FIG. 6 is a first side view thereof;

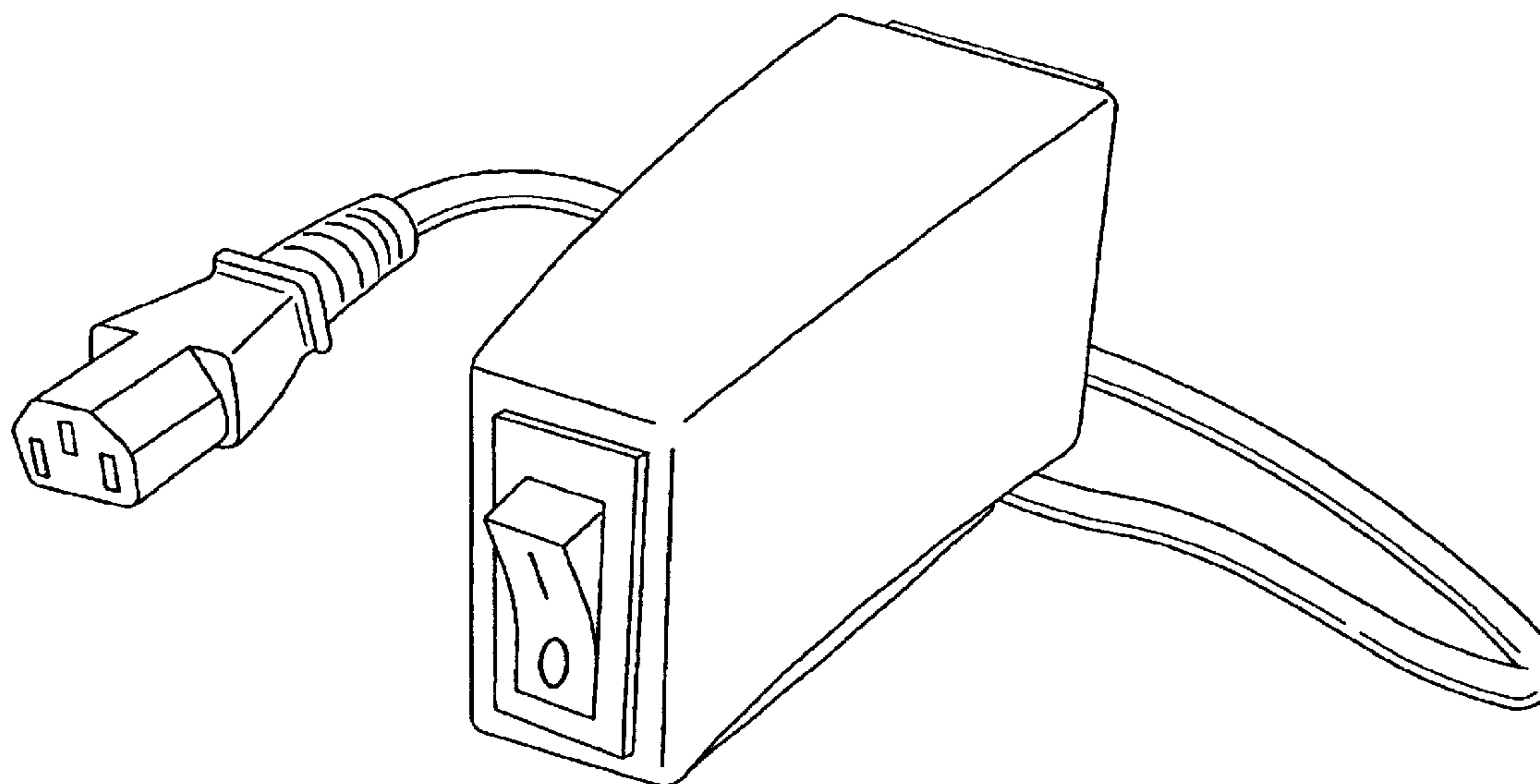
