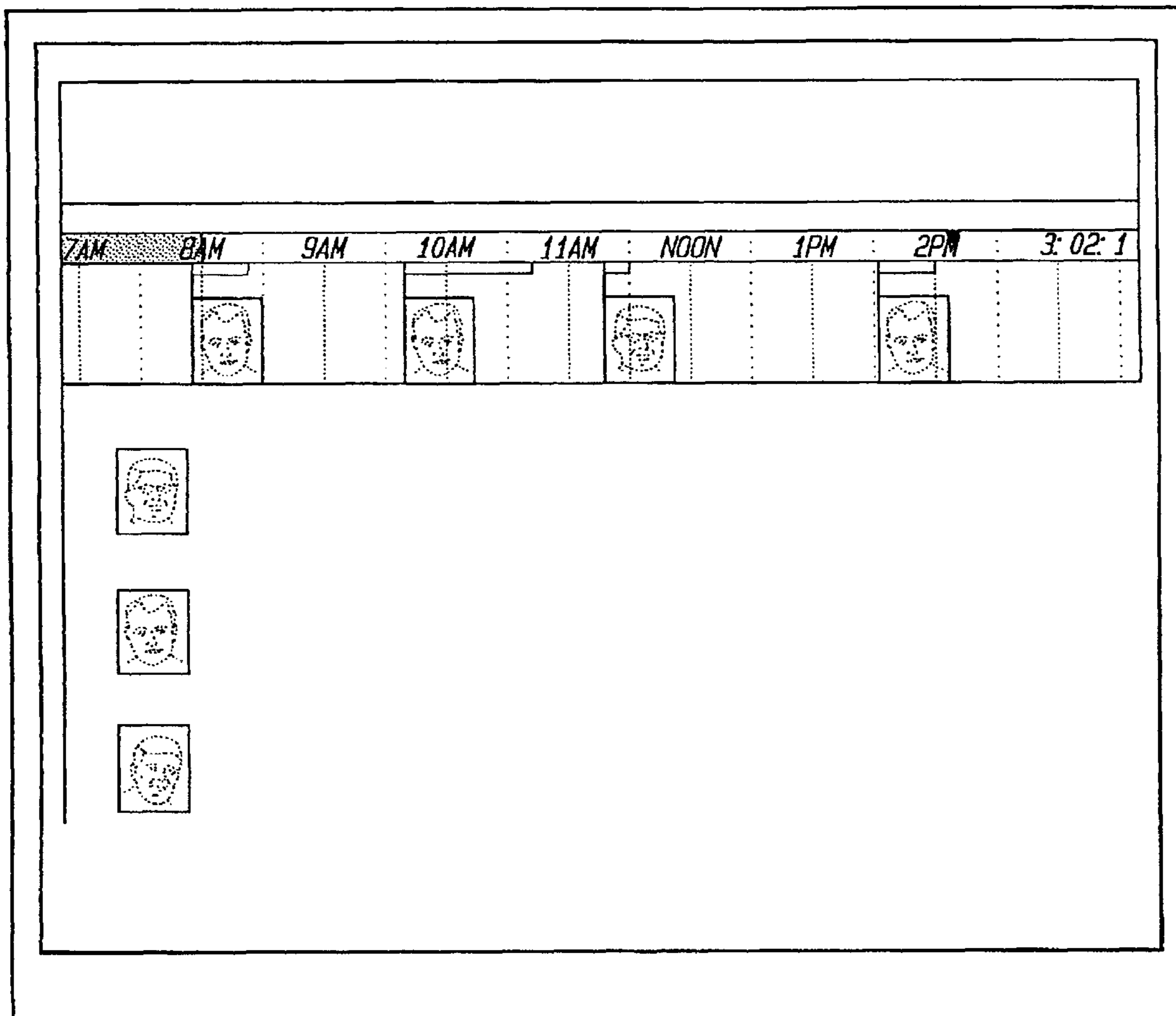
(57) **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