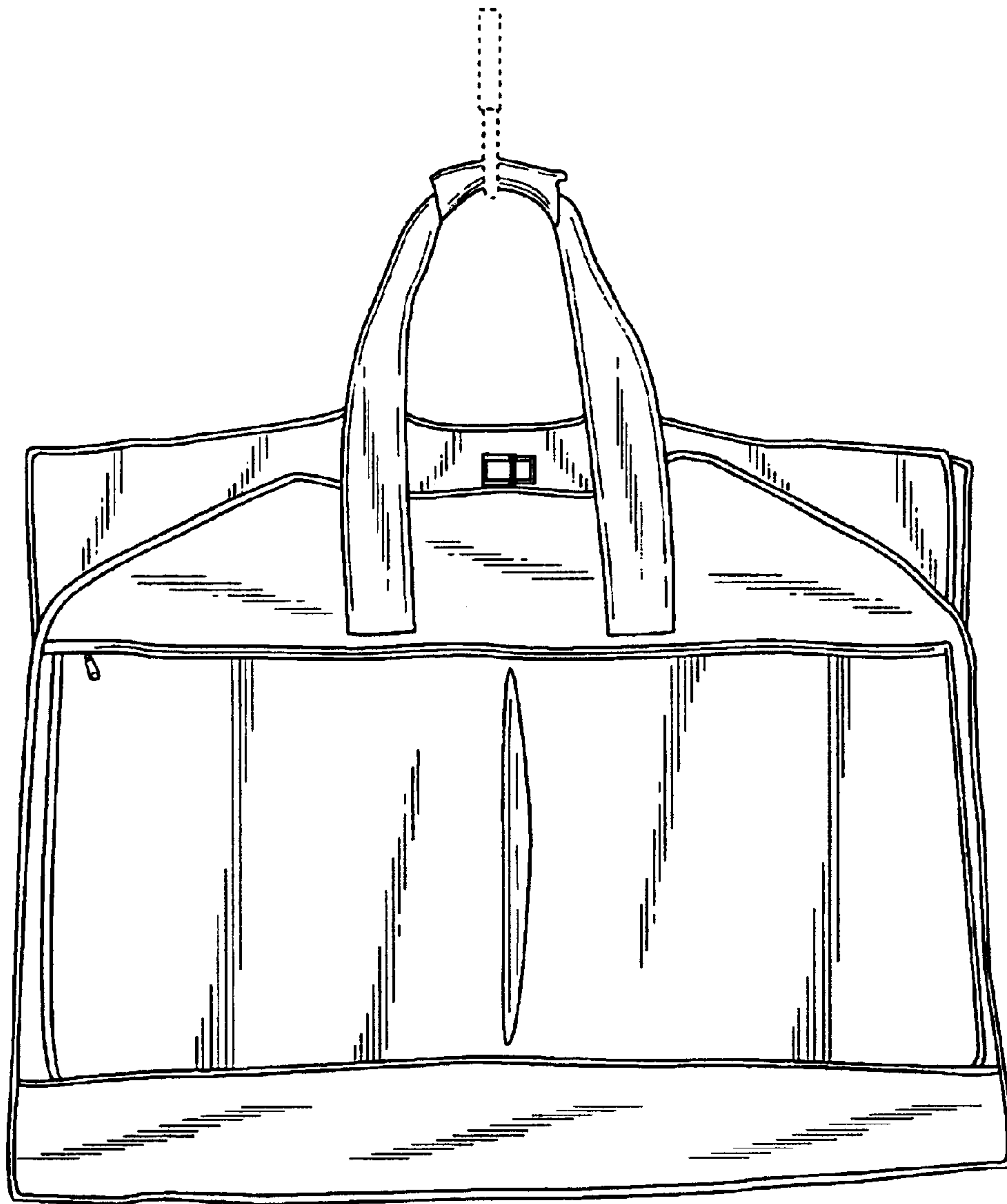