FIG. 7 is a front view thereof;

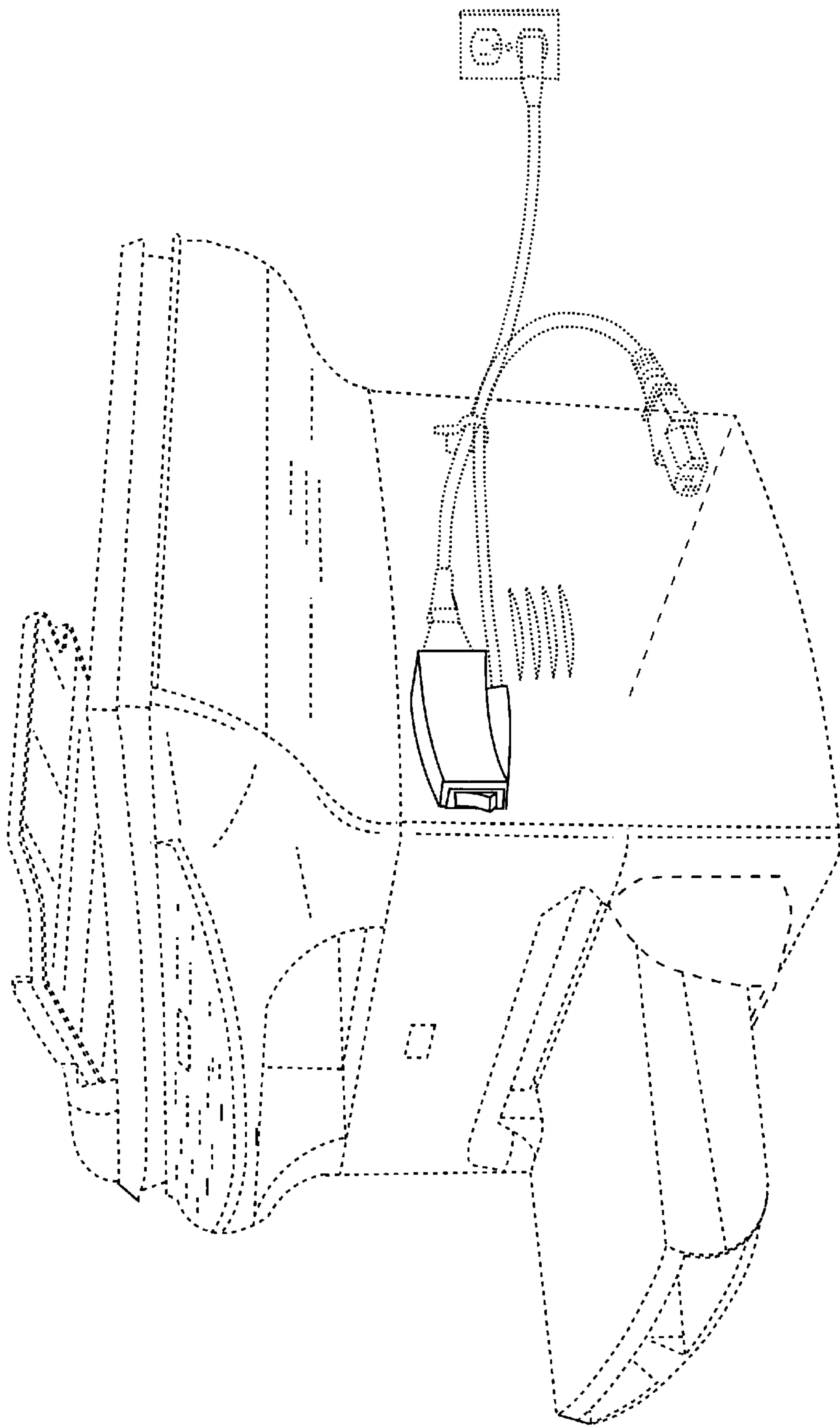

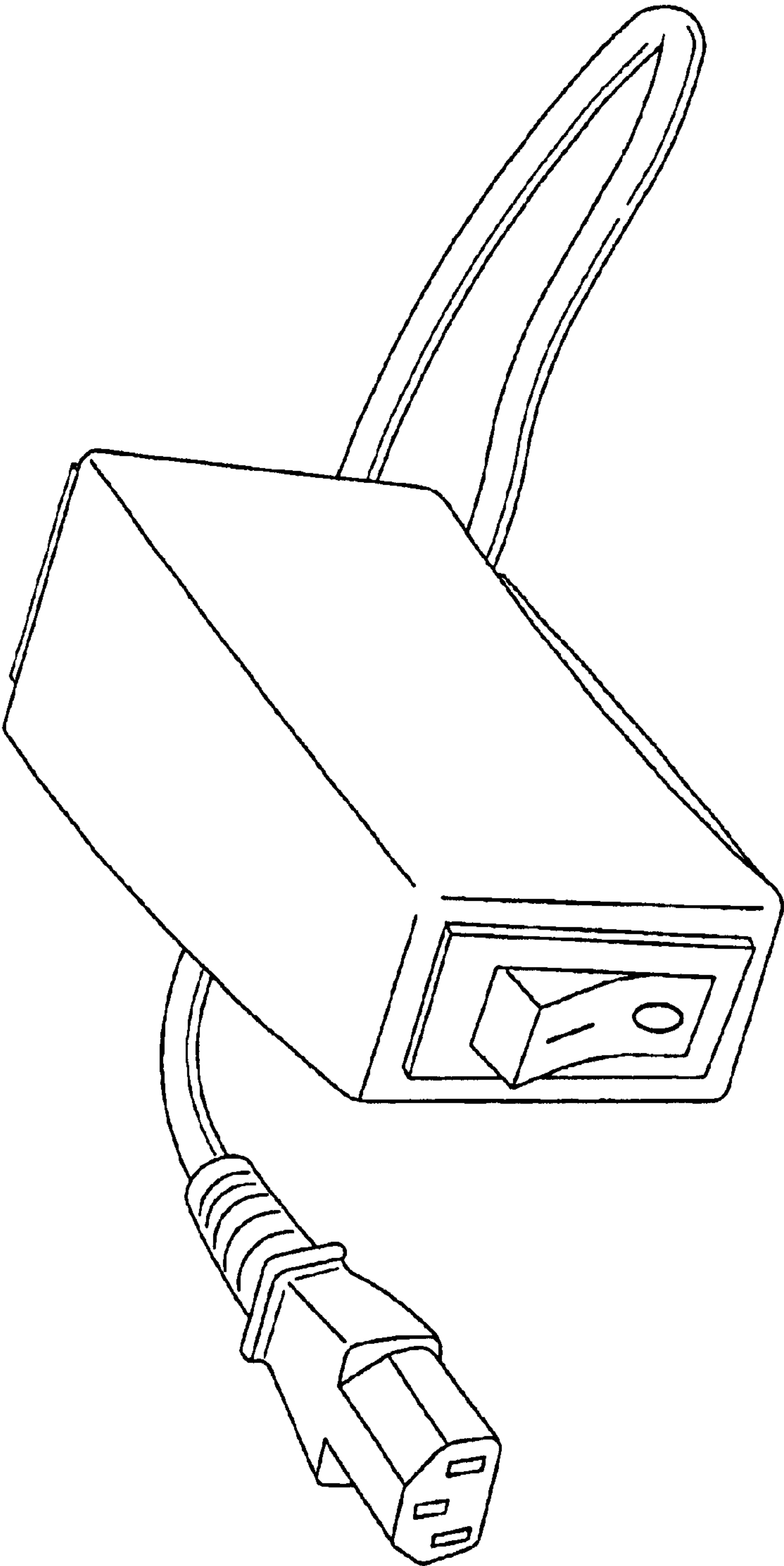