a timeline for a computer display
according to the invention;
FIG. 2 is front view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view of a third embodiment thereof; and,

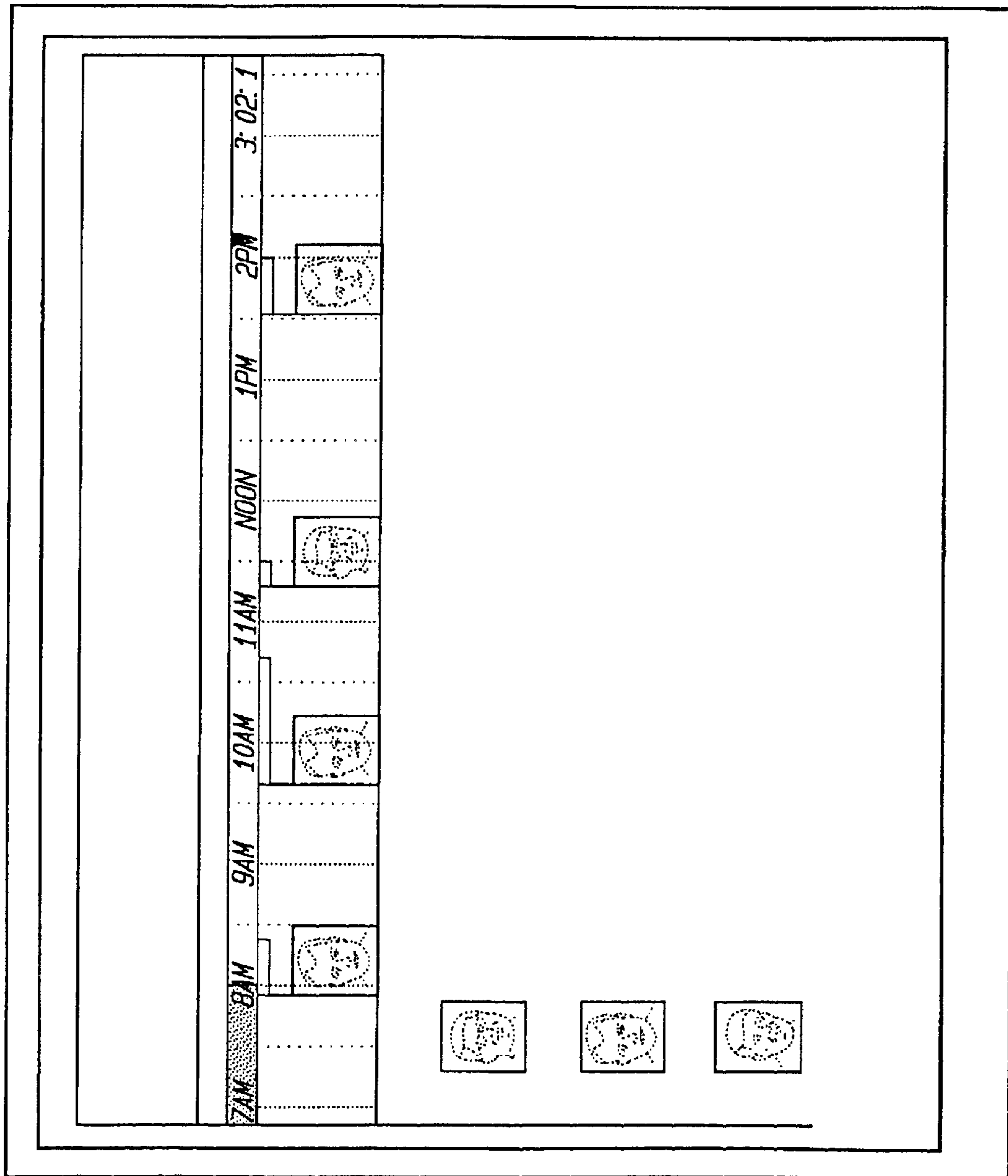

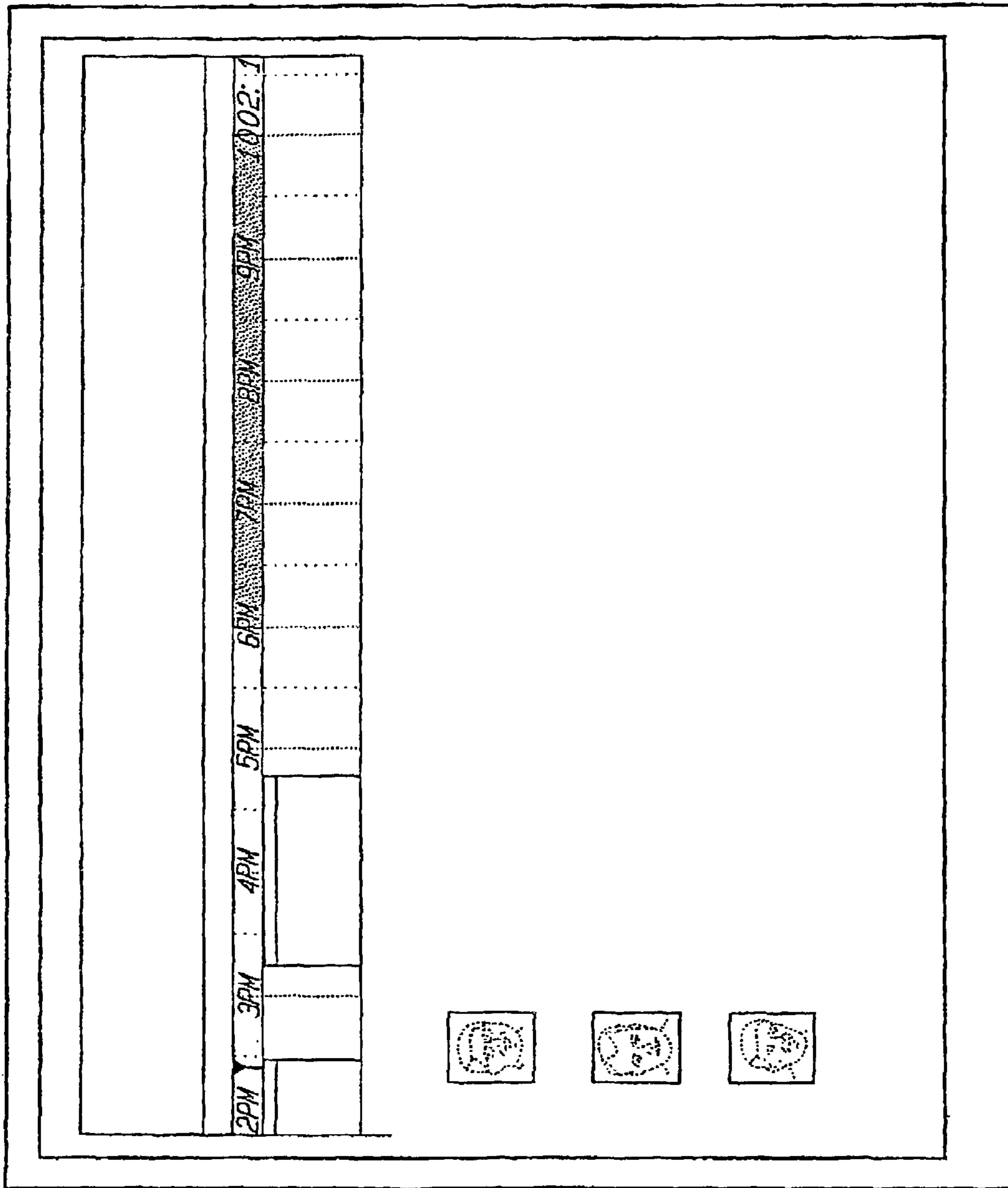