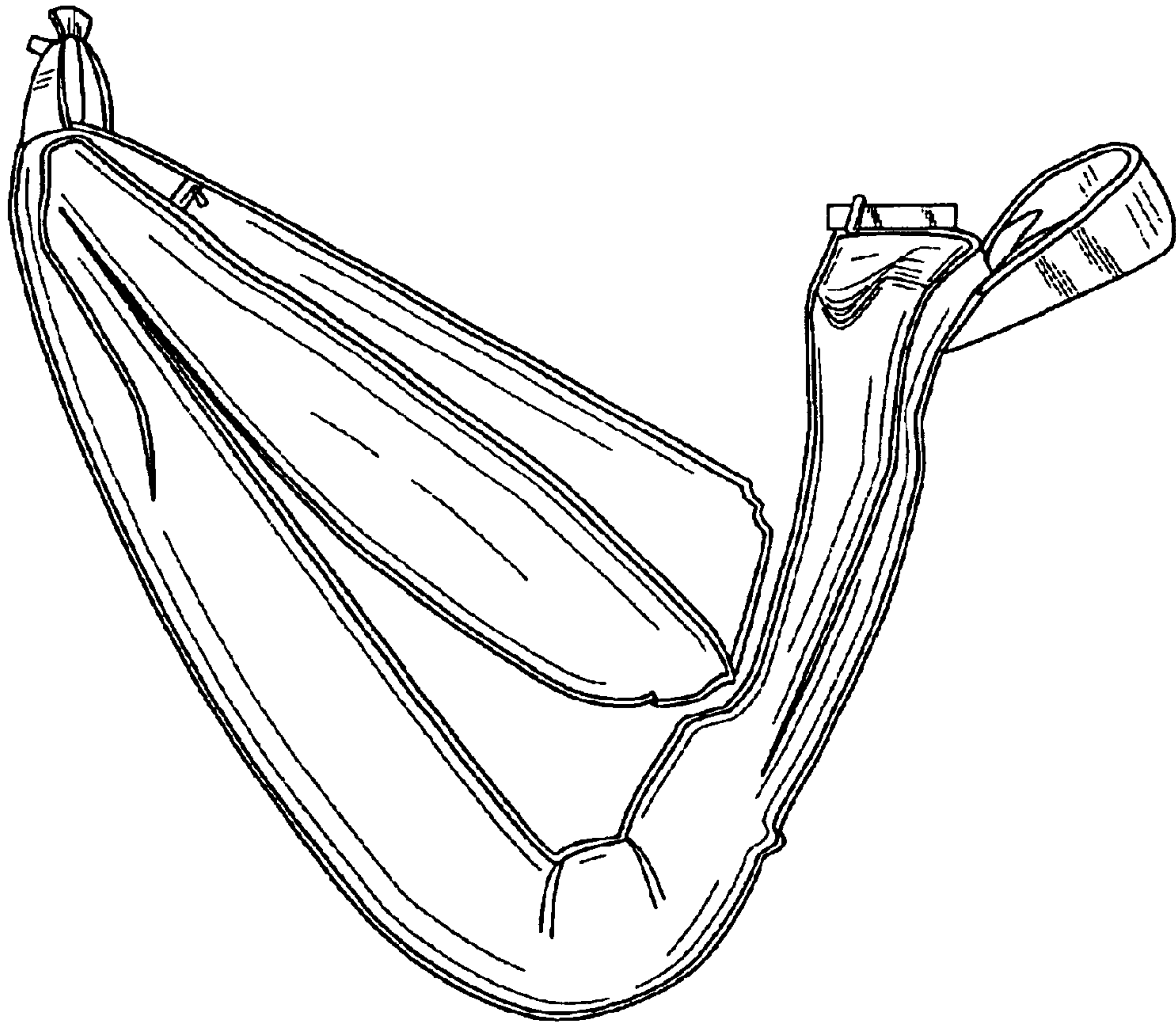