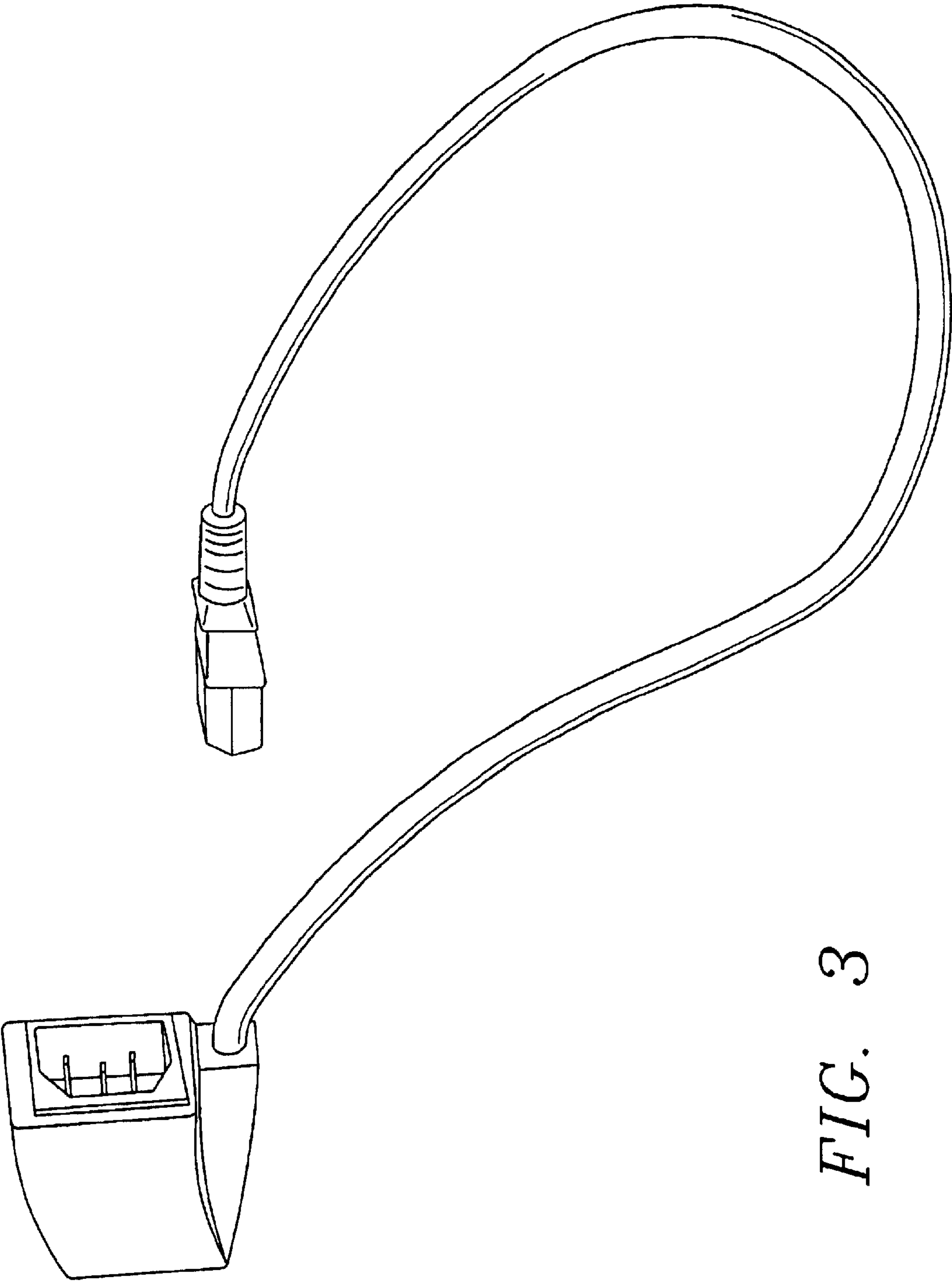

