FIG. 1 is a front view of the armoire of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a right side view of the armoire of the present invention, the left side being a mirror image.

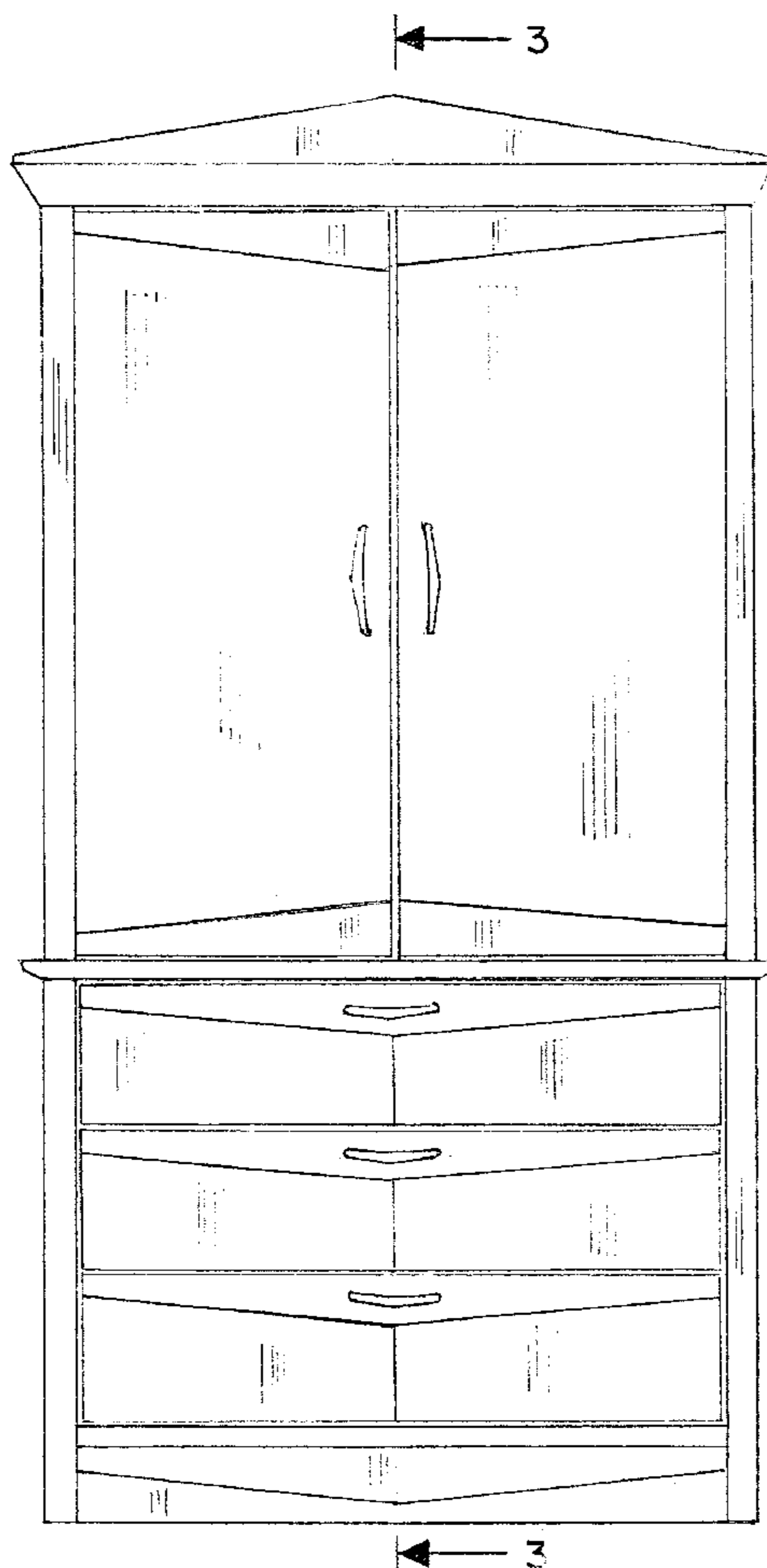

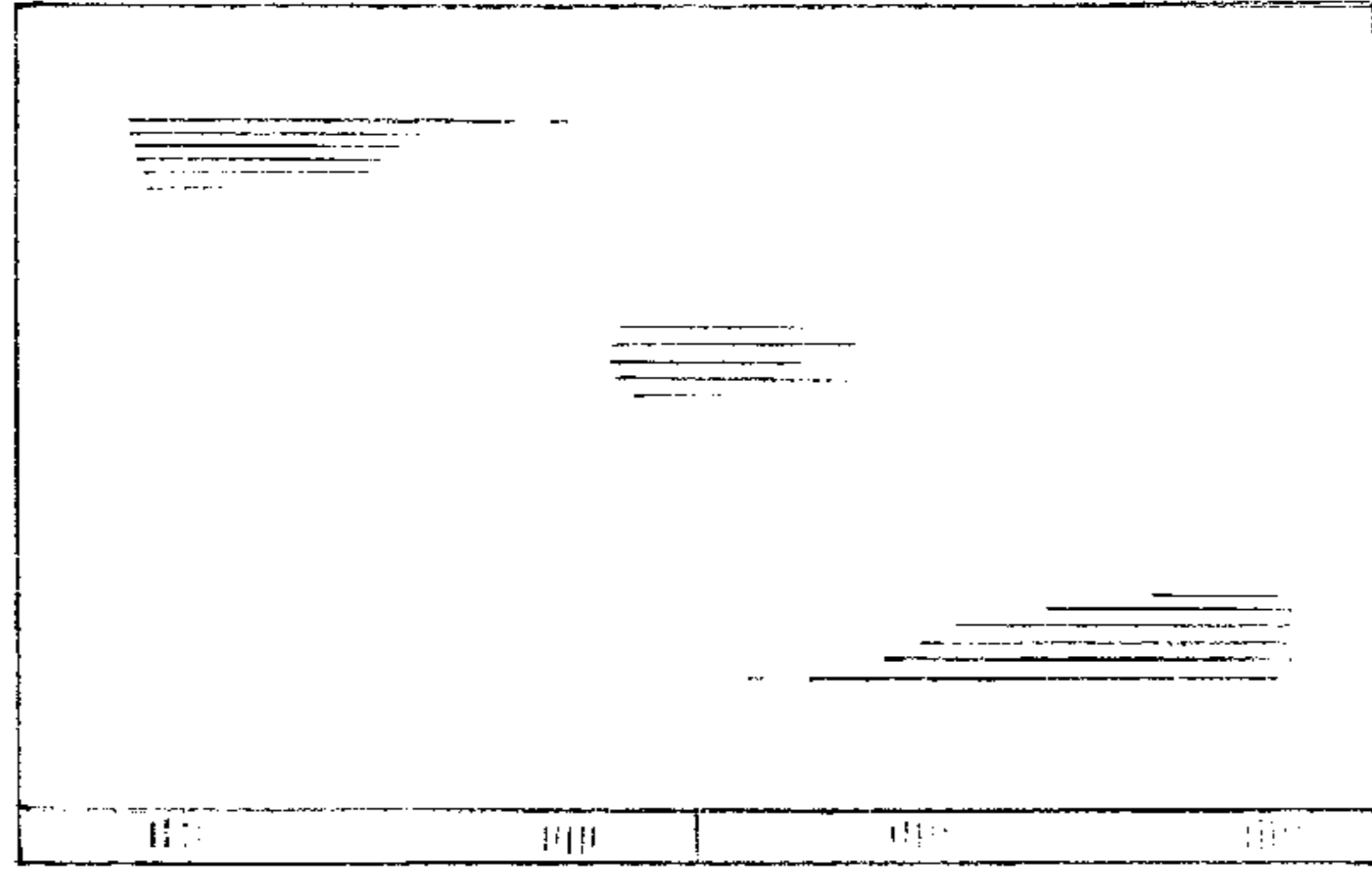

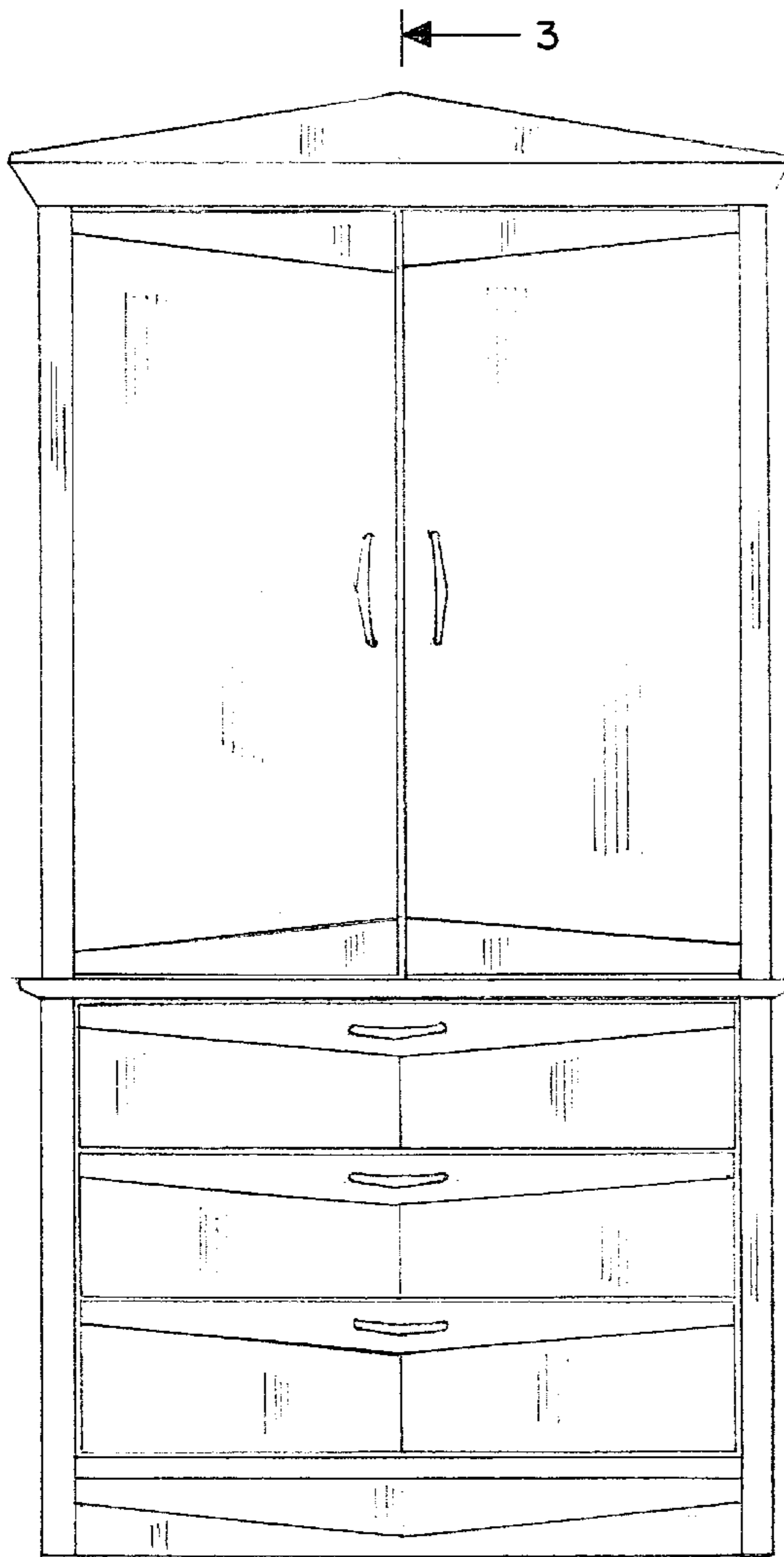