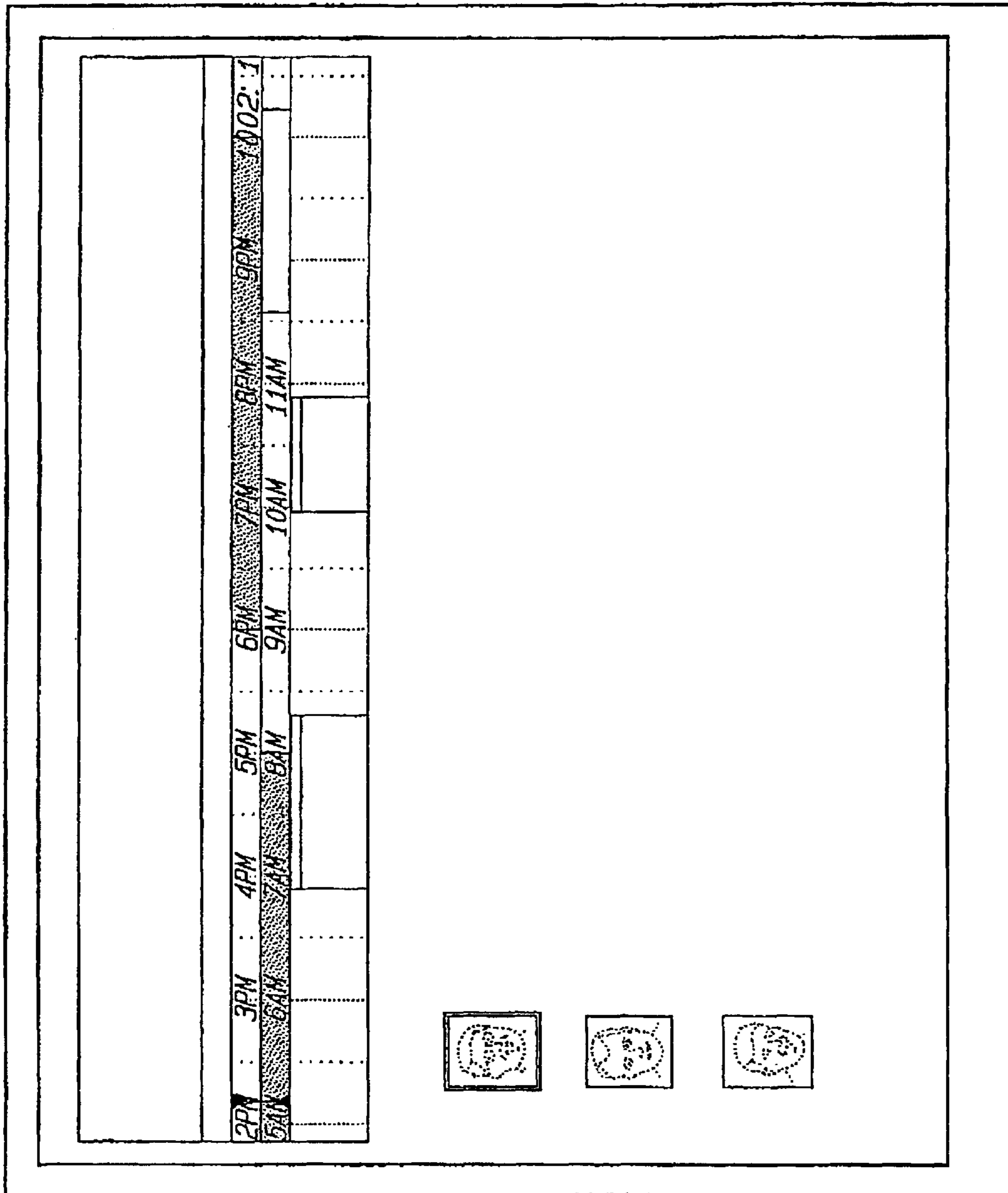

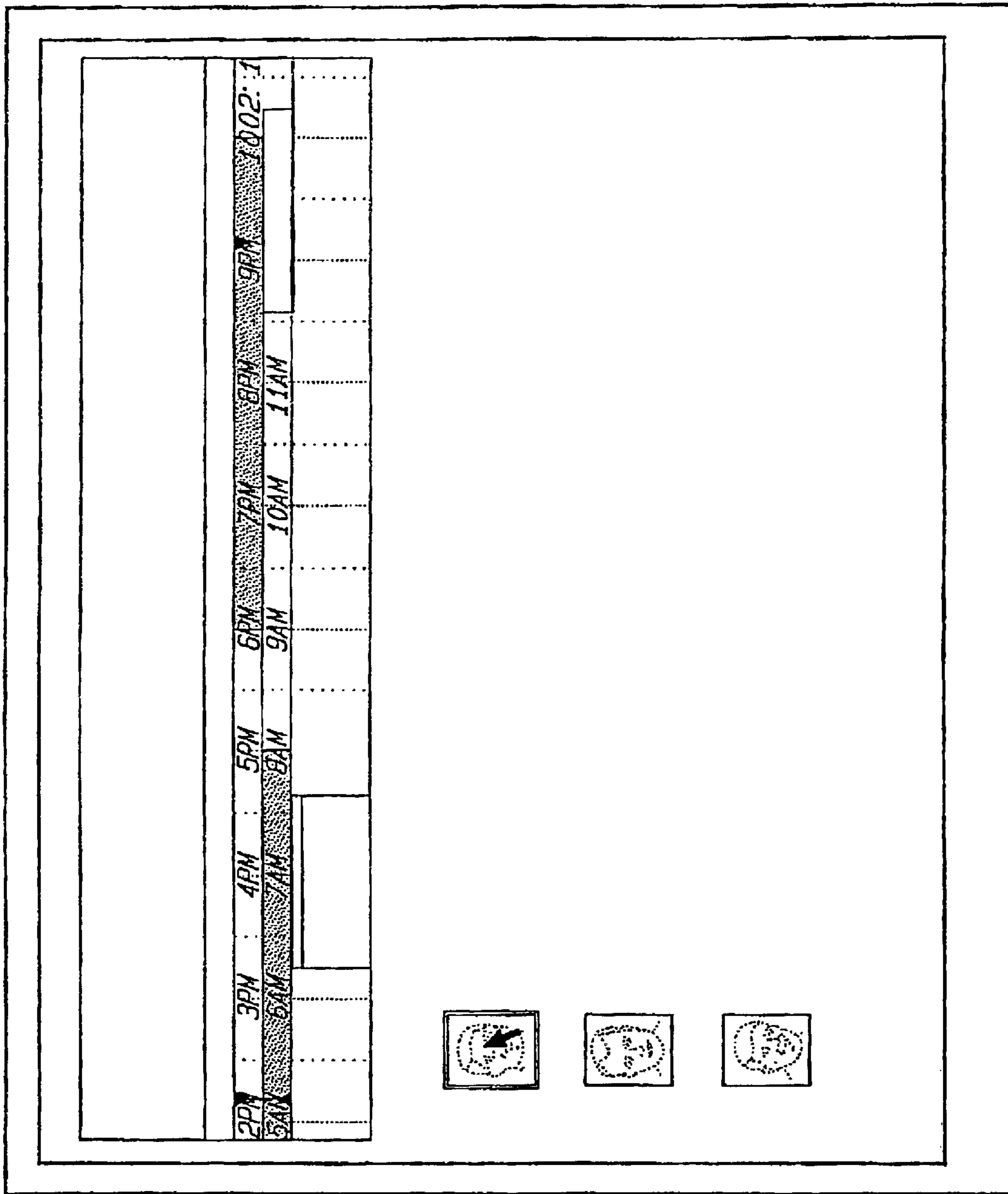