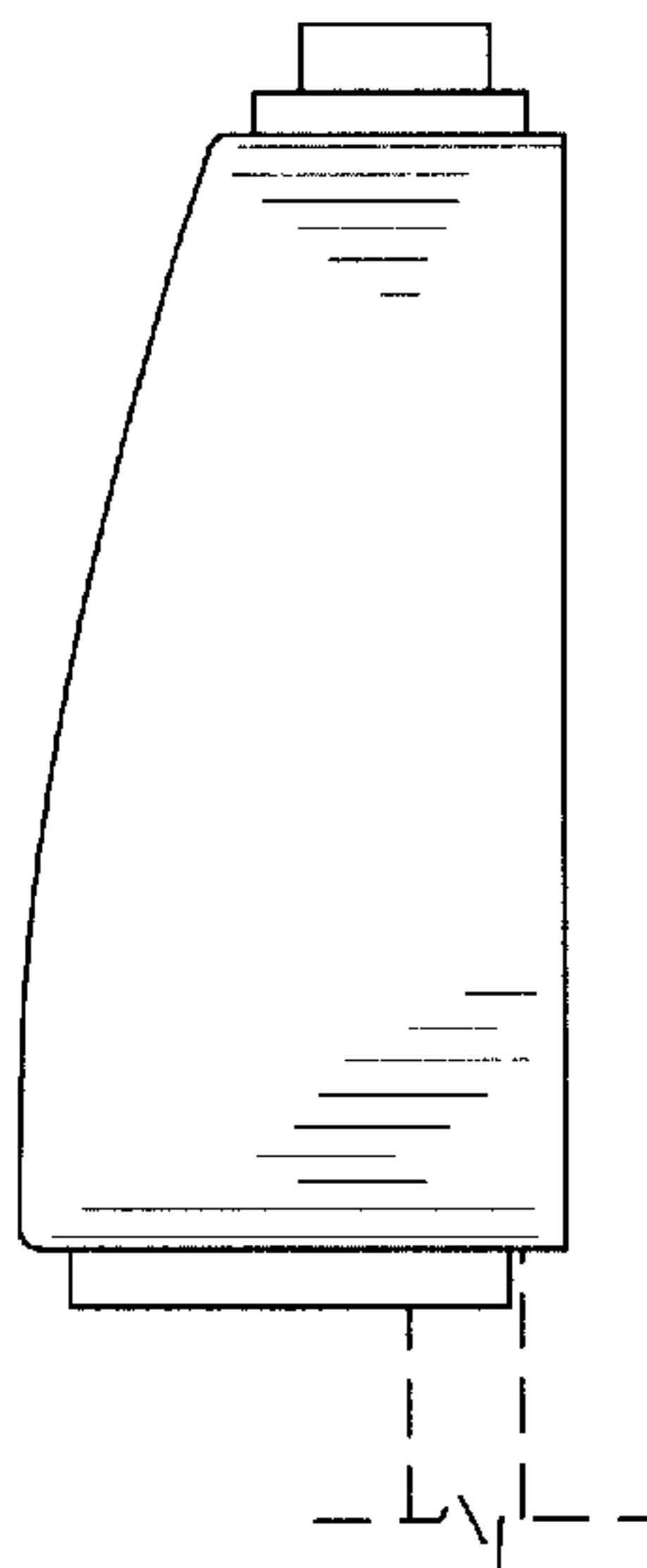

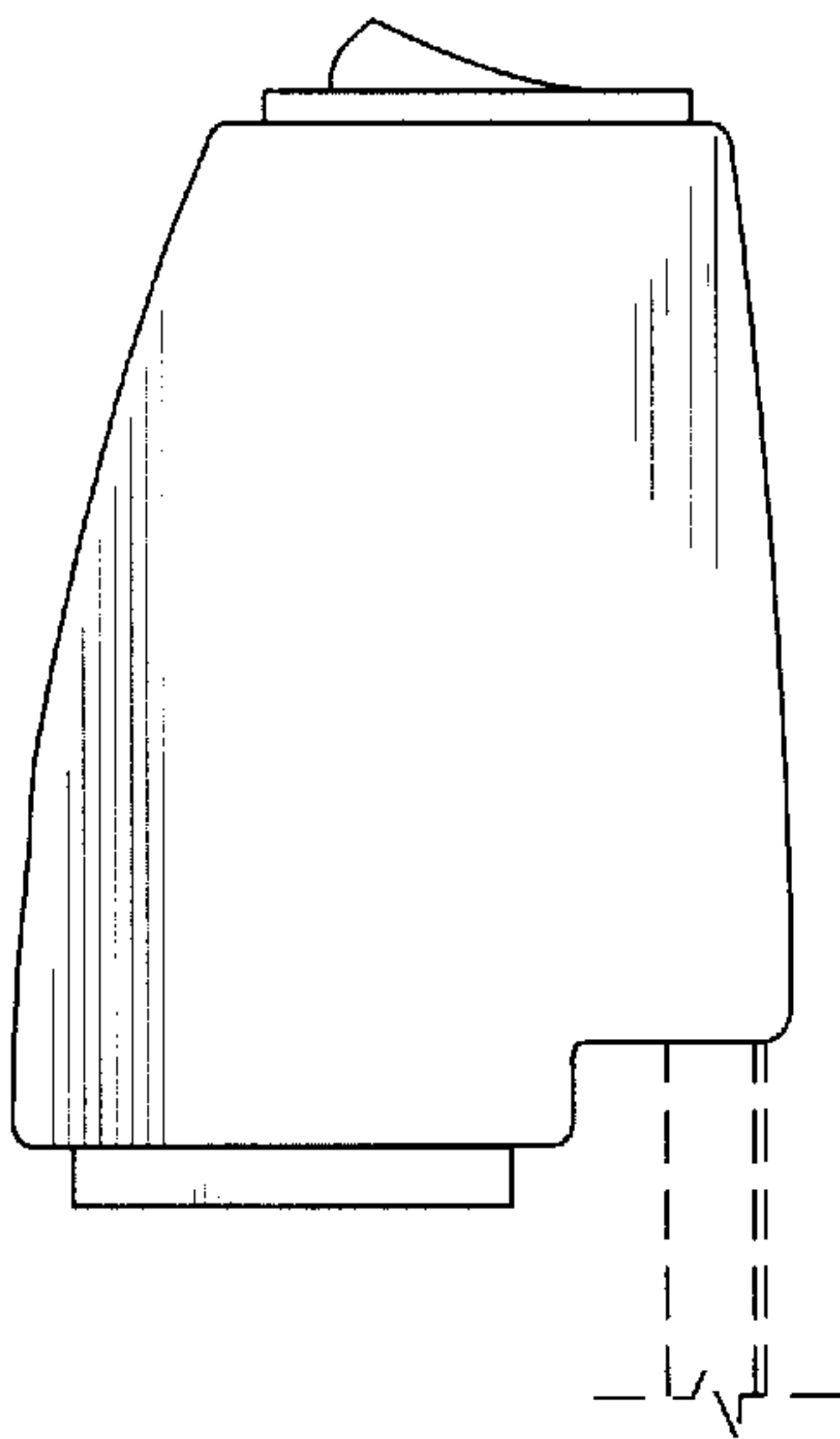