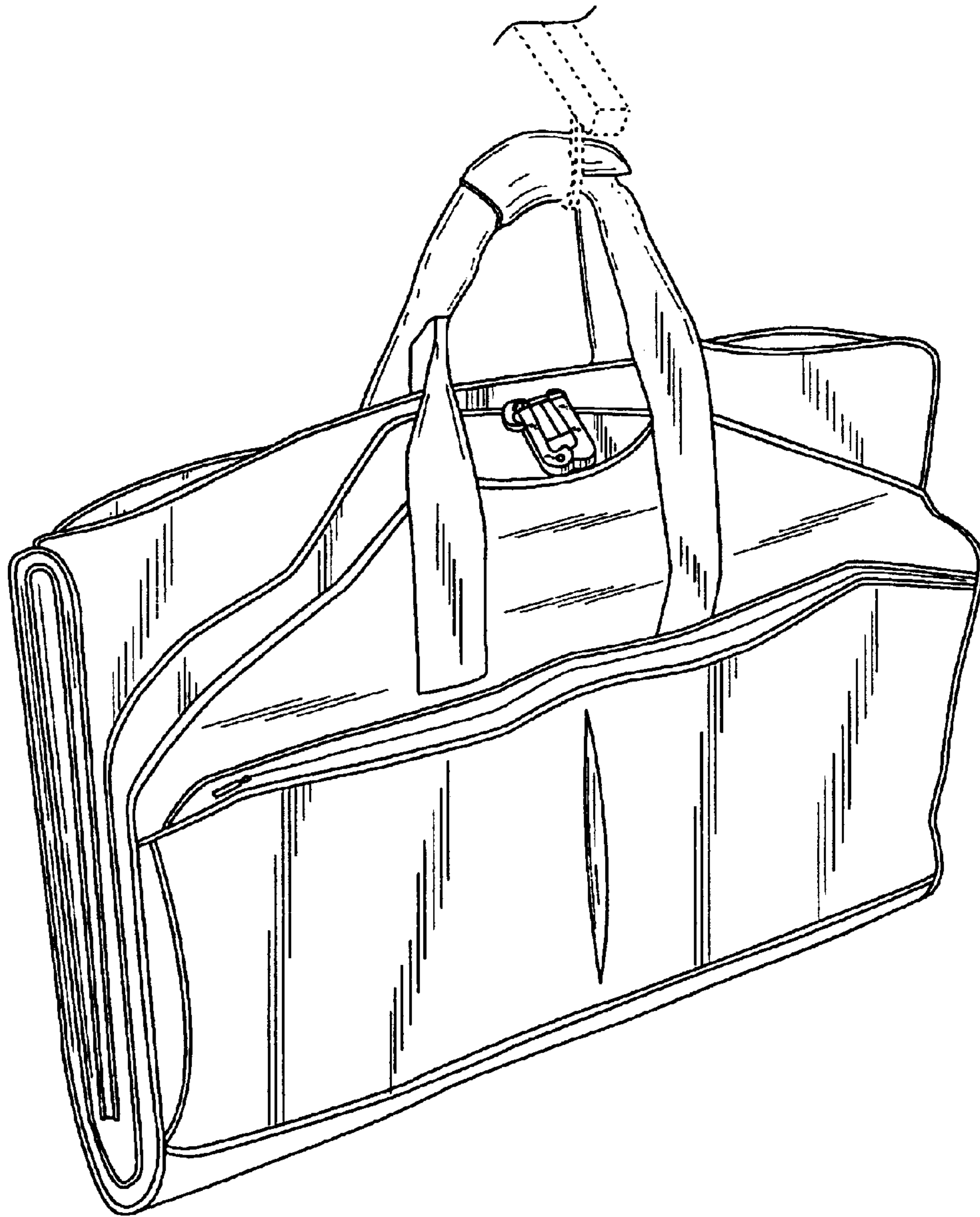