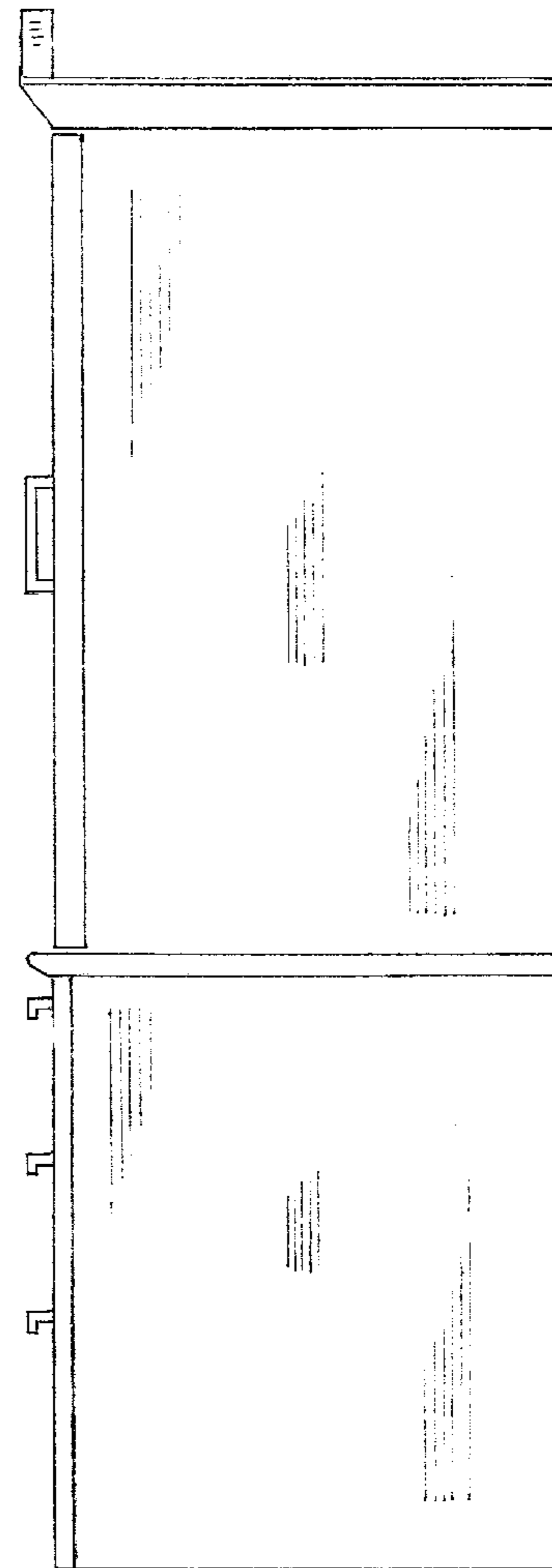

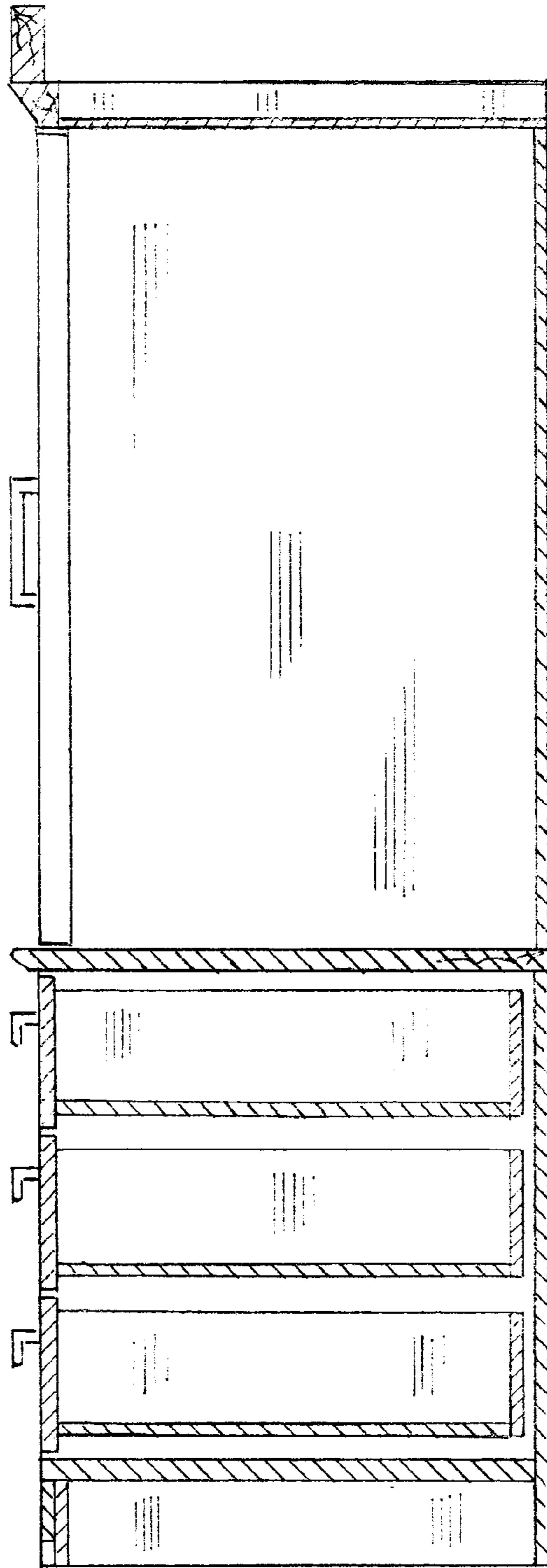