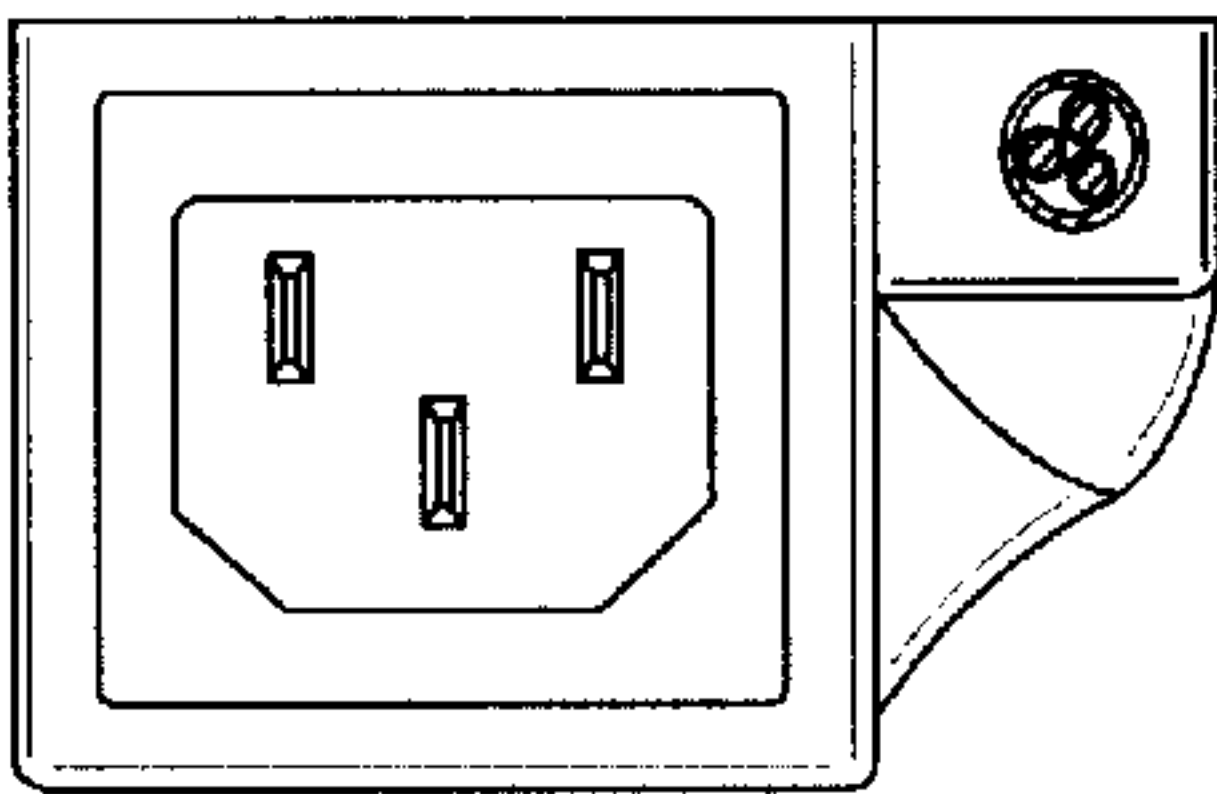

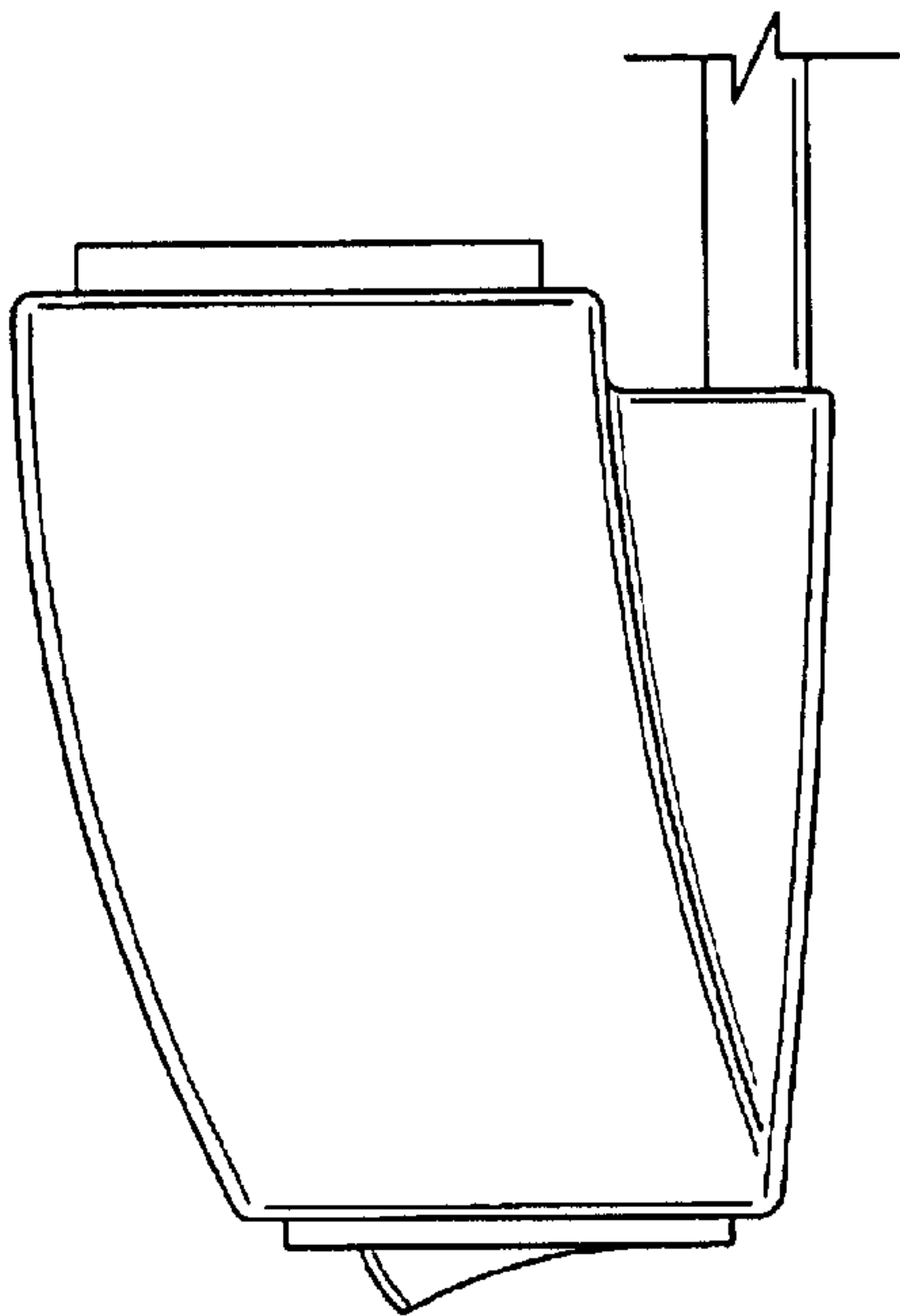

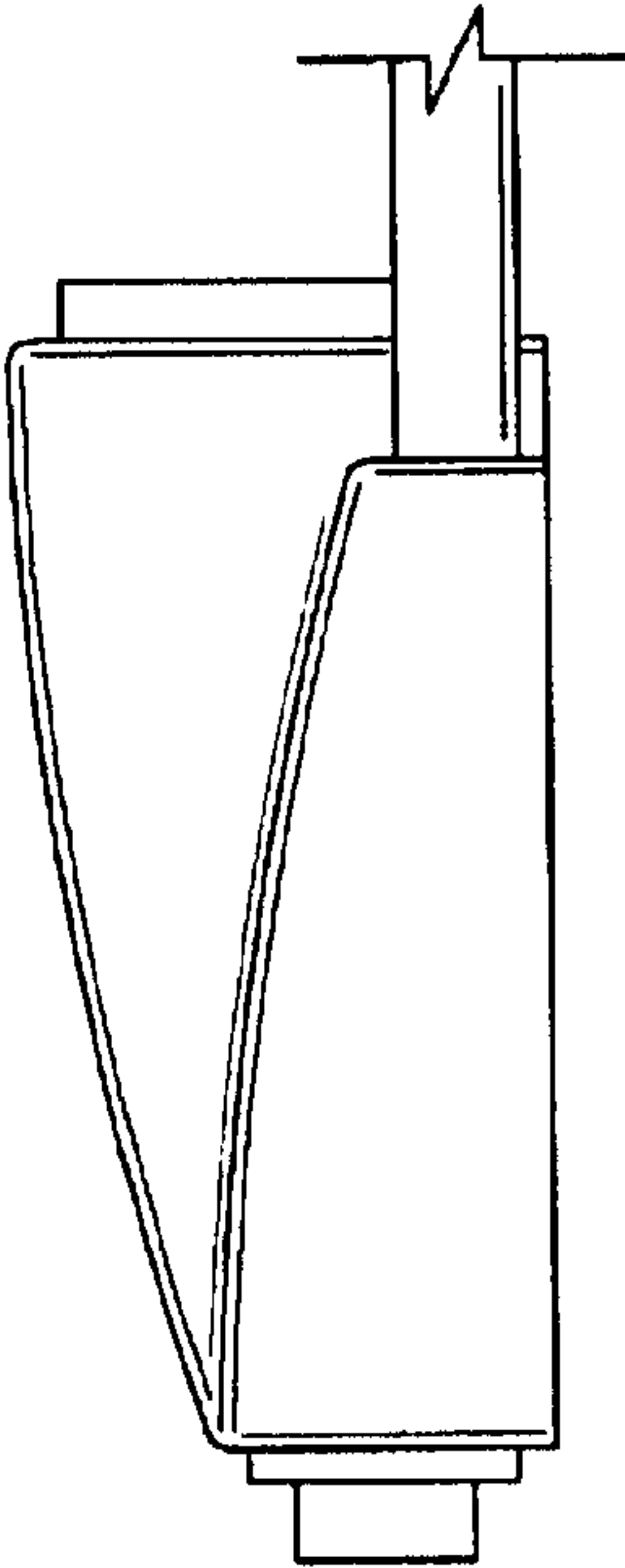

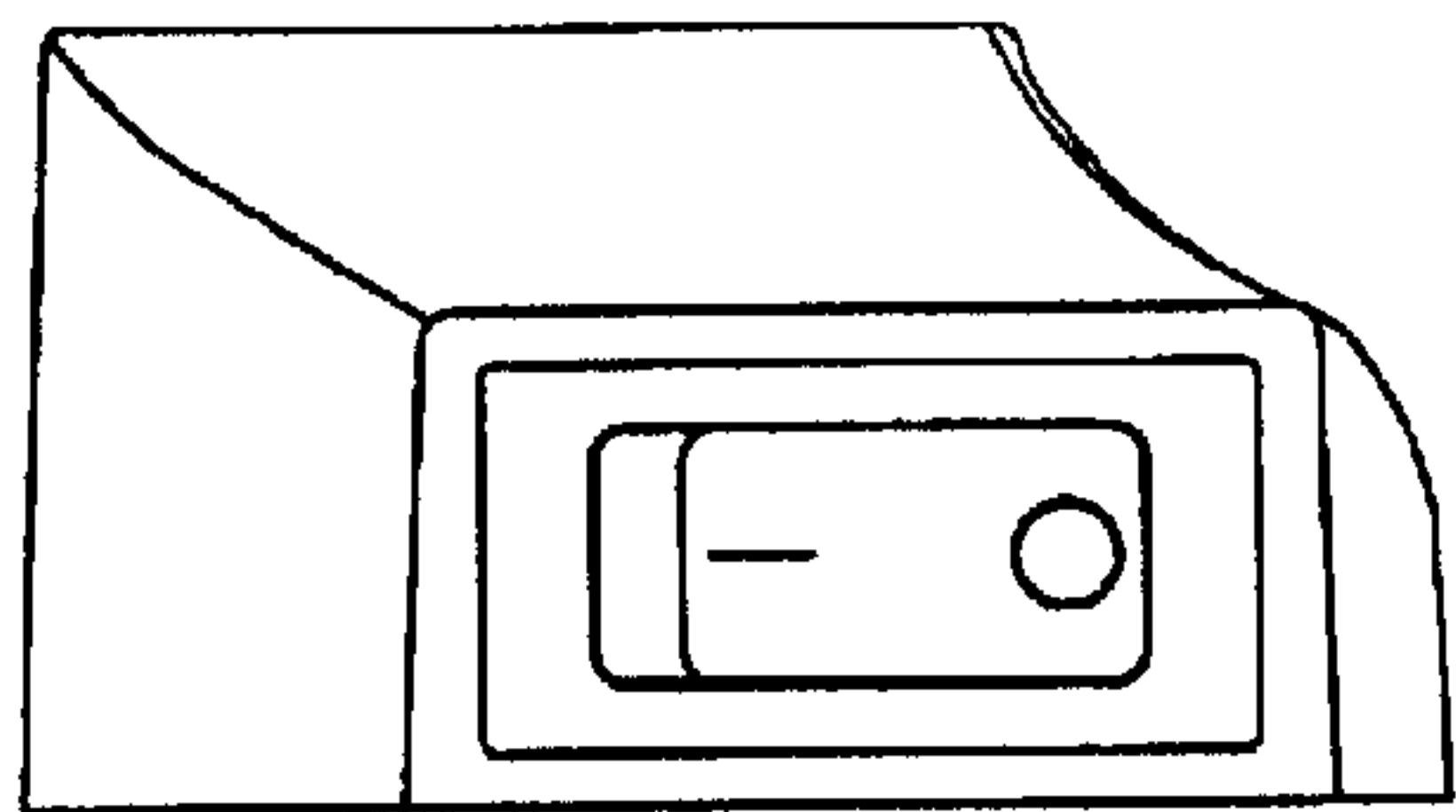
